[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adjustable trash bag holder, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of an adjustable trash bag holder showing my new design, FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the adjustable trash bag holder shown in the assembled condition, the opposite side being identical thereto; FIG. 3 is a front view thereof, the rear view being the same, FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof, and FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof, with a bag shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design.
