FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a shipping tray for dynamo-electric machines showing my new design;

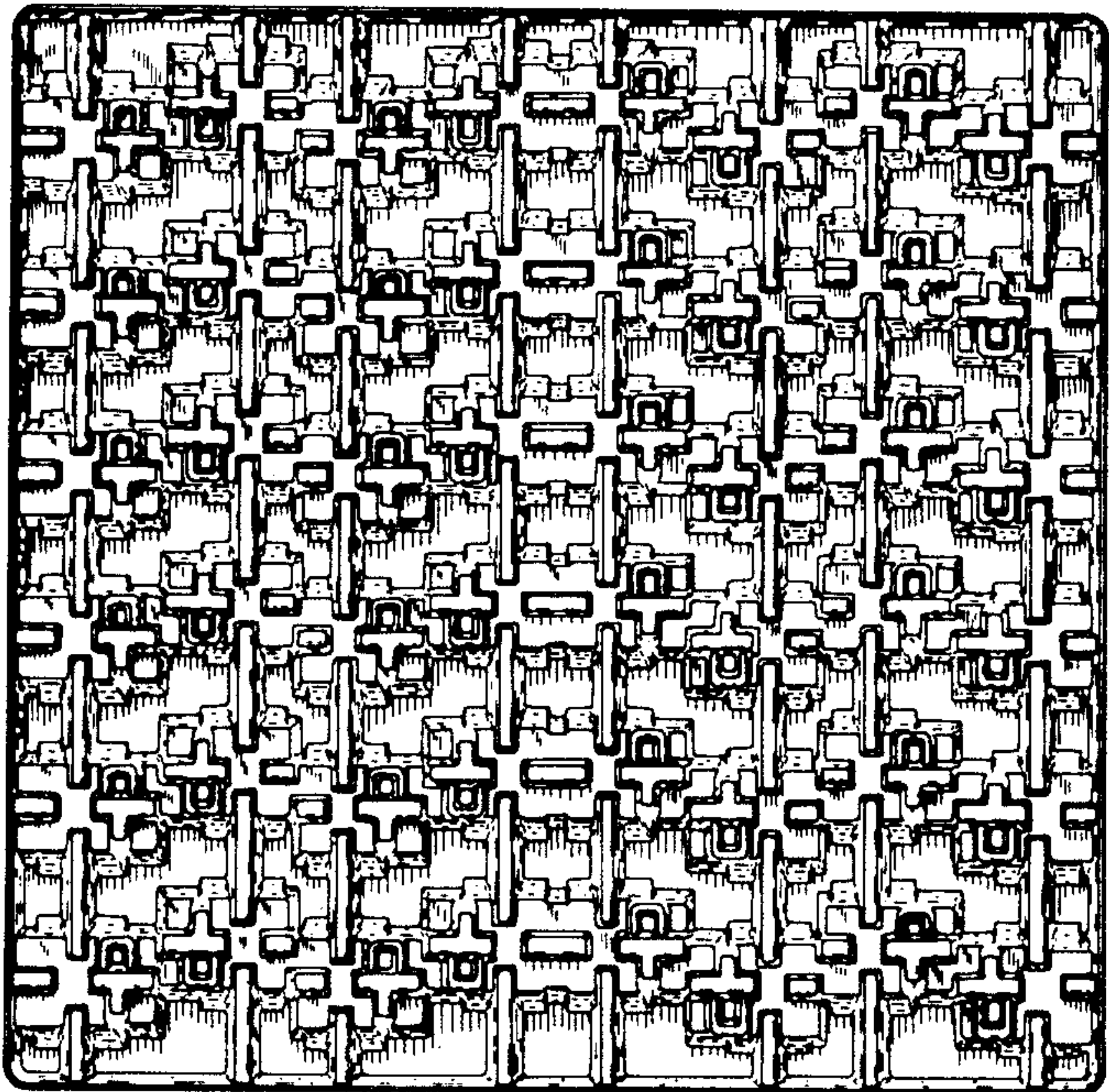
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 6 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1.



