The ornamental design for a medical identification card, substantially as shown and described.

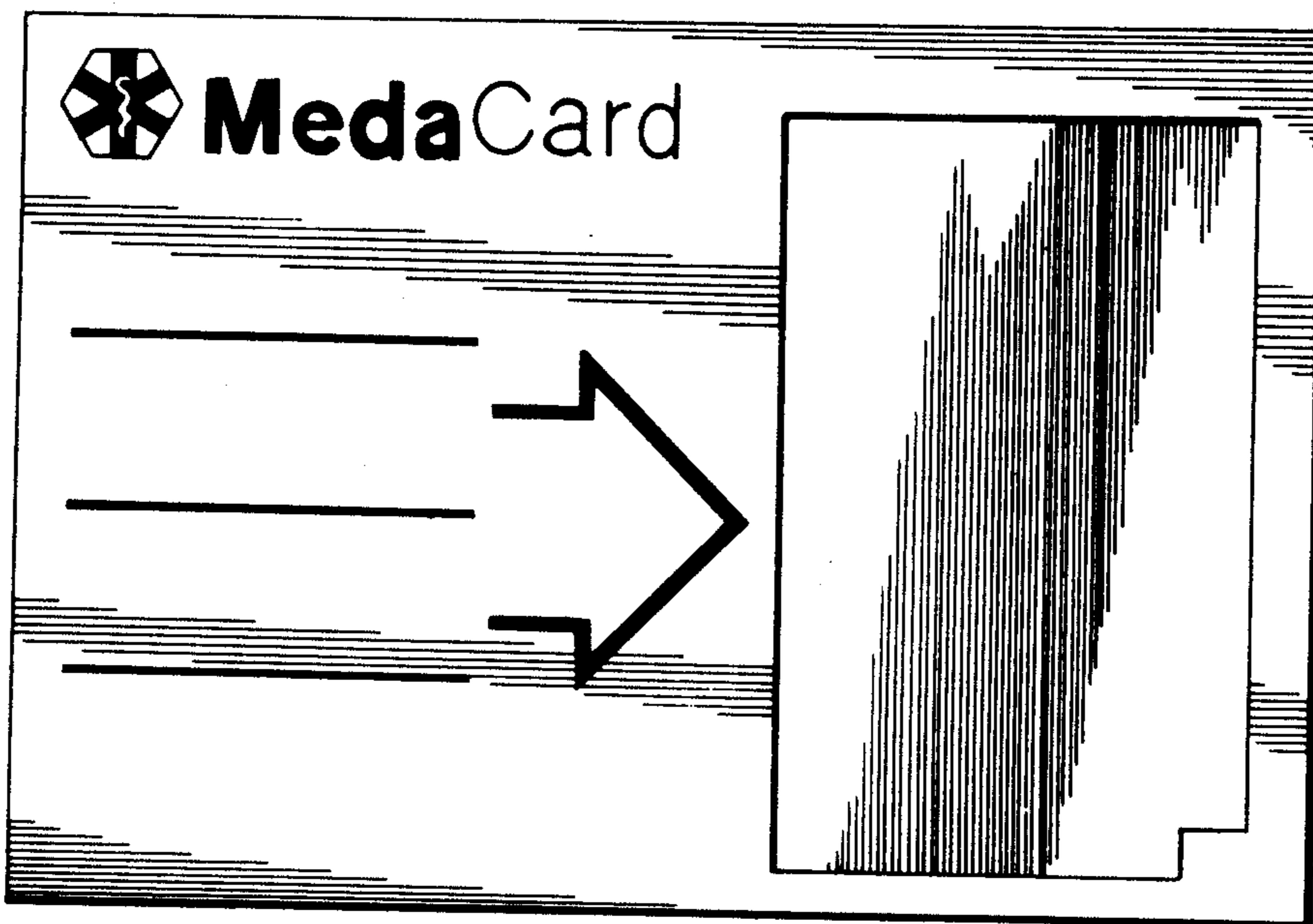
