DESCRIPTION

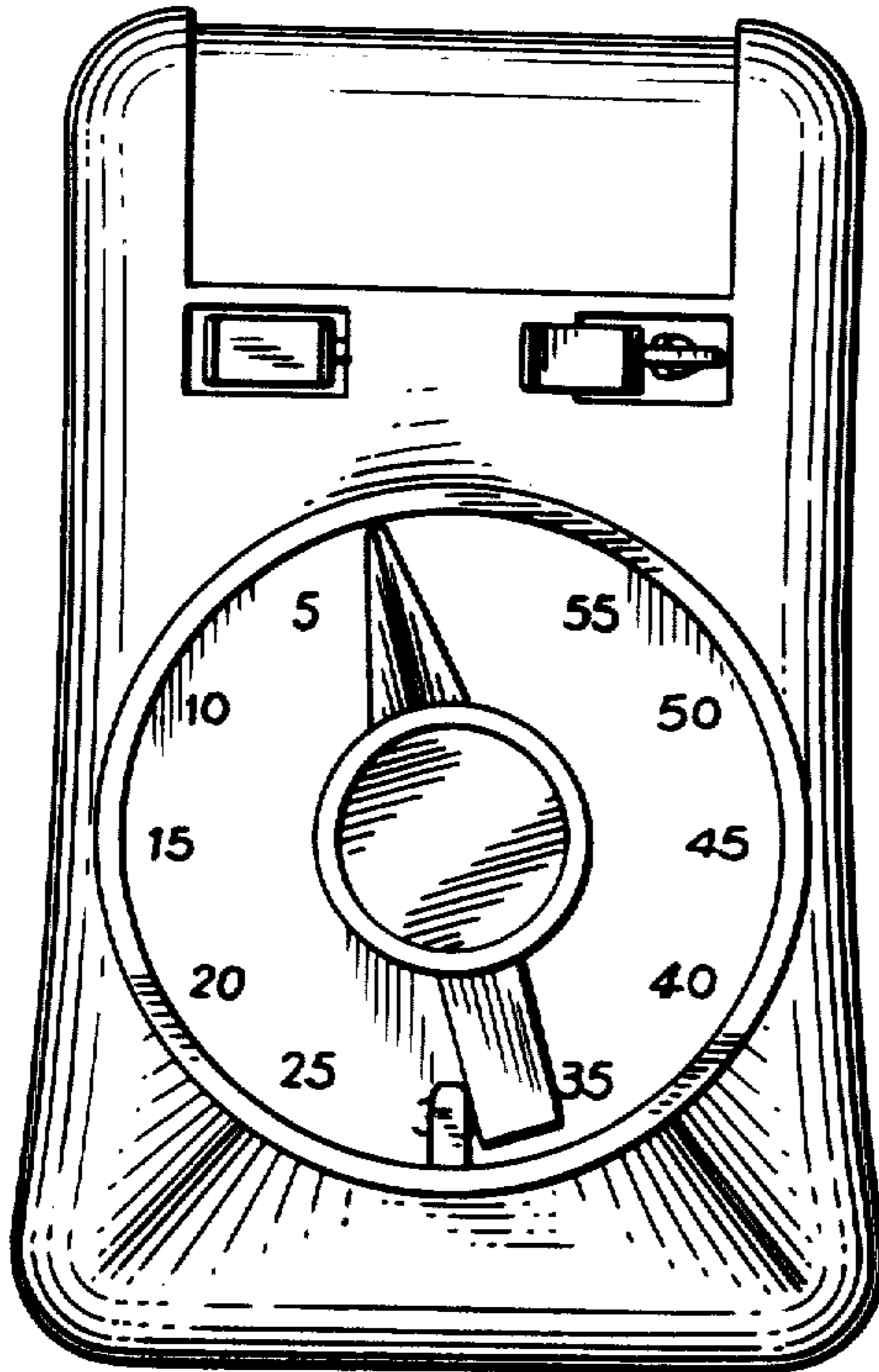
