FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof.

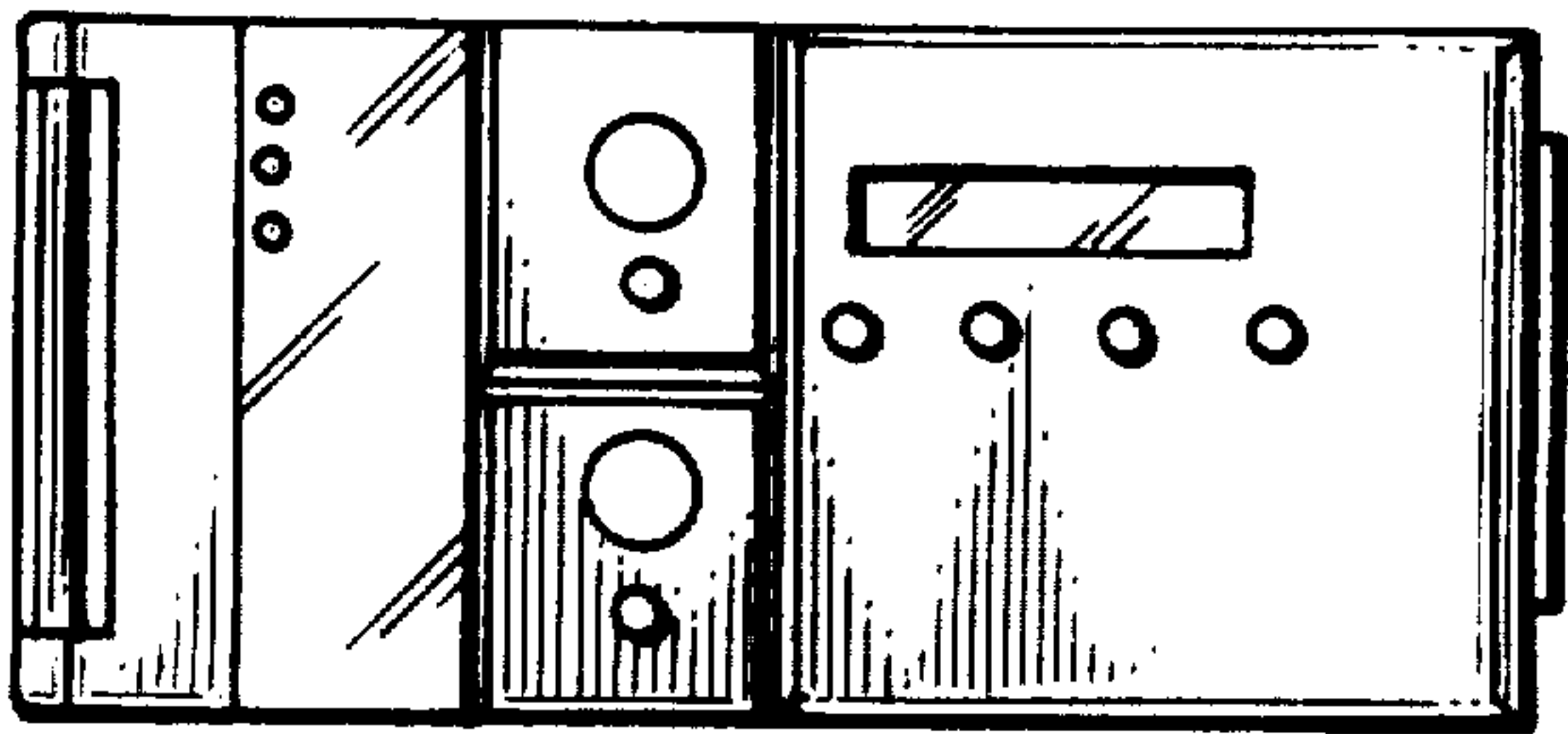

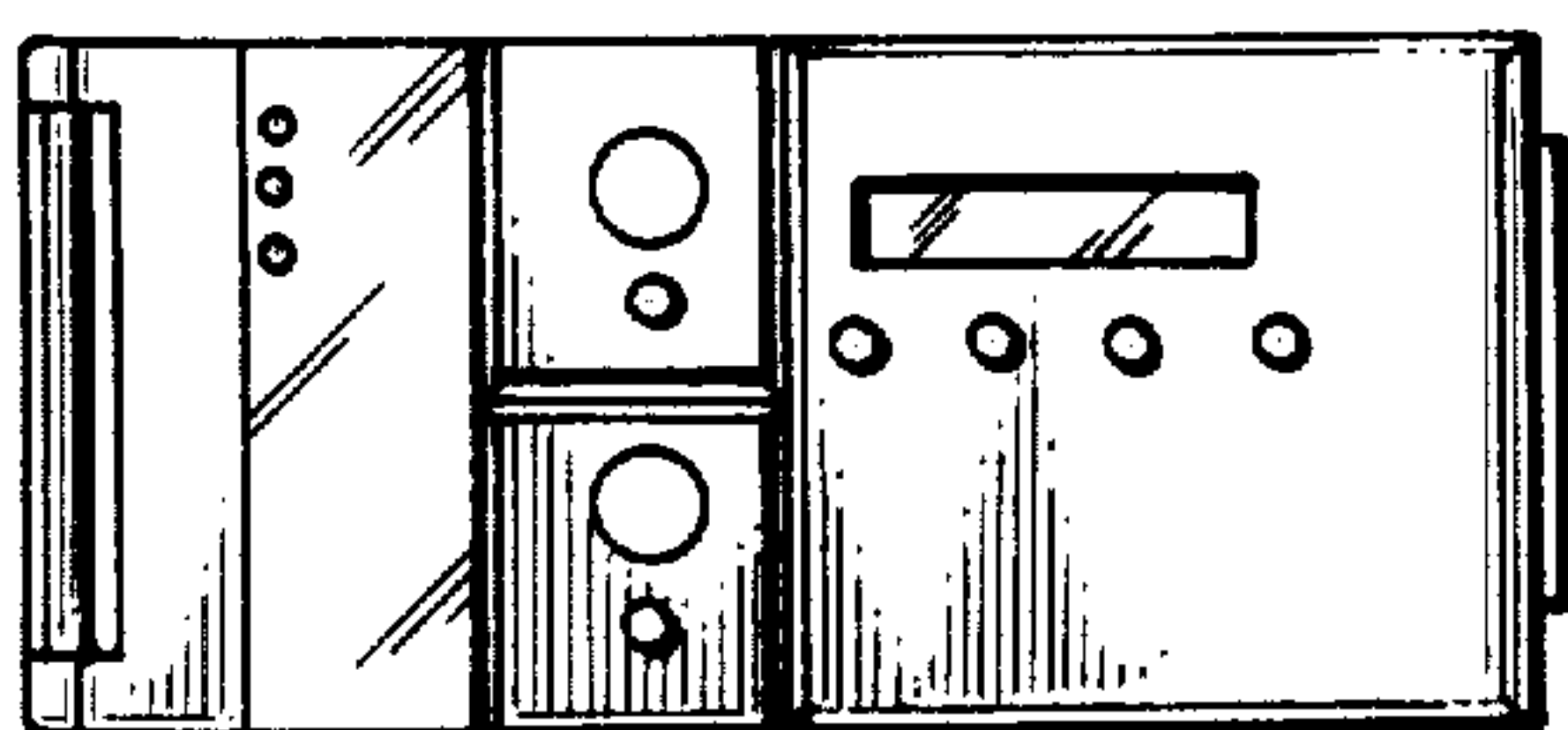

