DESCRIPTION

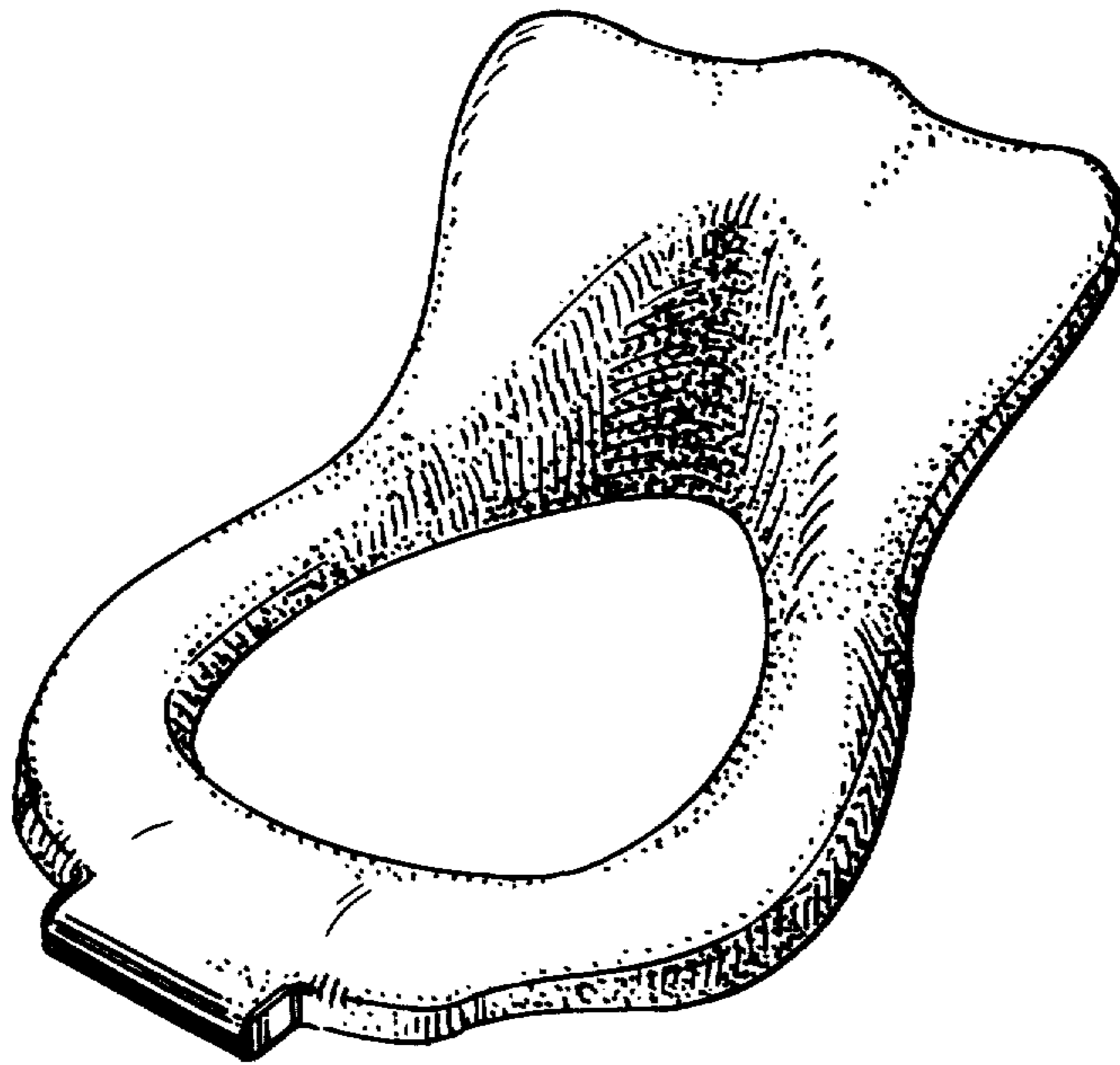
FