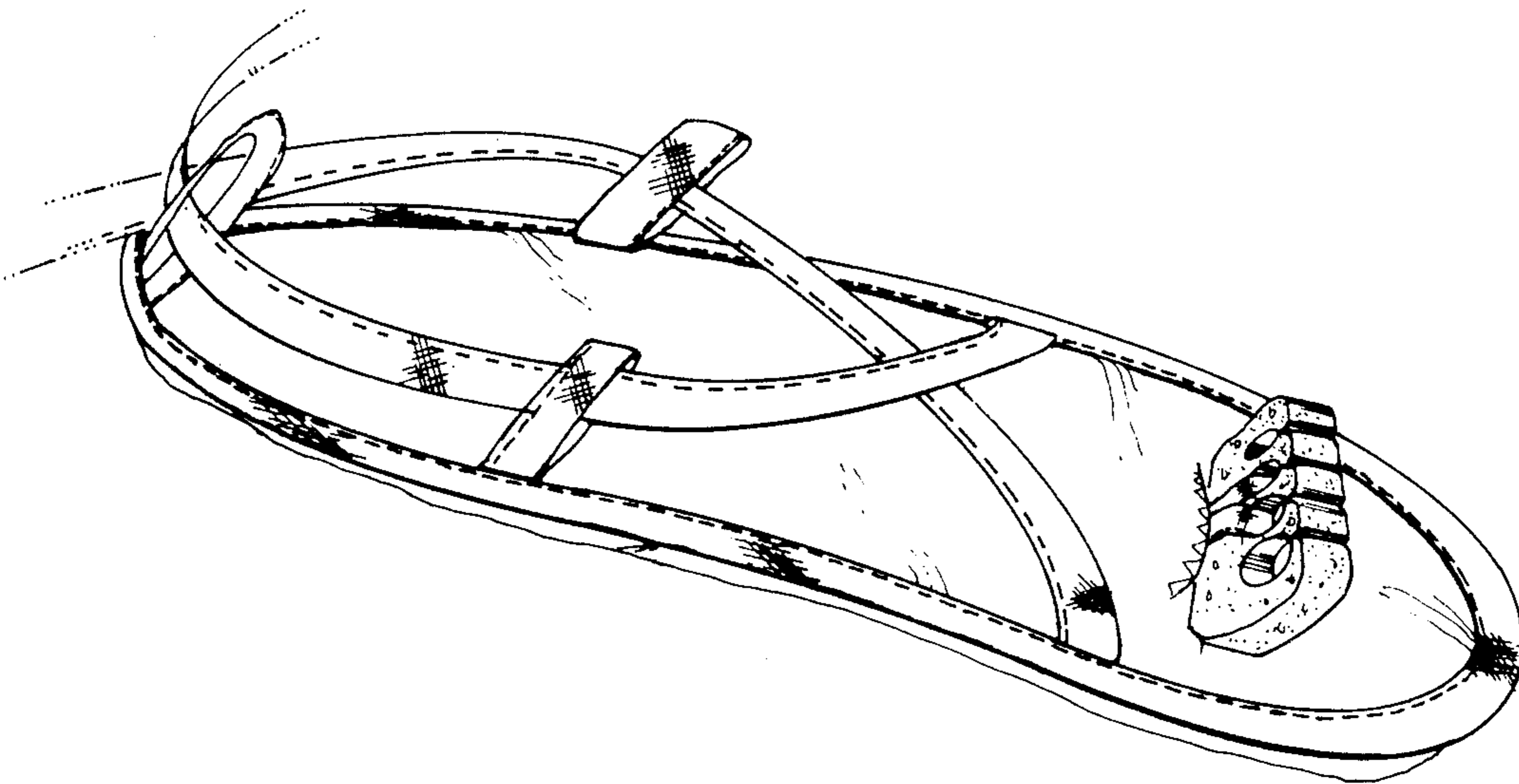

