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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sole and toe portions of a shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a shoe and toe portions of a shoe showing our new design, the broken line portions of a shoe upper are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; The left side, not shown, is substantially a mirror image to the right side.

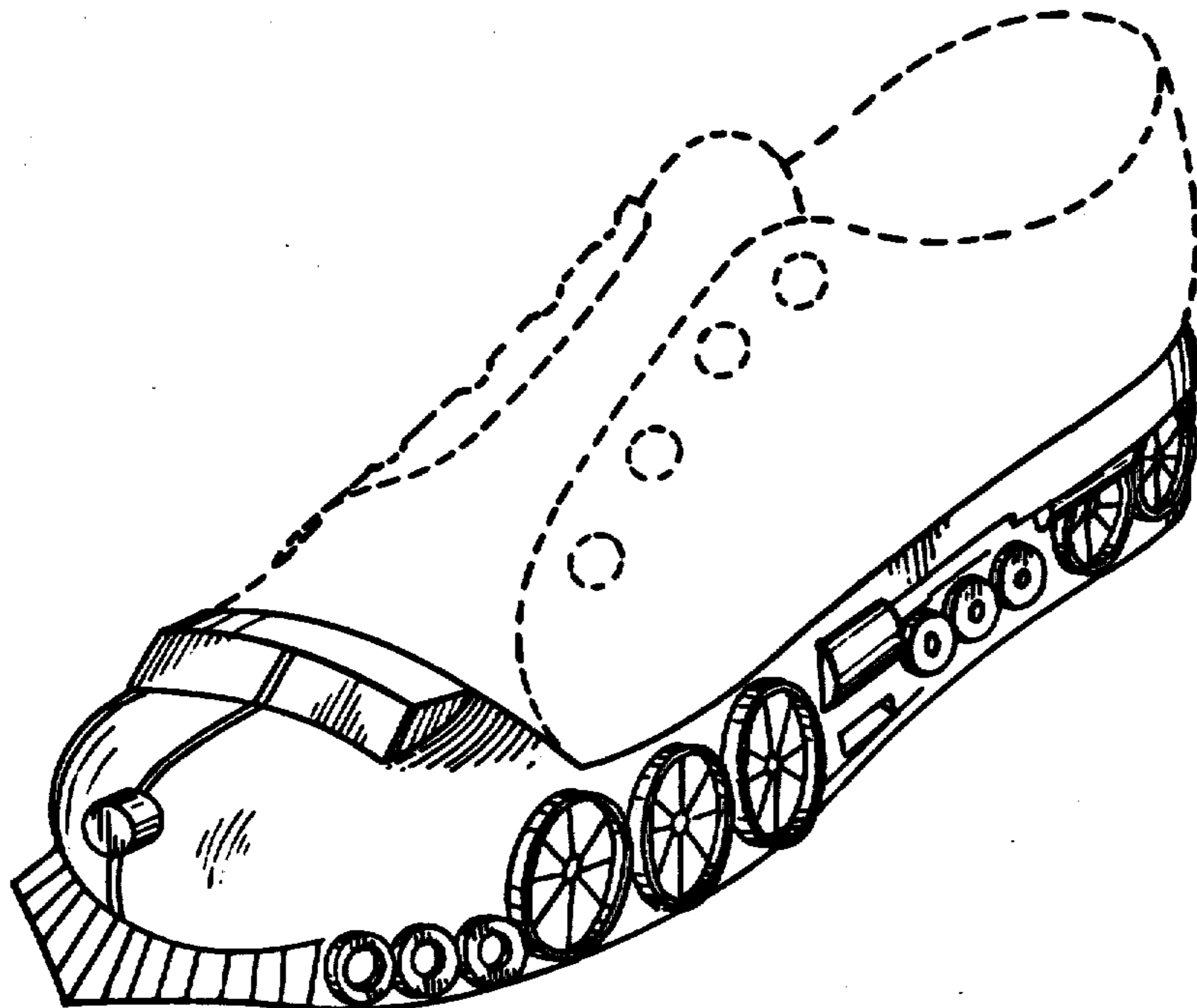

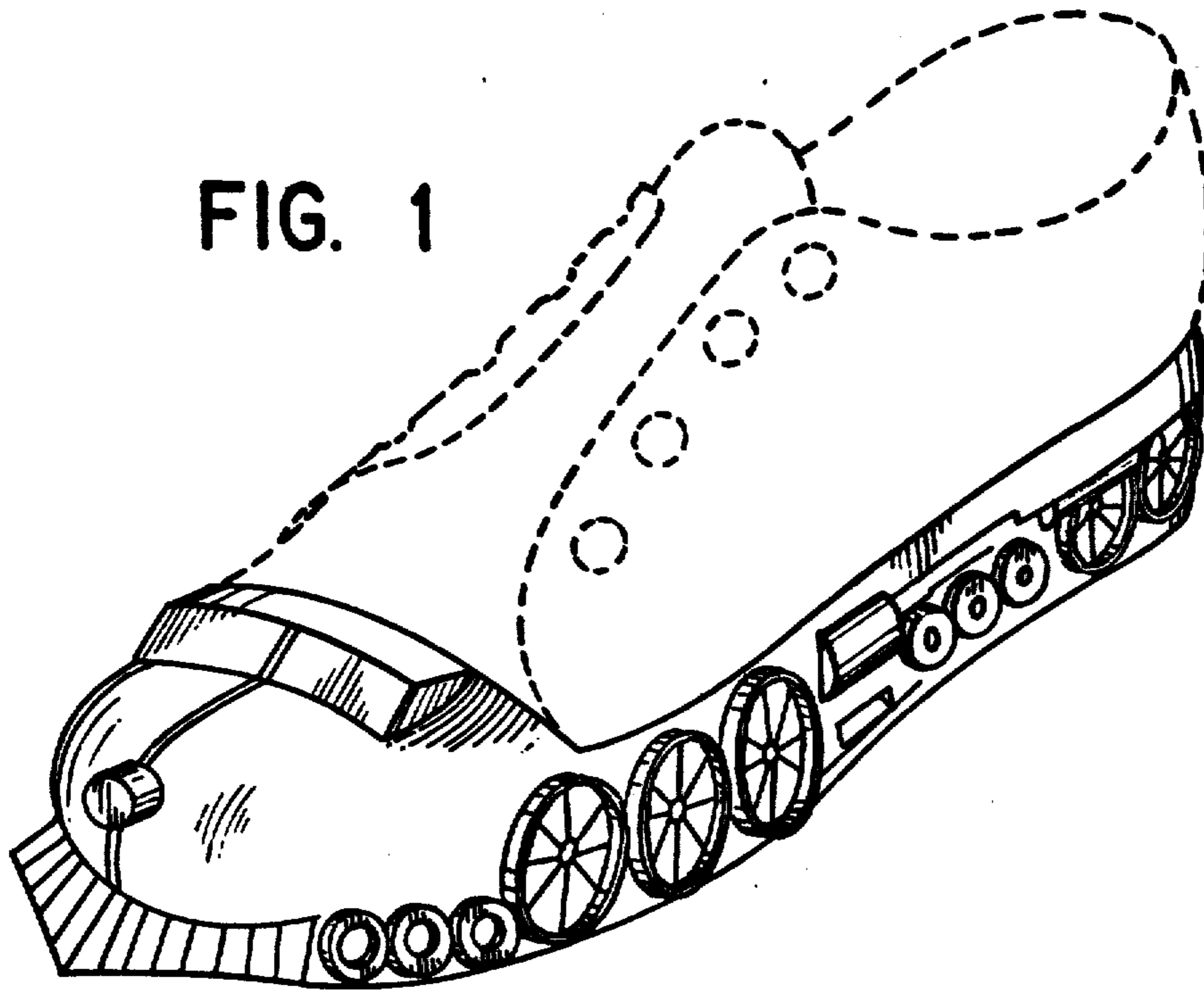
