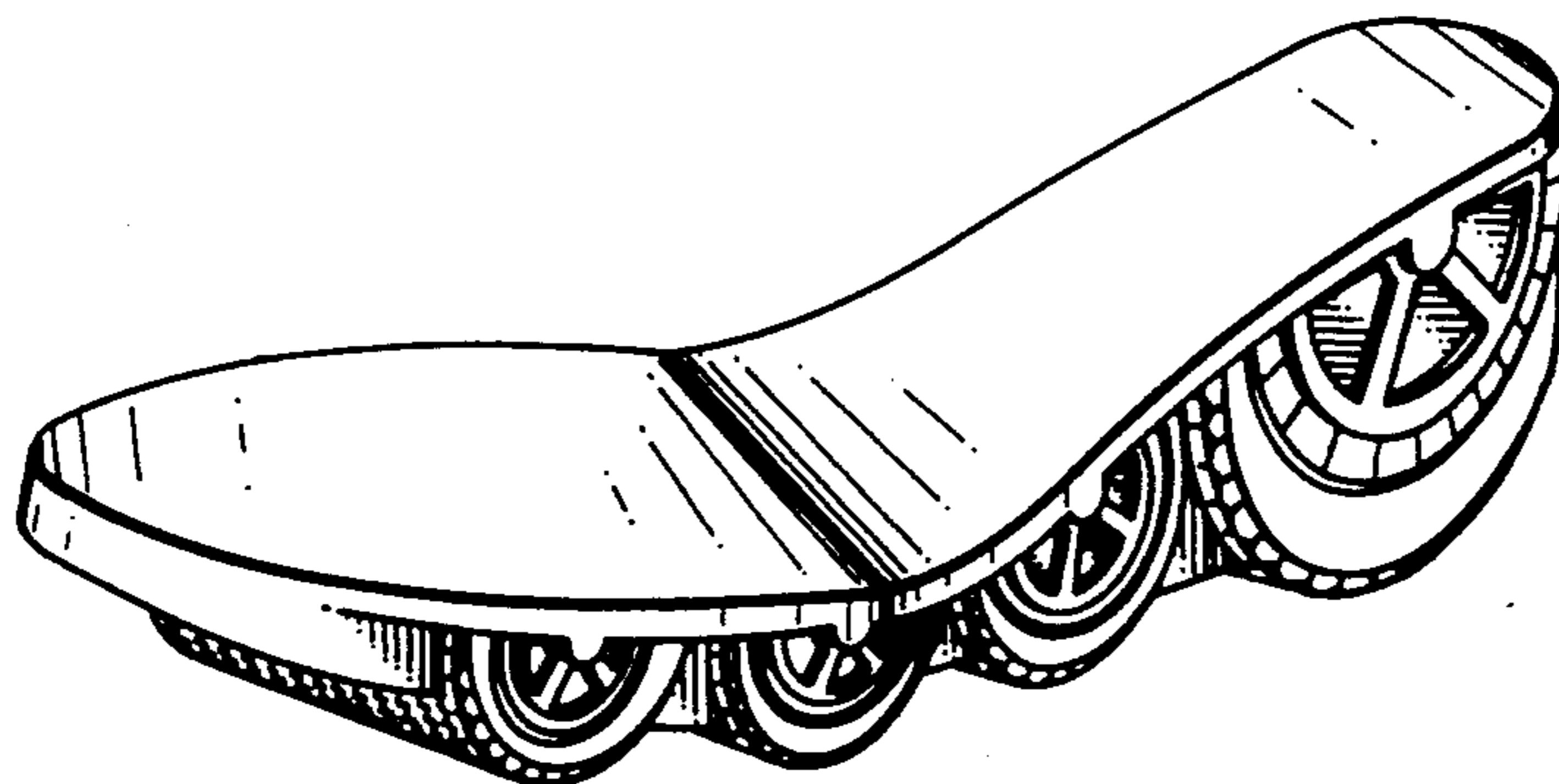

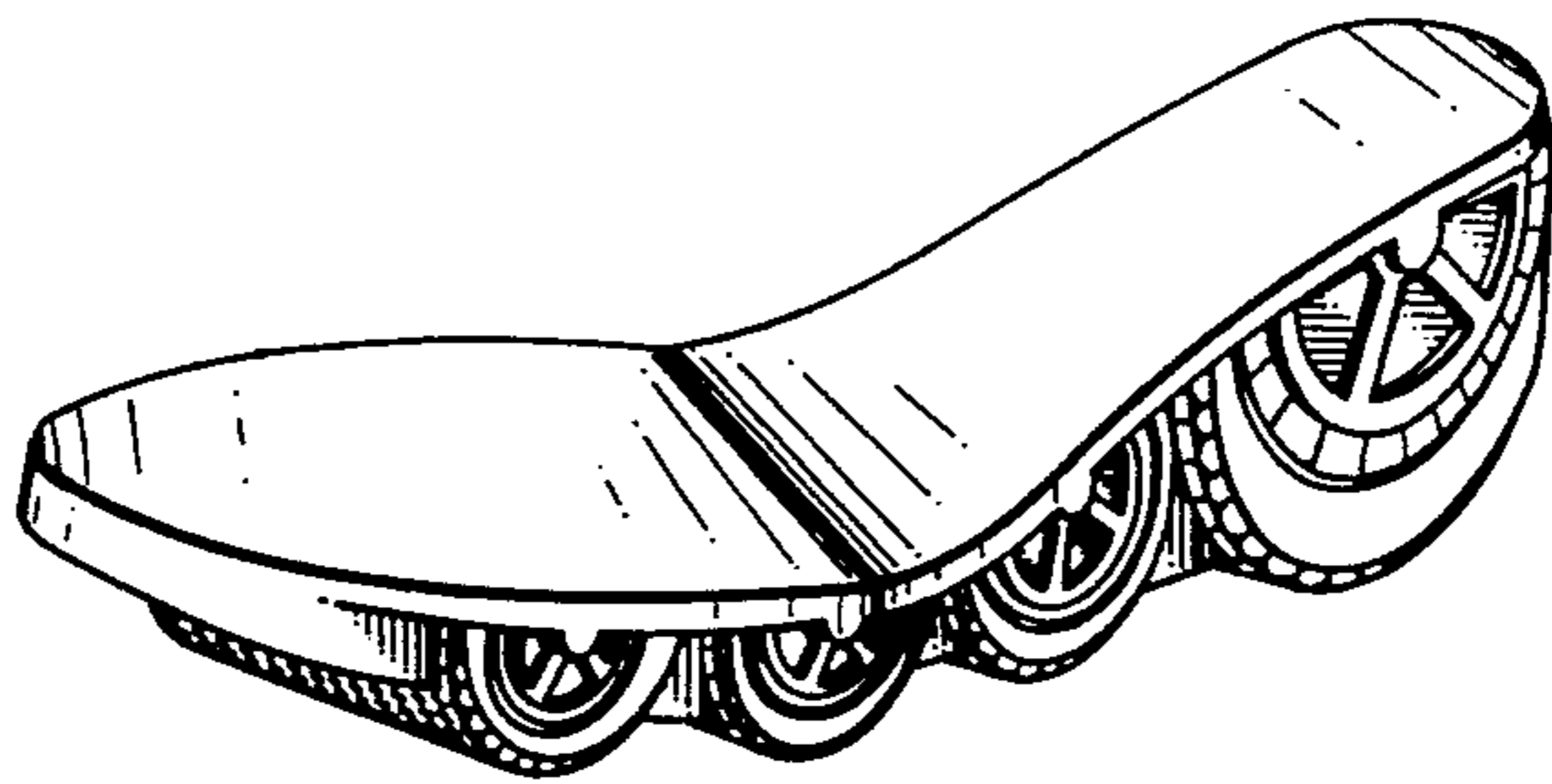