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



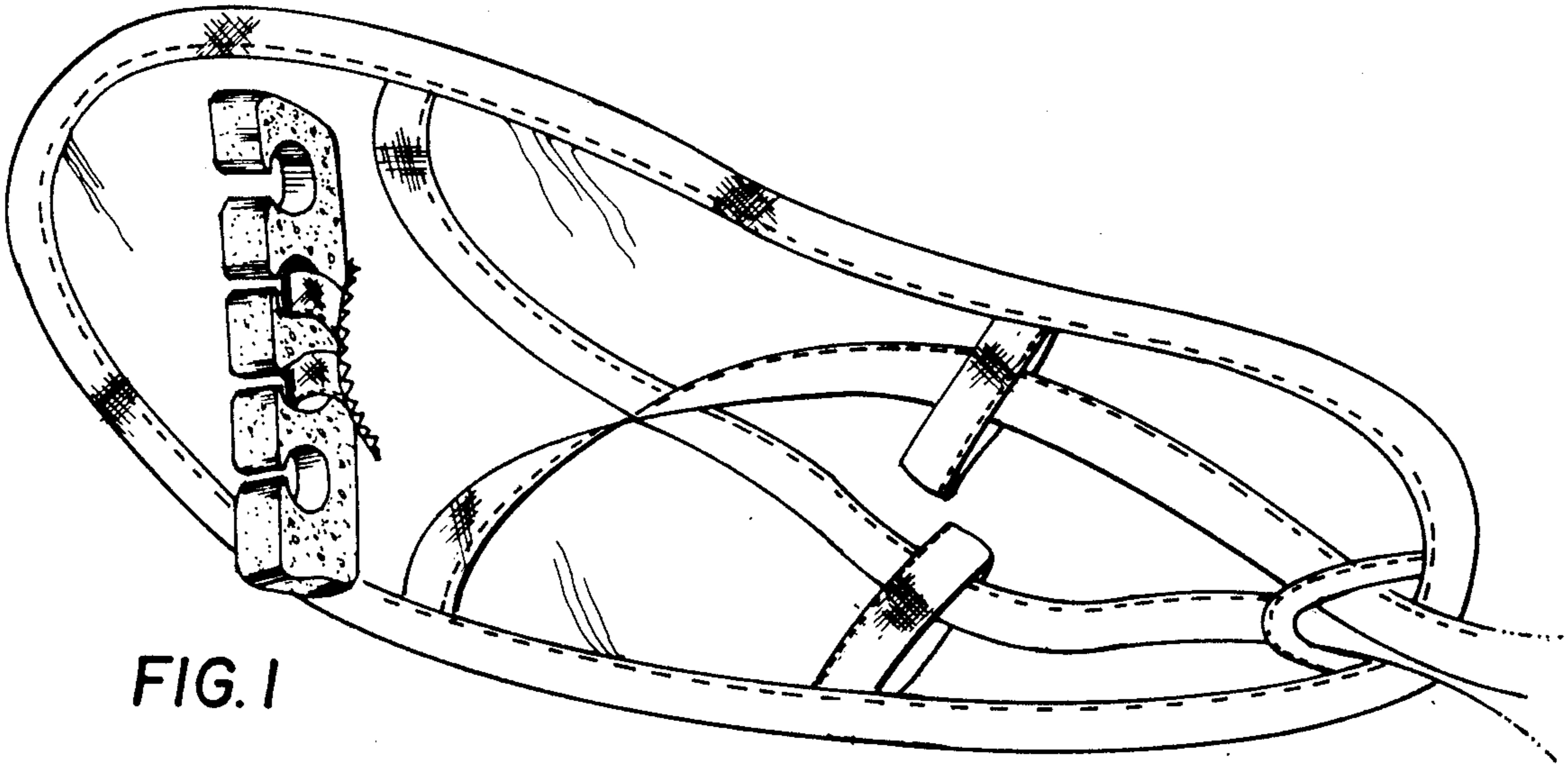

