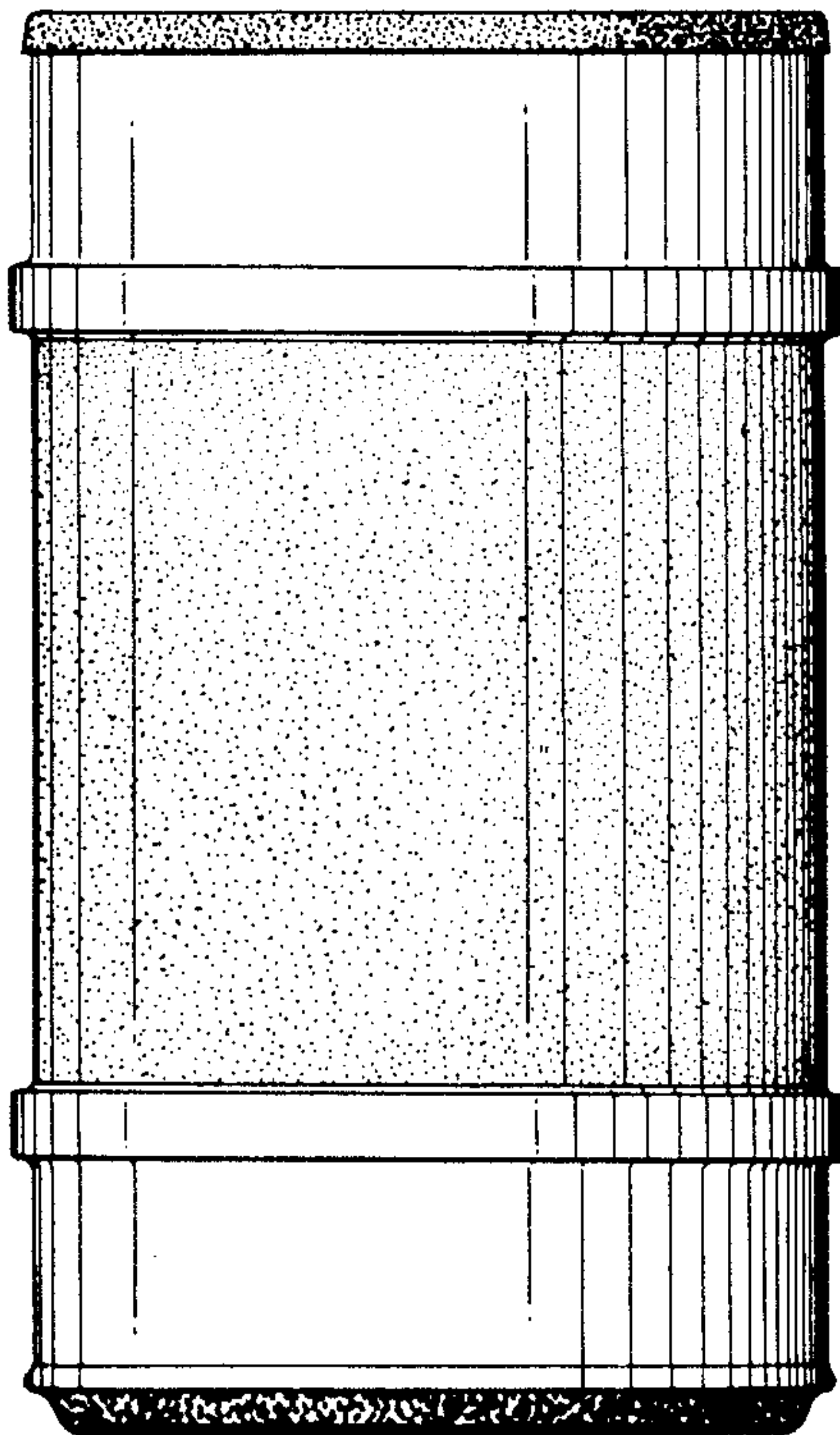

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DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a drum showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the other side elevational view being identical;
FIG. 5 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 in FIG. 2.