**DESCRIPTION**

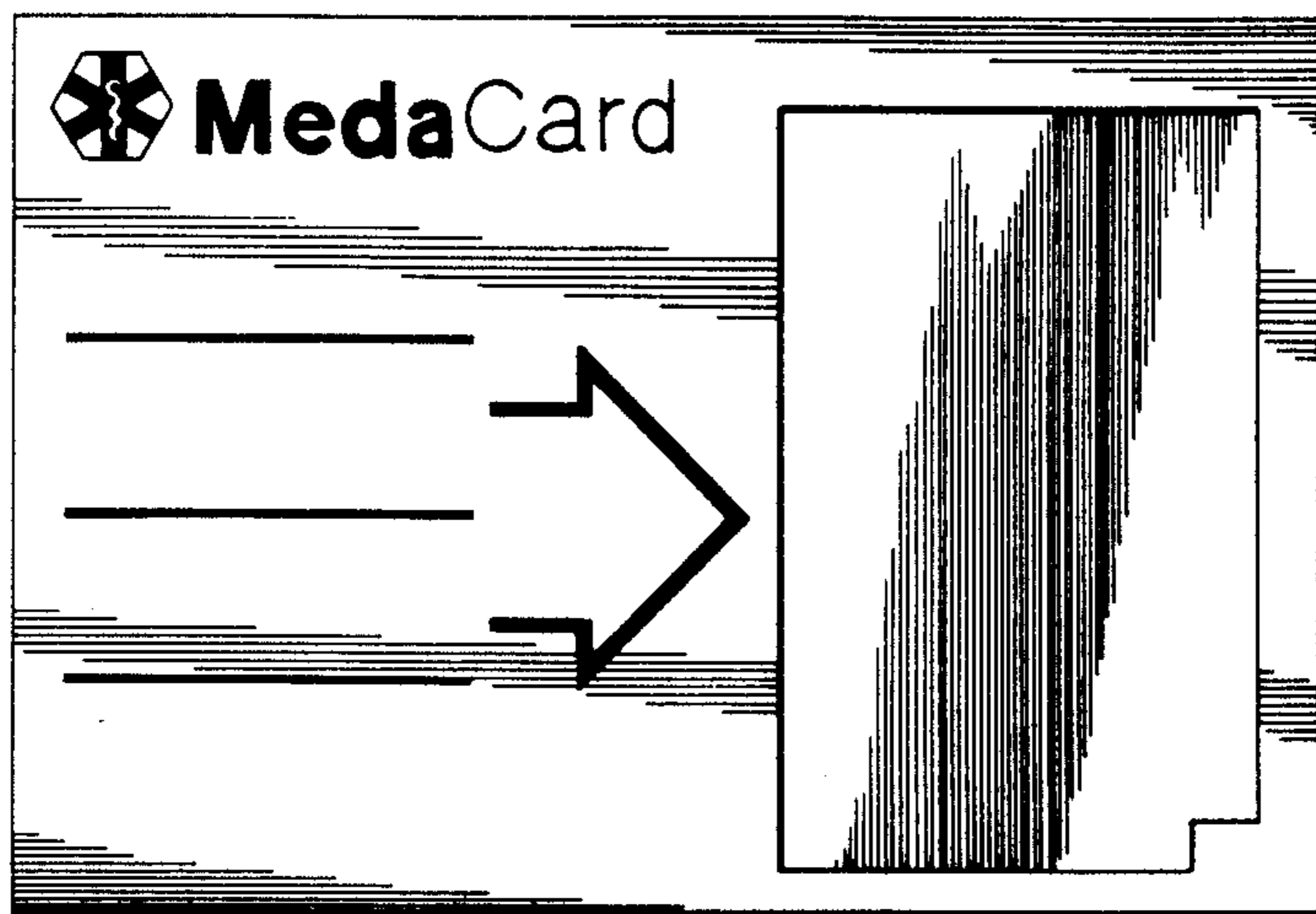
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a medical identification card showing my new design.