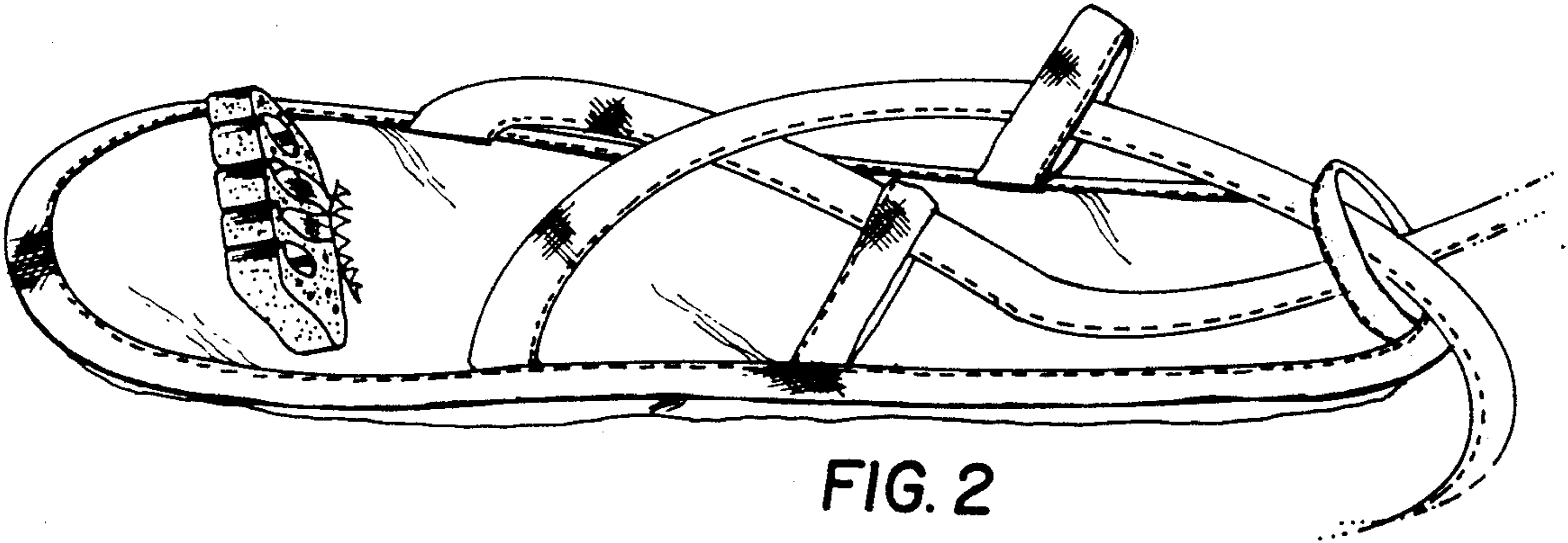

