FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof of the side opposite from the side shown in FIG. 1;

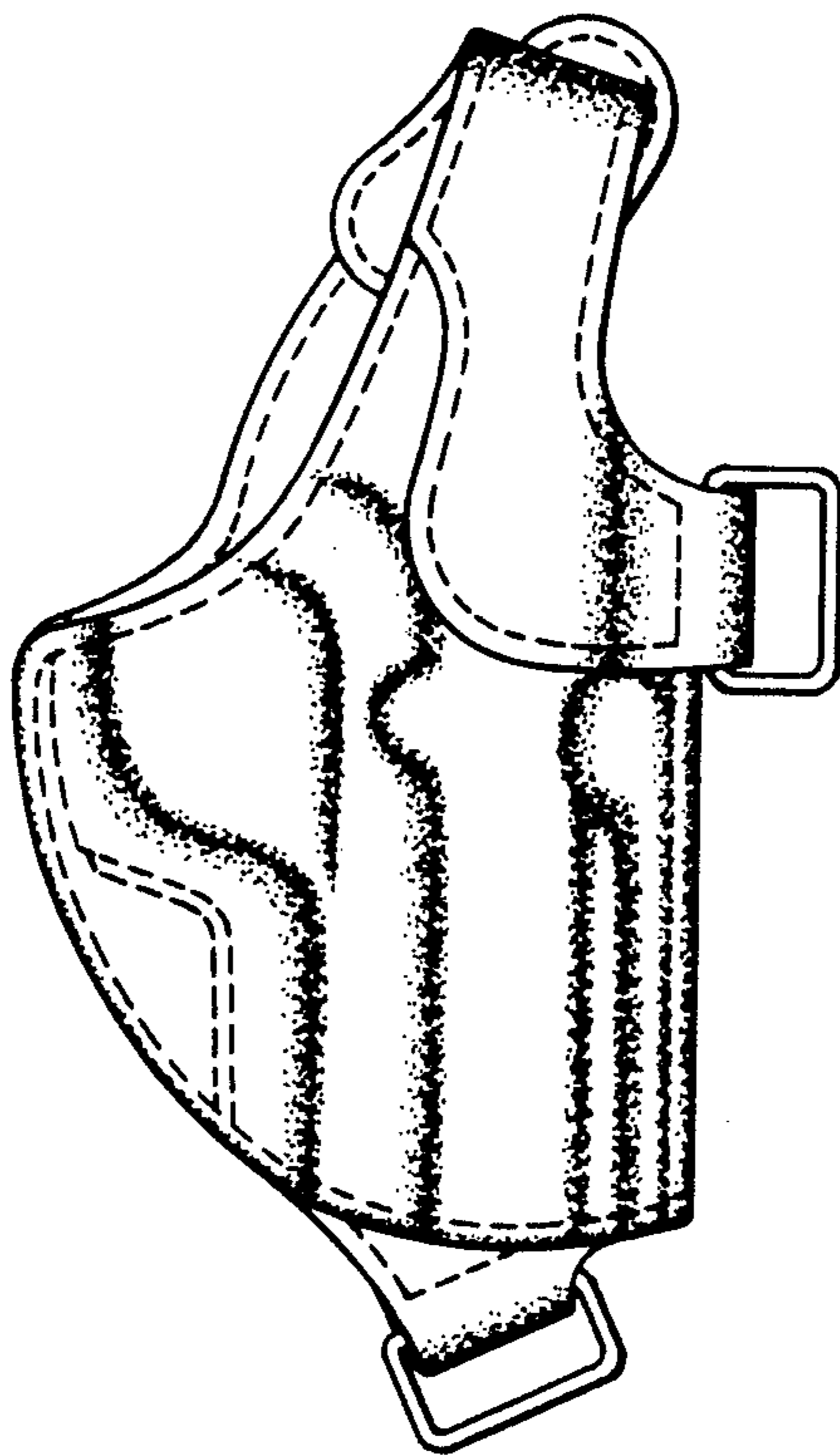
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