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a timer showing our new design;

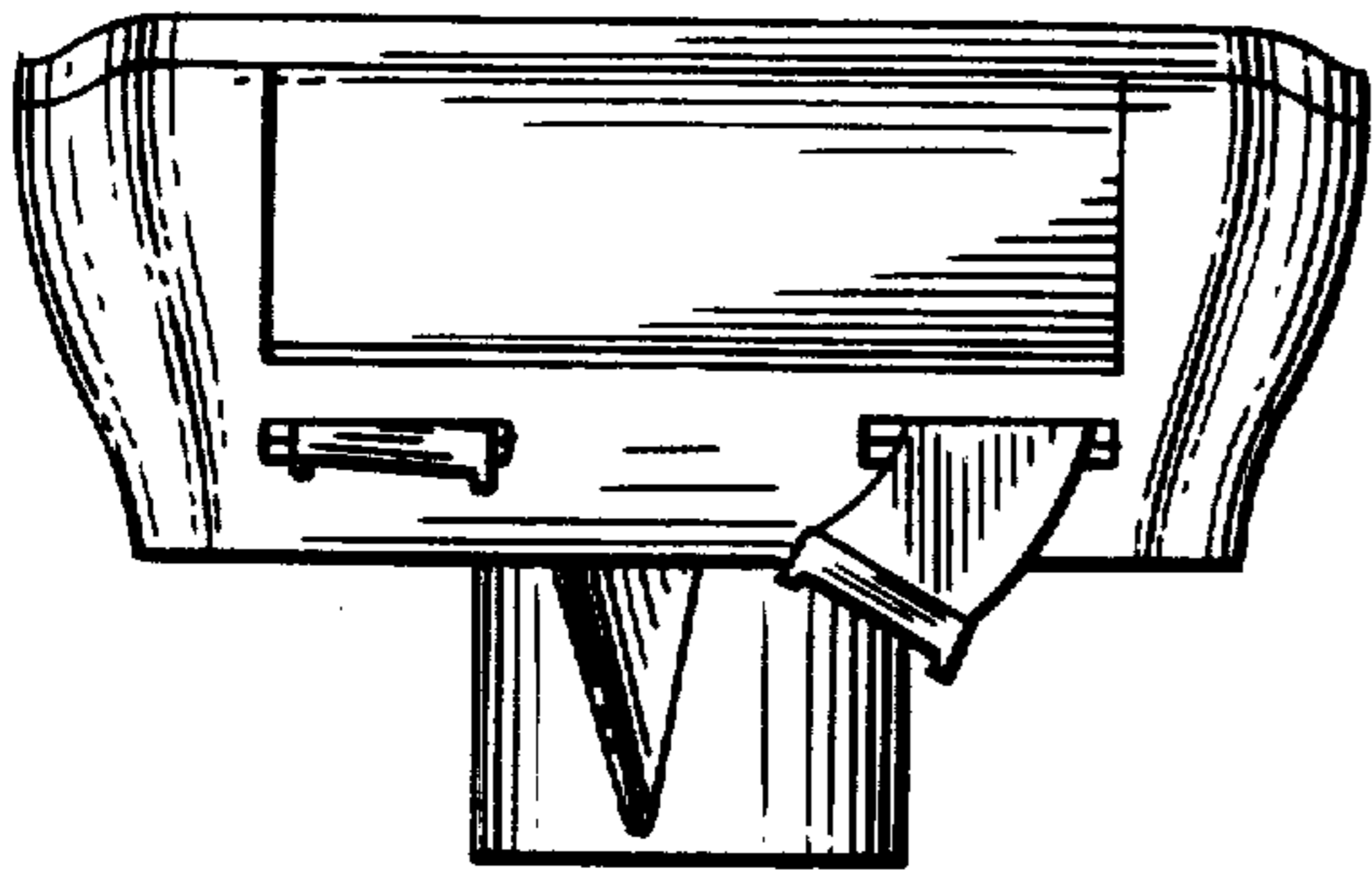

