FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a tape recorder and player showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof.

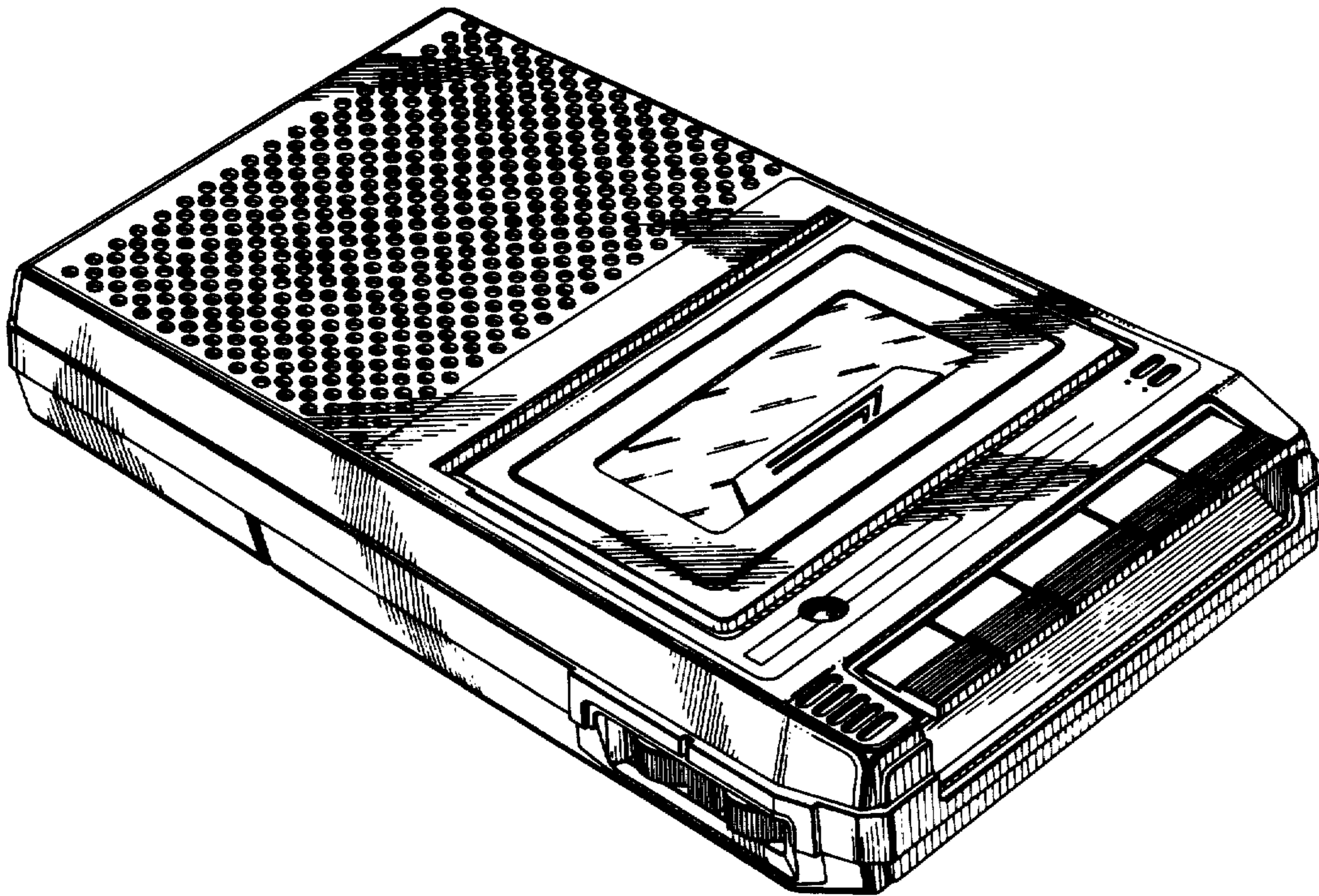