and

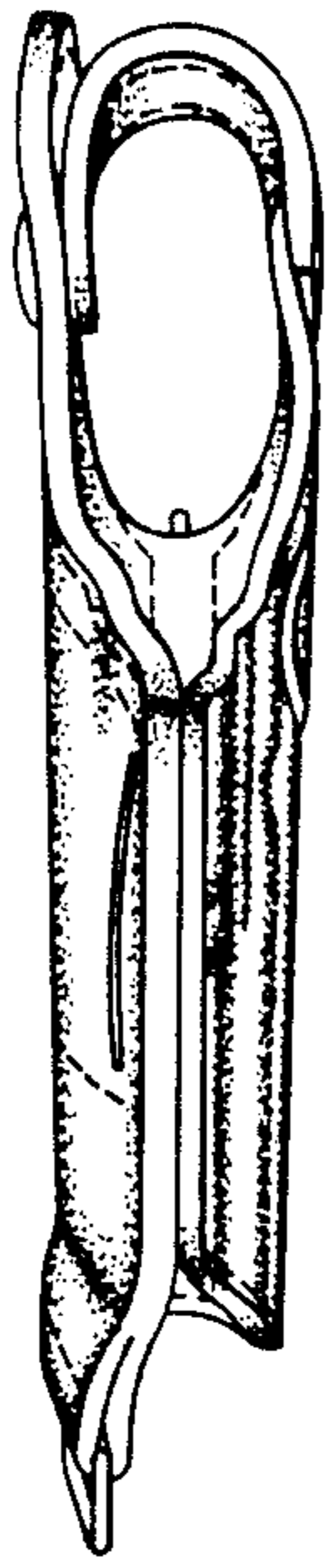

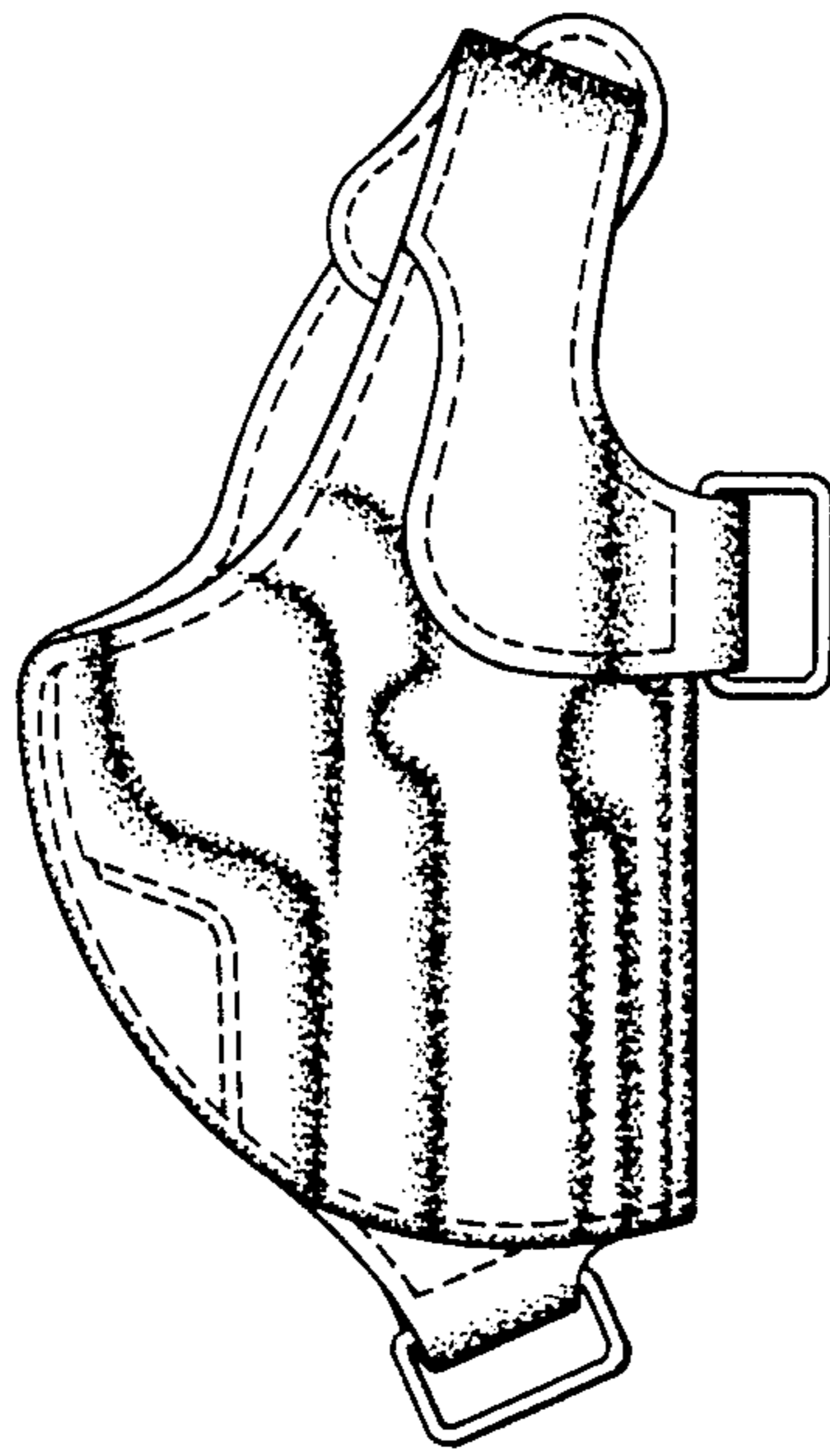