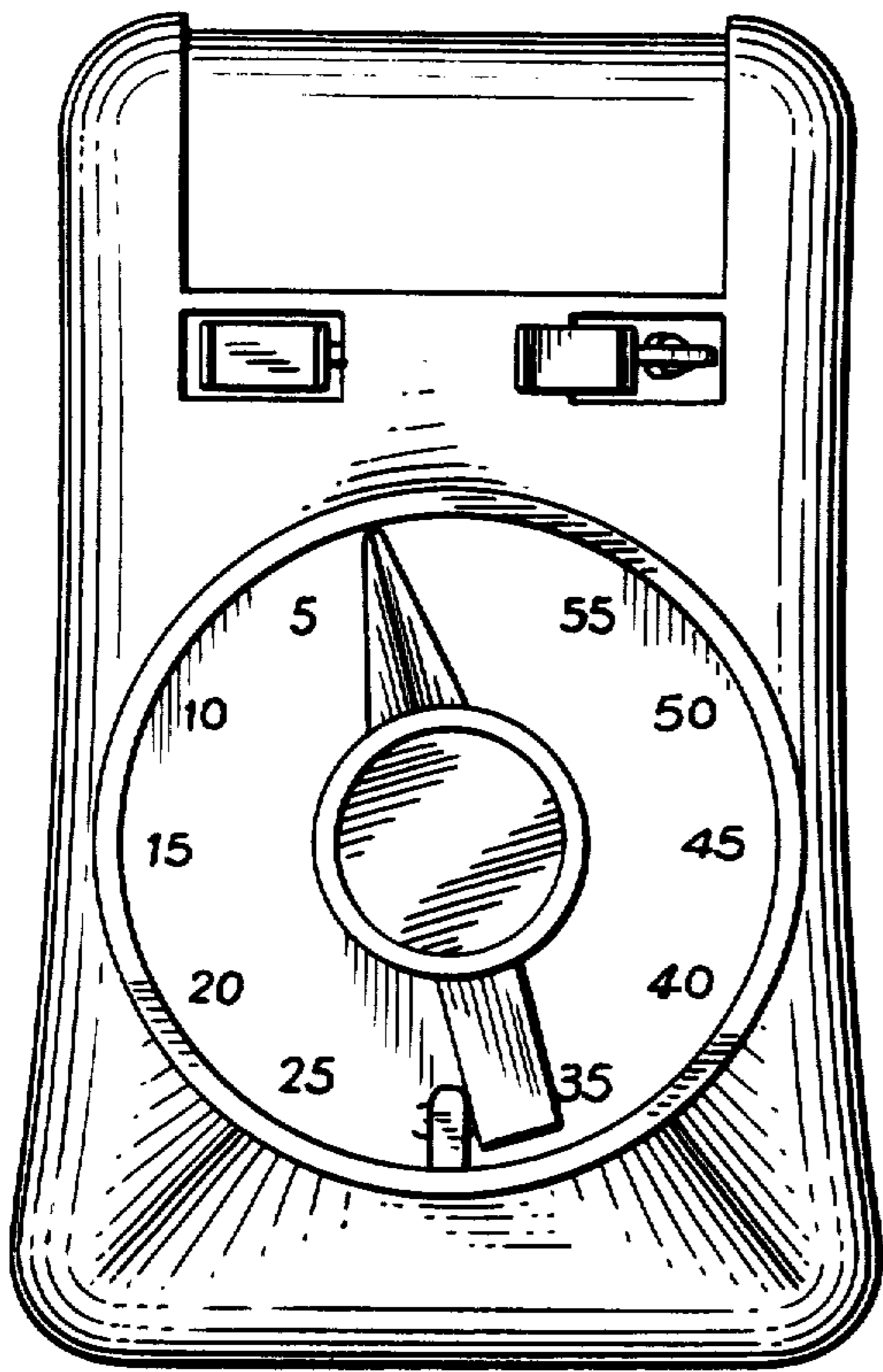

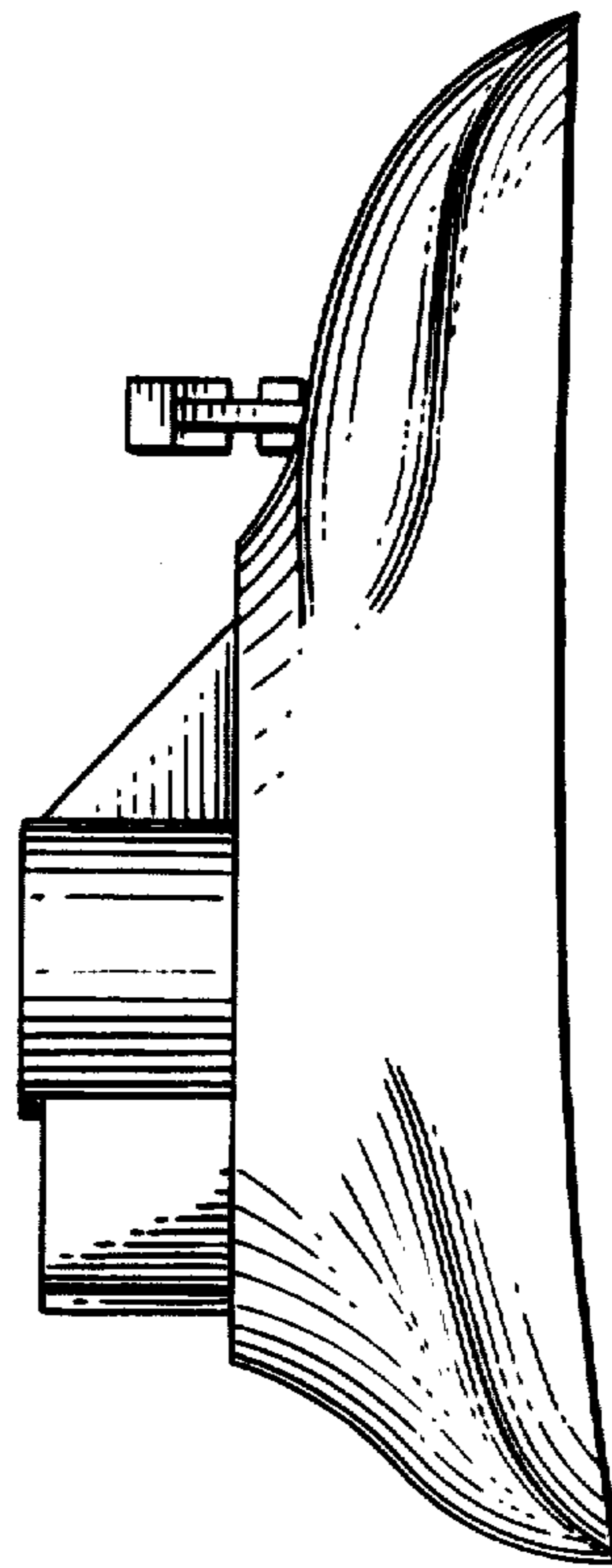