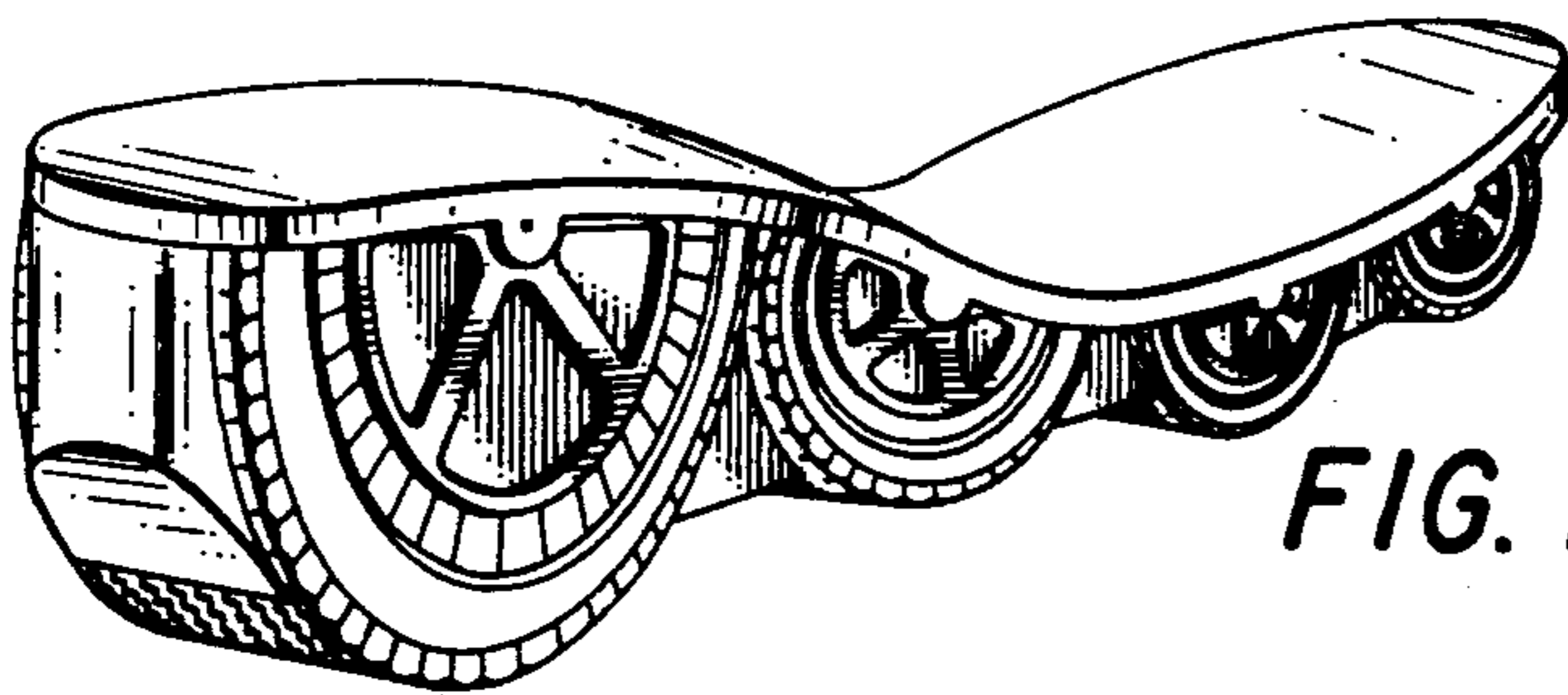
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe sole showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view, thereof.



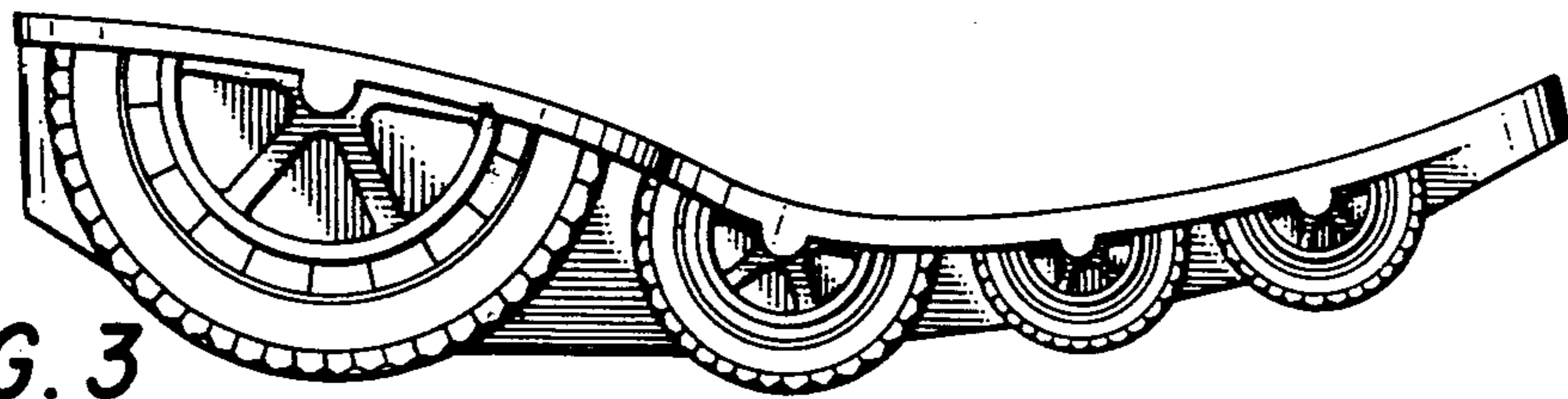

