FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

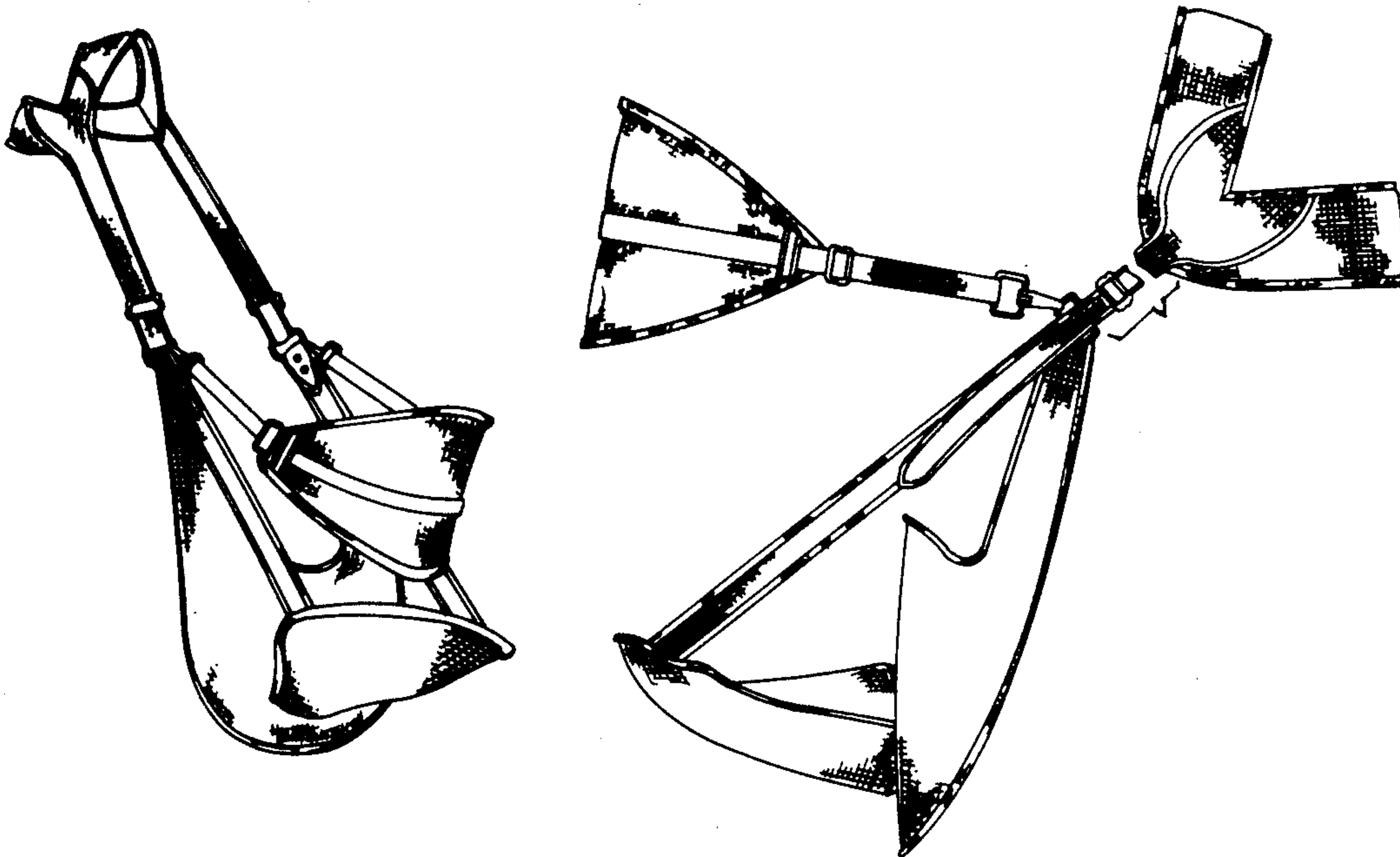
