FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the same.

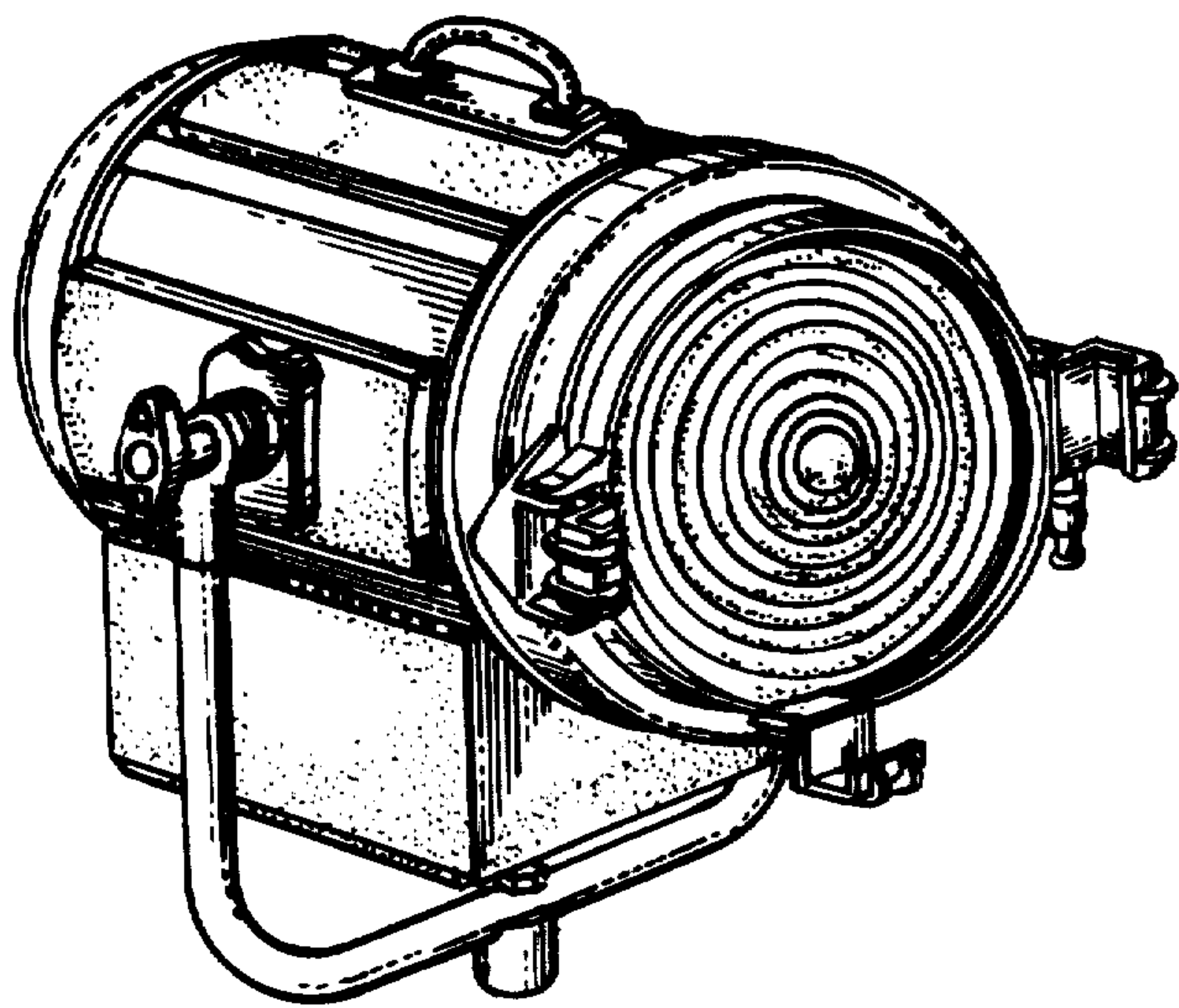