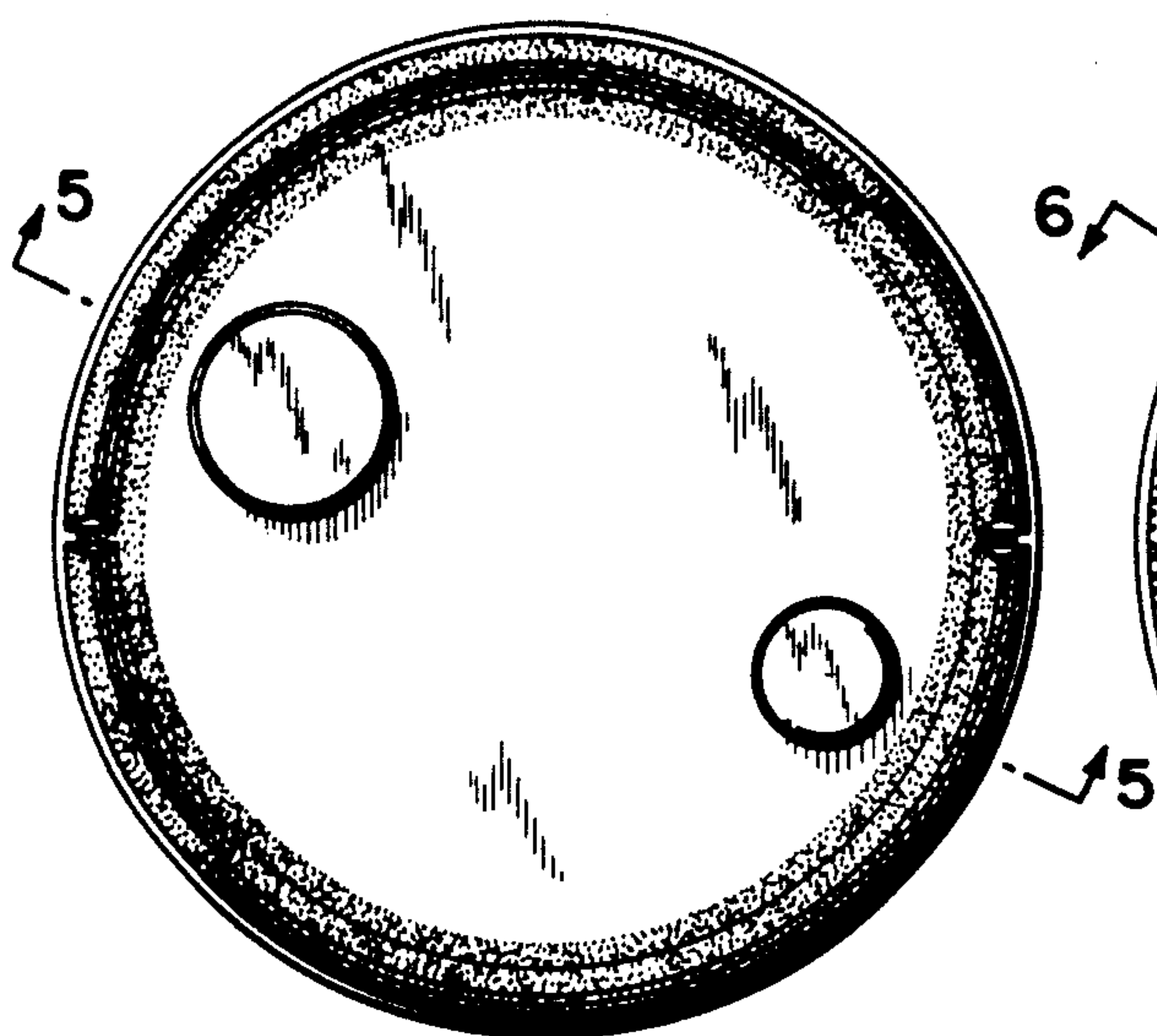