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

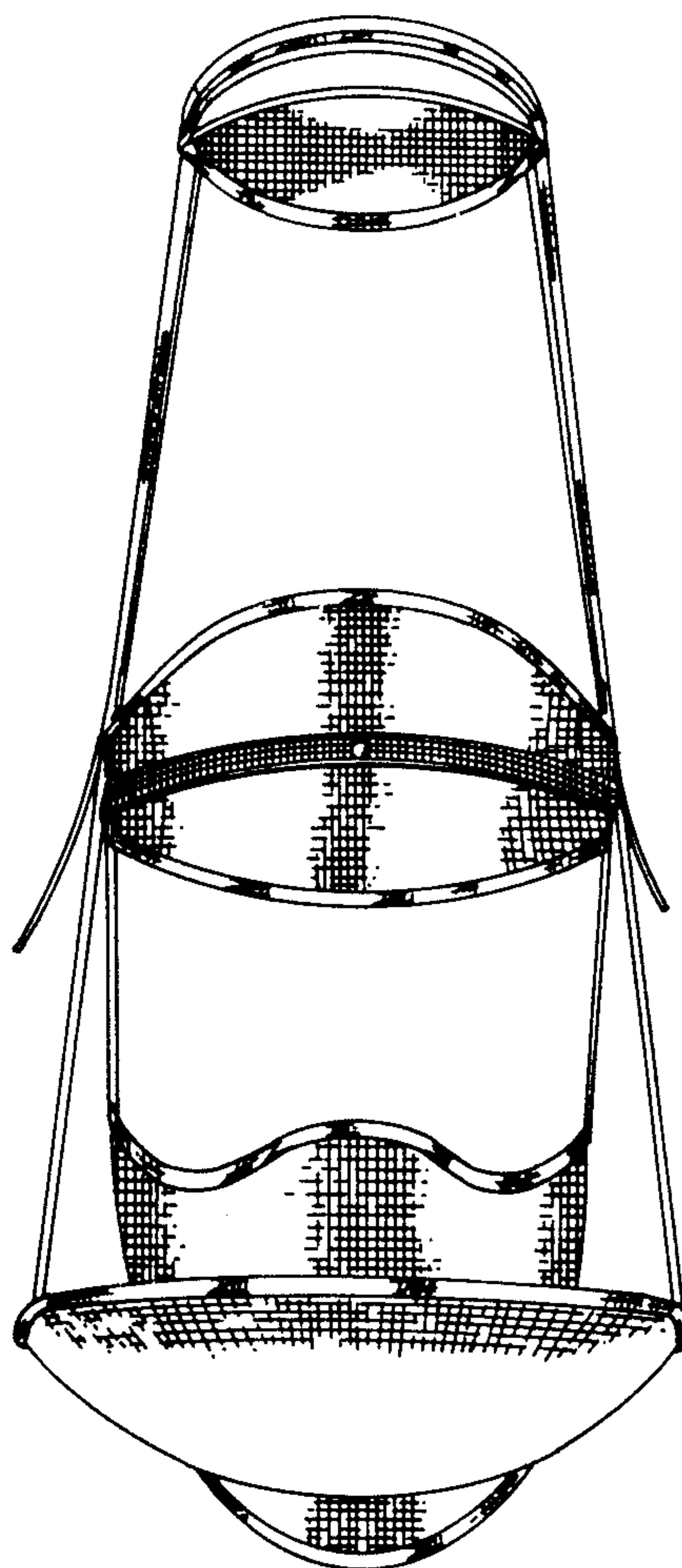
