DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an illuminated display showing my new design;

 My new design for an illuminated display is believed adequately shown in the above-discussed FIGS. 1-4 of the drawings.

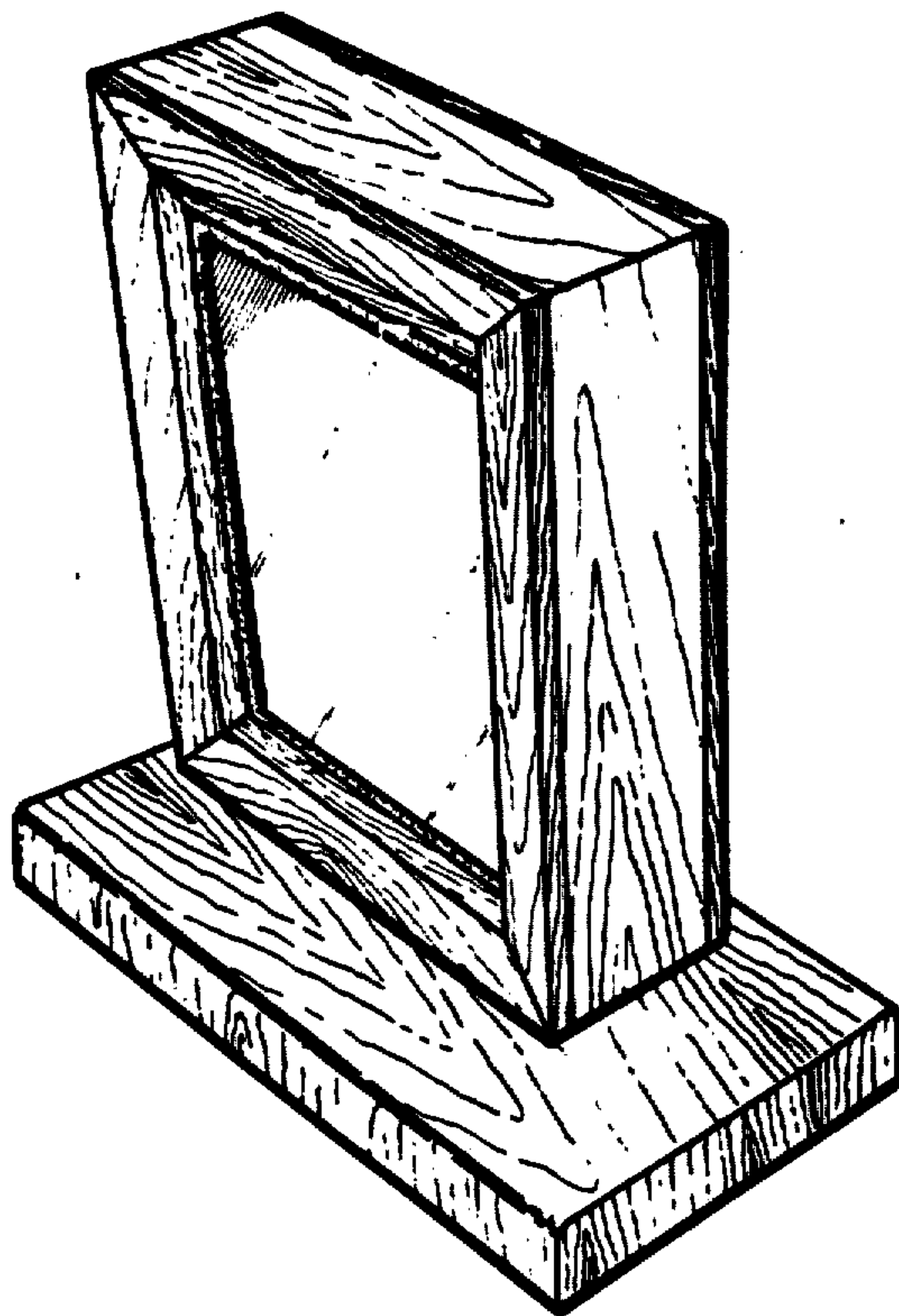

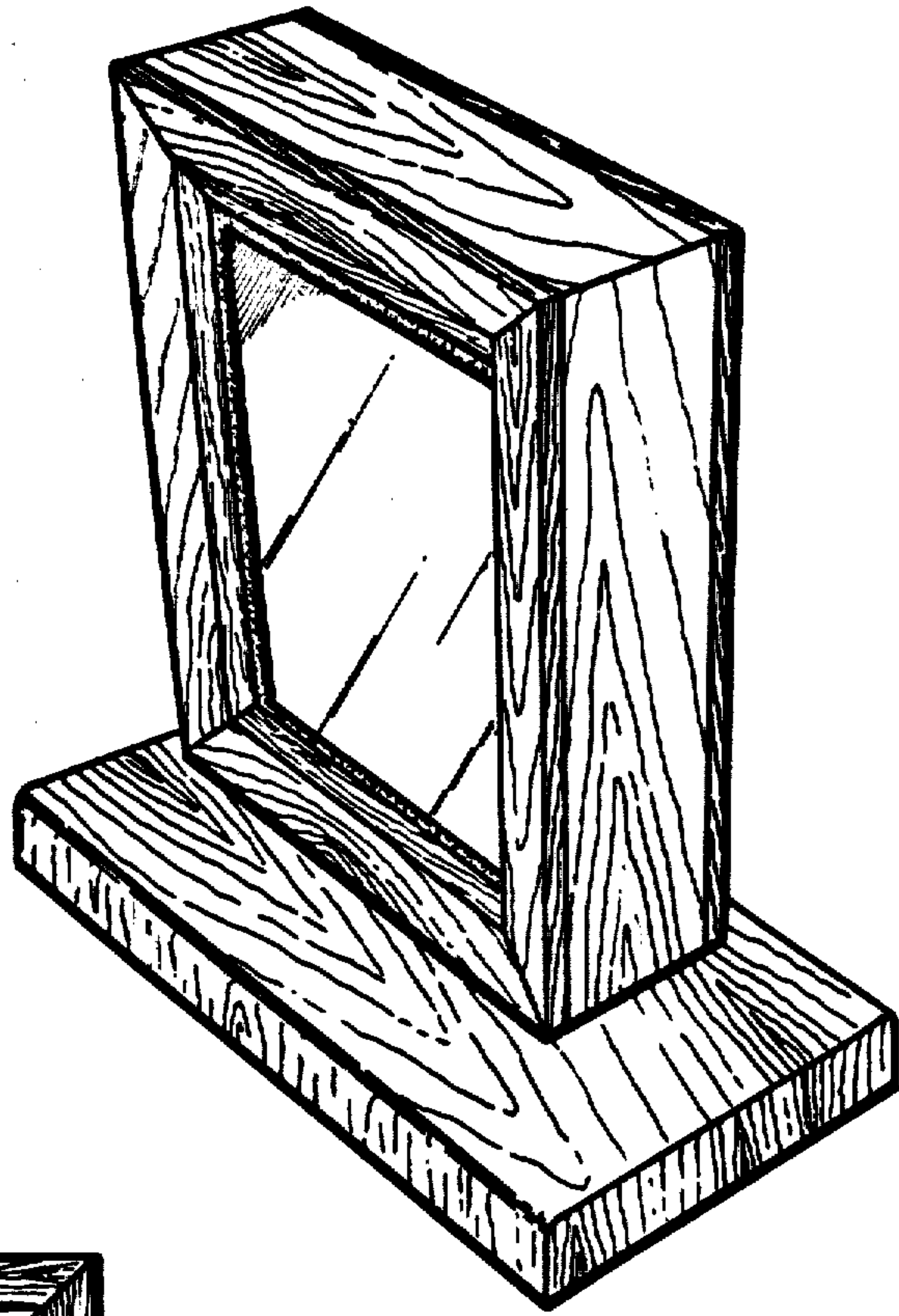

