[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a laminate sheet, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

The FIGURE is a plan view of a laminate sheet showing our new design, the sheet being of conventional thickness.

The repeat unit shown is slipped or staggered lengthwise only at both edges thereof. No border or finished edge exists.