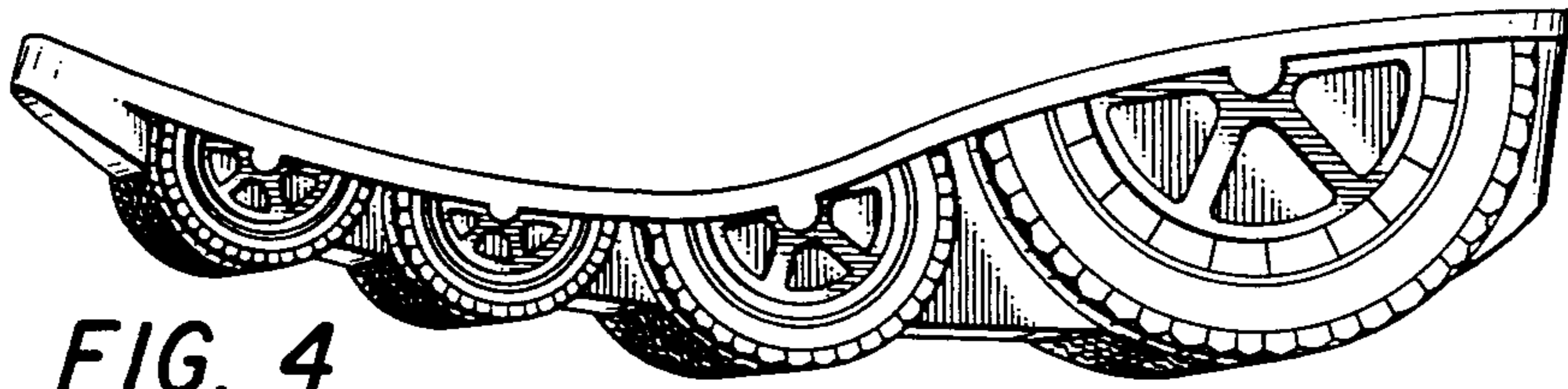

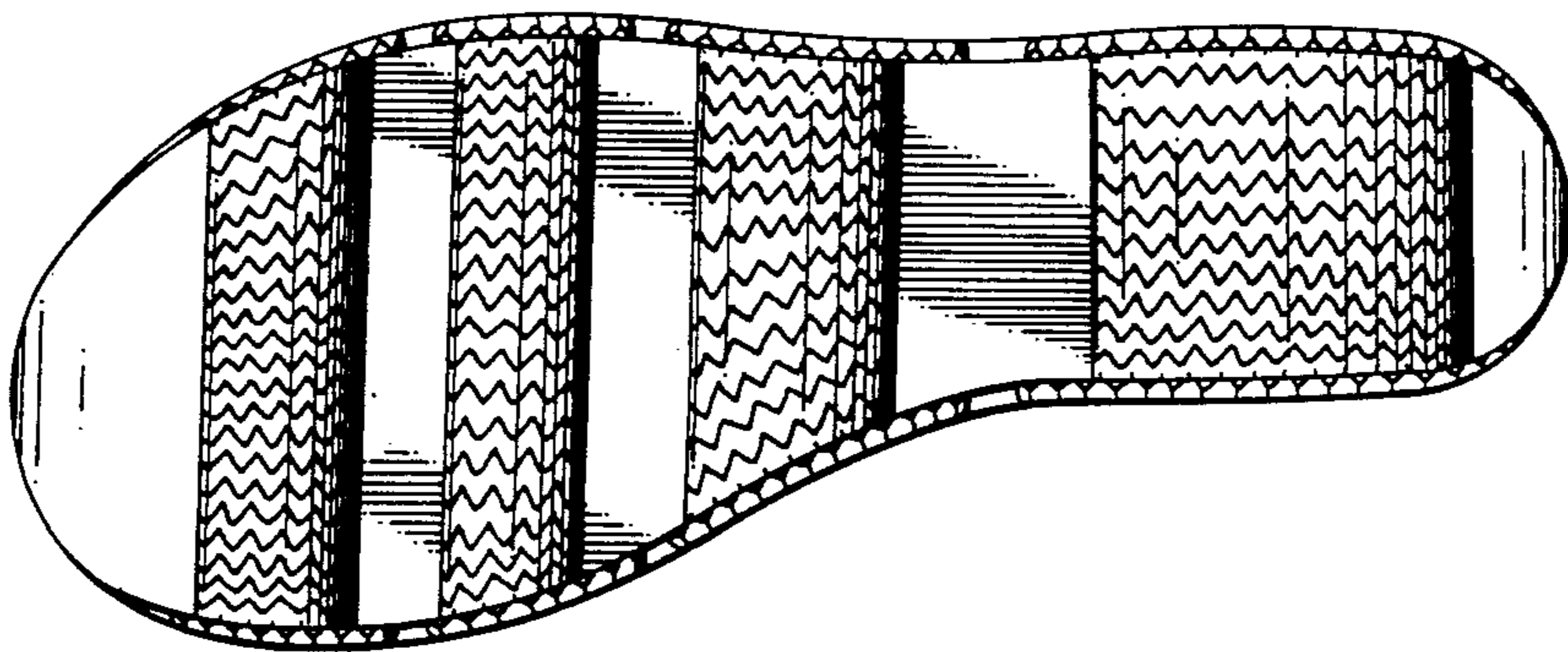