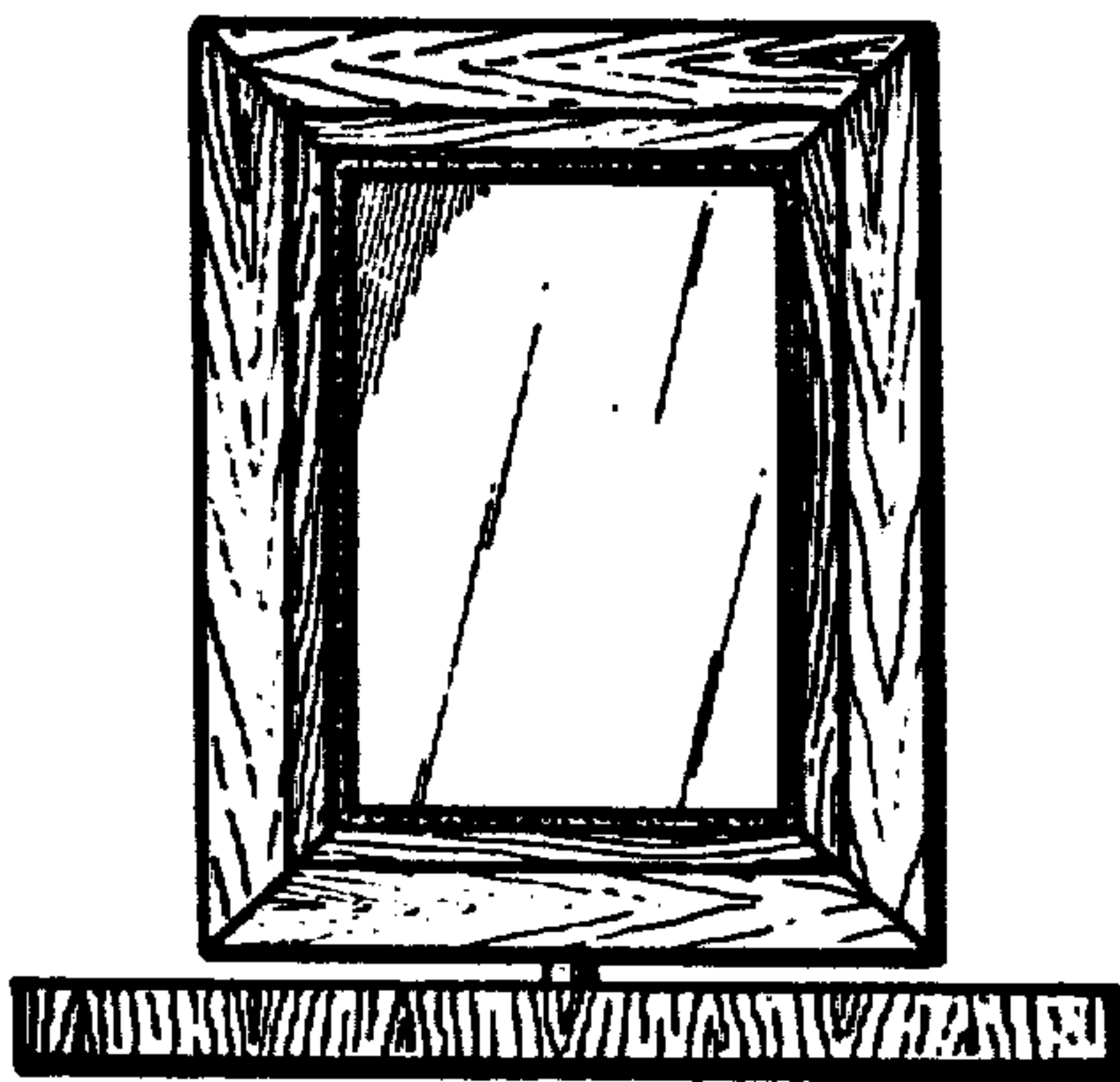

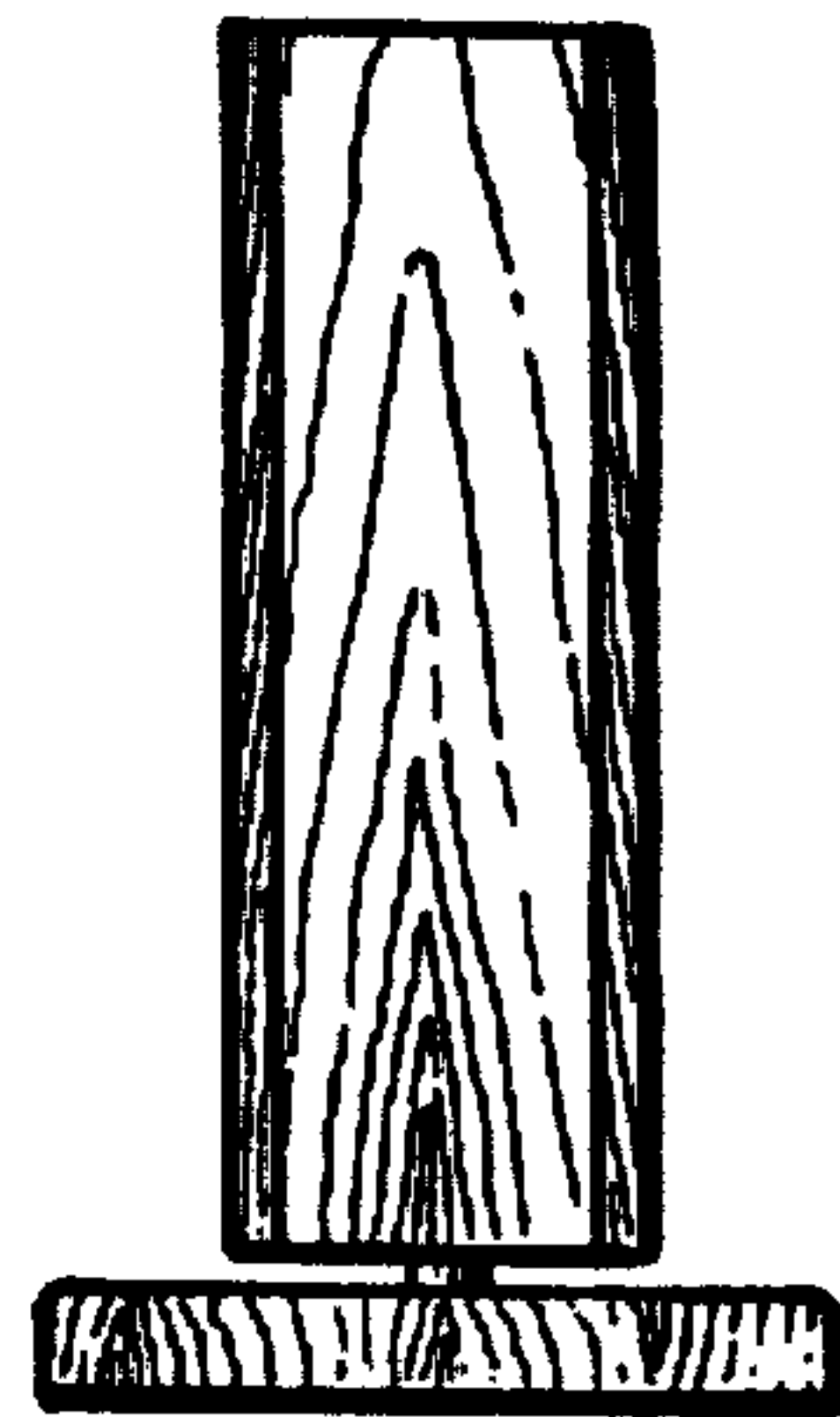
