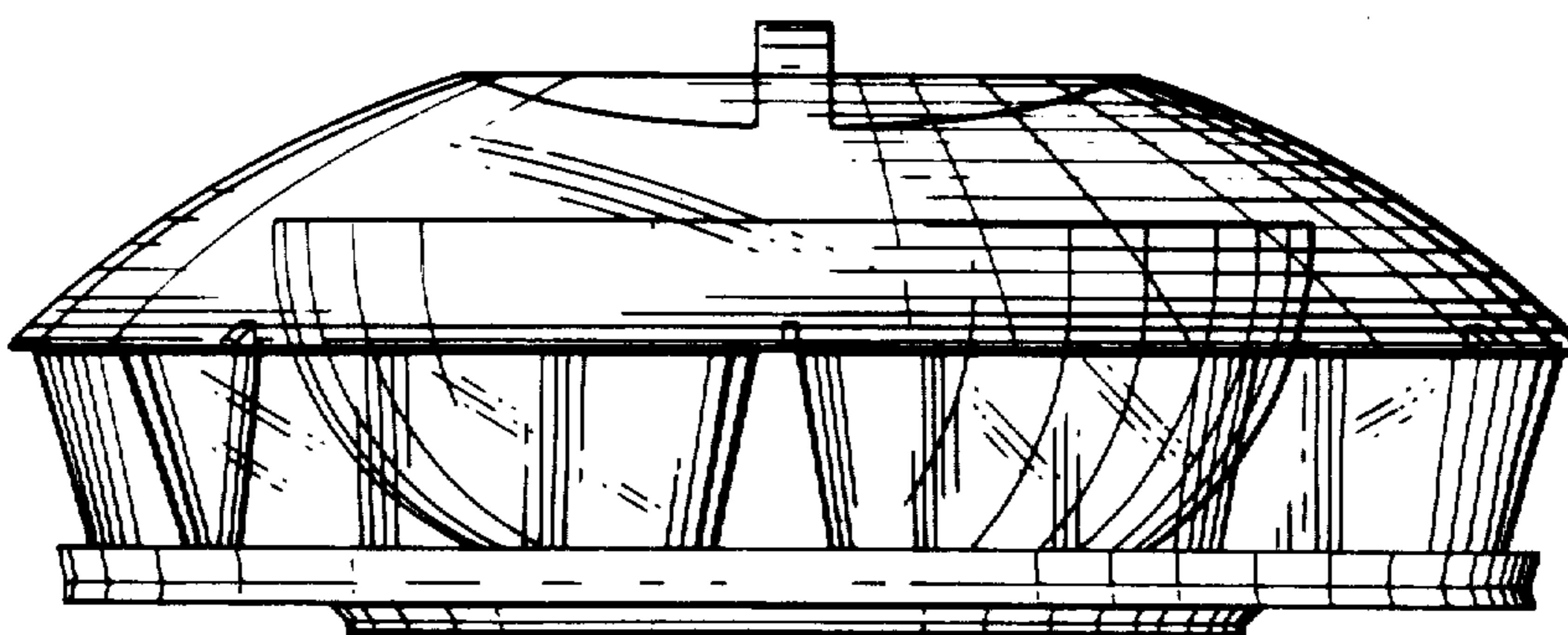
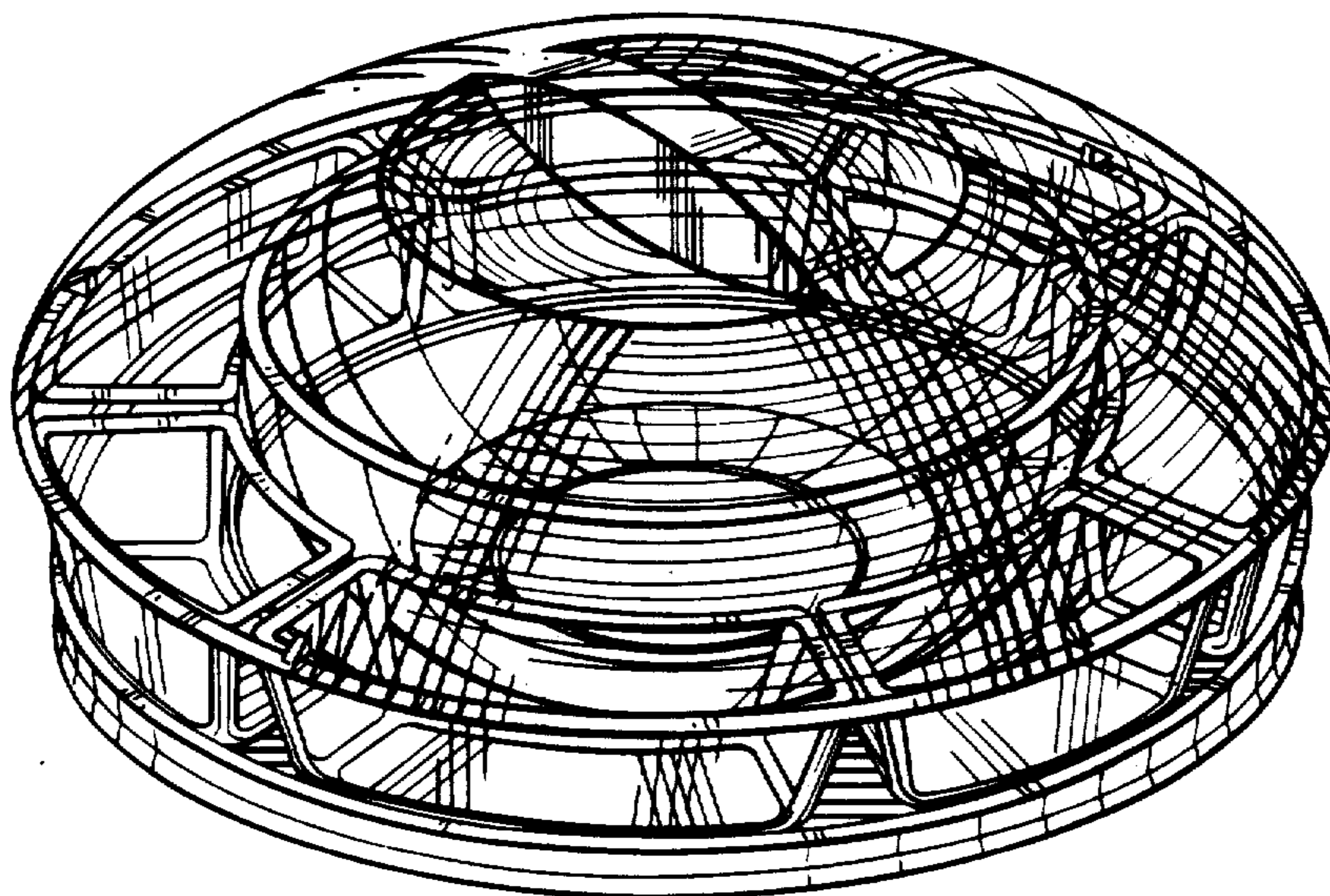