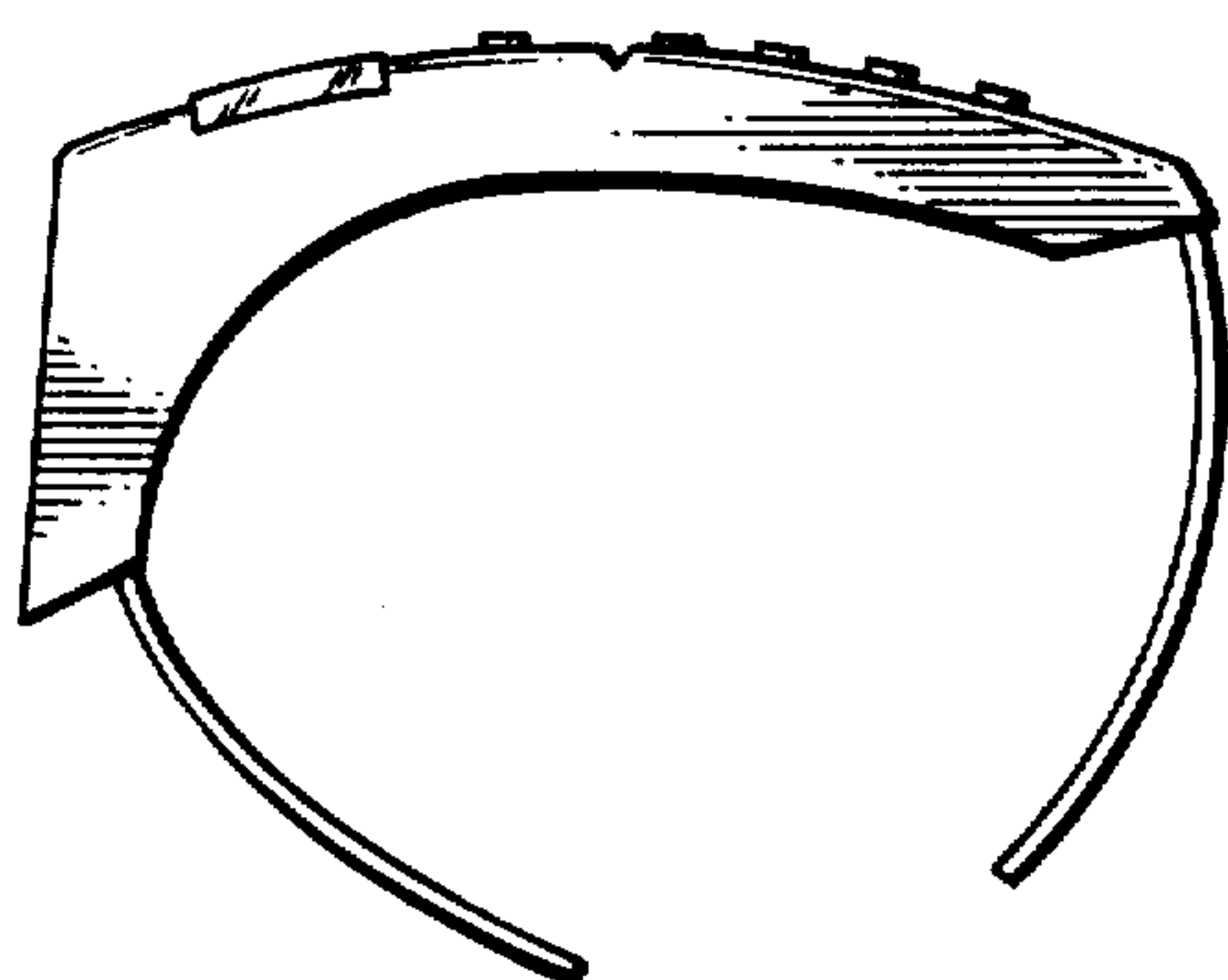

