DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a composite glass panel embodying my new design; and FIGS. 2 and 3 are enlarged fragmentary sections taken on the lines 2—2 and 3—3, respectively, of FIG. 1. The dominant features of my design reside in the illustrated combination of particularly shaped and edge beveled pieces of transparent or translucent glass and opaque dark beading of T-shaped section between adjacent pieces of glass, the beveled edges being present on only one surface of the panel.

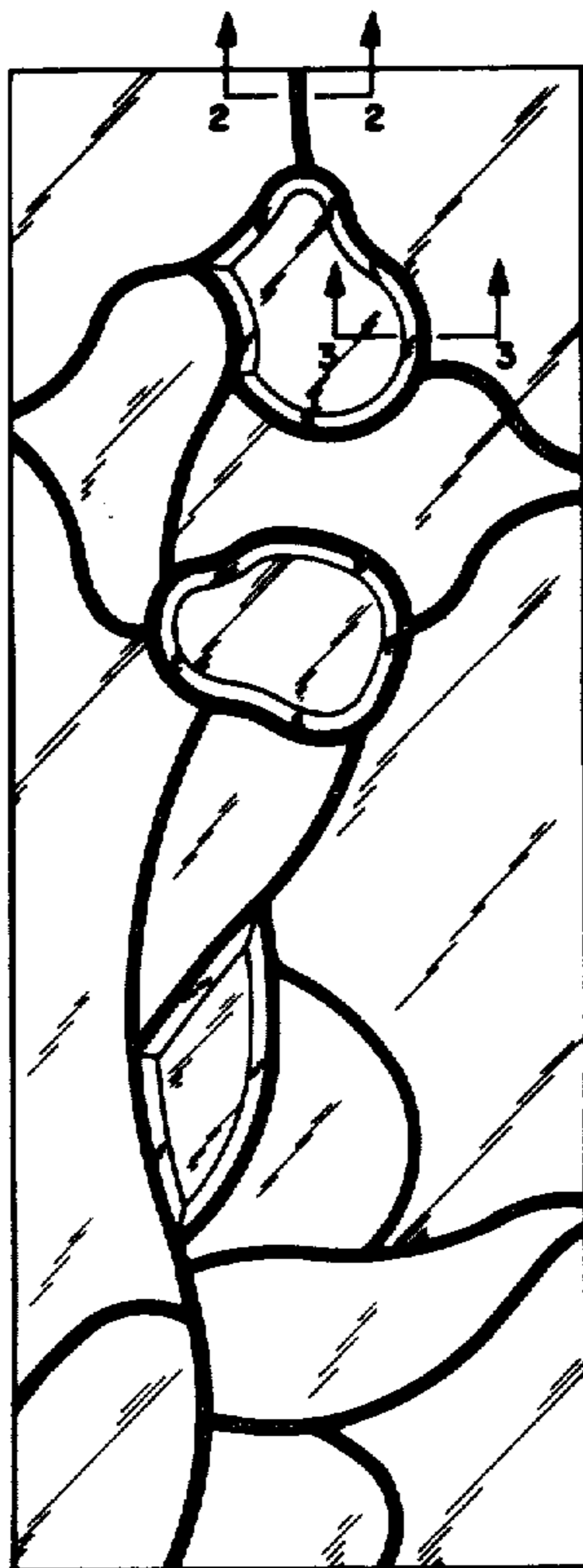

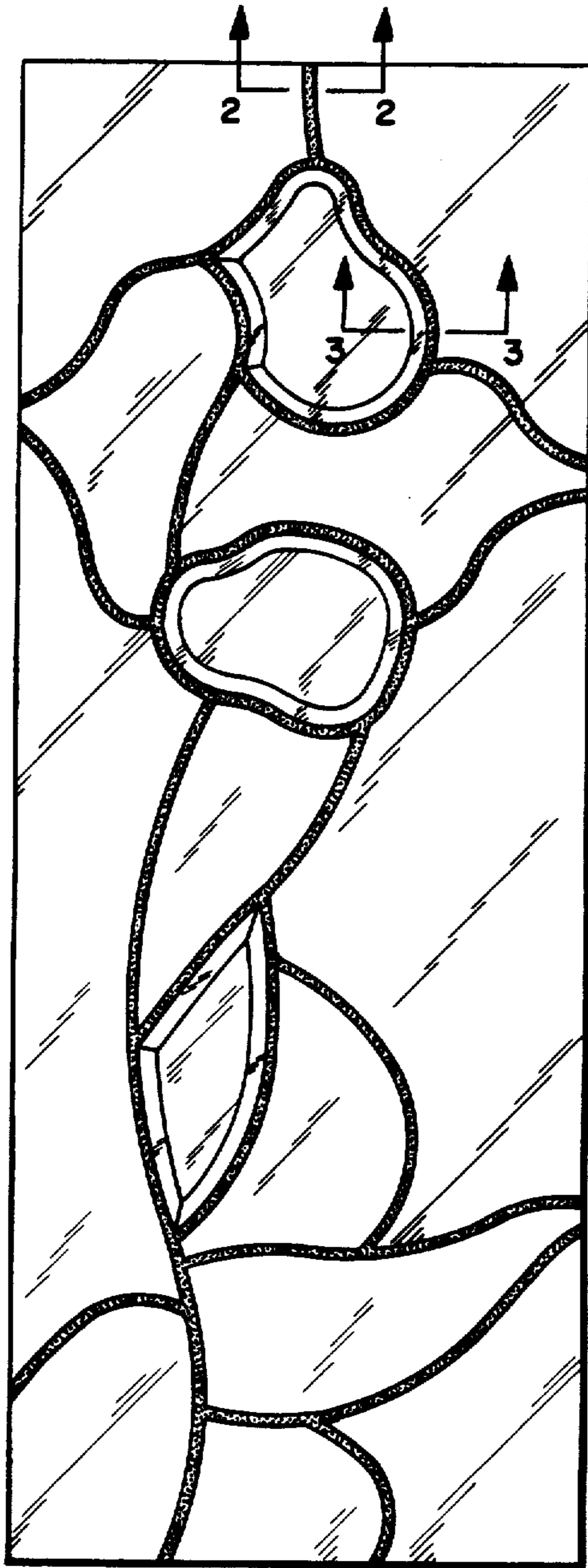
