FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof.

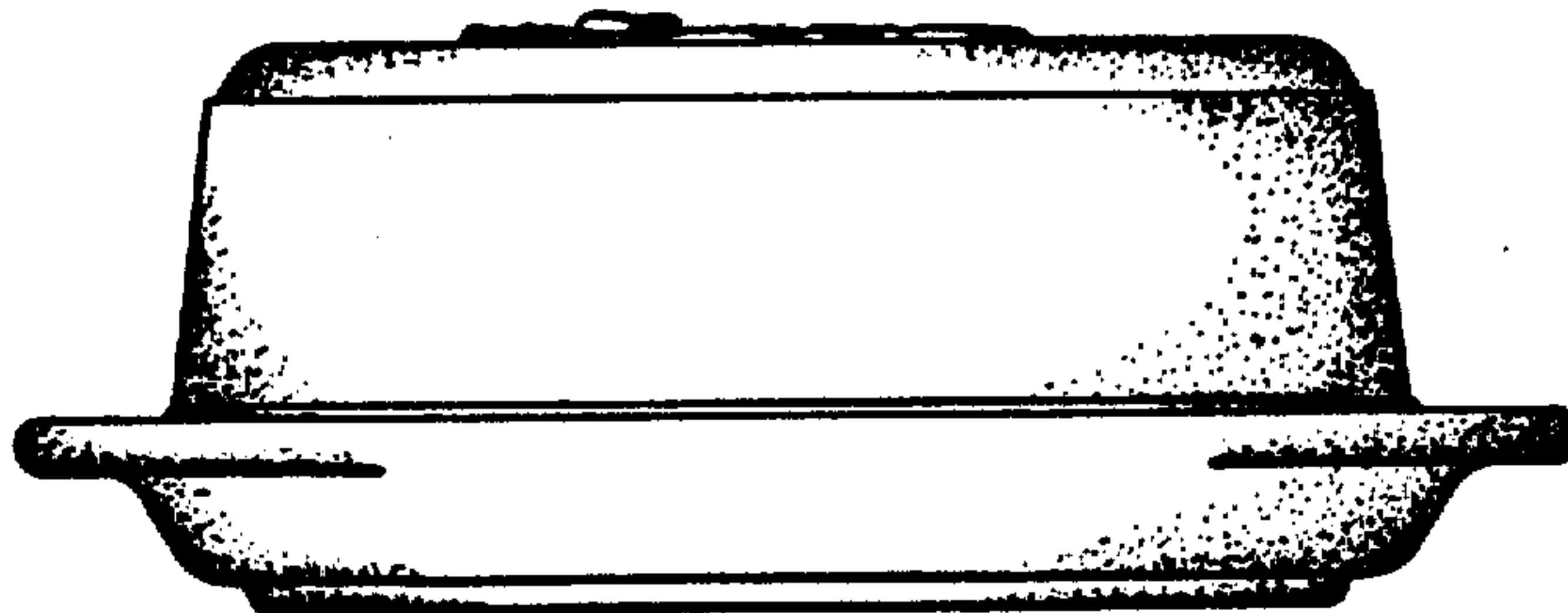