The partial showing of shading indicating a fabric texture is understood to be continuous throughout on the surfaces where shown.

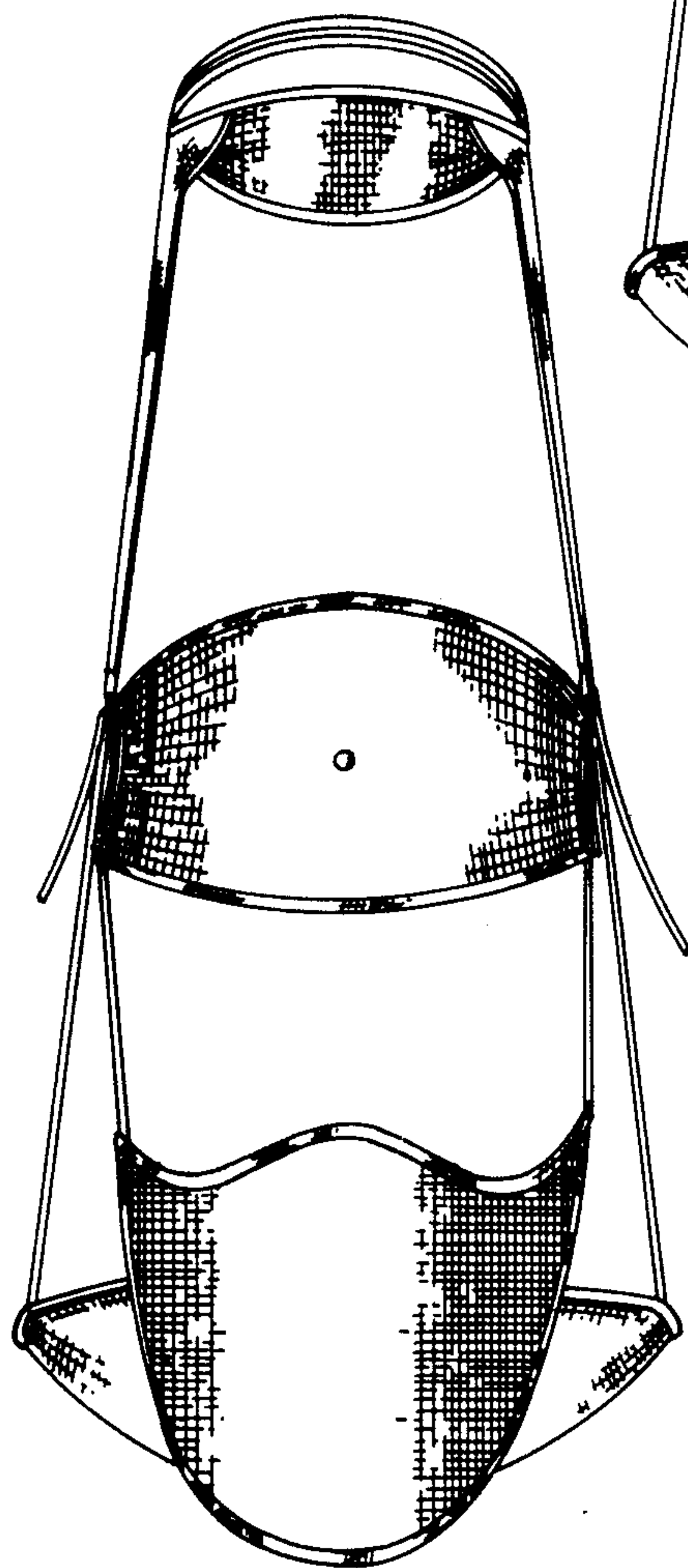

