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[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a permanent wave rod, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a permanent wave rod showing my new design in extended position;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view on an enlarged scale of the rod in engaged position, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the rod as shown in FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

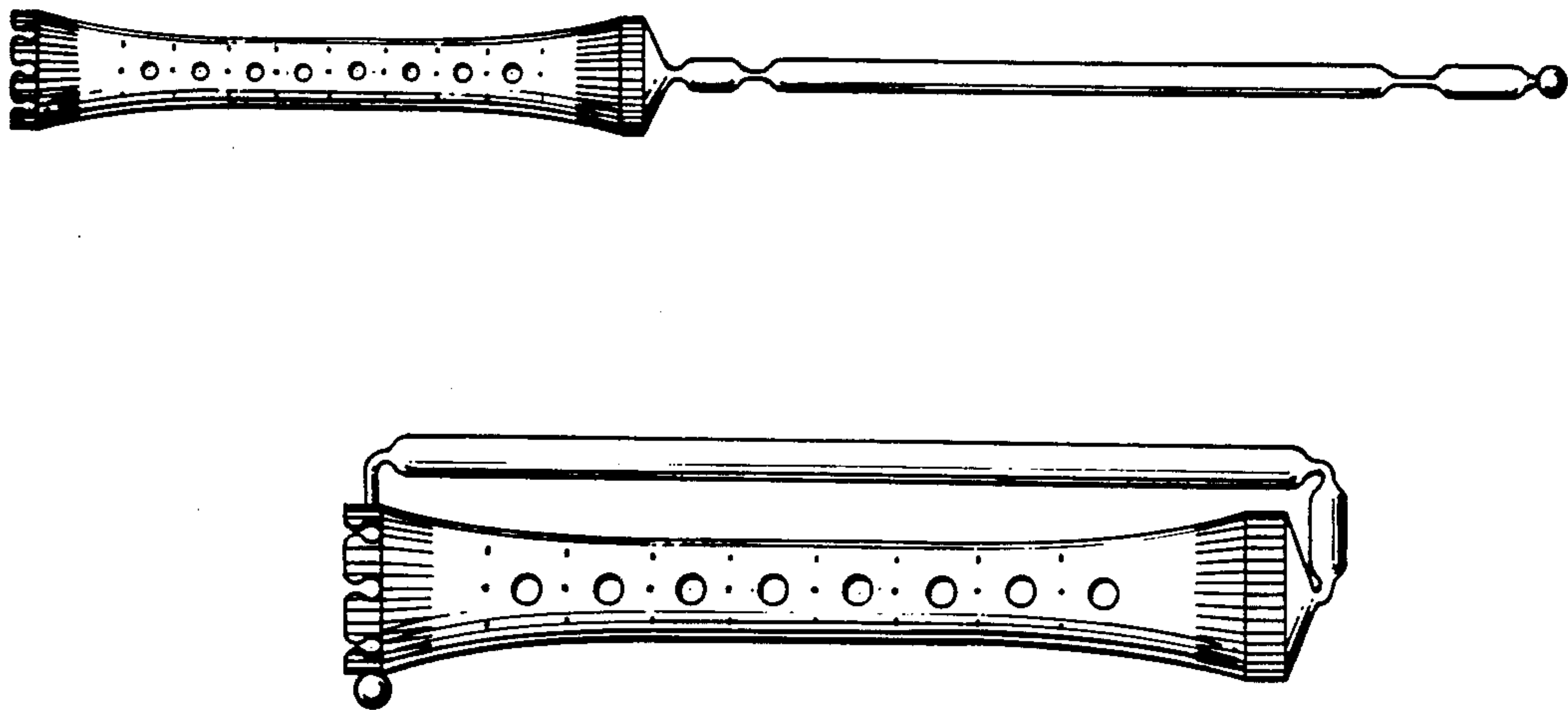

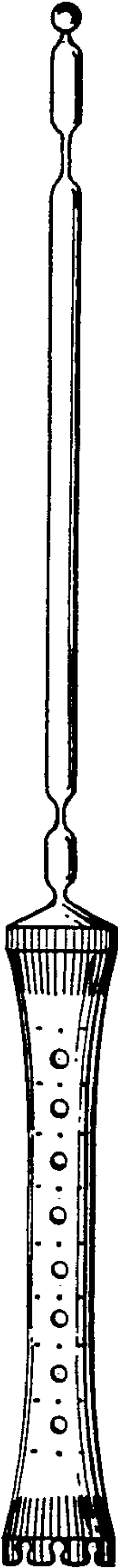

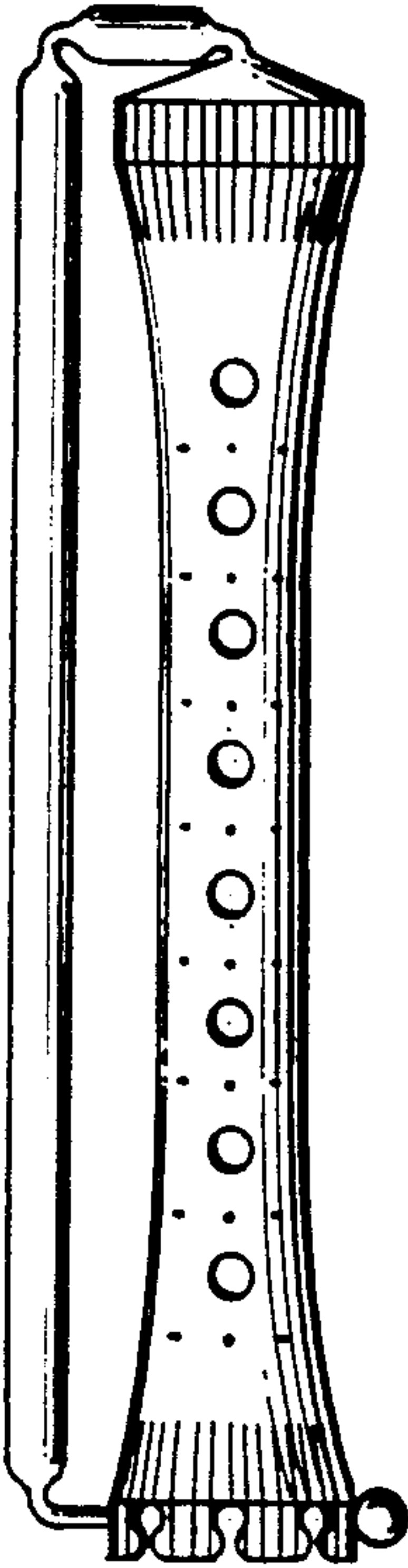

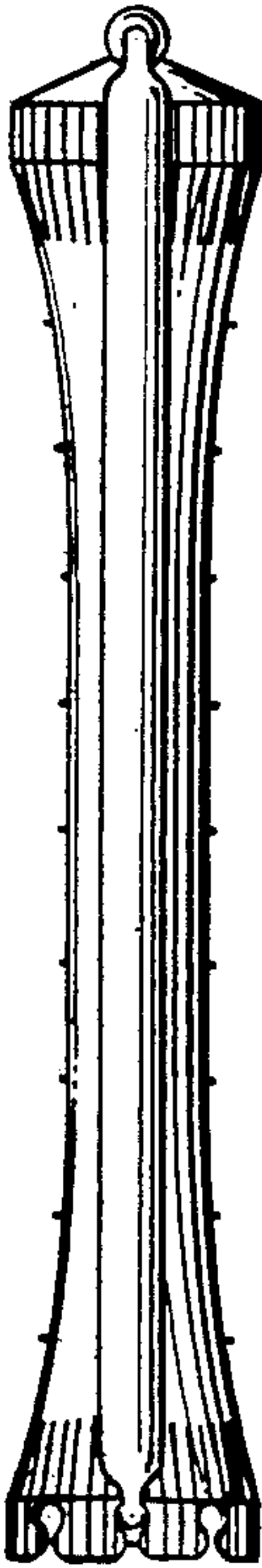

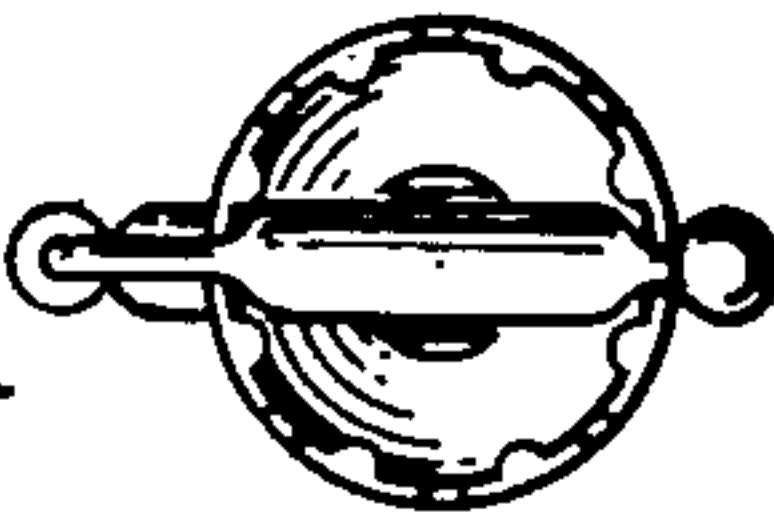