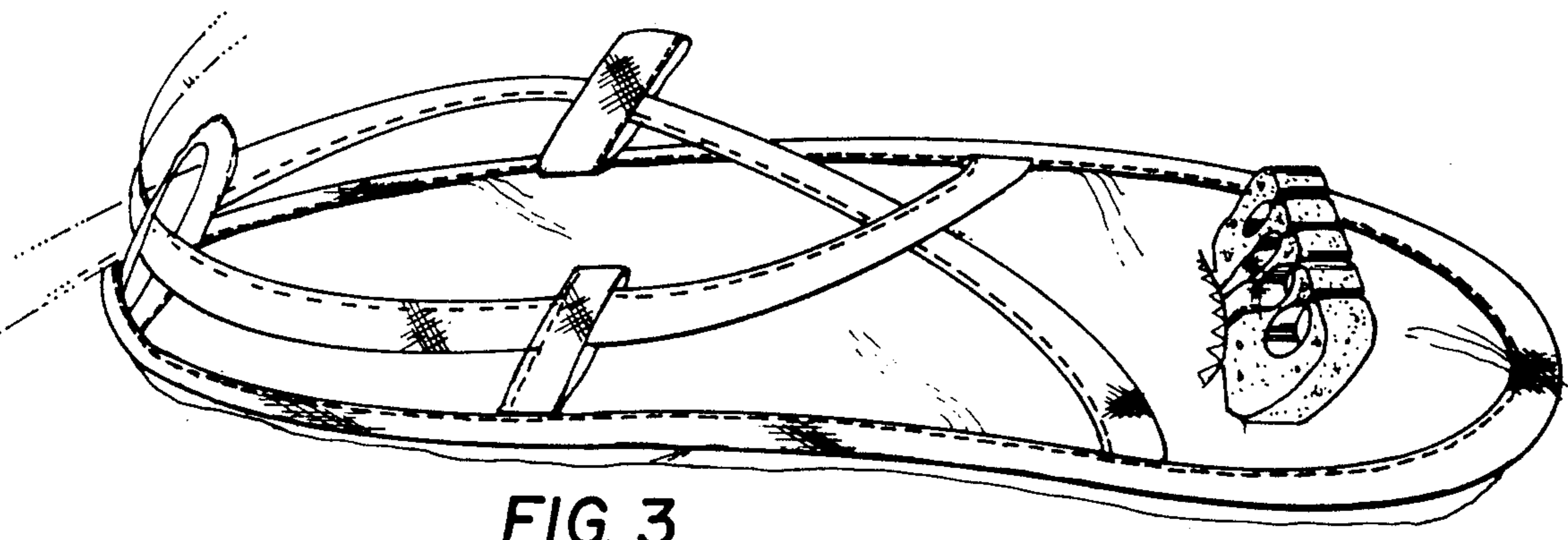

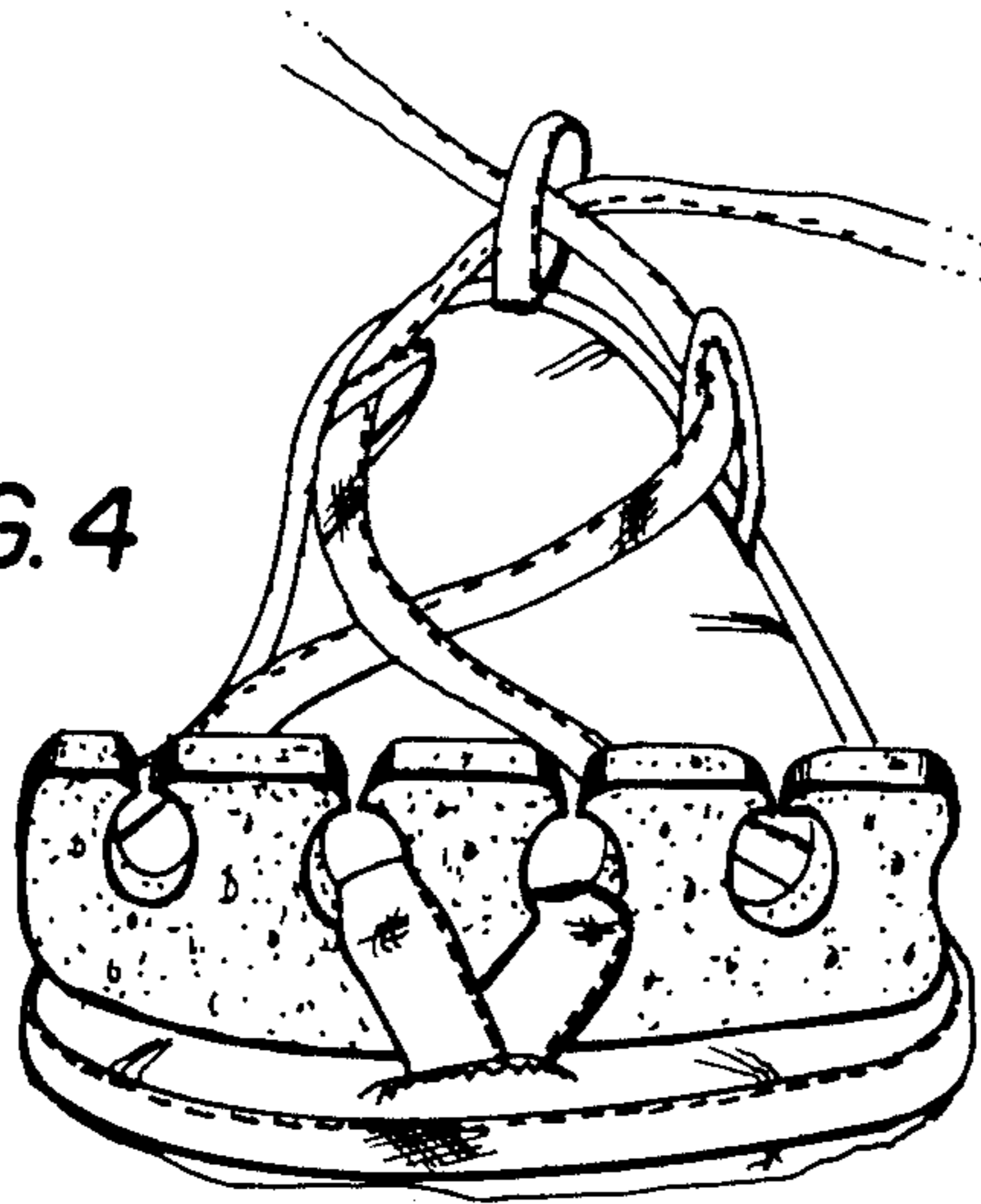