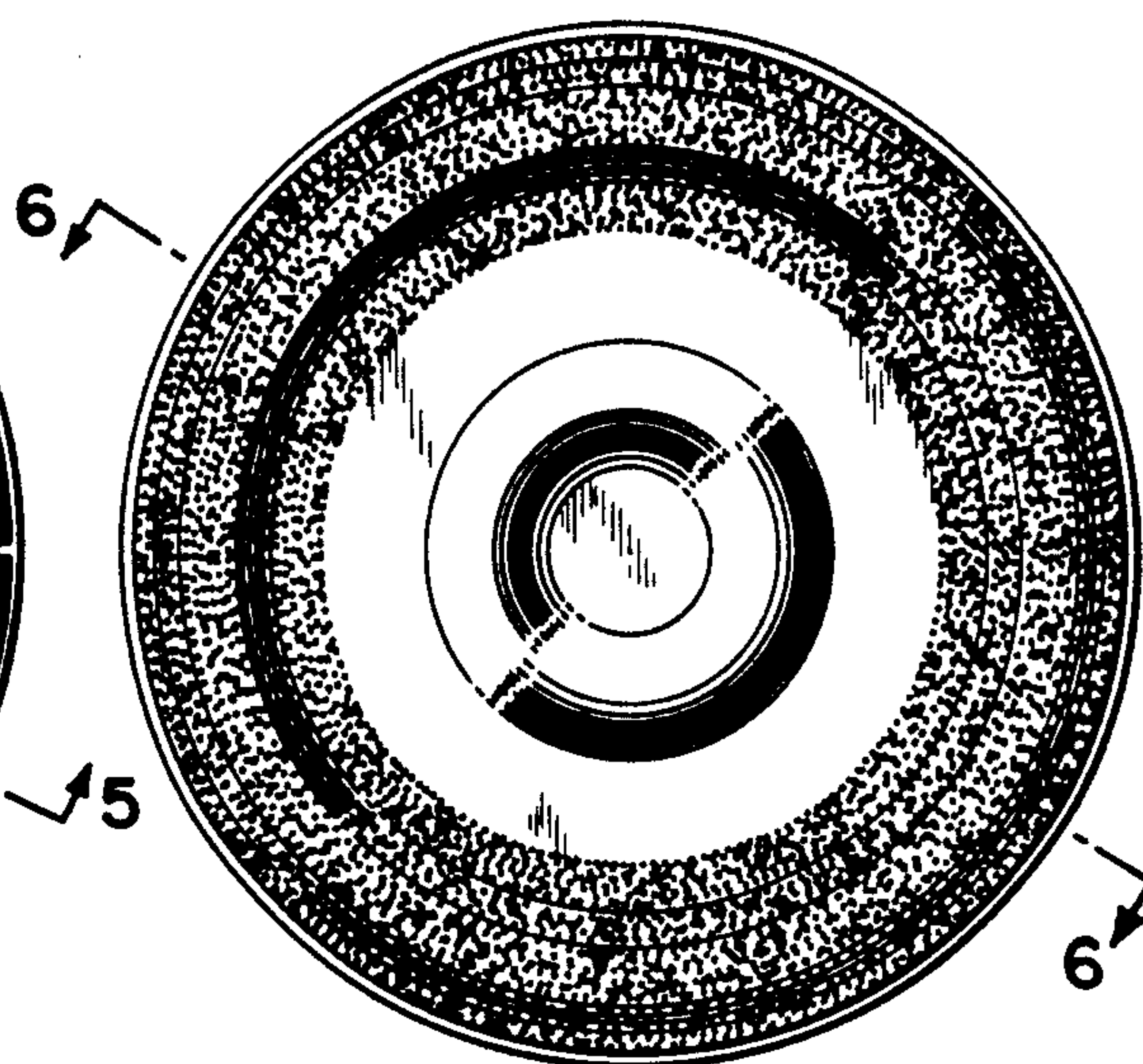