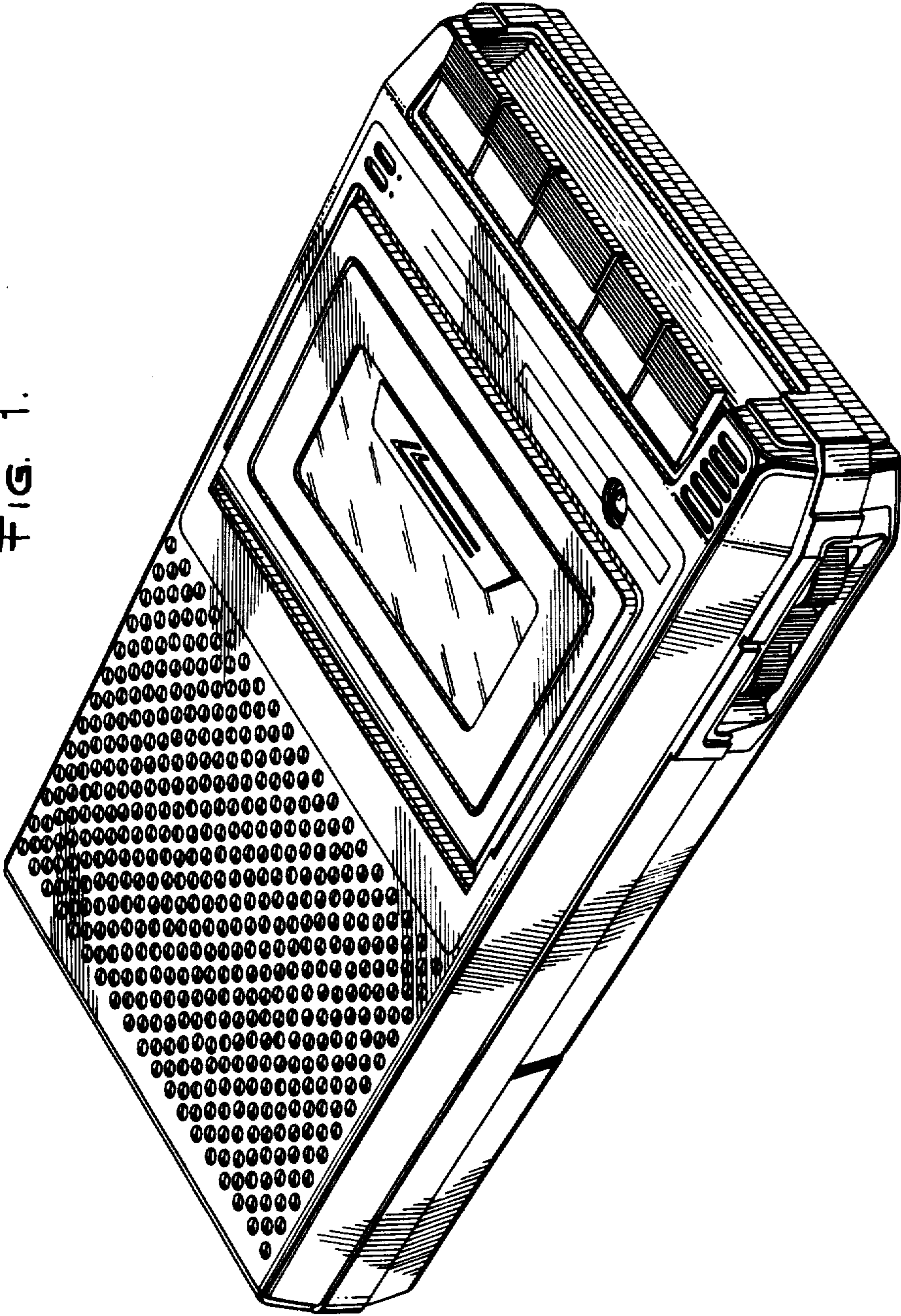

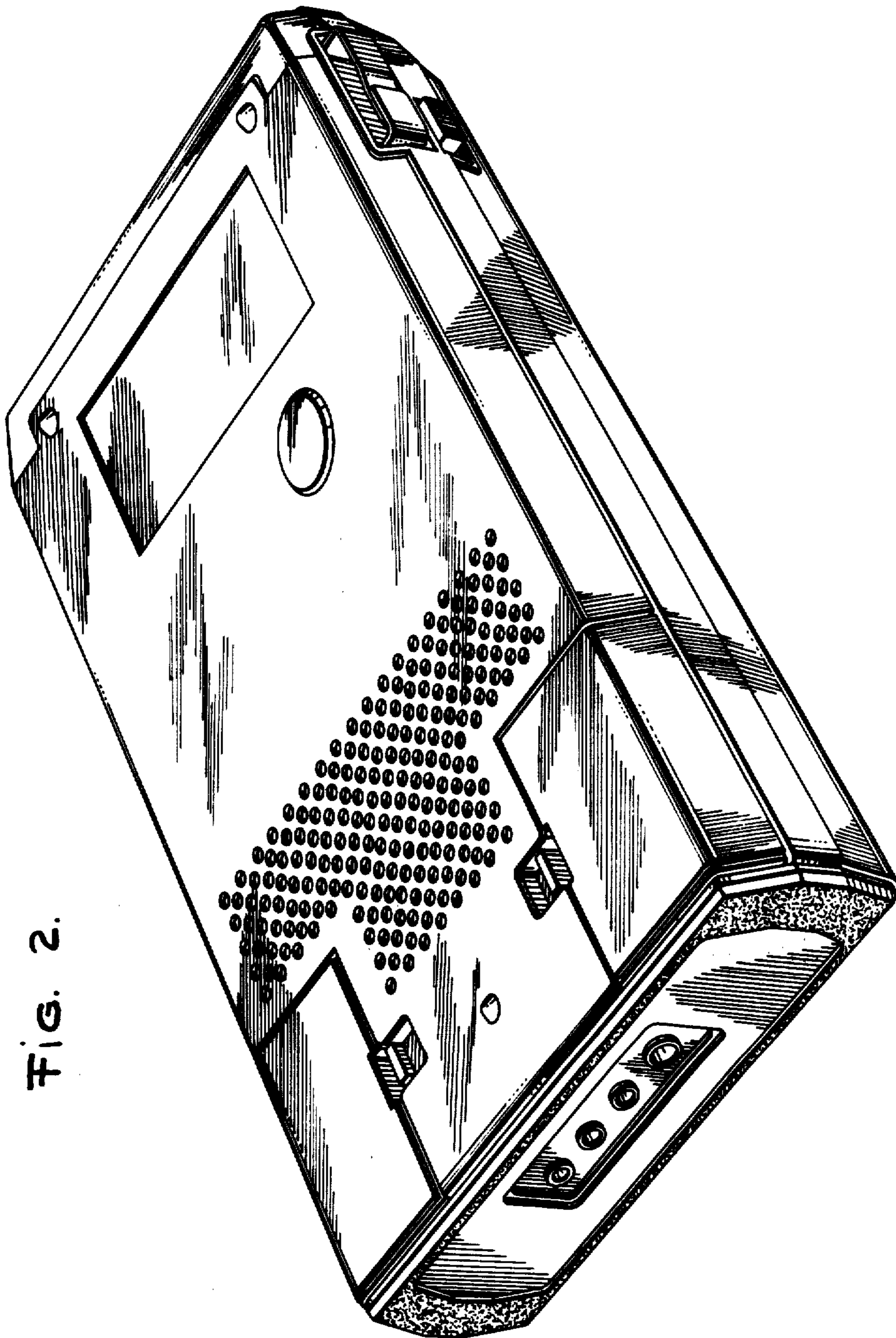