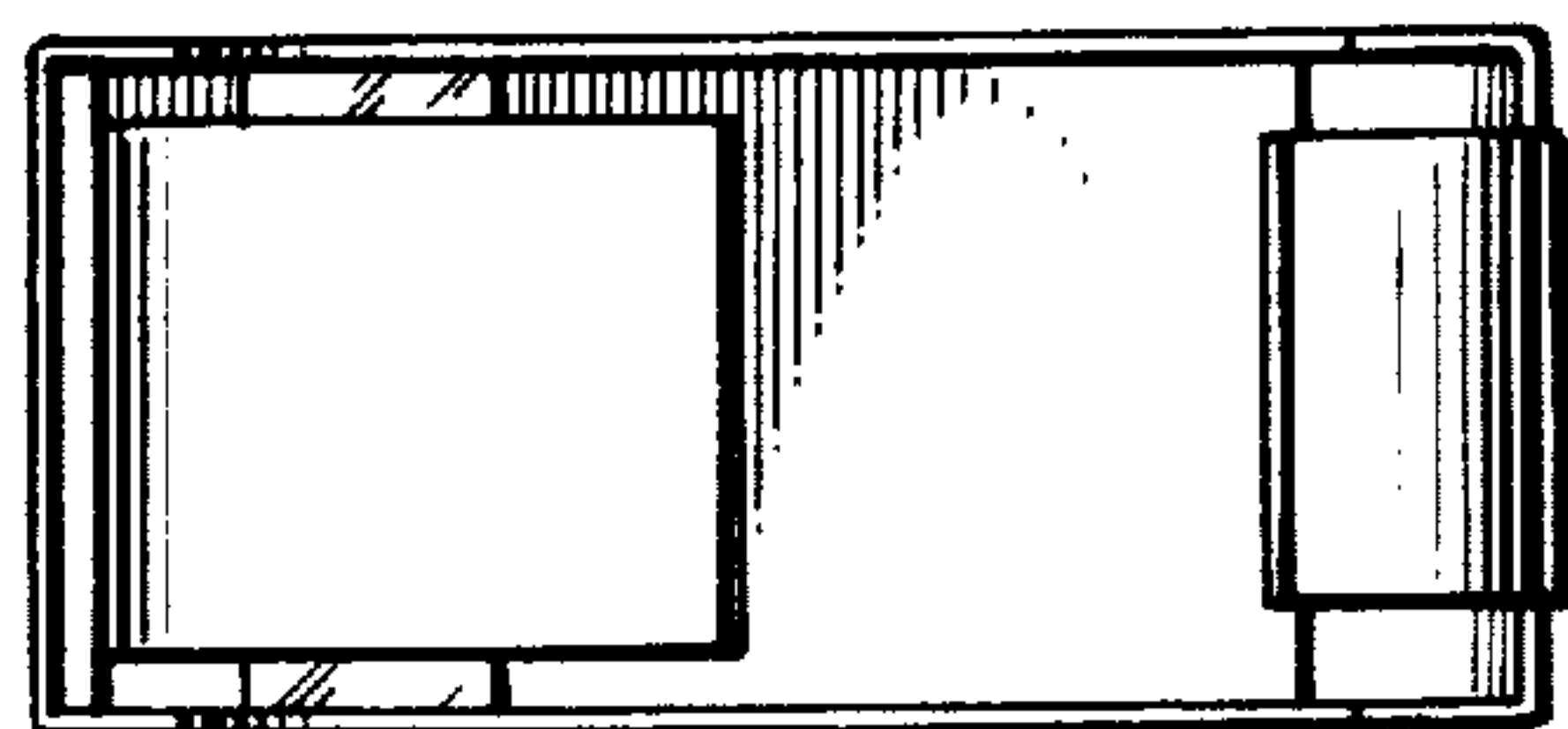

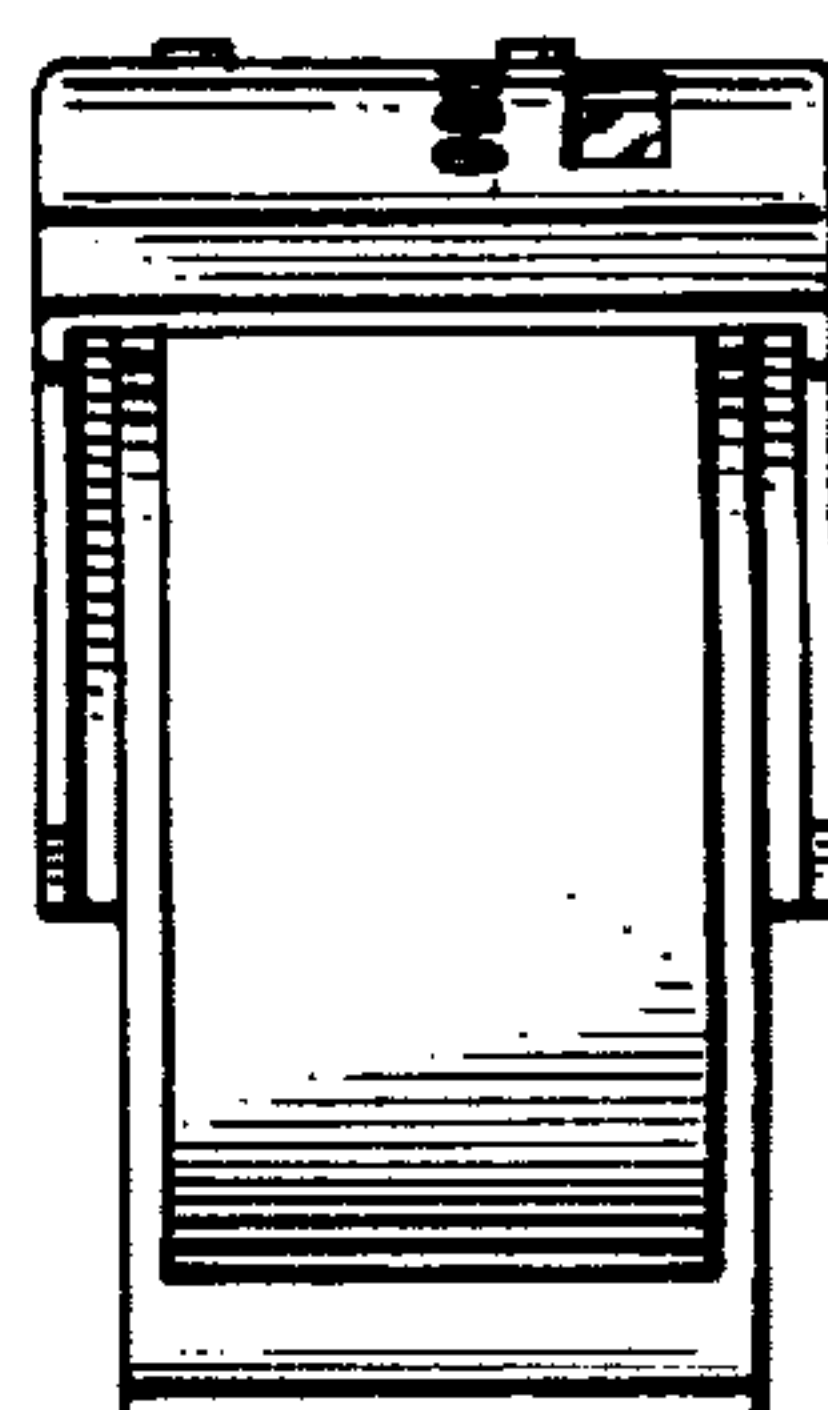
