FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the design.

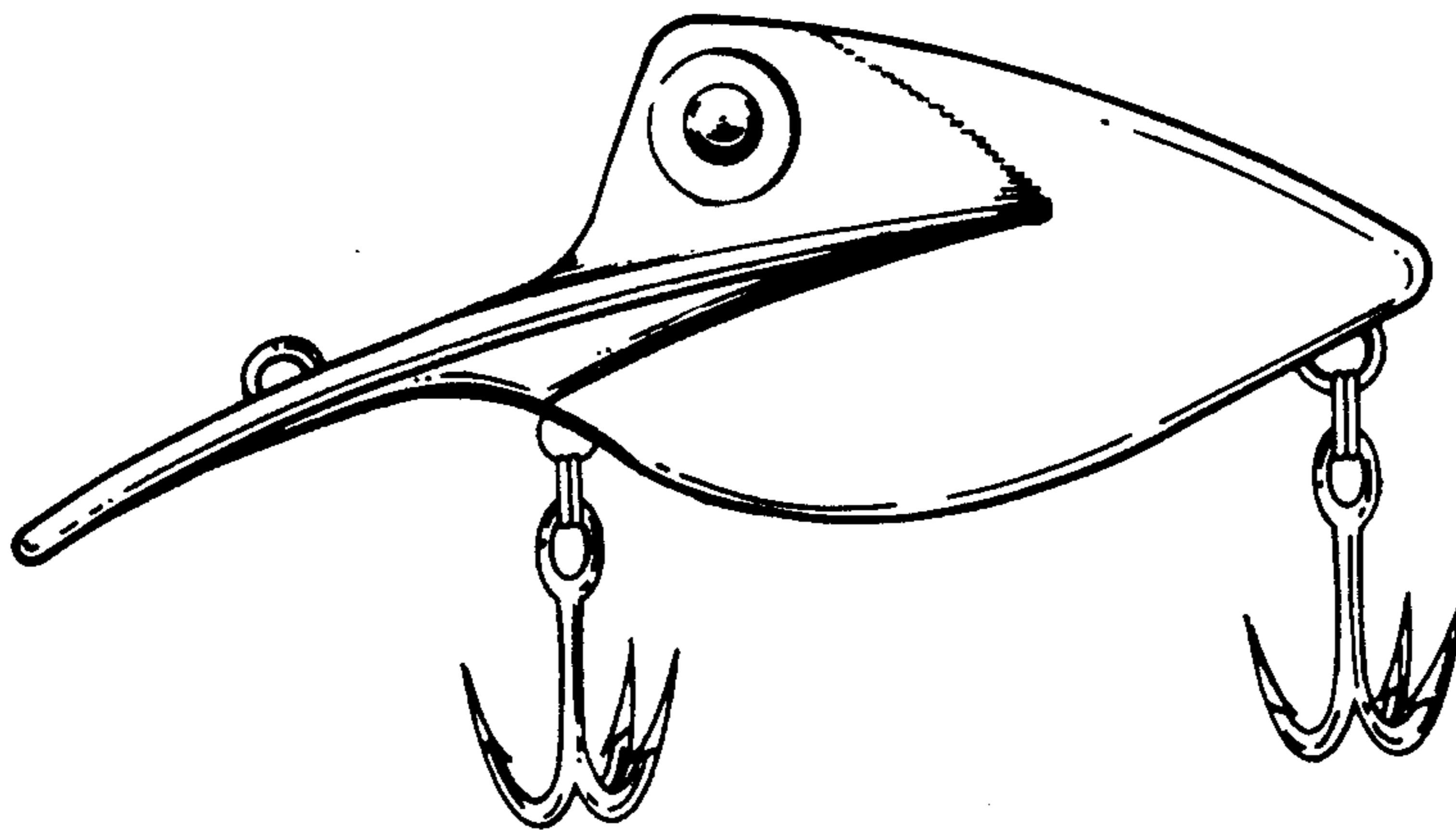

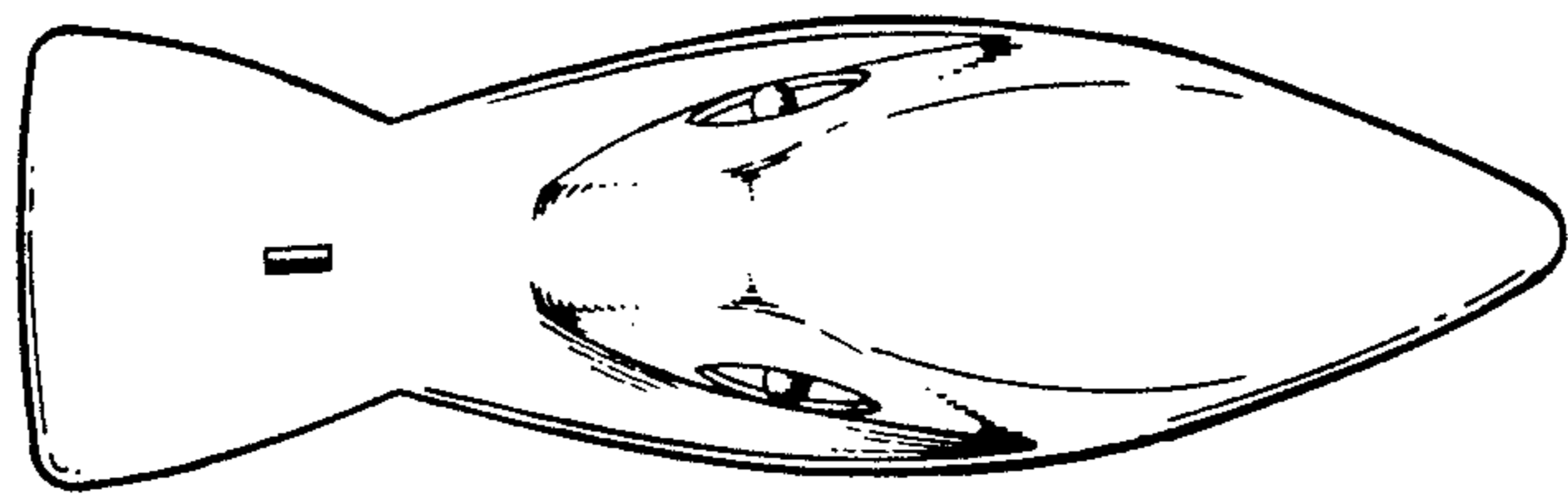