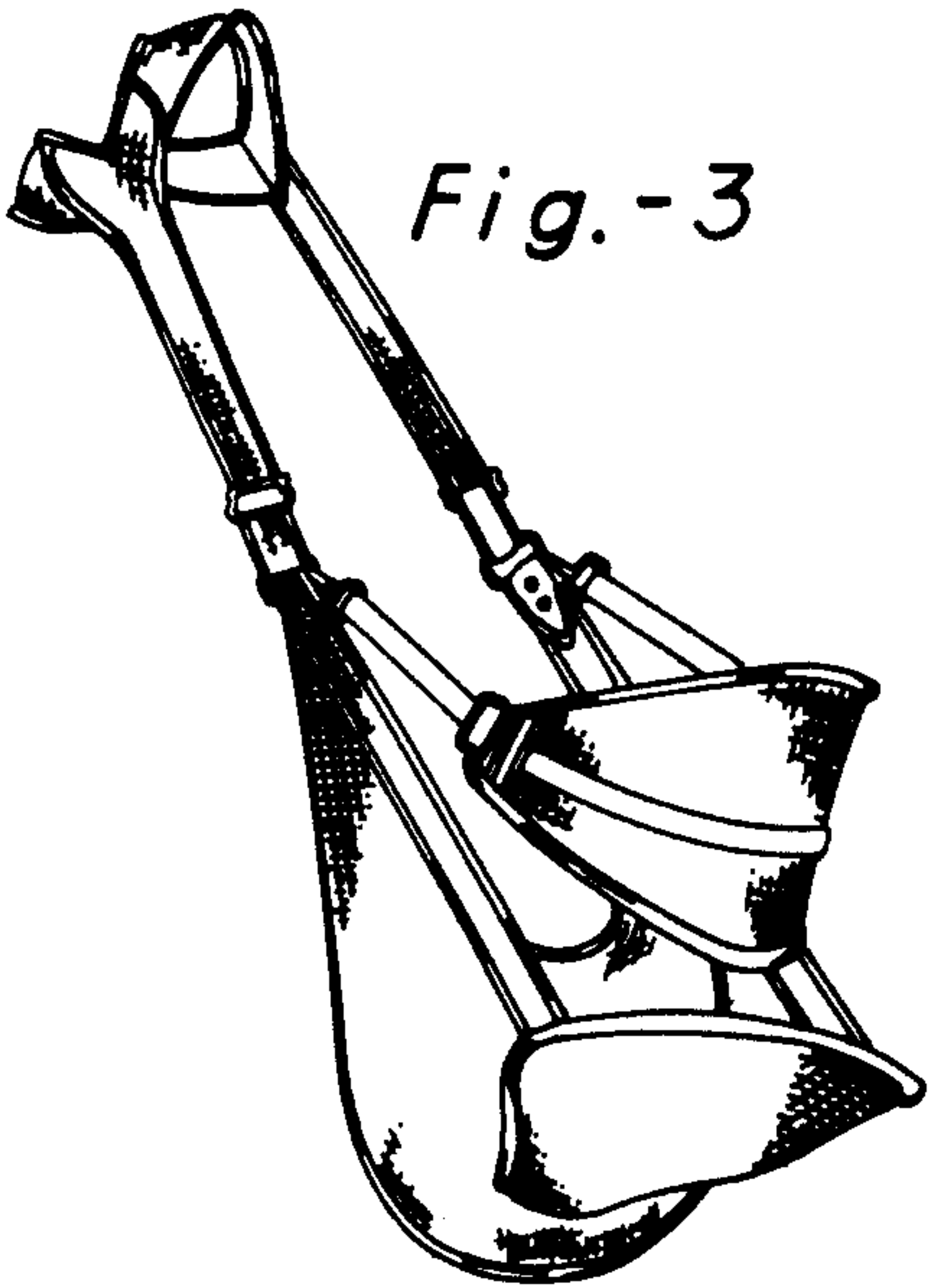




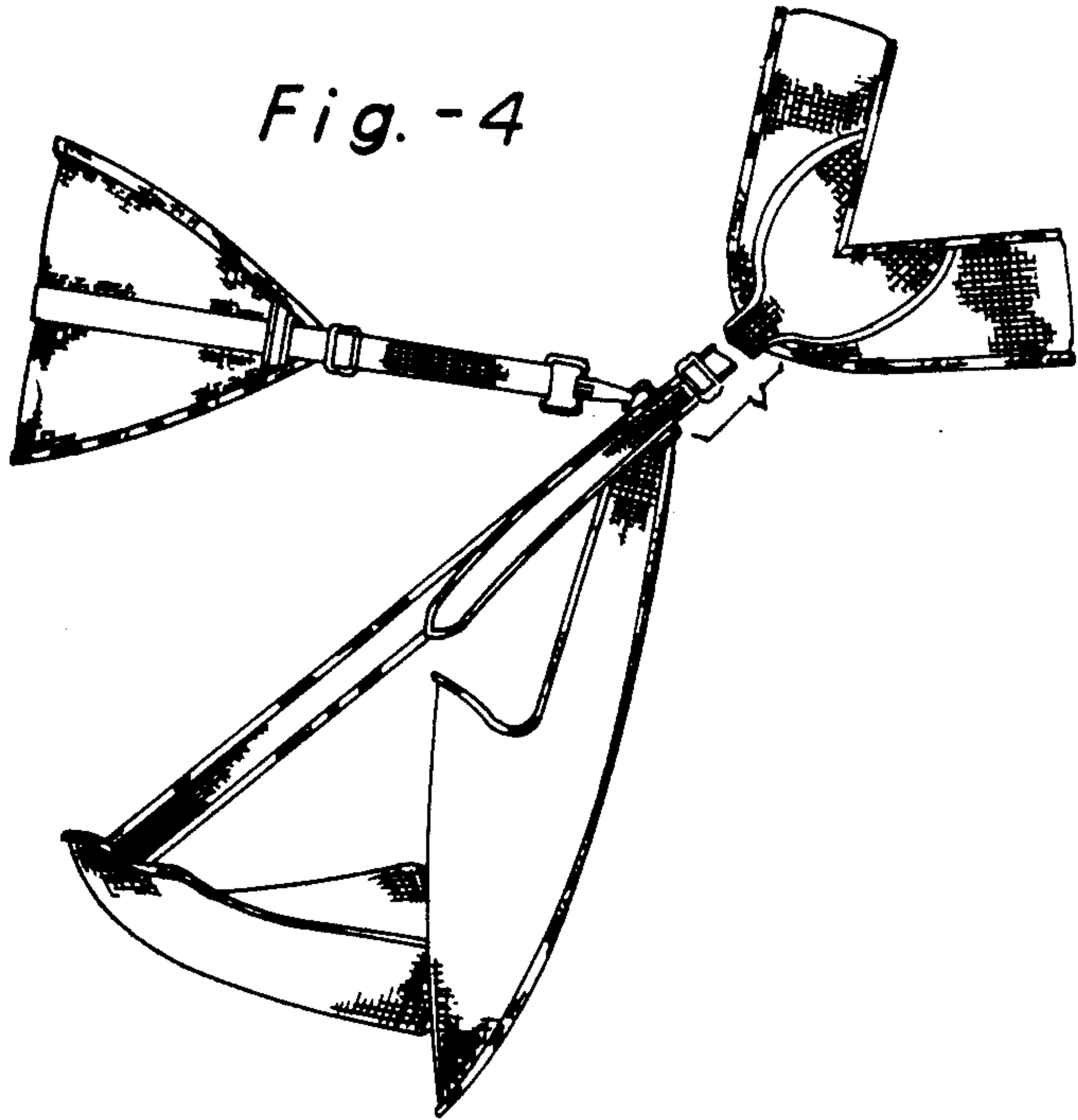