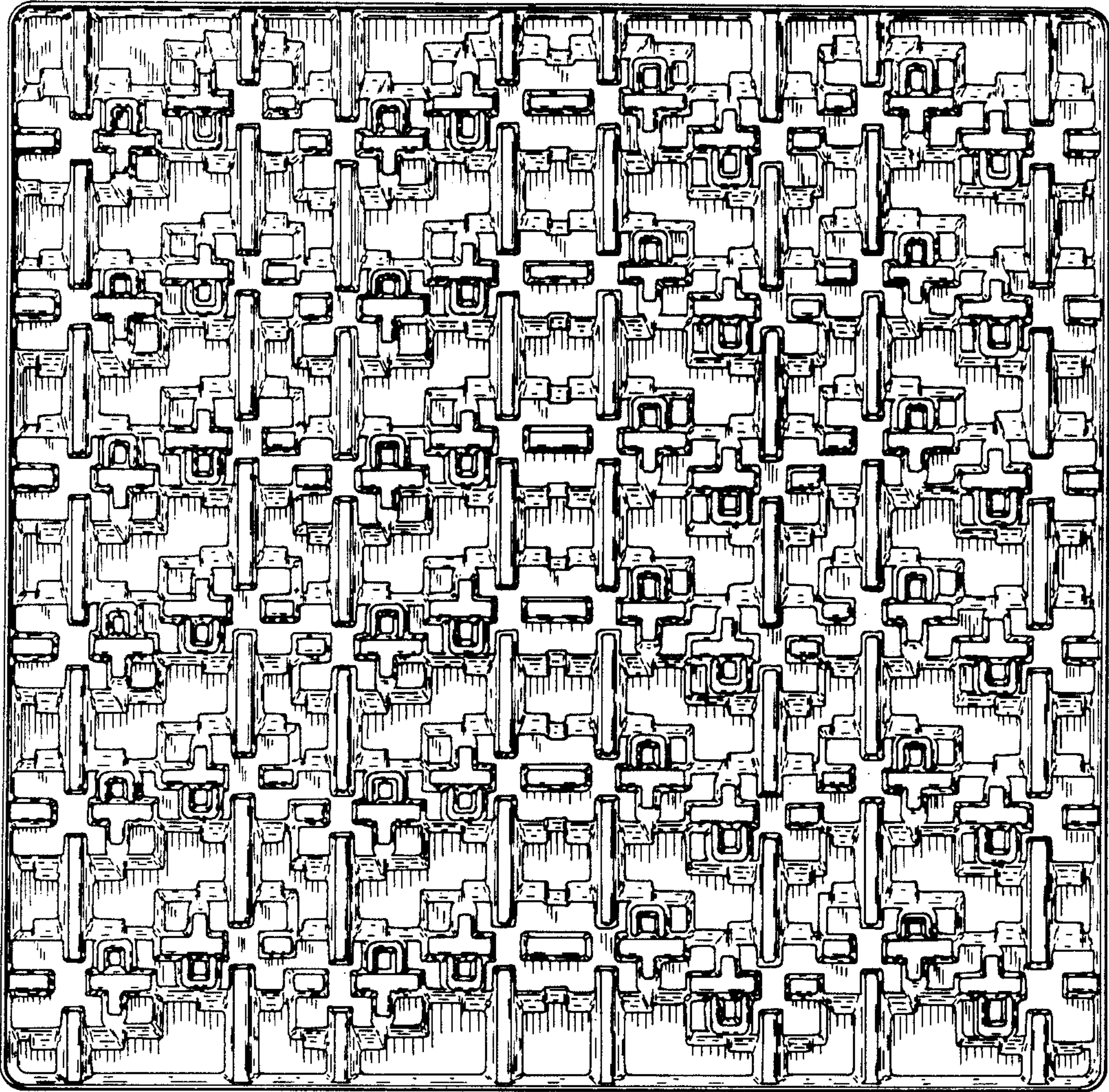