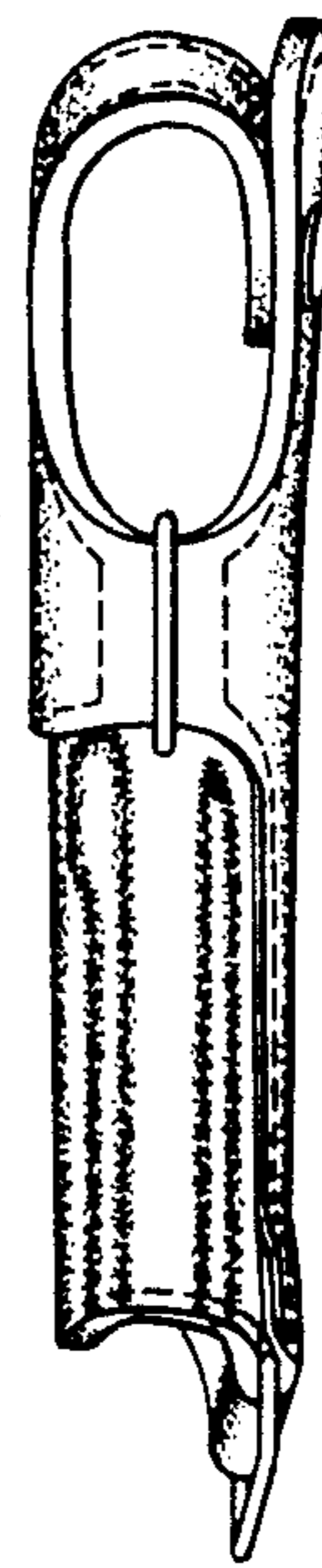

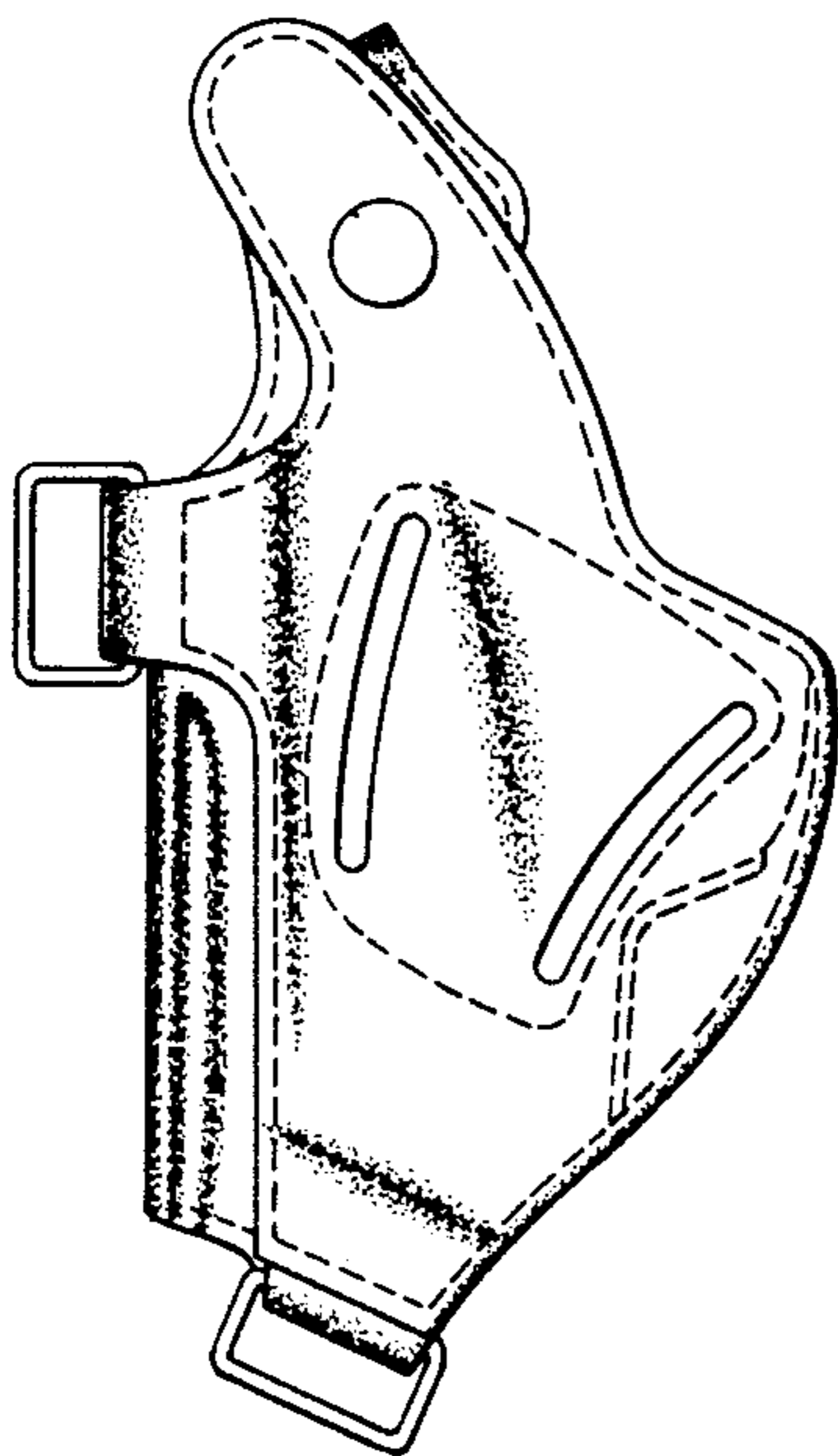