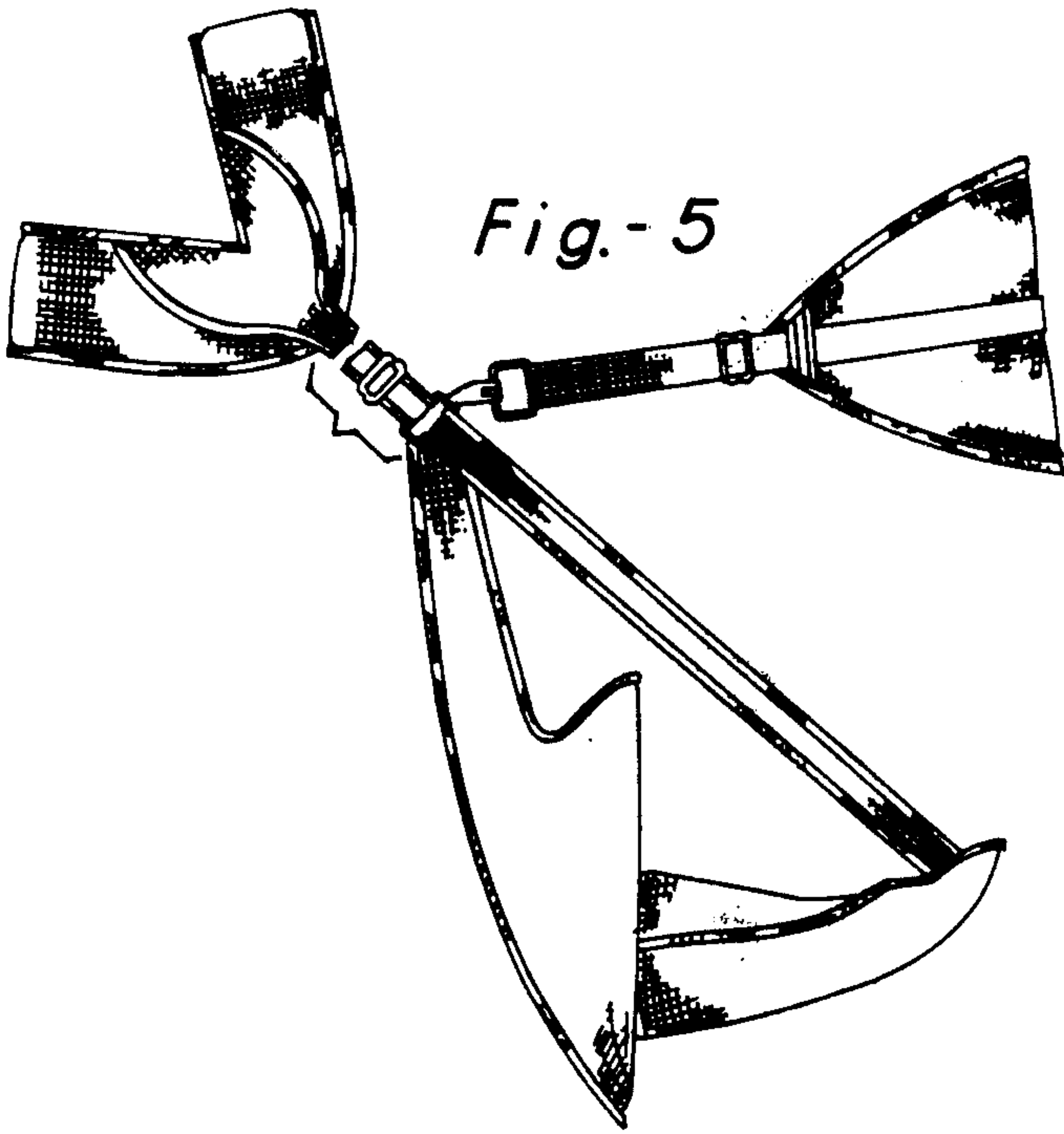

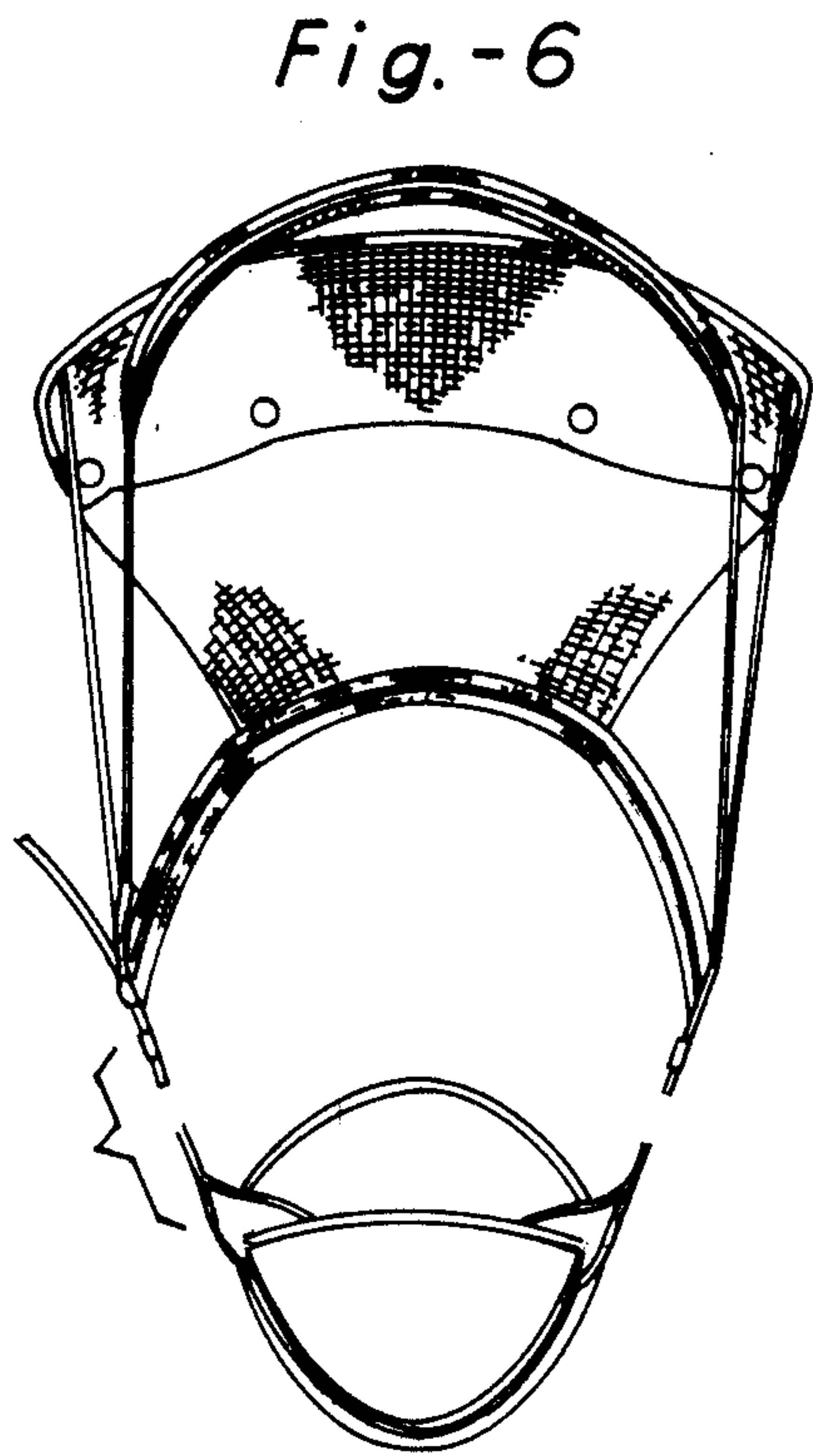
