[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clothes-peg, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a clothes-peg showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an end view of that which is shown in FIG. 1;

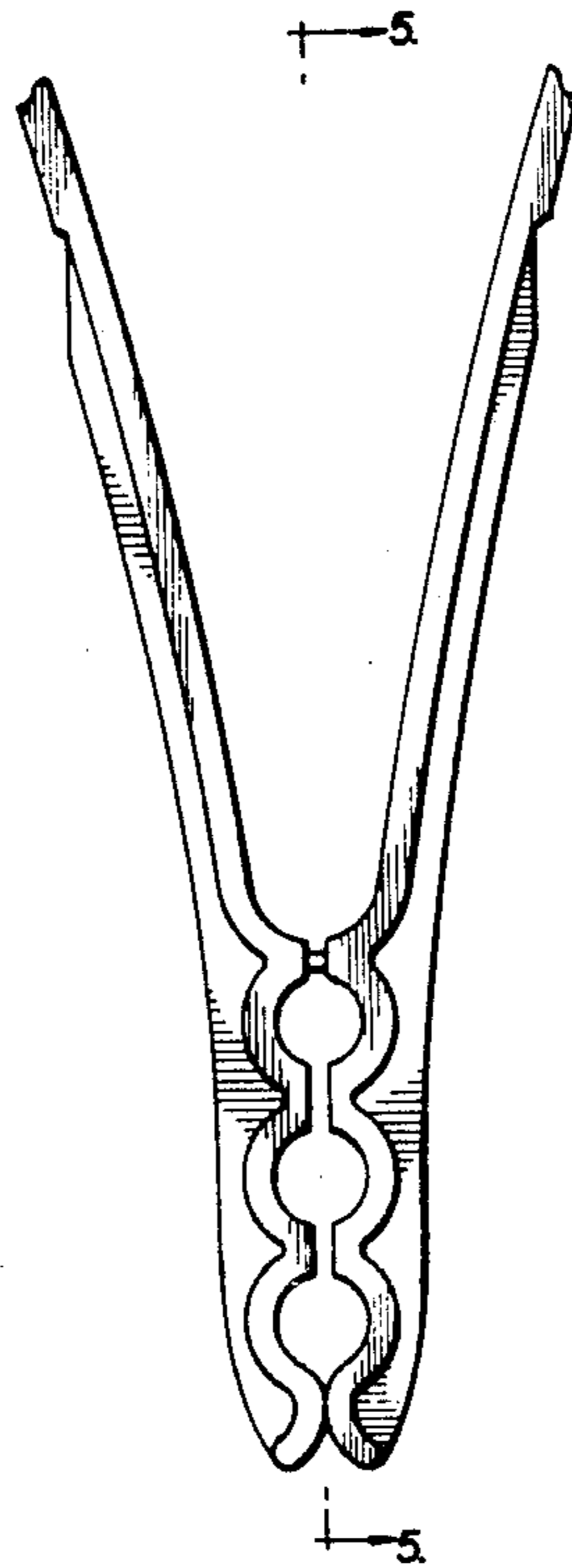
FIG. 3 is a top plan view looking down on FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an opposed end view from that of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a view of one half of the clothes-peg taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary side view of a second embodiment from that shown in FIG. 1; and

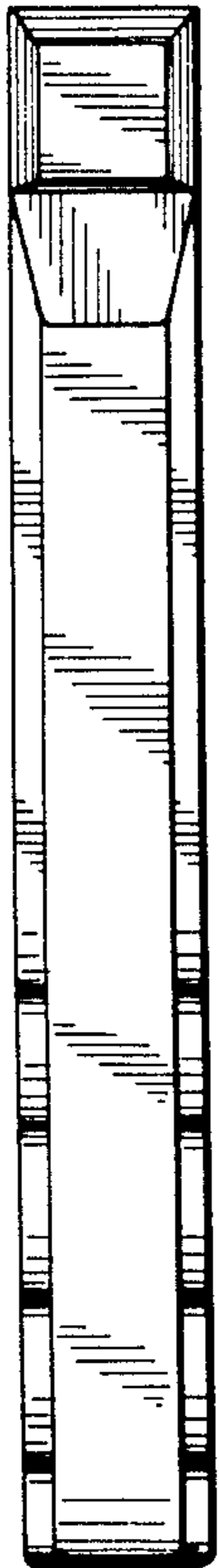
FIG. 7 is a view of one half of the clothes-peg taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 6.