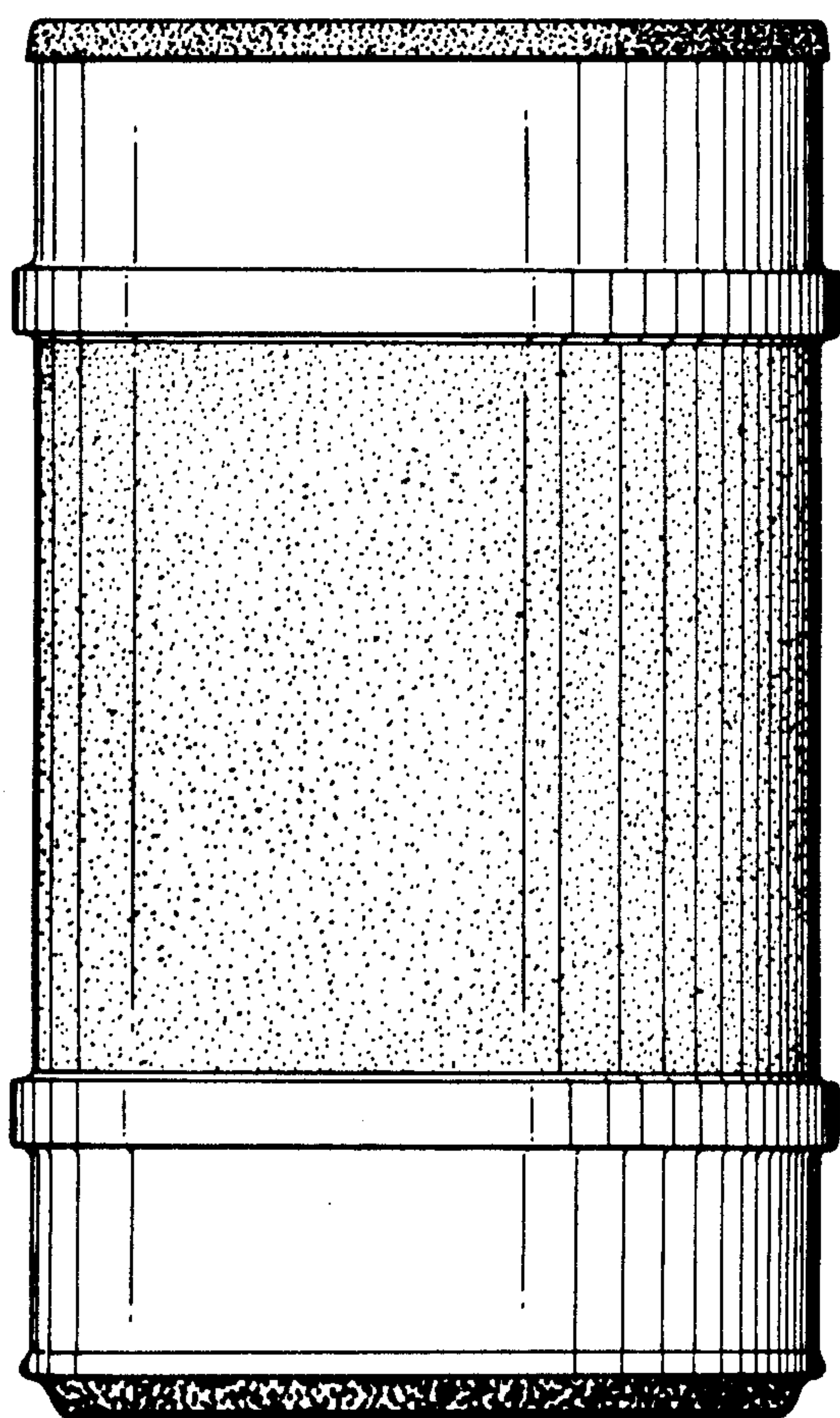

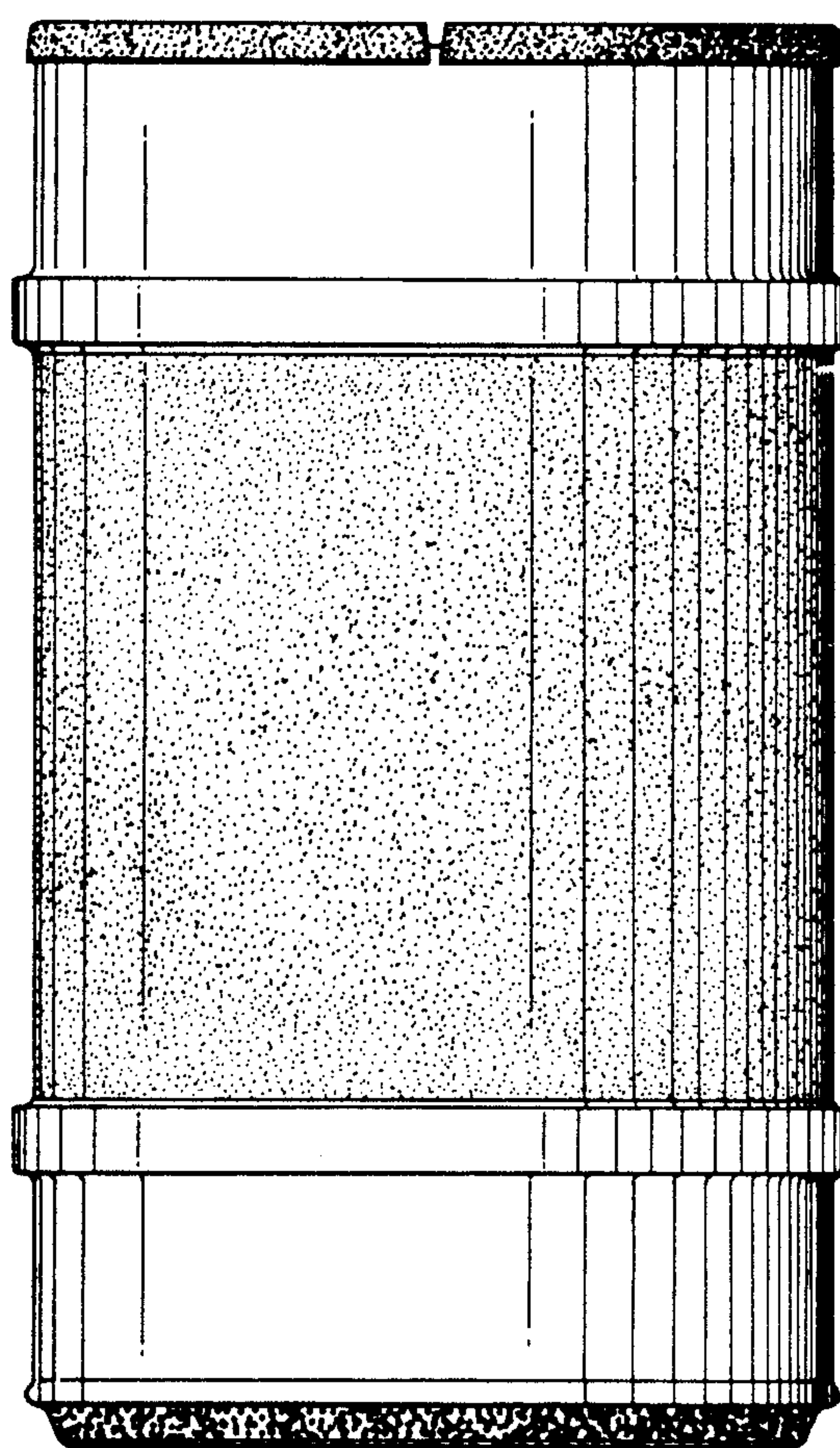