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, rear and left side of a toilet seat accessory showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



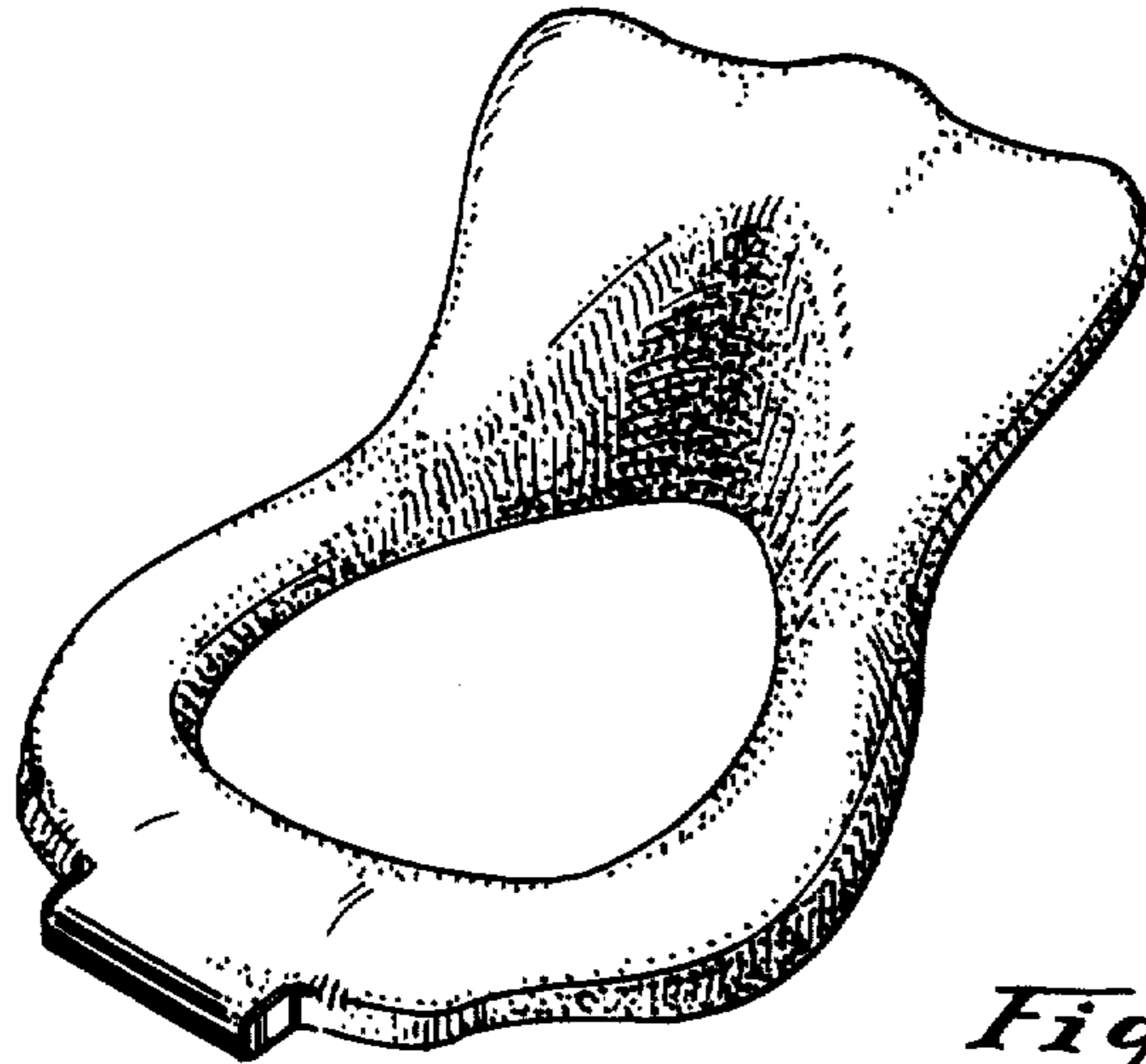

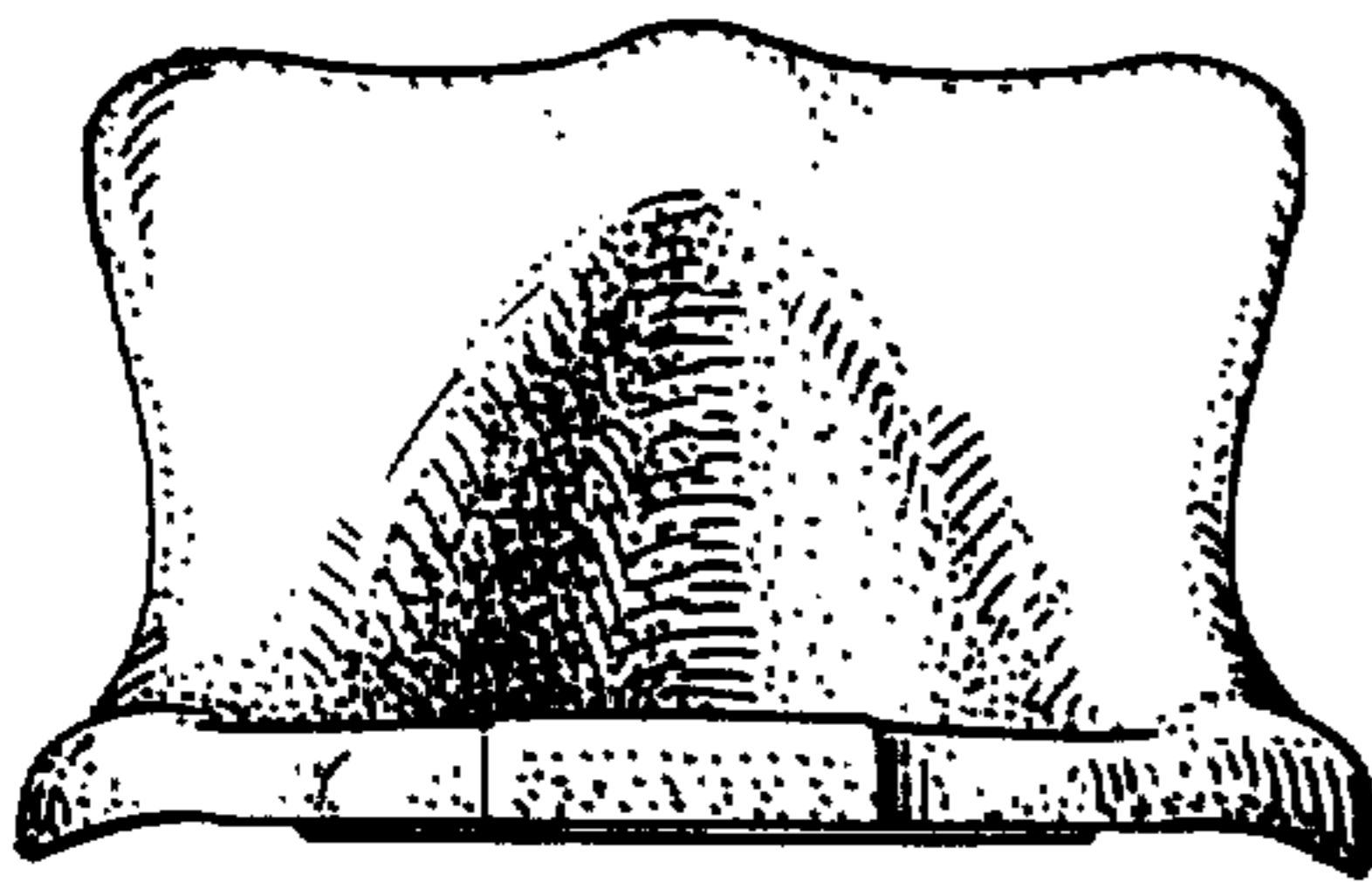