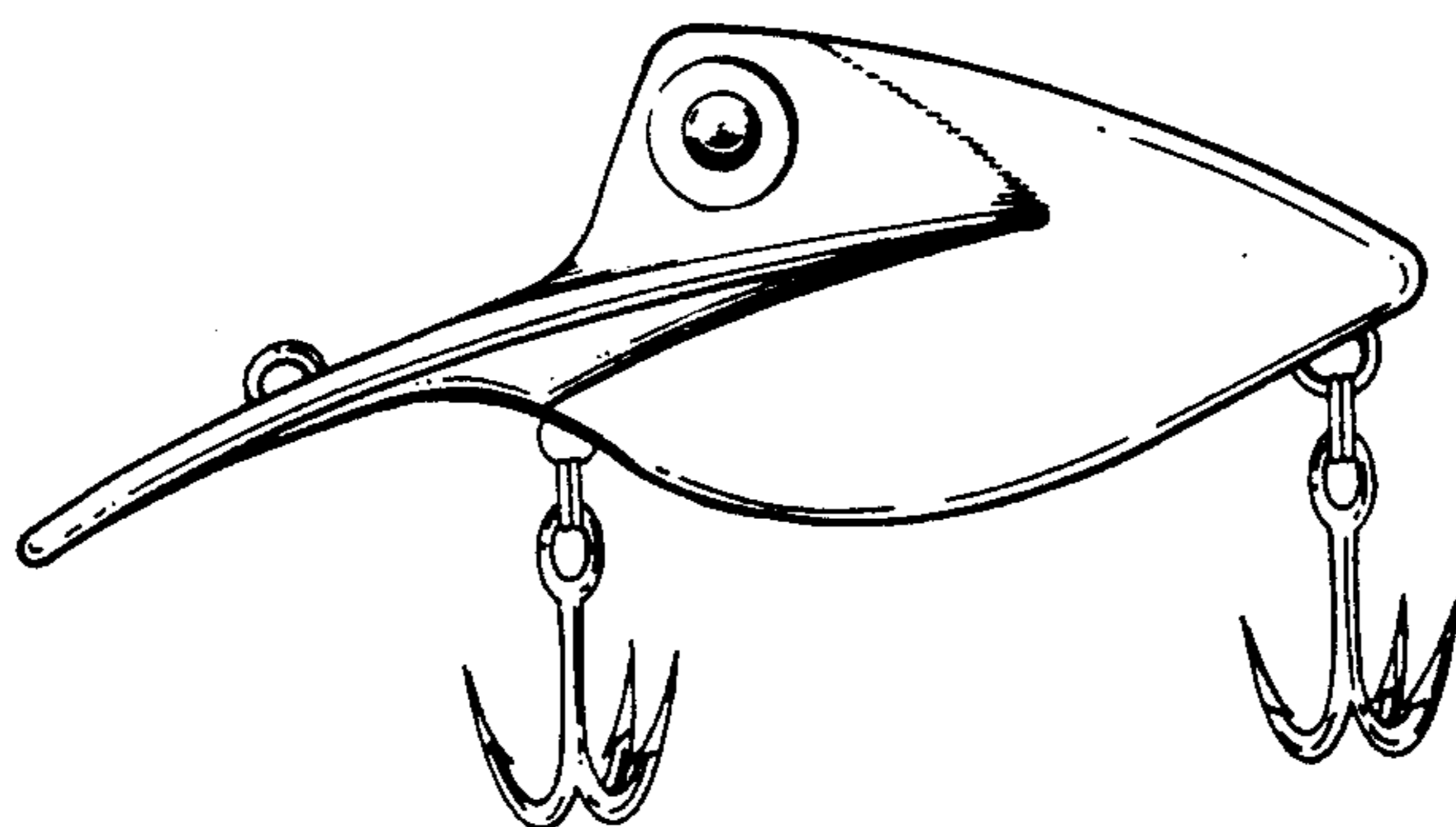