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a rotatable food serving assembly, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a rotatable food serving assembly showing our new design;

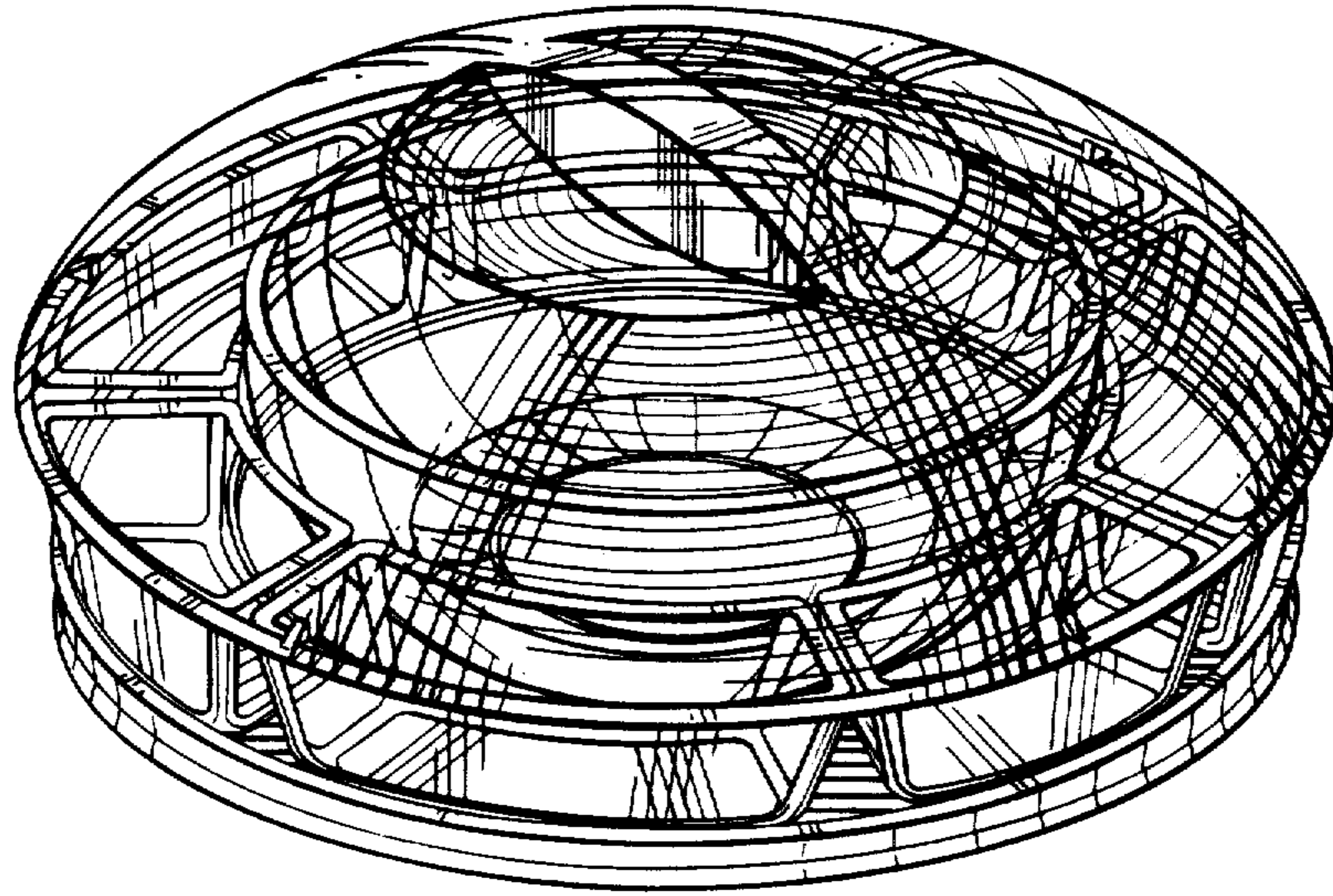

