[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for the lighted traveling mirror, shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a lighted traveling mirror showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof in open hanging position; FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof in open book position; FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof in another open position. The cord in FIGS. 7 and 8 is omitted for ease of illustration.

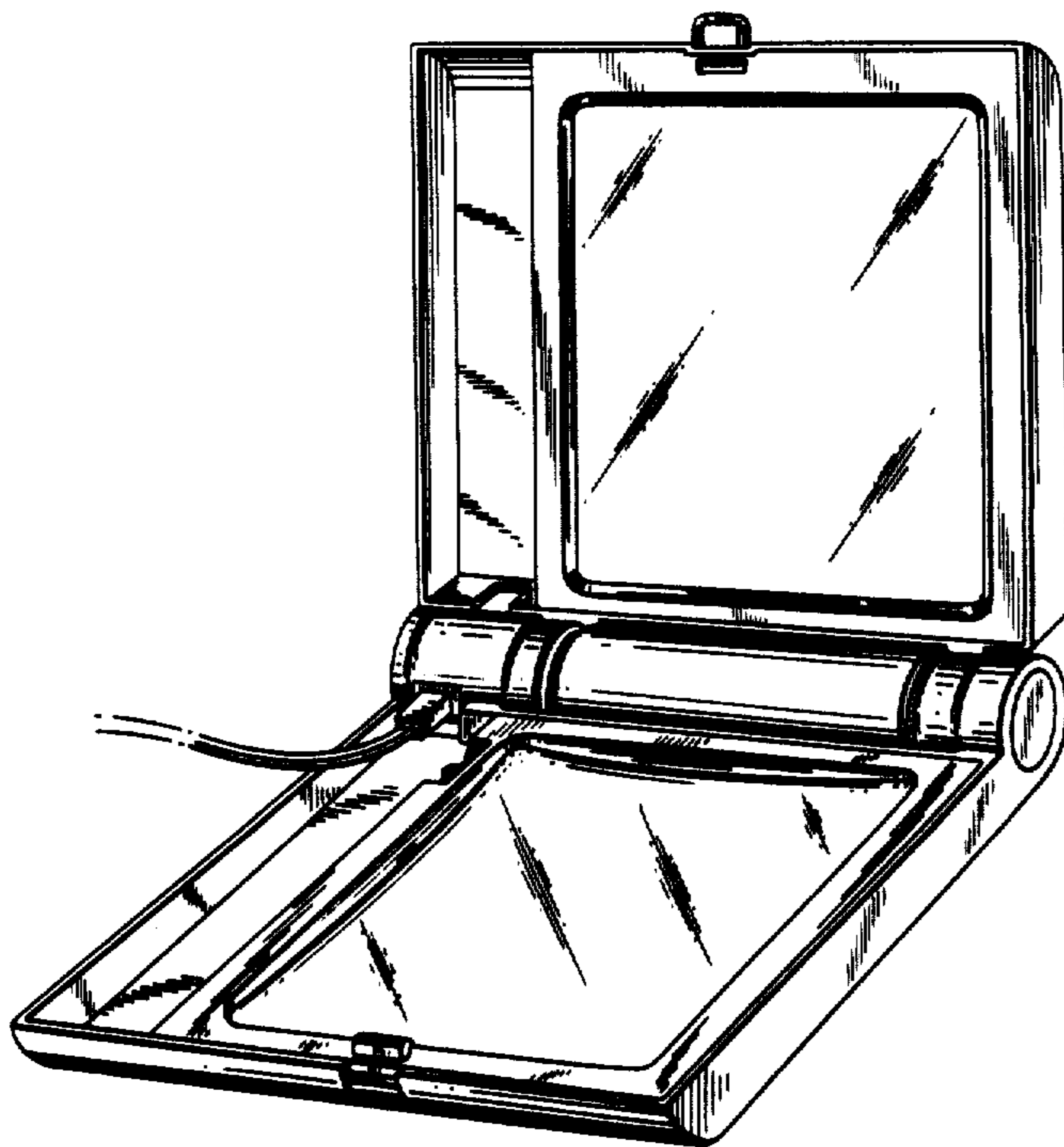

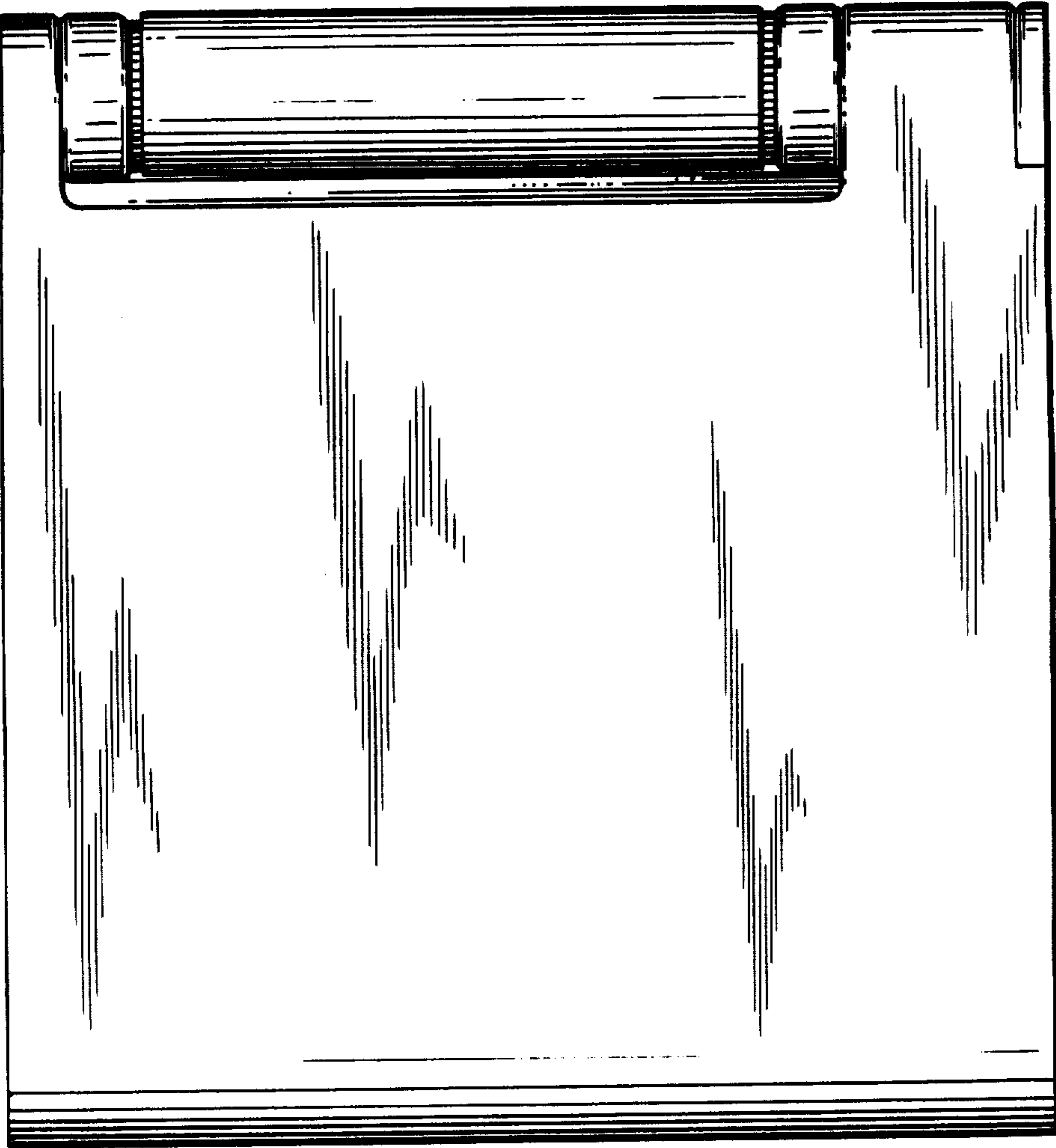