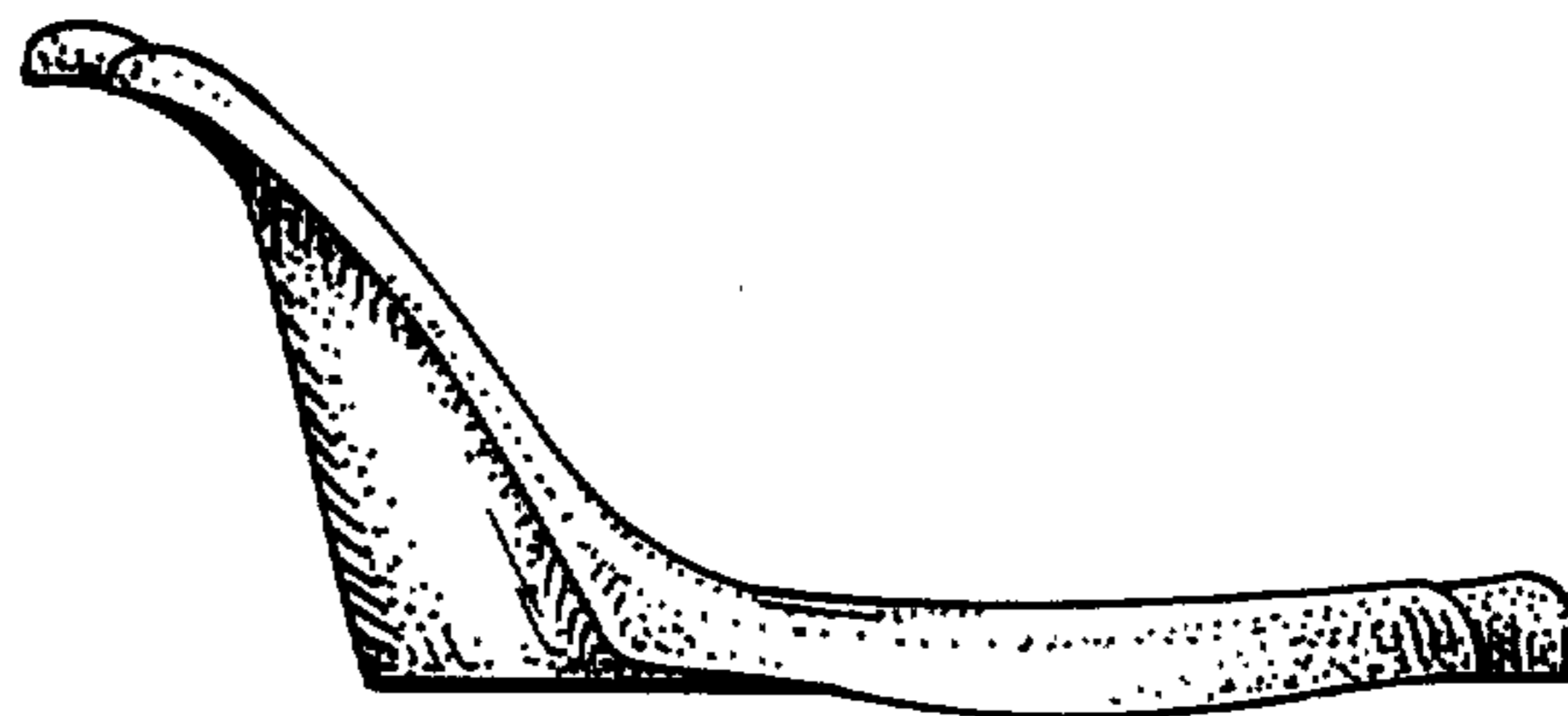