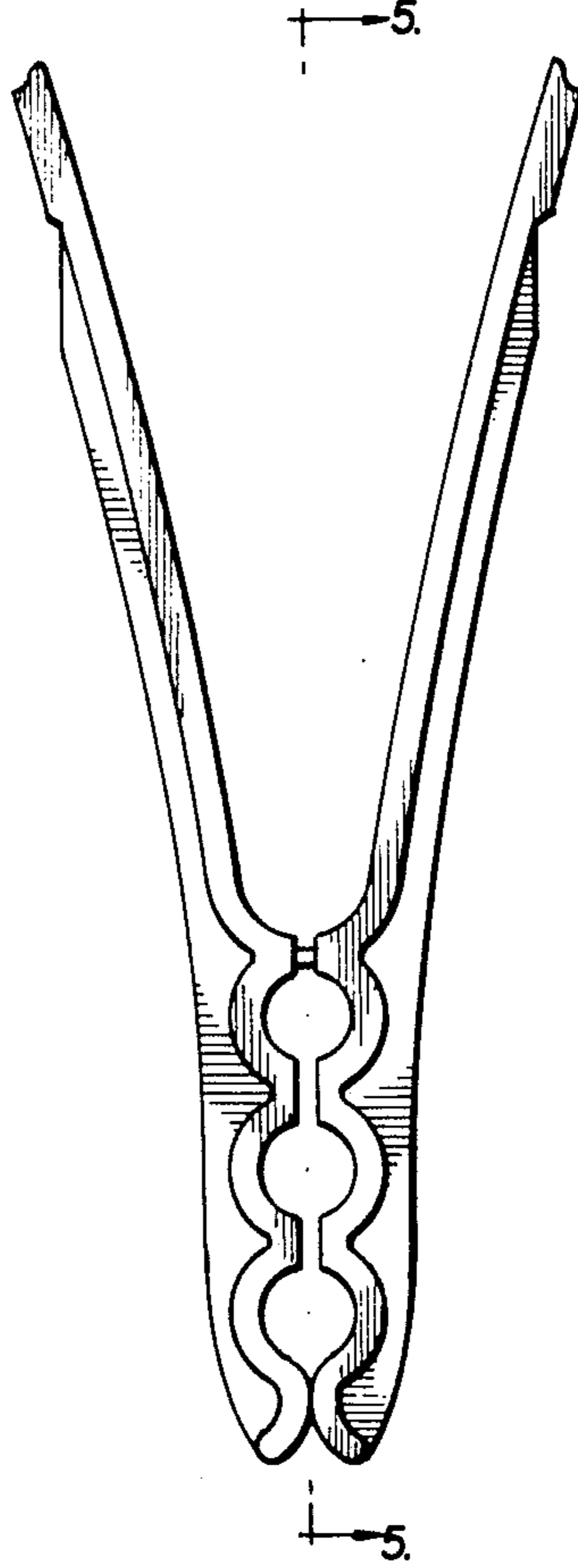

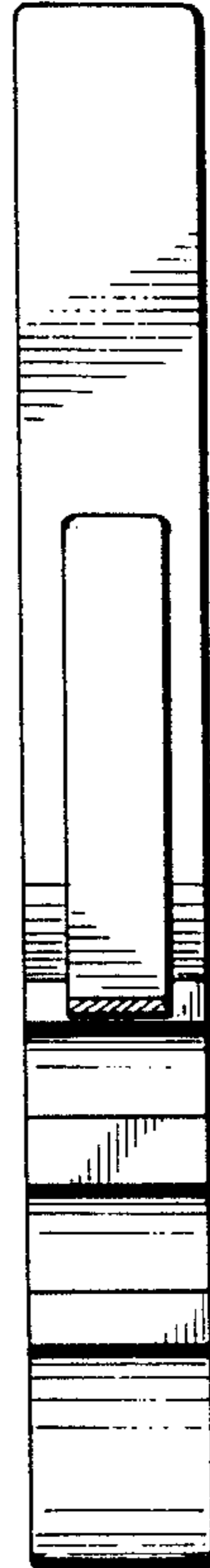

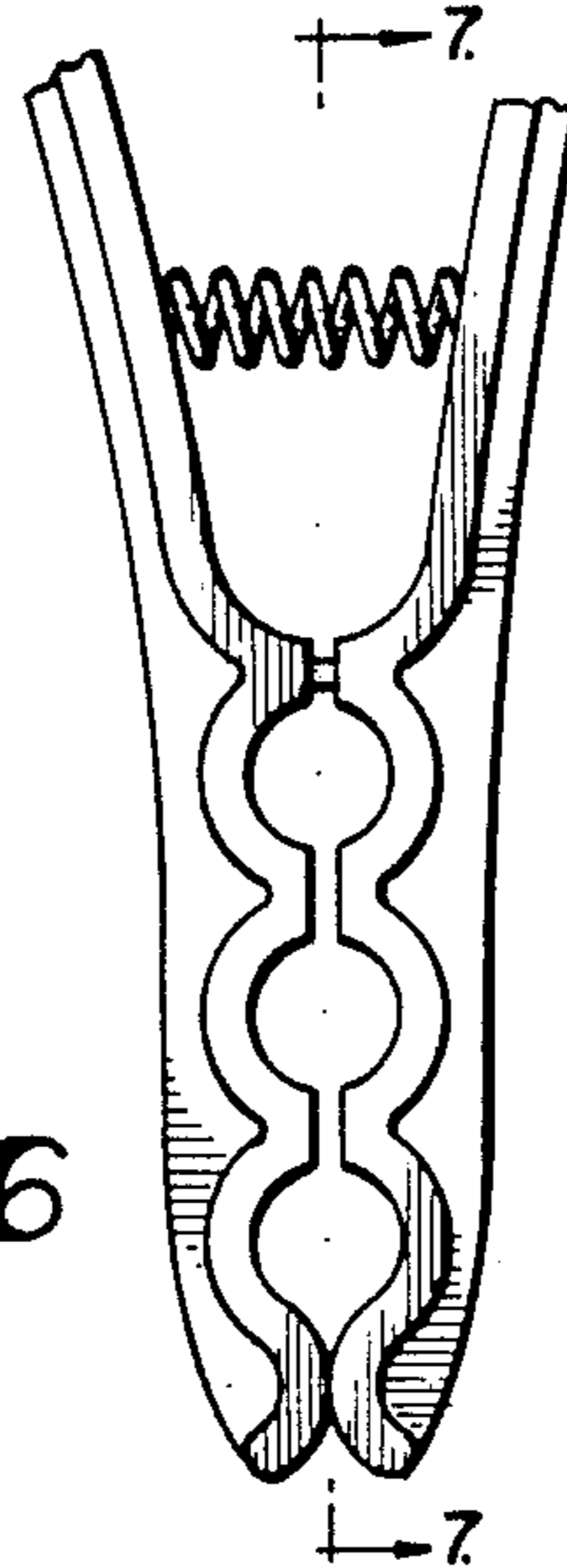