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, with the opposite side elevational view being substantially identical thereto.

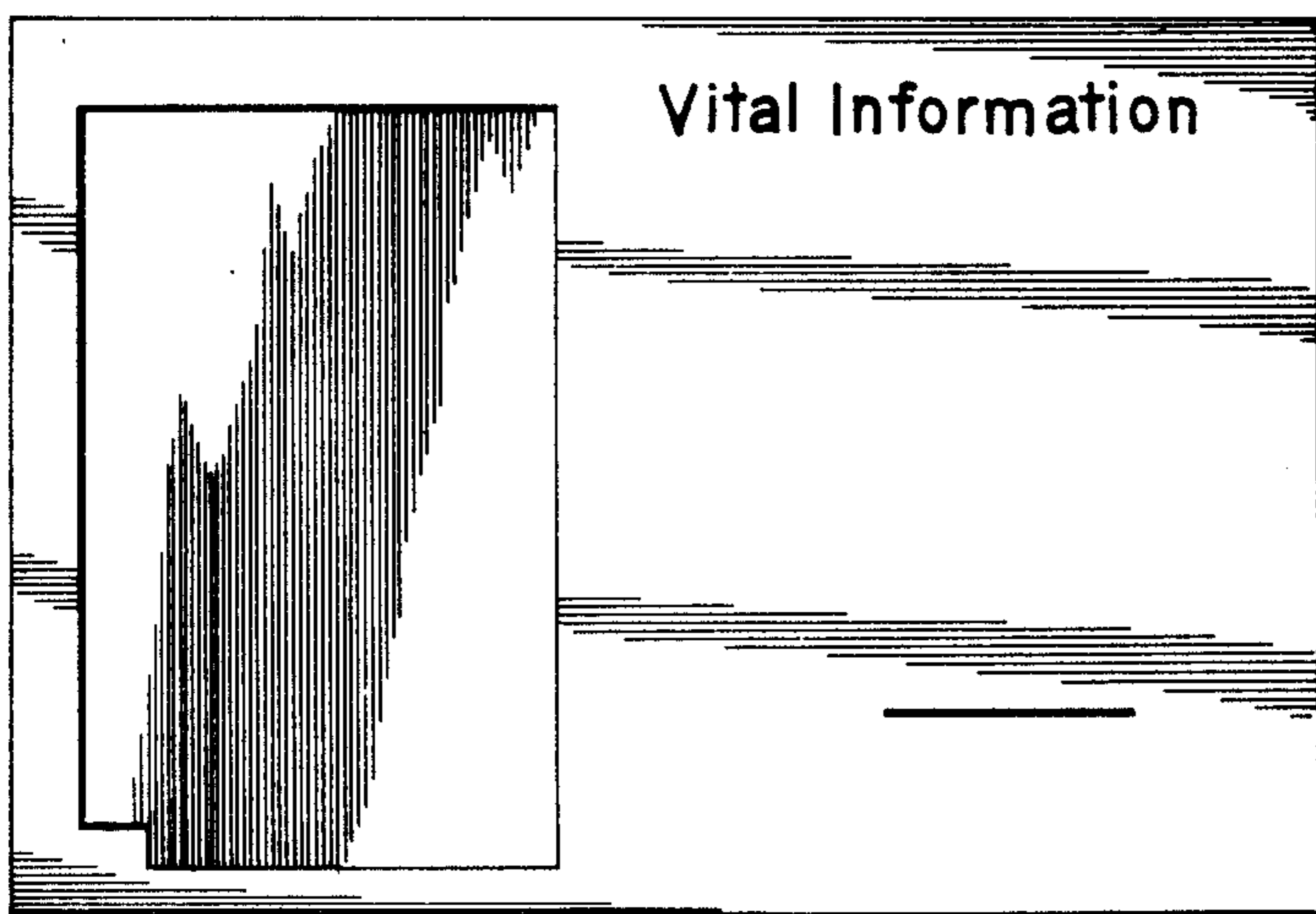