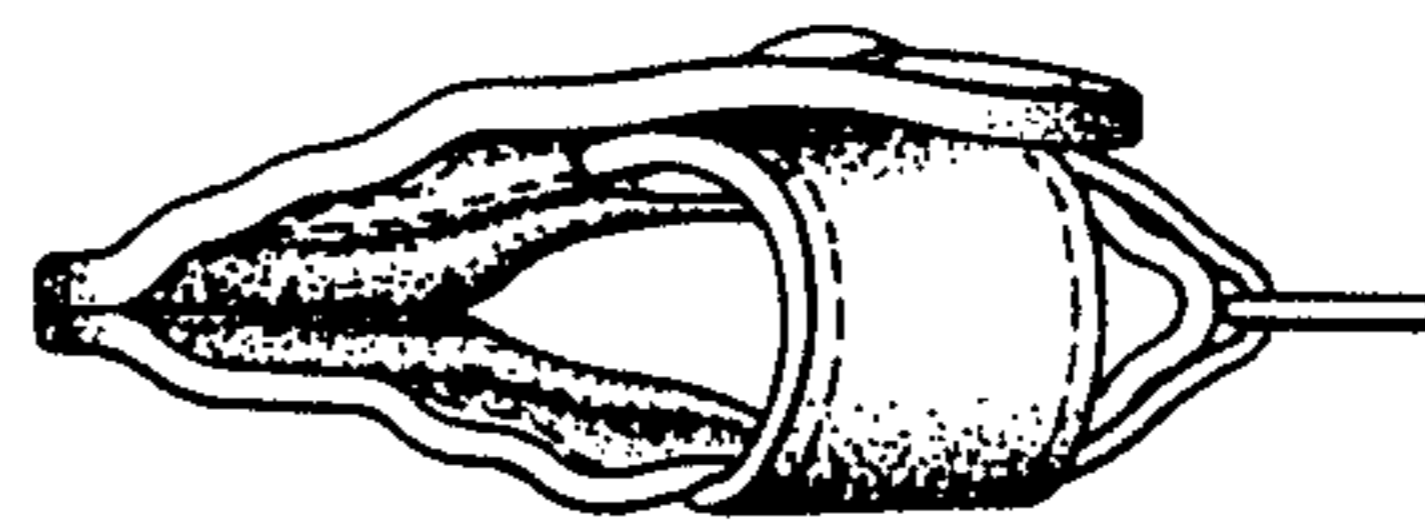

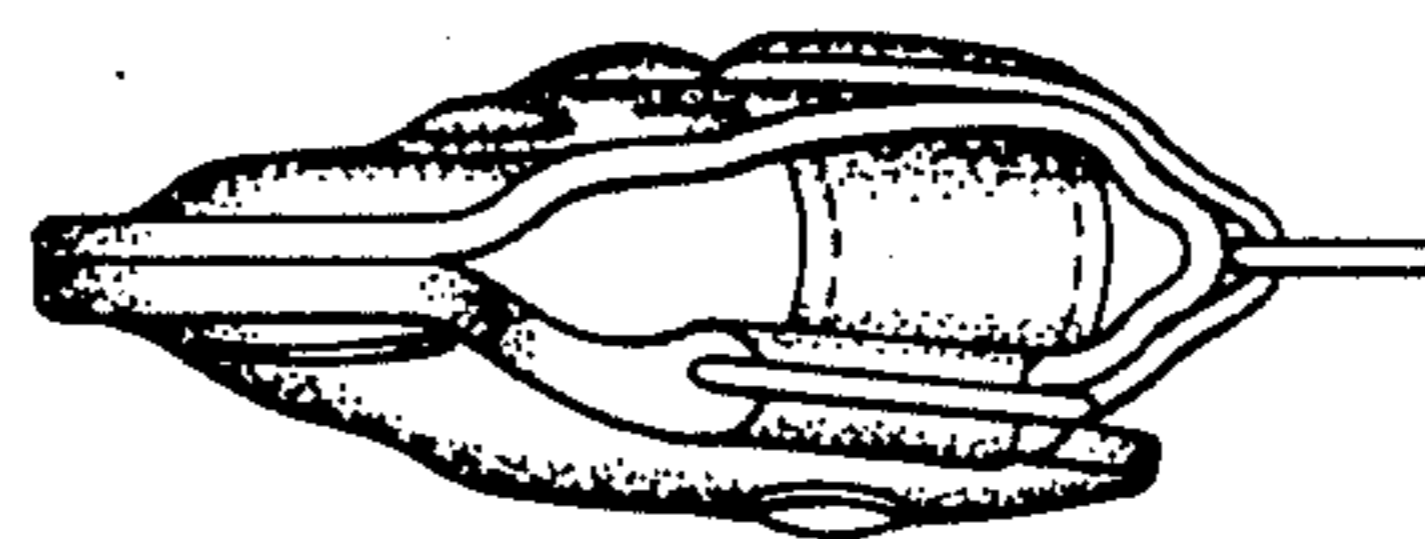