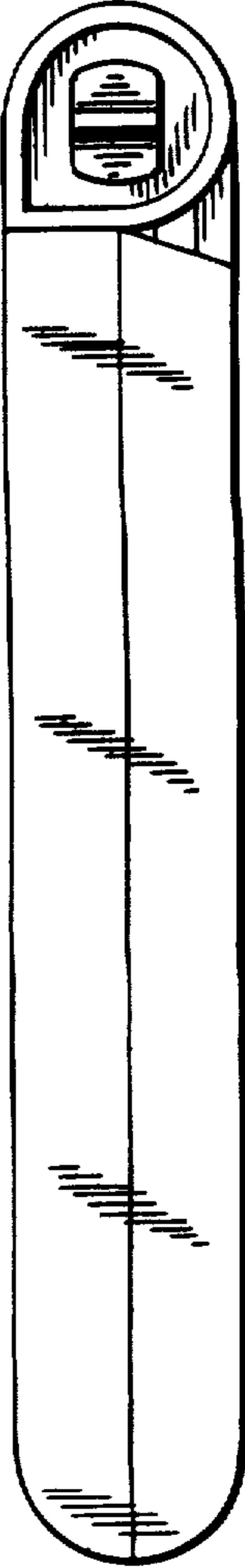

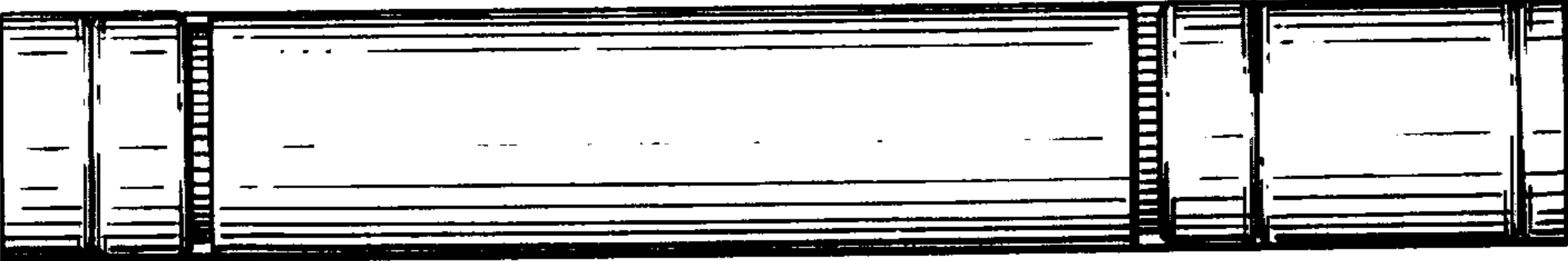

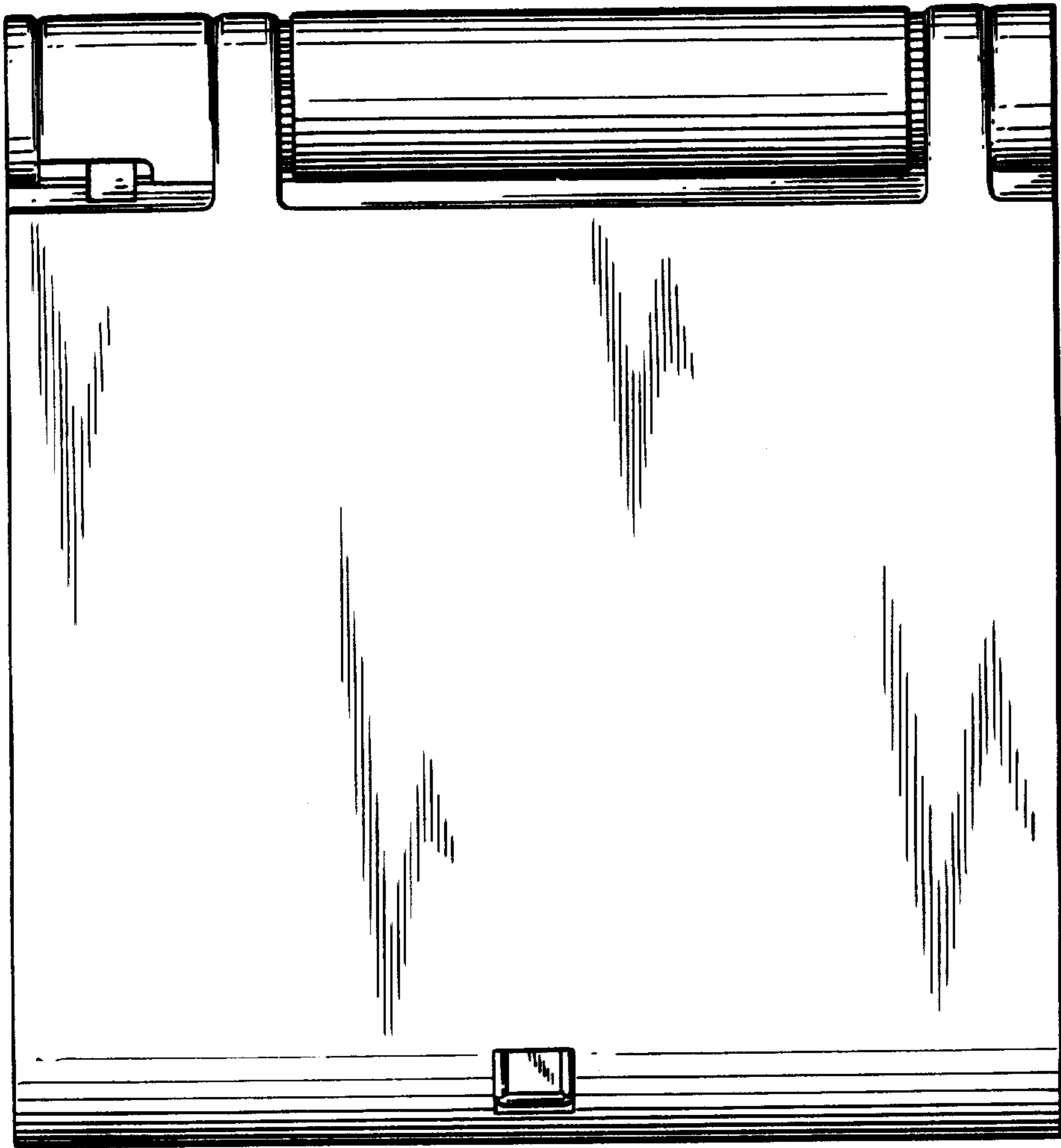

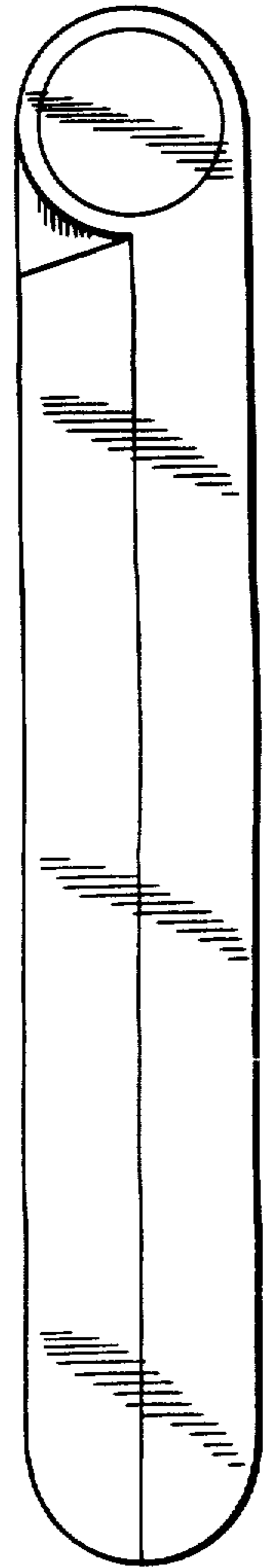