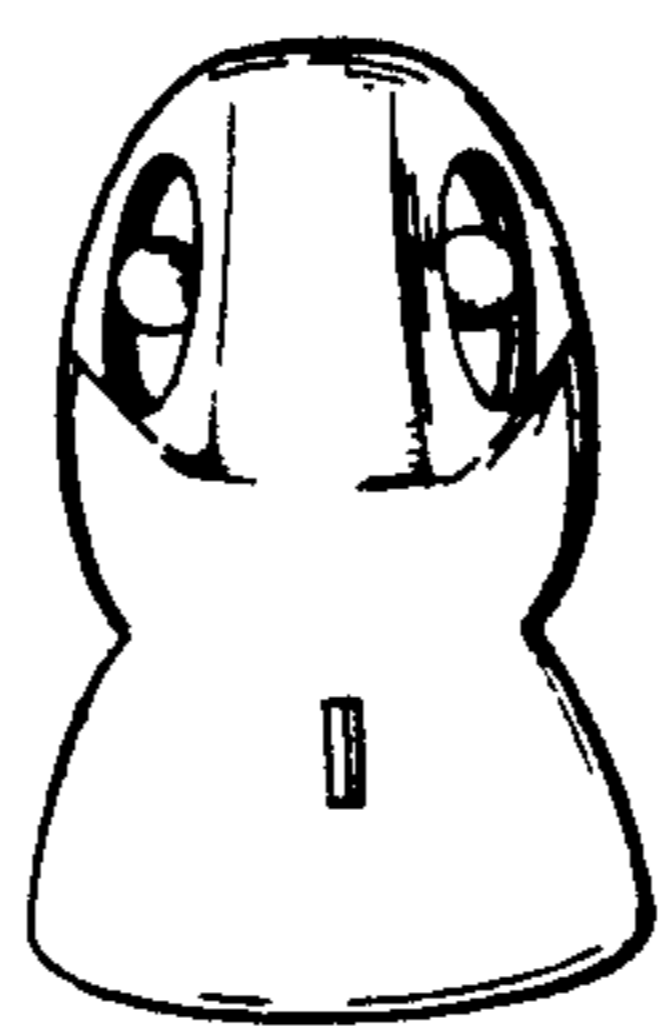

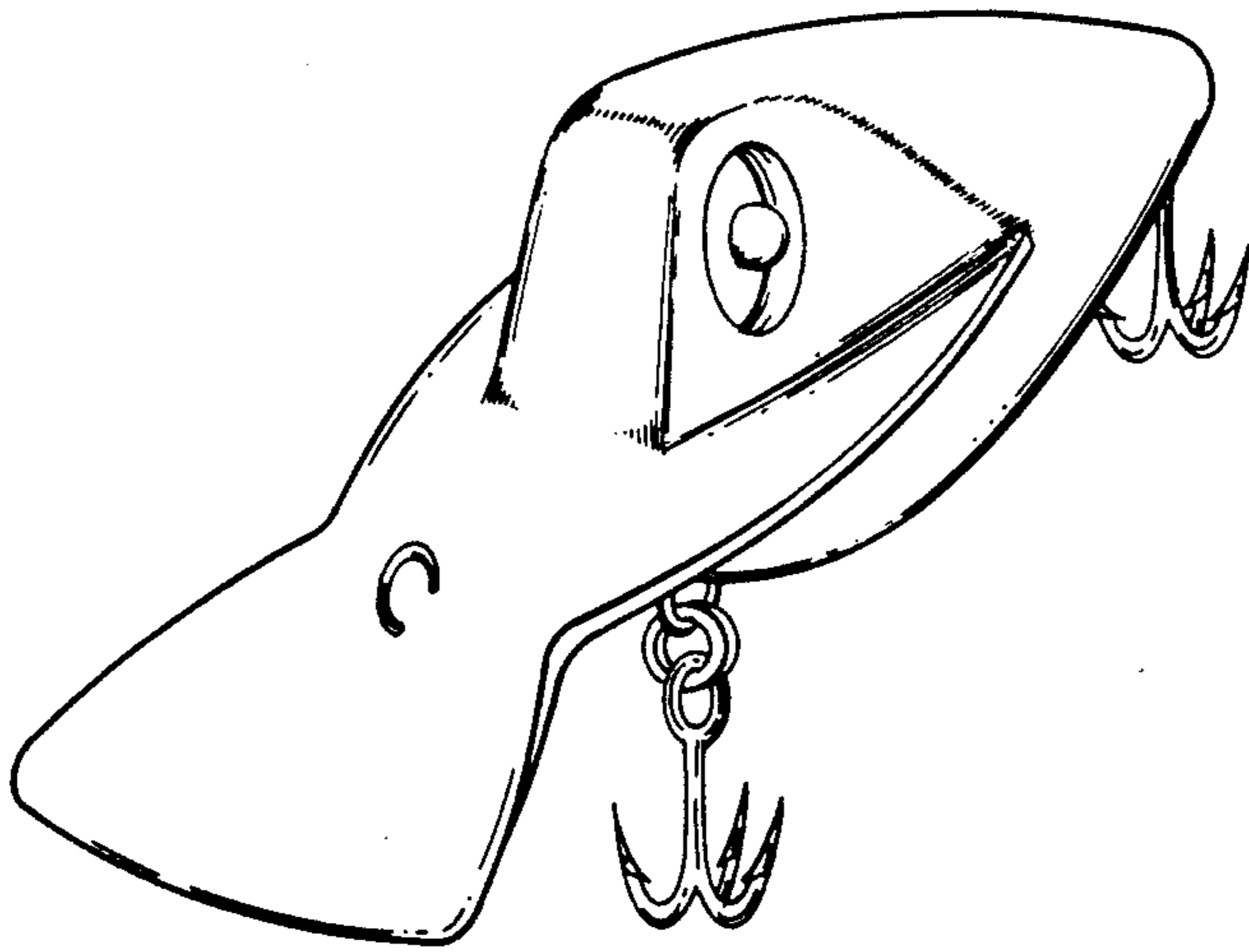