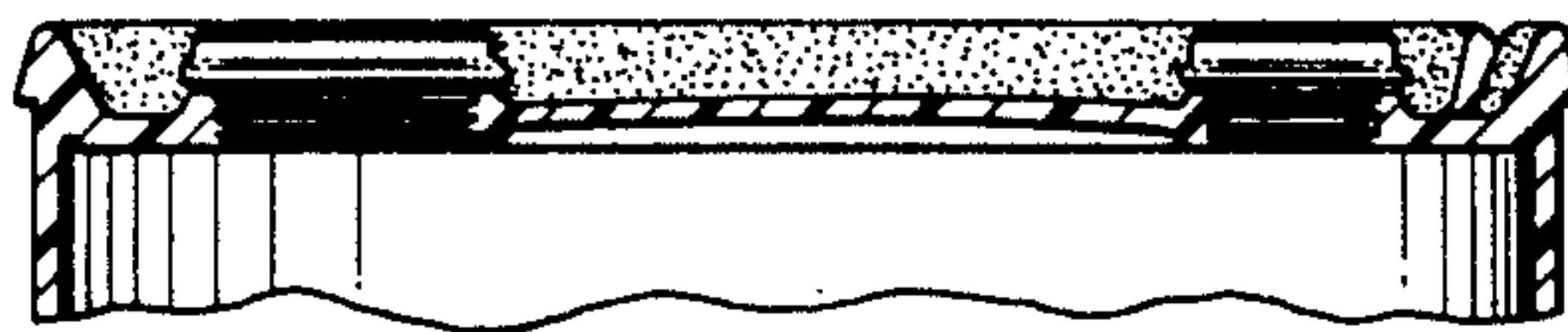