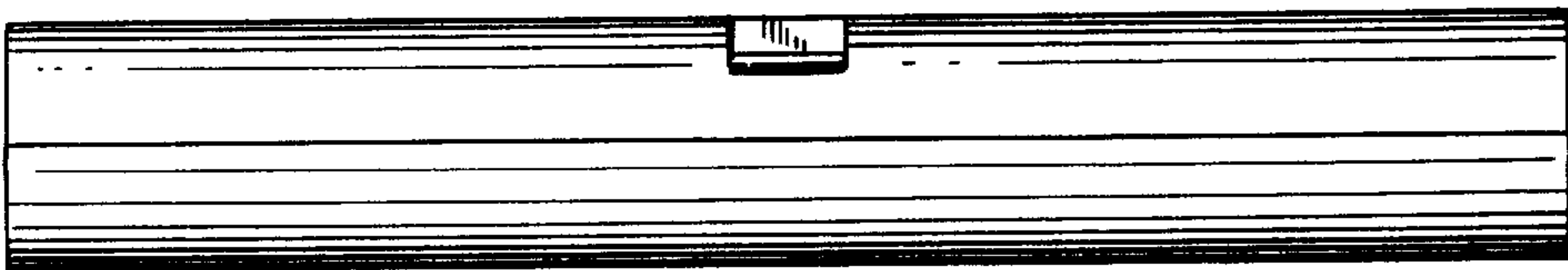

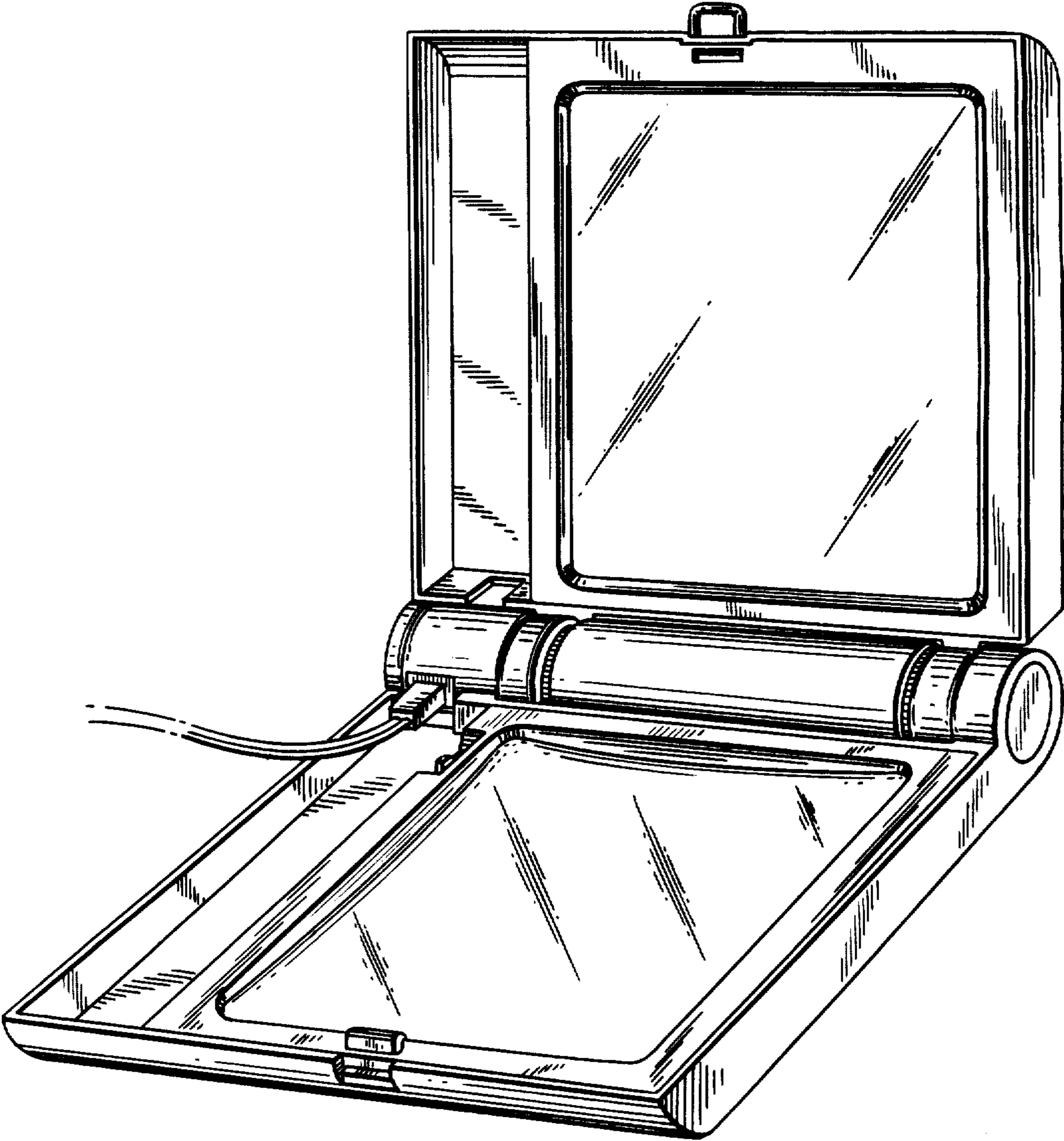

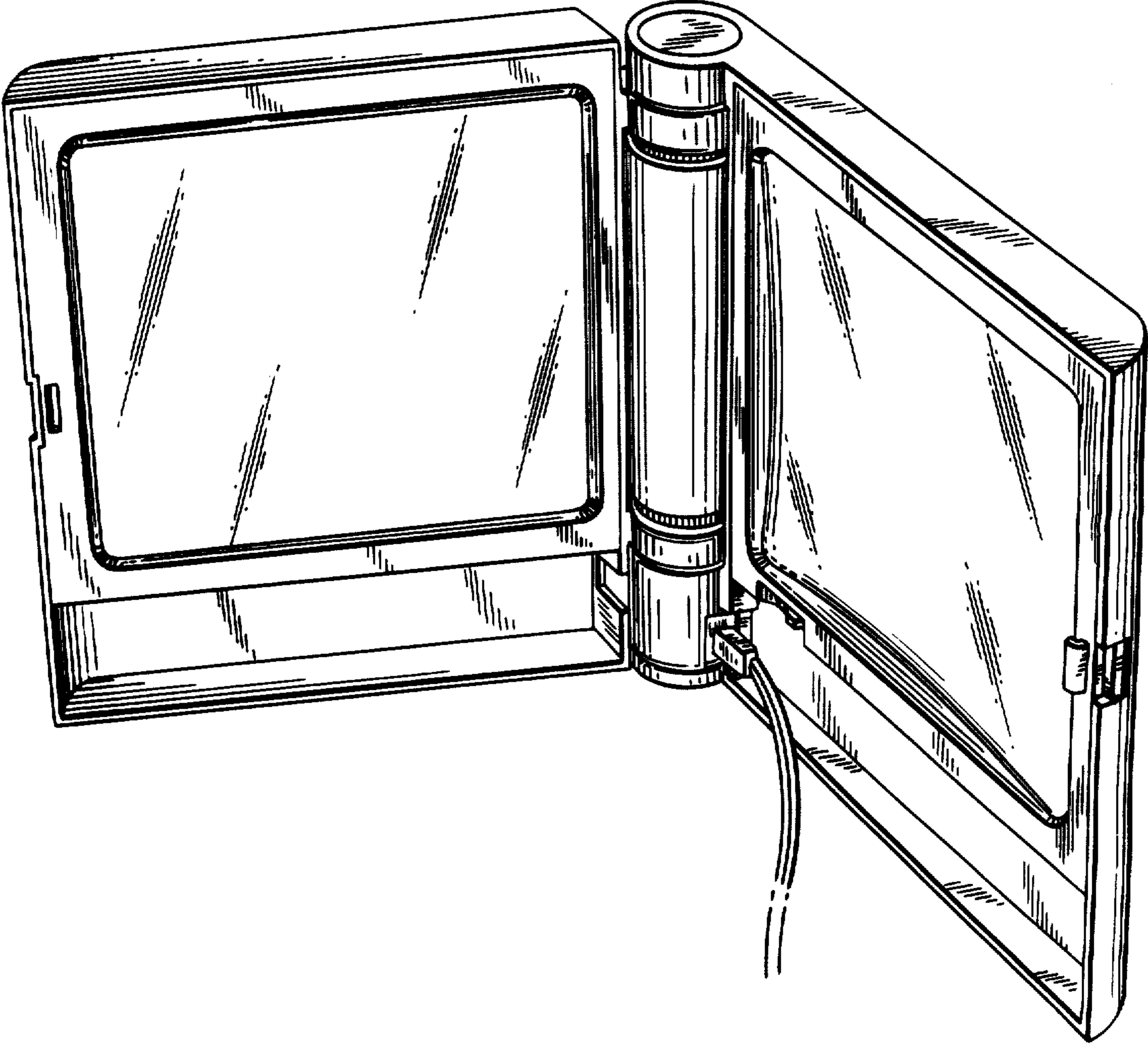
