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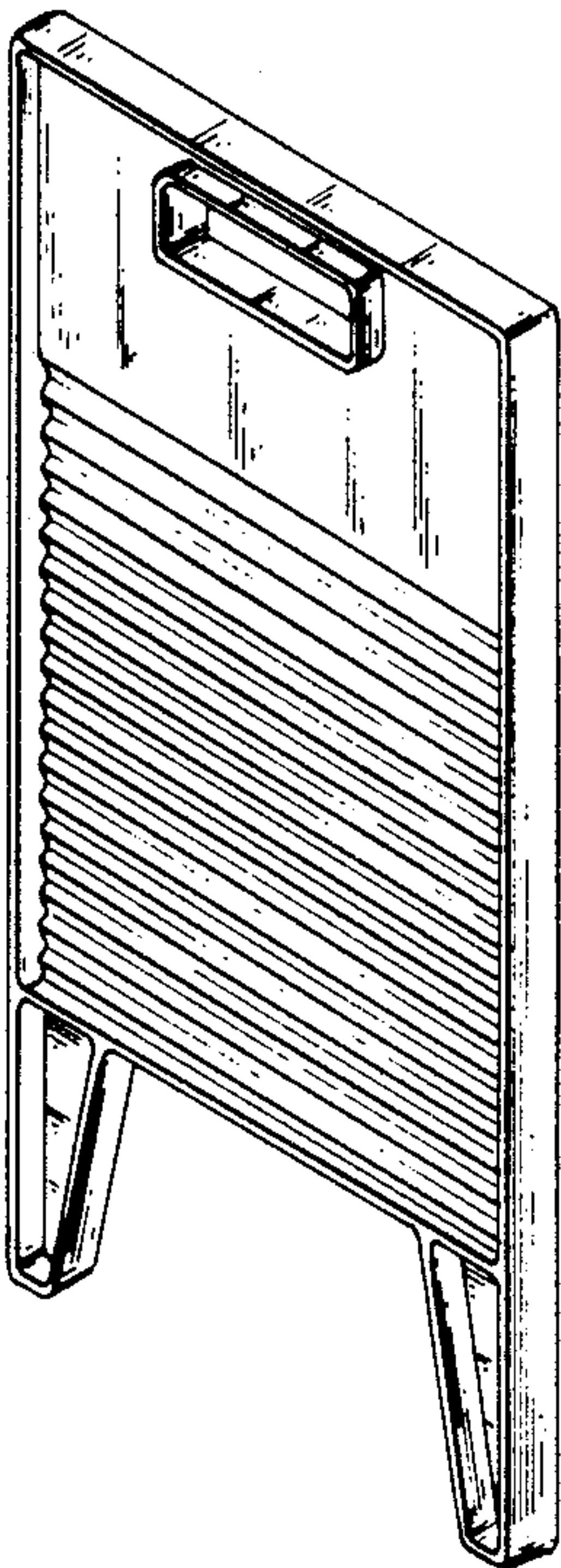

FIG. 3 is a side sectional view thereof taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 2.