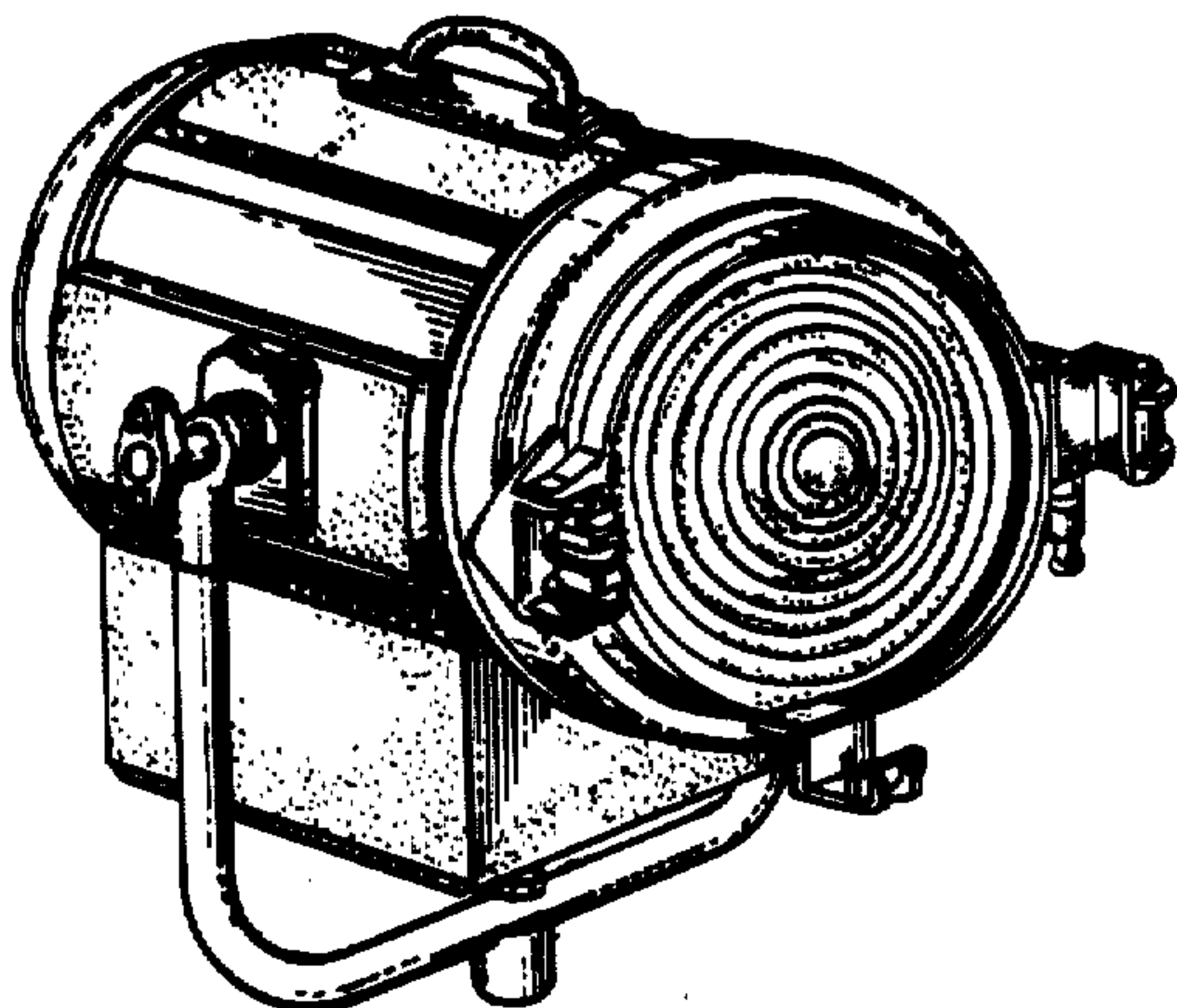

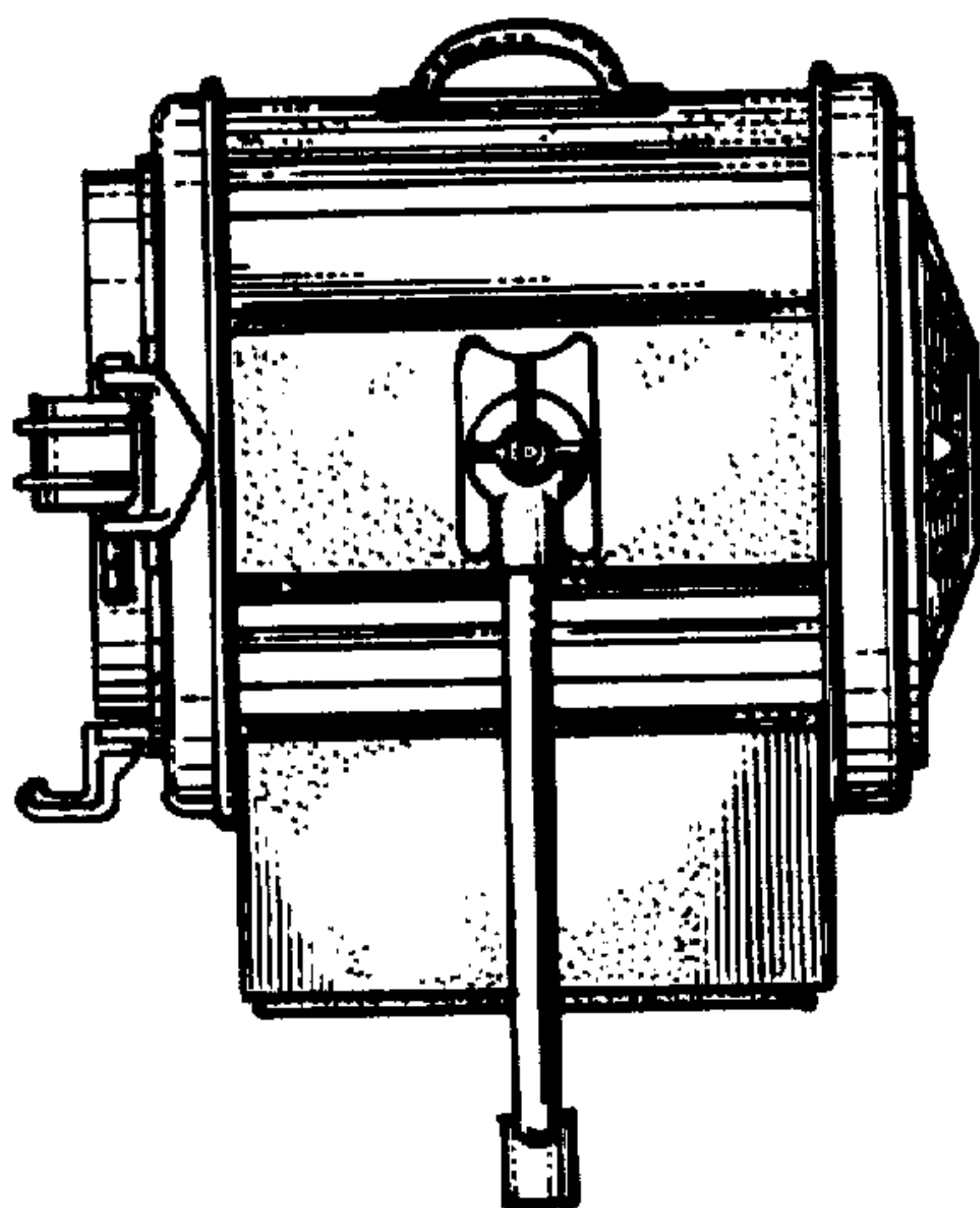