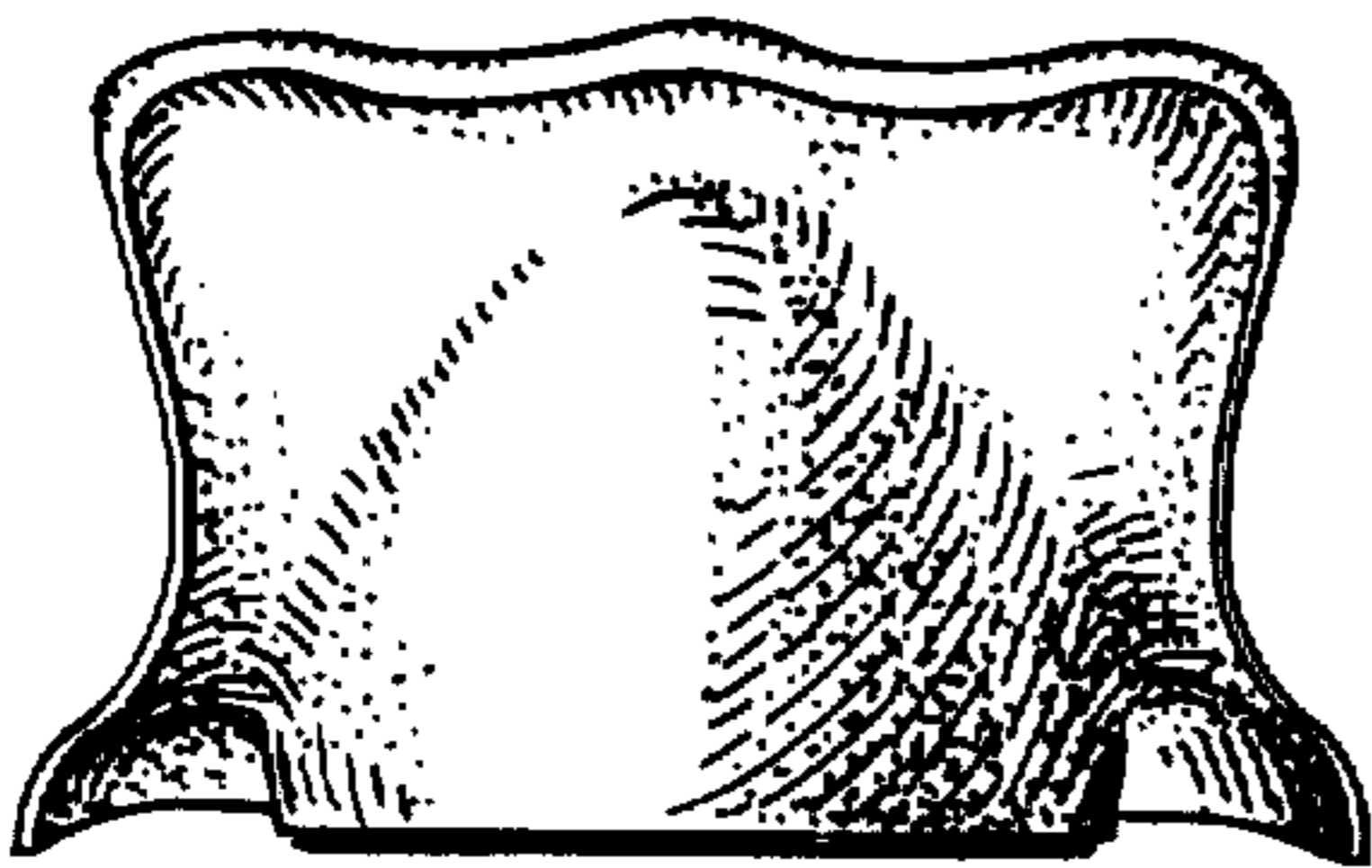

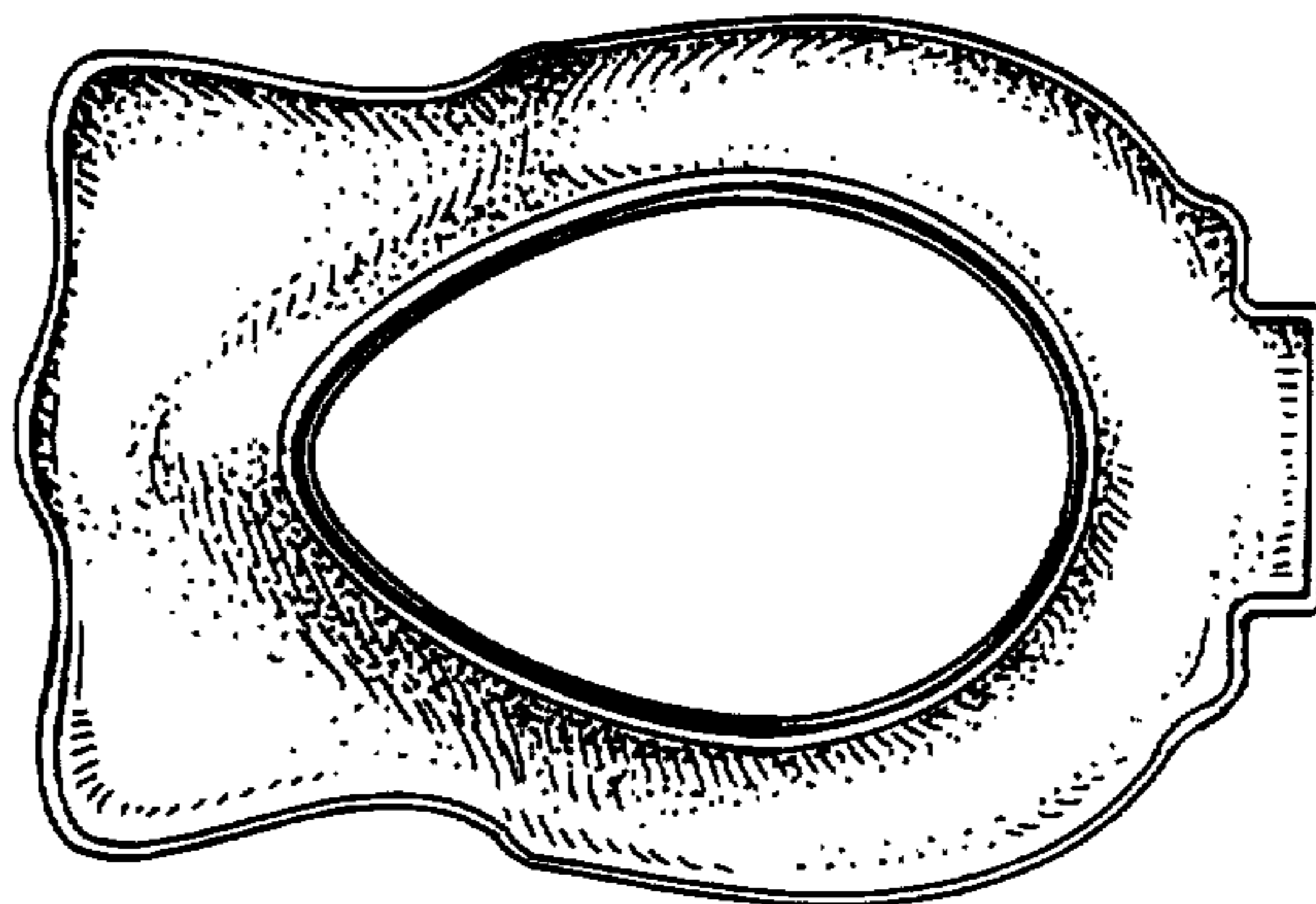
