[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tray, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above showing a tray embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The thickness of the material of the tray is substantially uniform throughout; and so the appearance of the two inner sides not visible in FIG. 1 will be apparent from a comparison of FIGS. 1 and 4. Similarly, the appearance of the bottom of the tray when viewed in top plan, is apparent from FIG. 4 except that the ribs on the underside of the tray bottom, seen in FIG. 4, do not appear on the upper side of the tray bottom, which is flat and smooth.

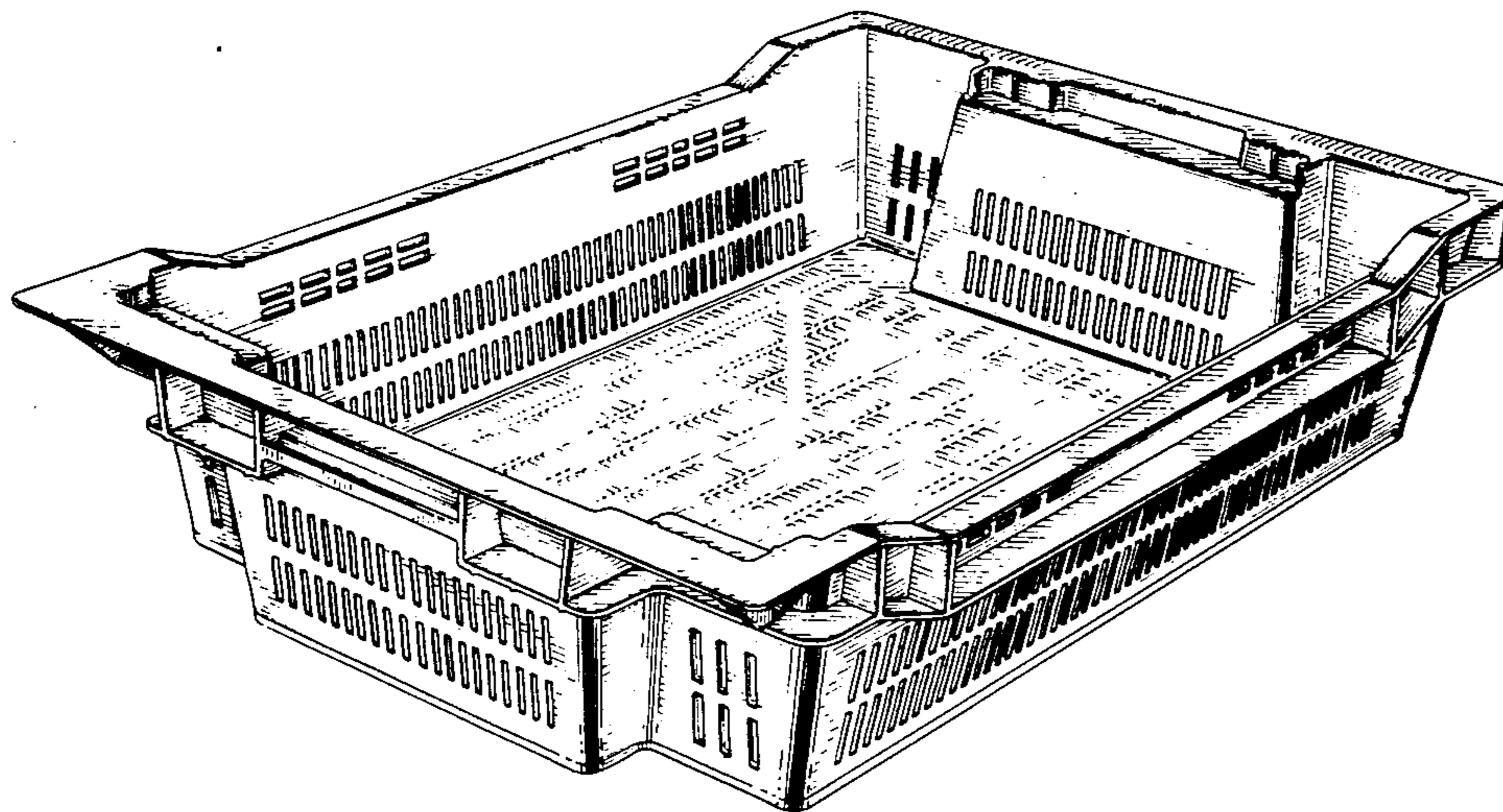

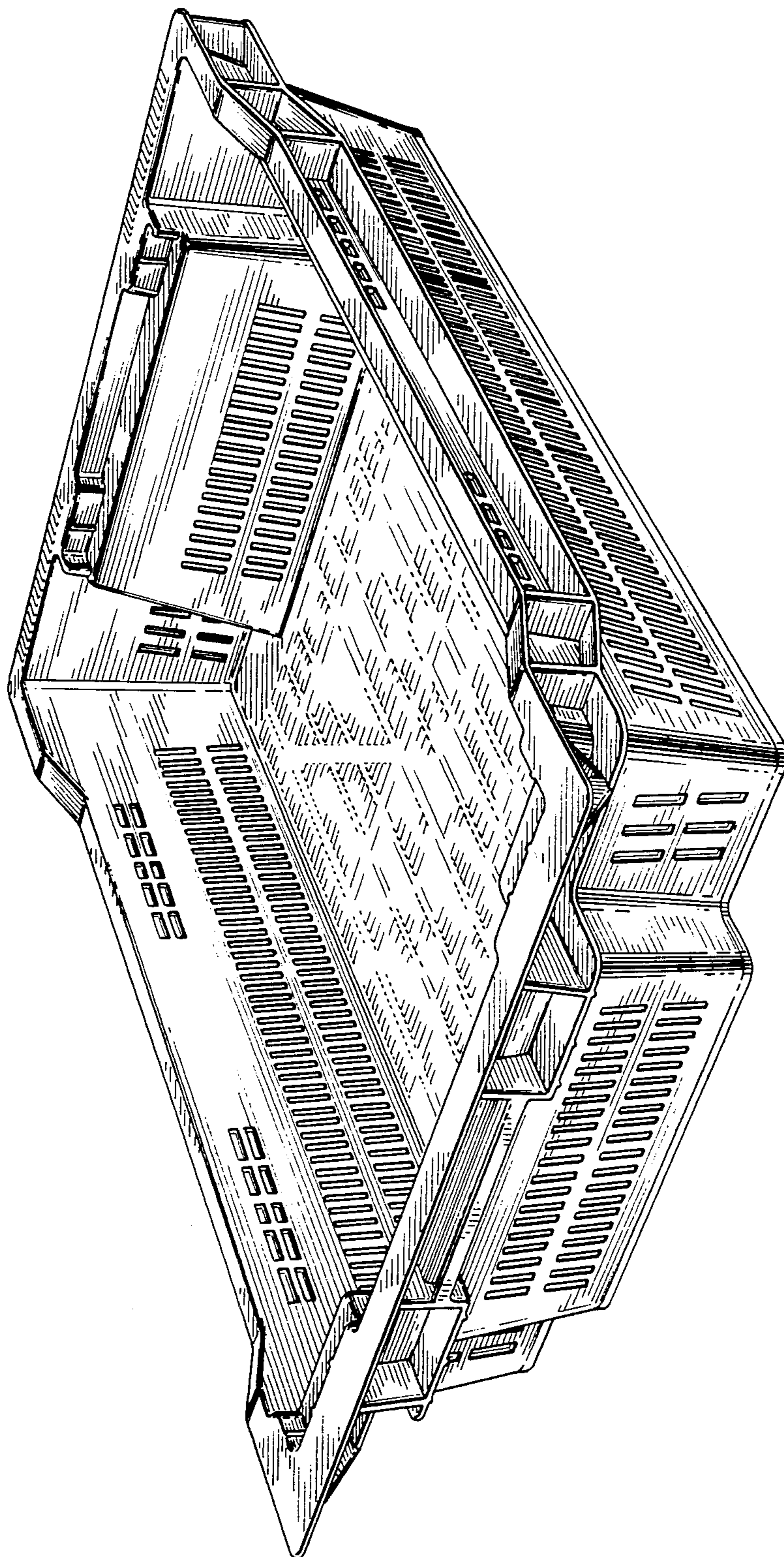

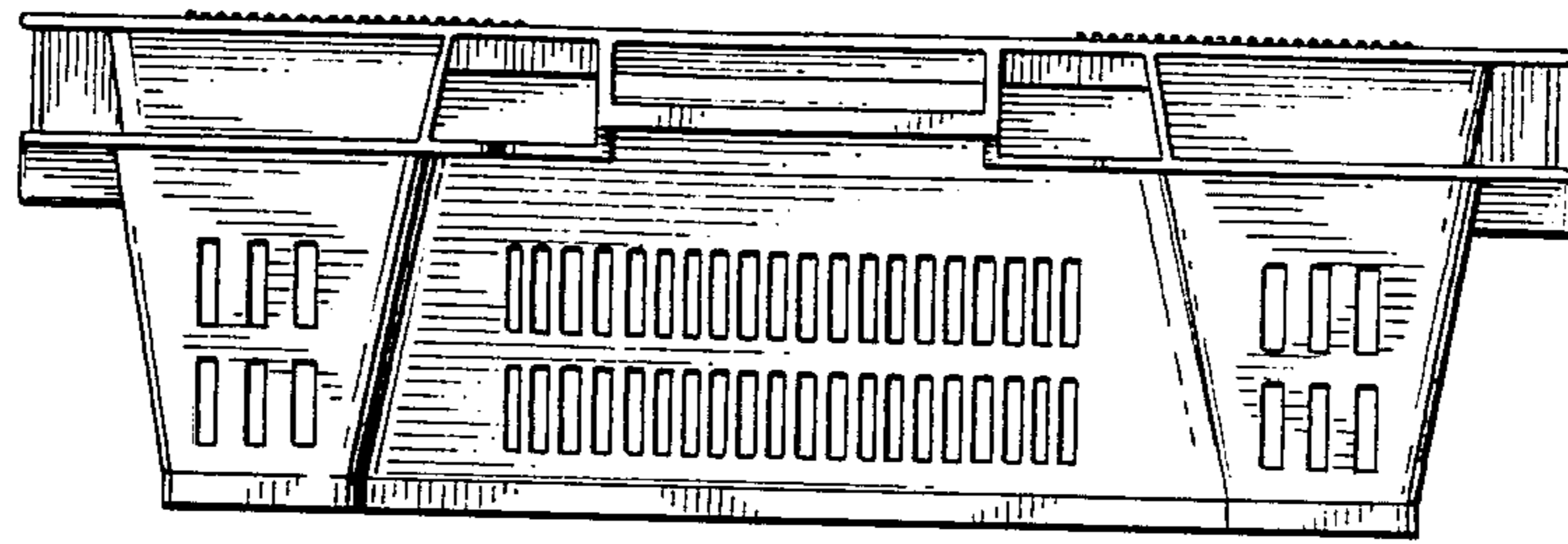

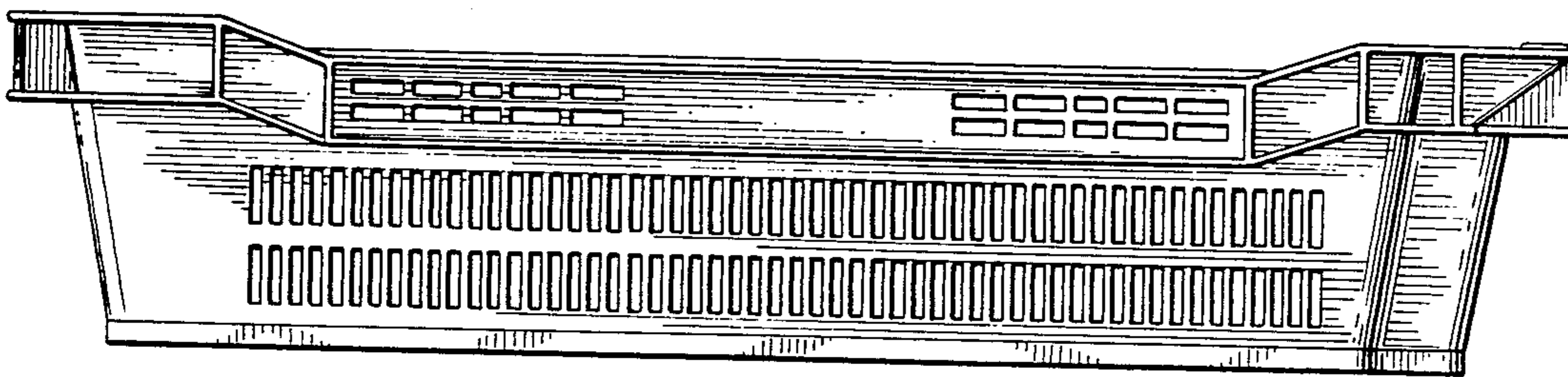
