[57] The ornamental design for a bookcase, as shown and described.

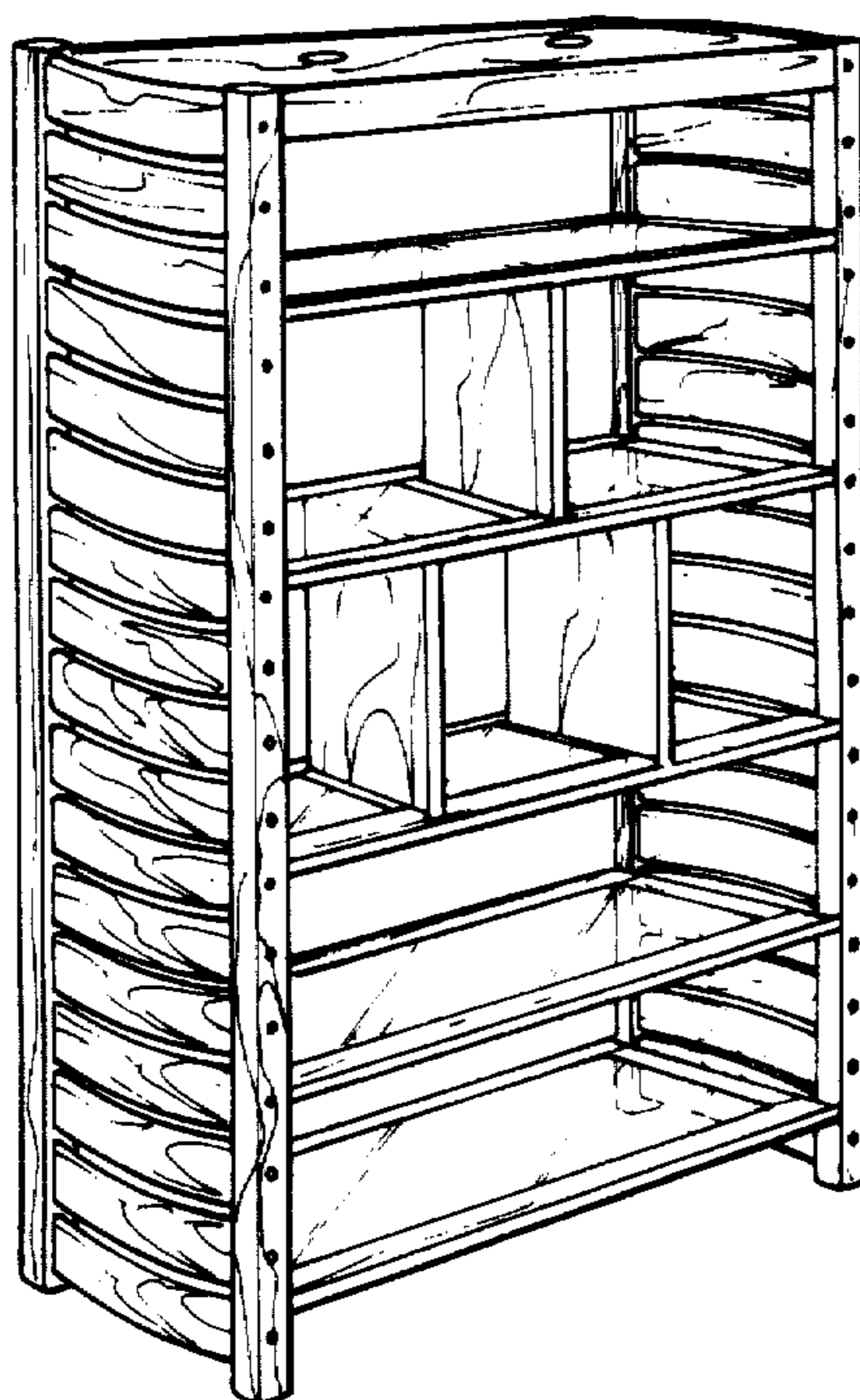