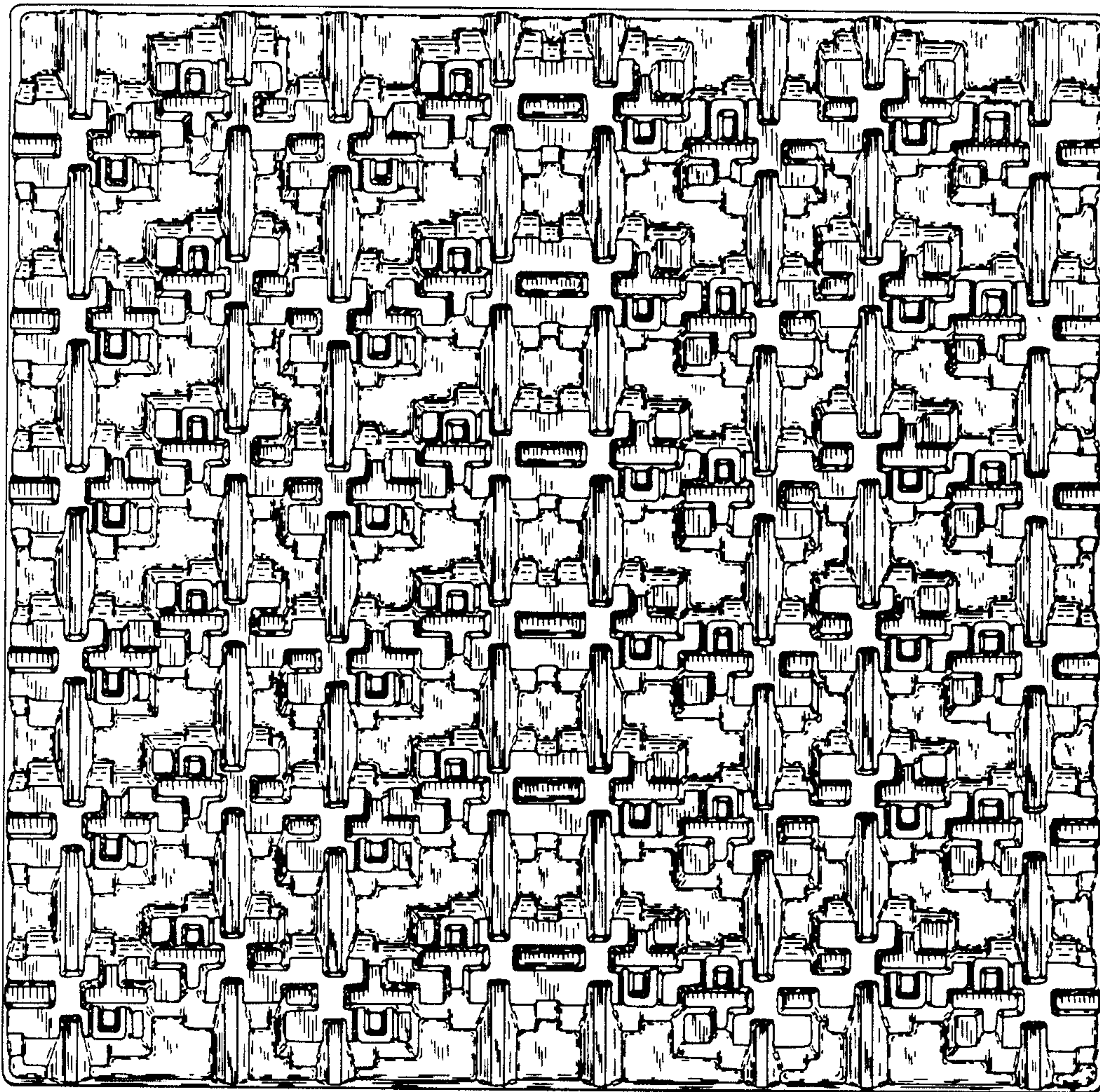