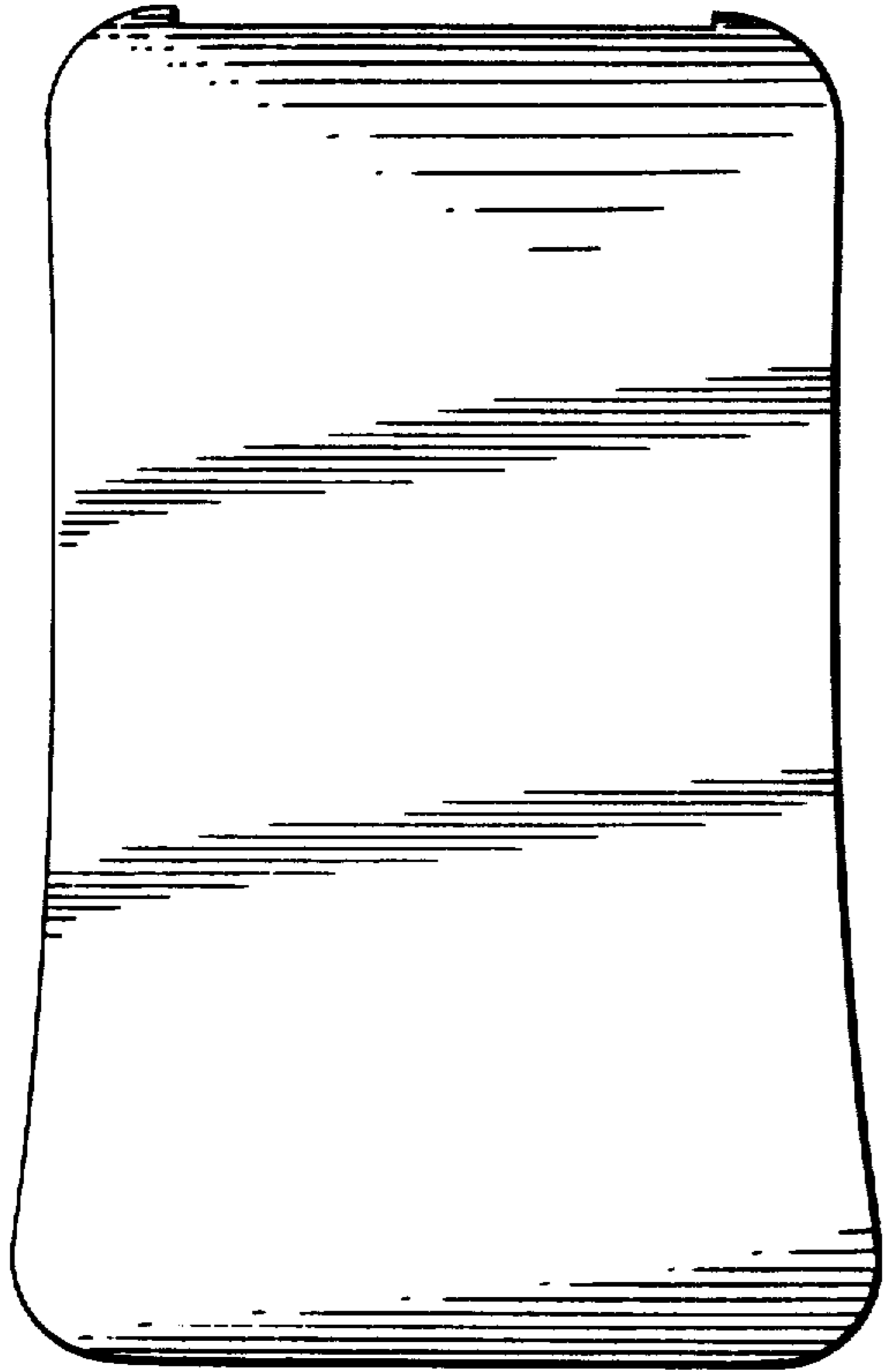