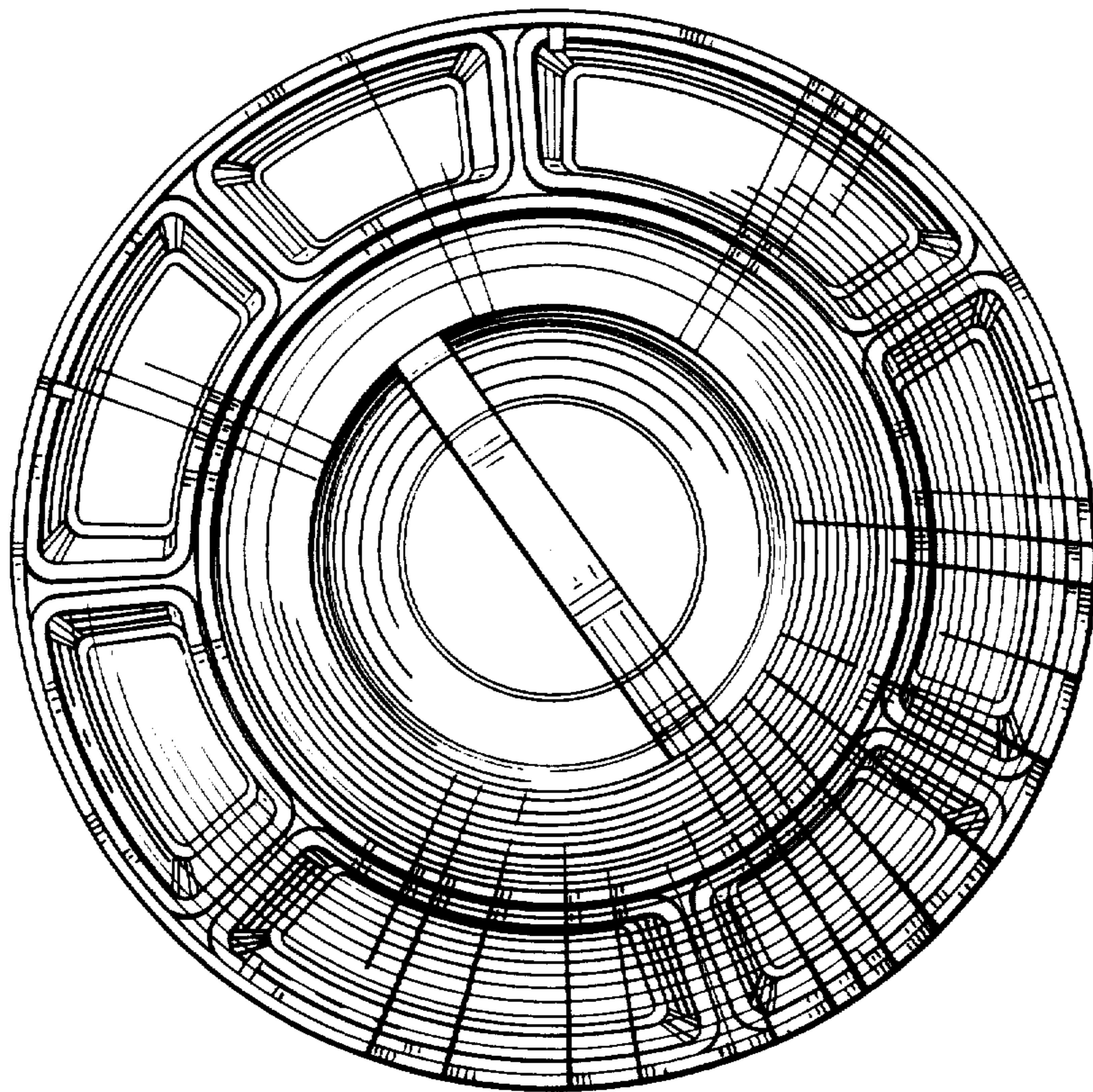

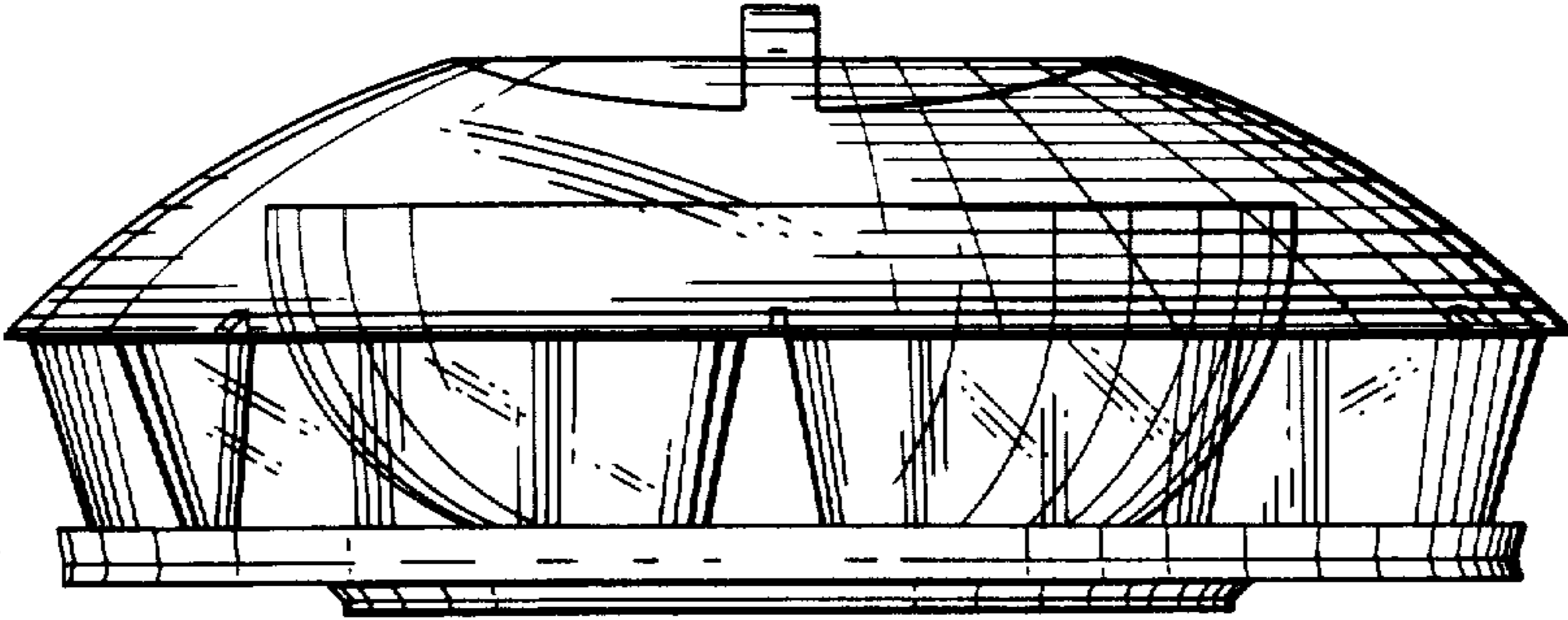