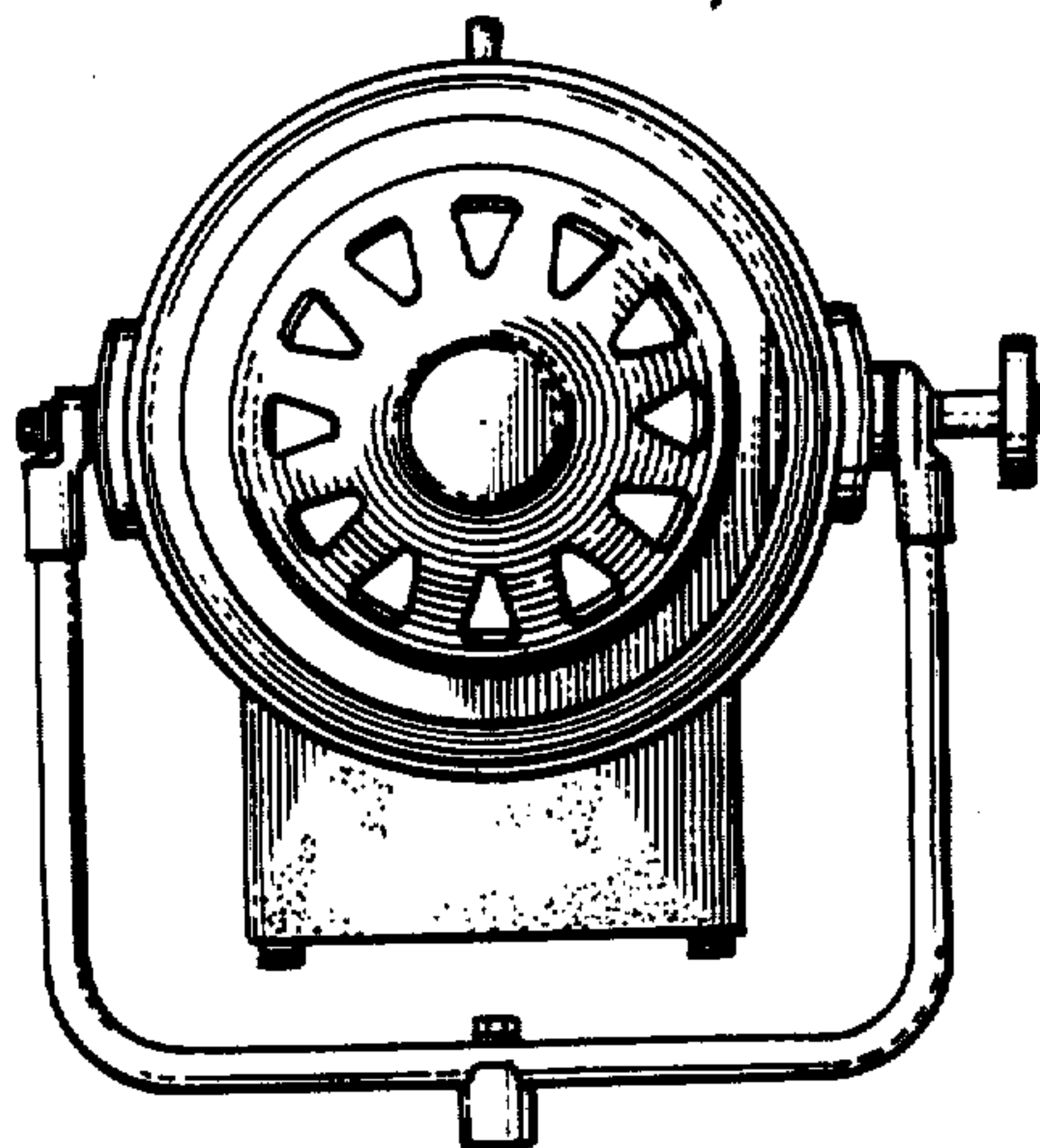