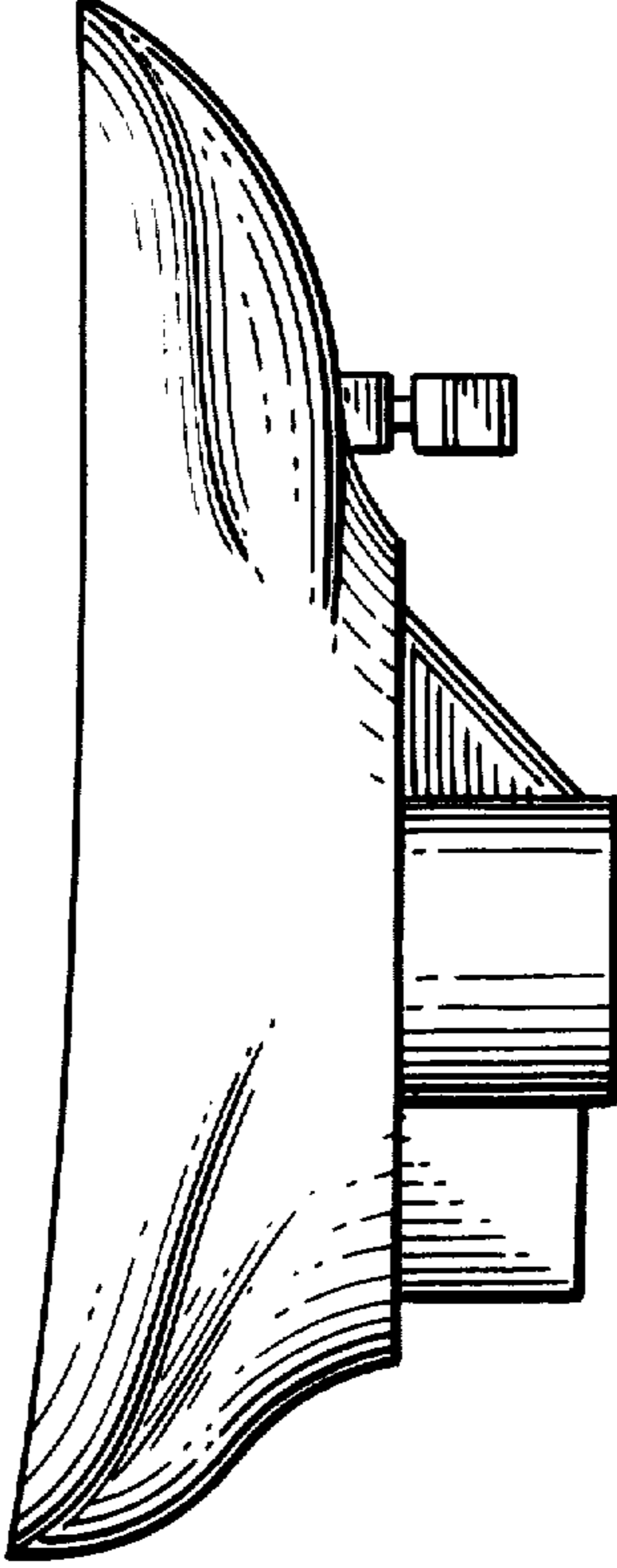

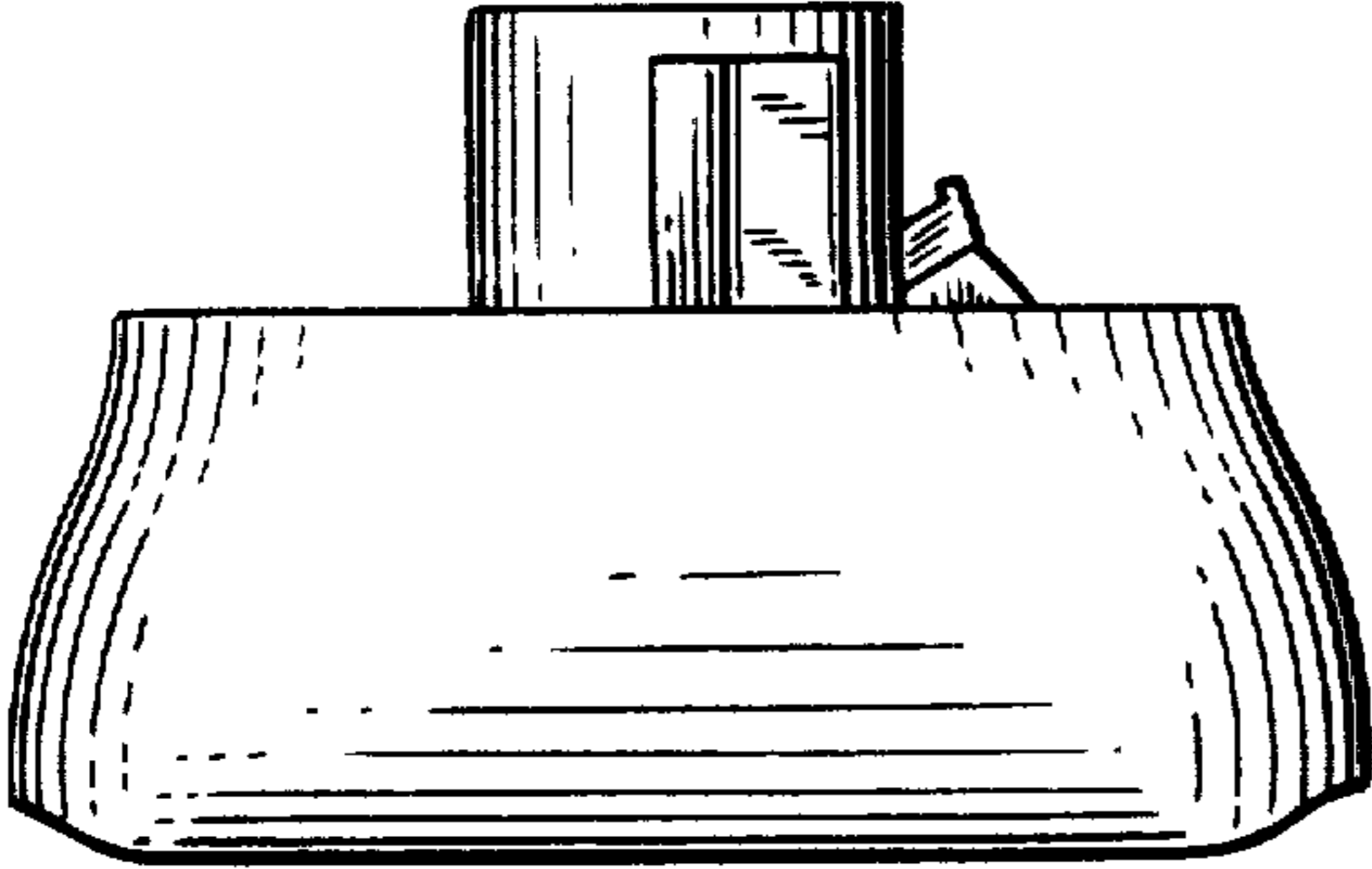