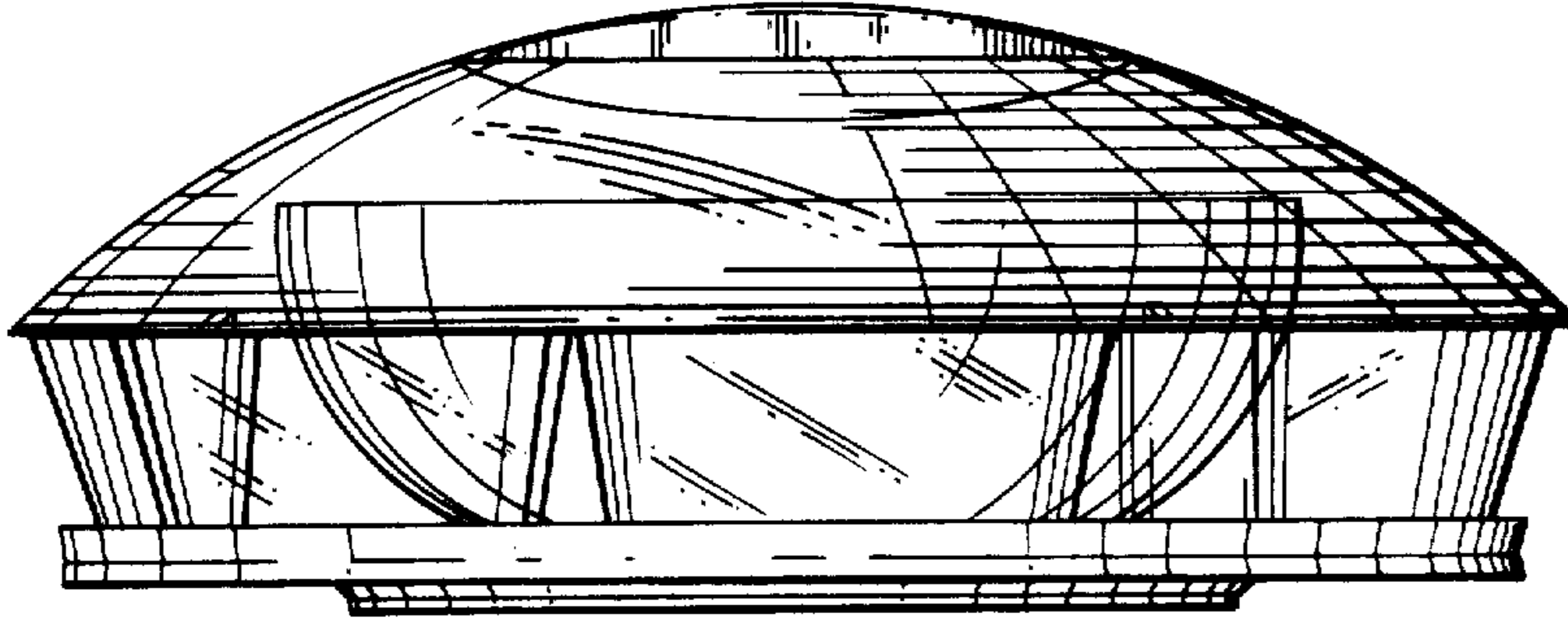

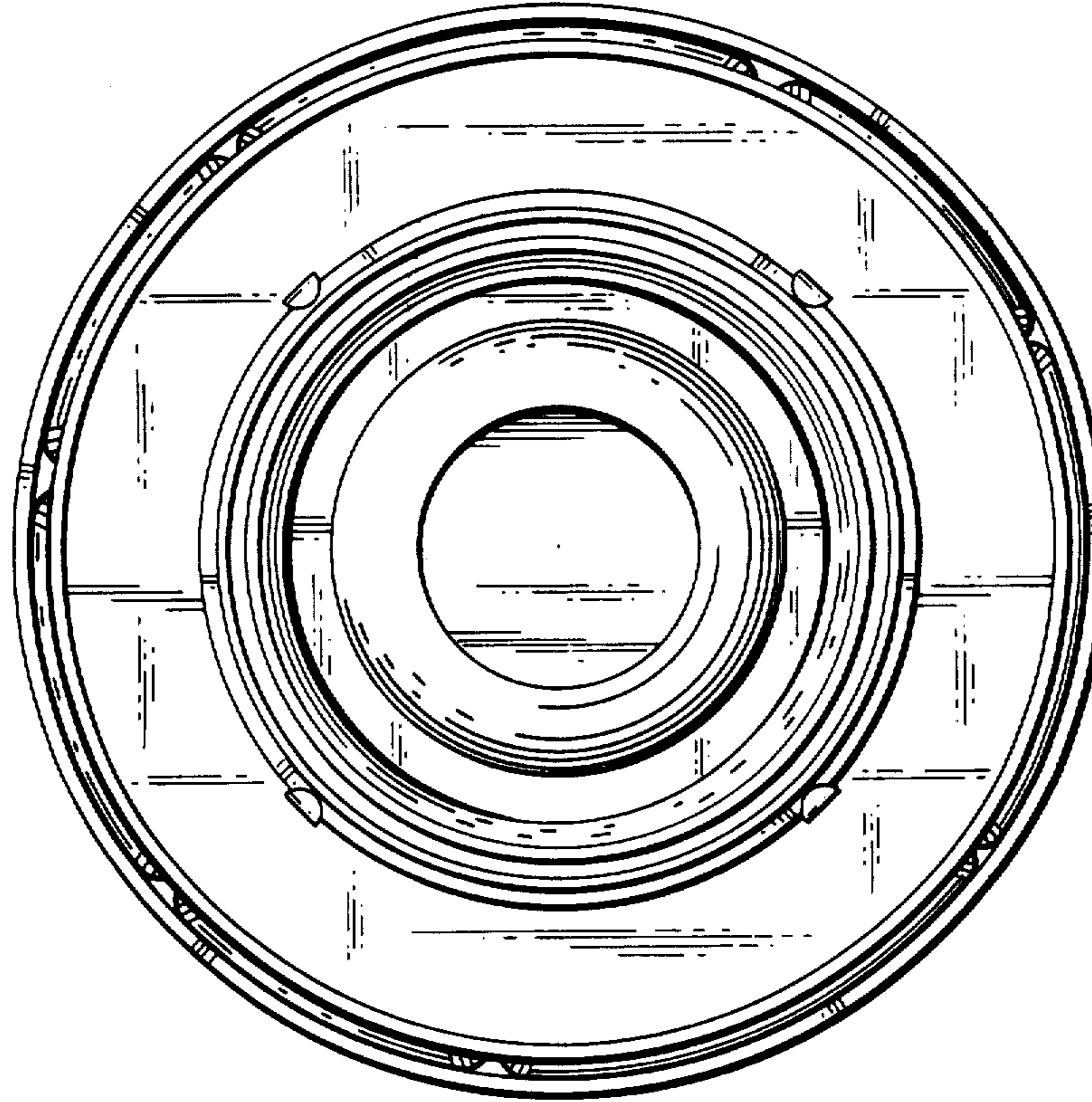