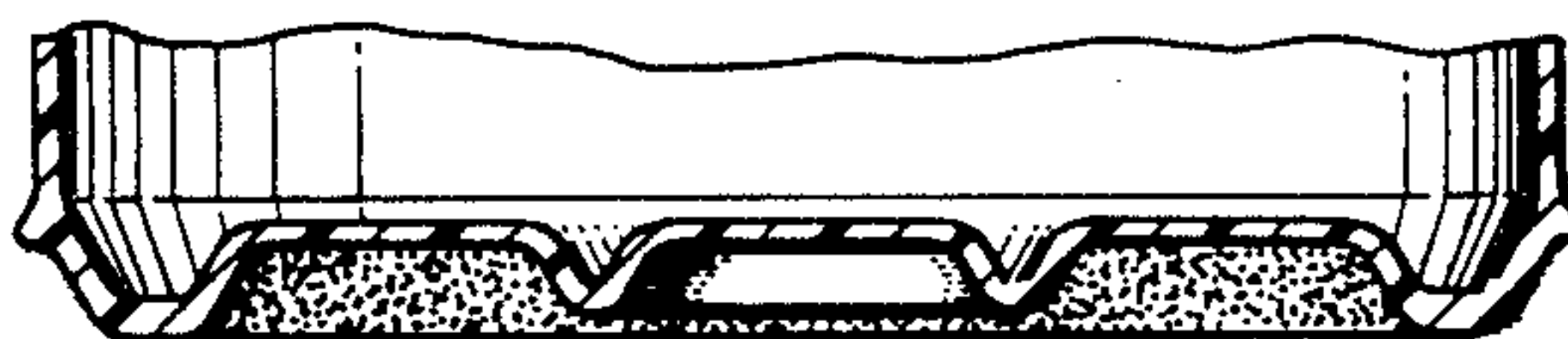