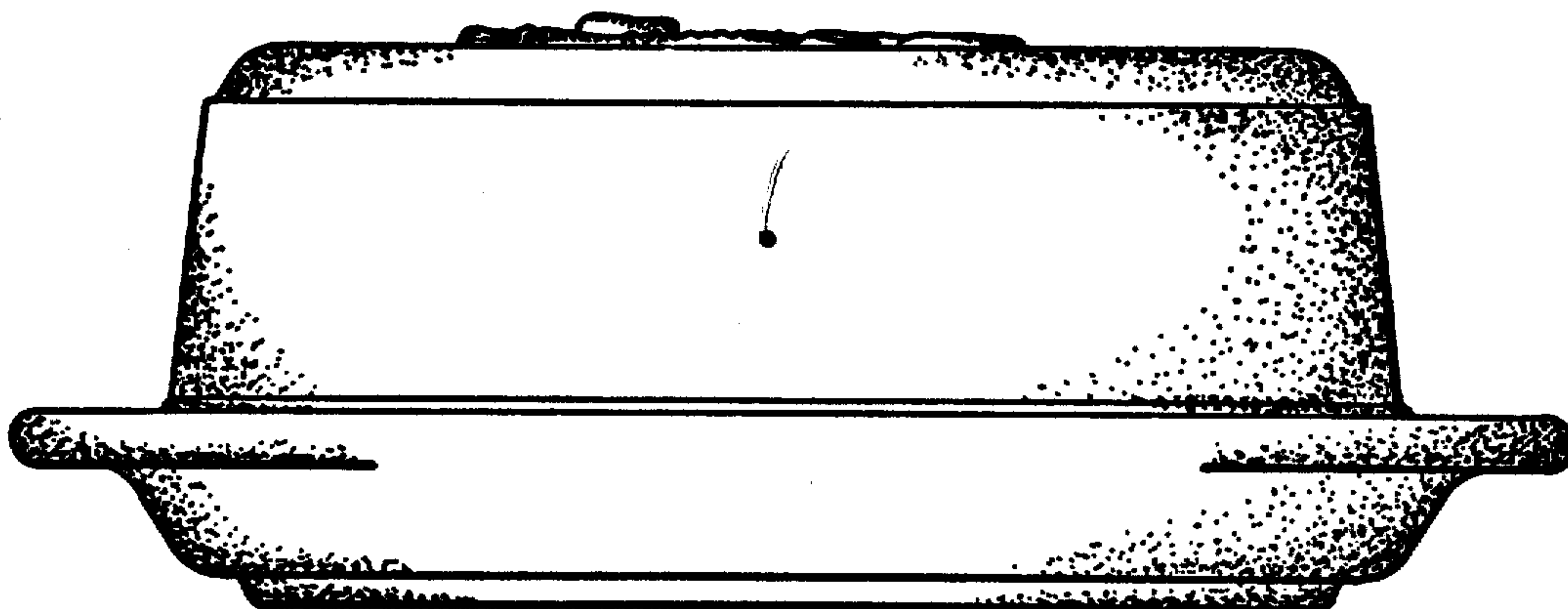

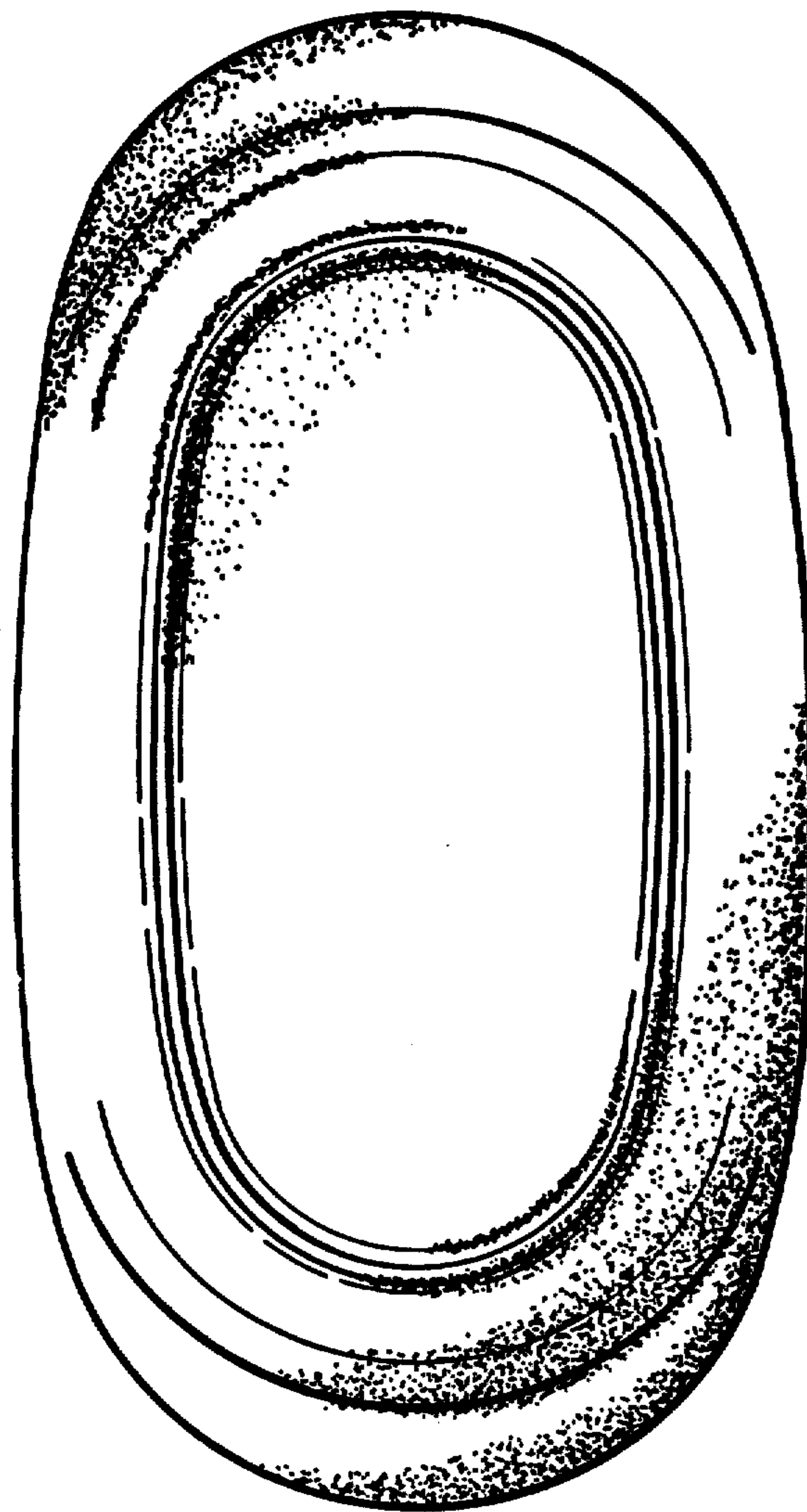
