[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a laminate sheet, substan-
tially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a plan view of a laminate sheet show-
ing our new design, the sheet being of conventional
thickness.

The unit of repeat is precisely the bounds of the FIG-
URE. The manner of repeat is a side-by-side relation-
ship both lengthwise and widthwise. No border or fin-
ished edge exists.