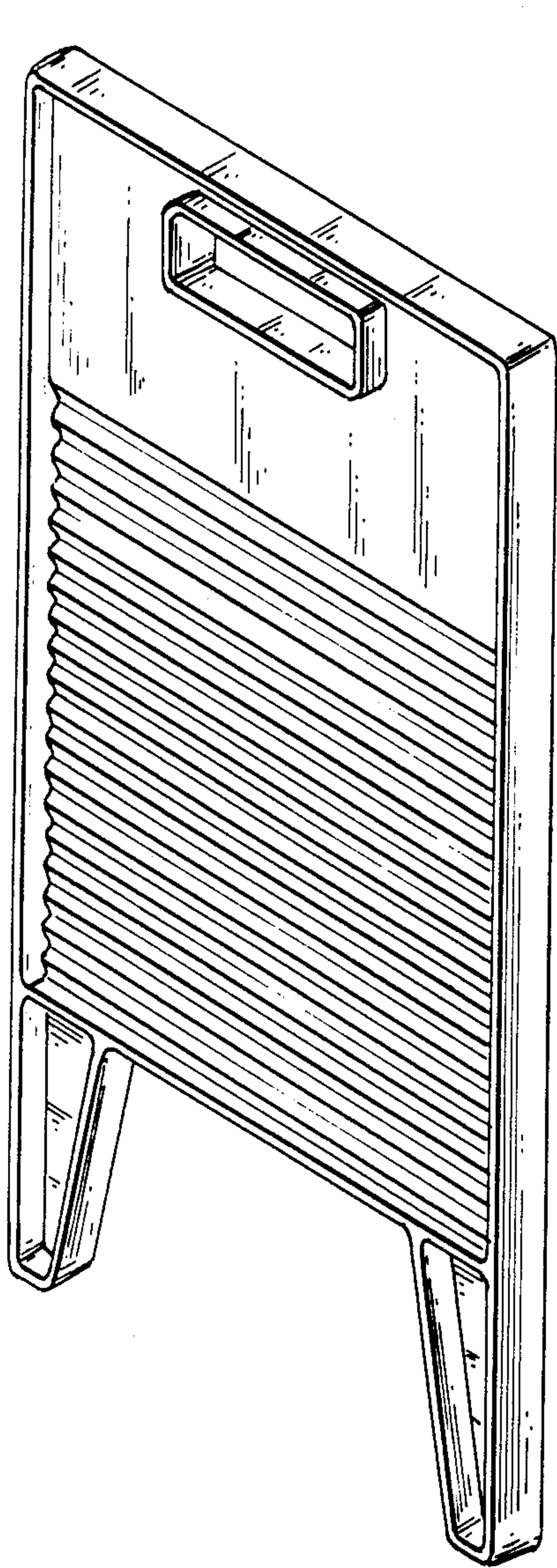

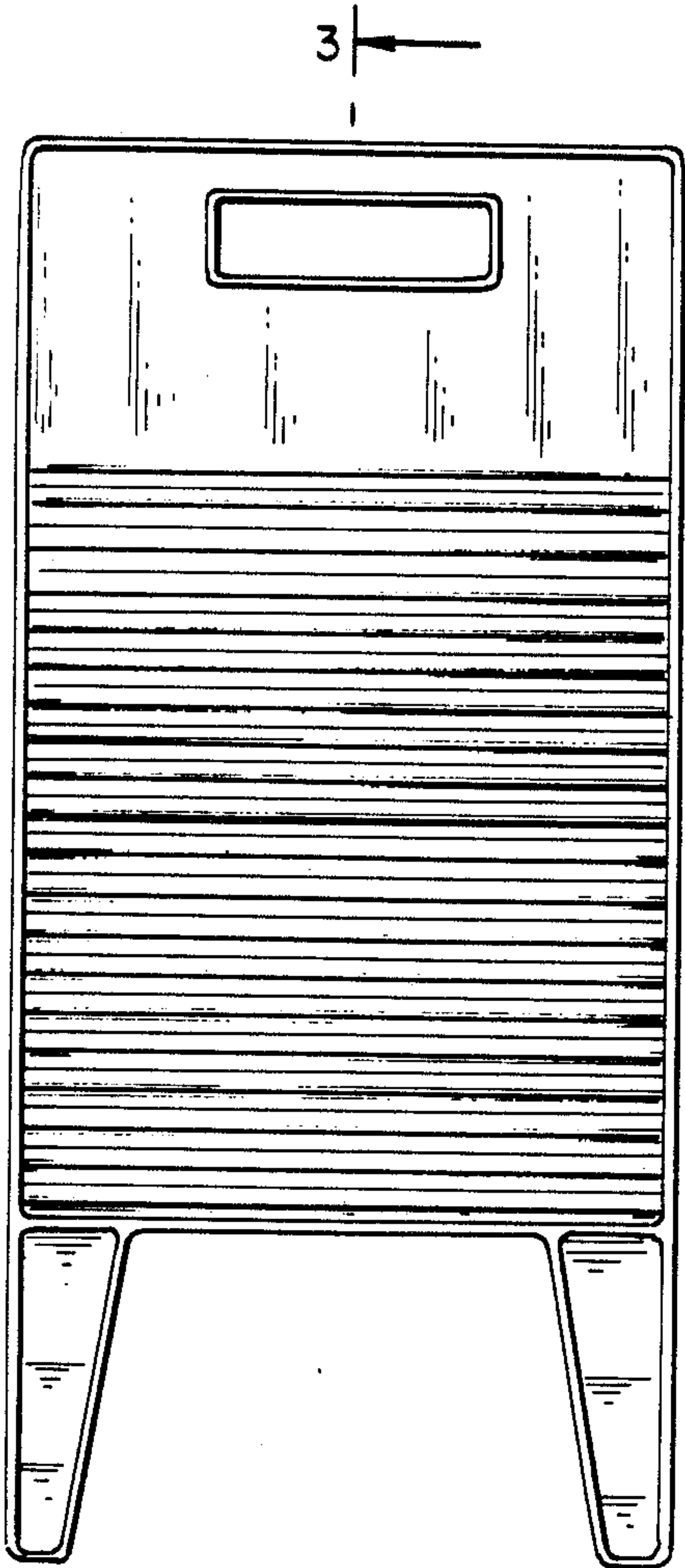

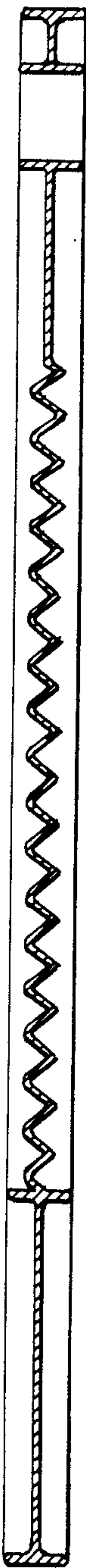
