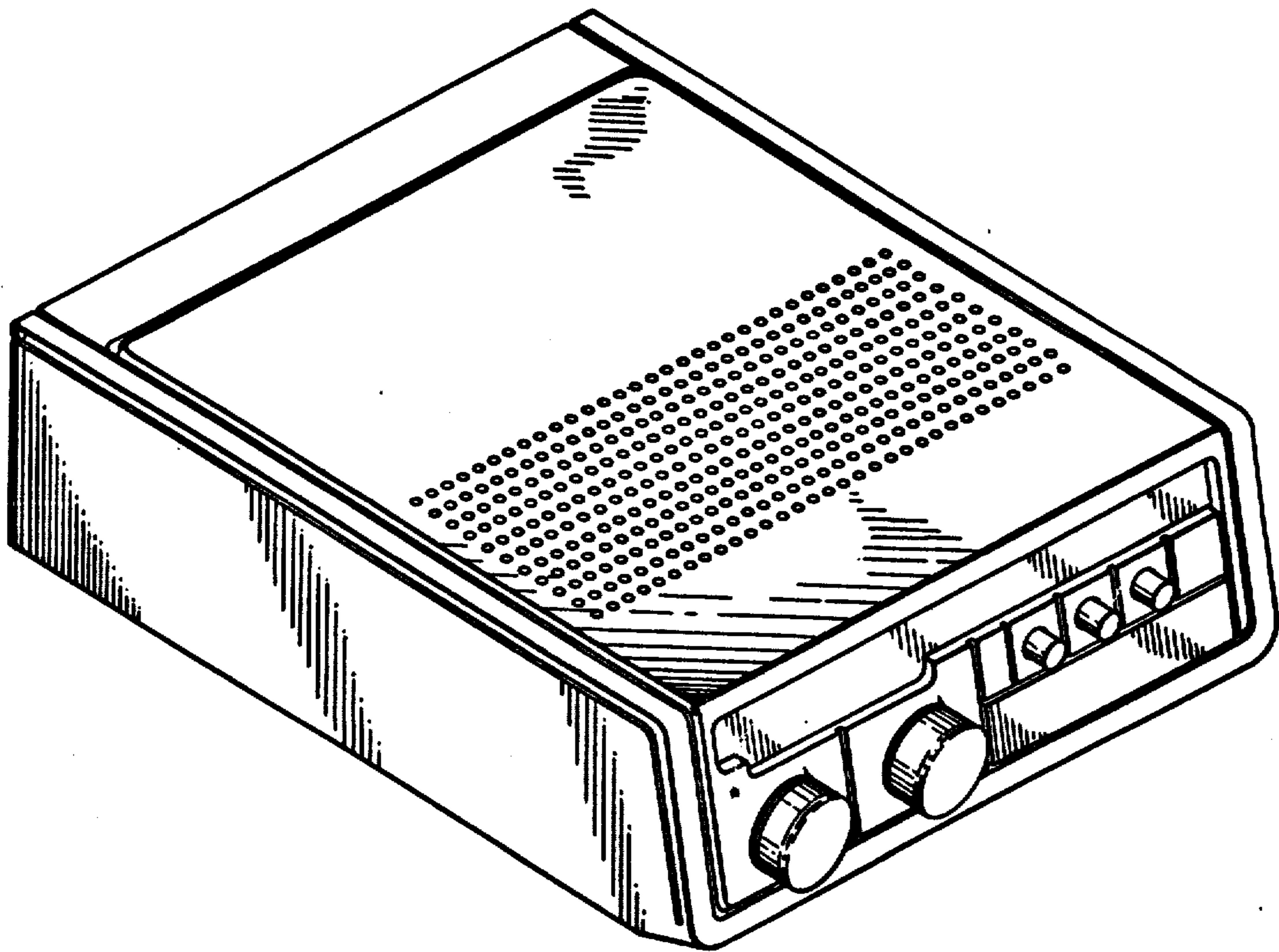

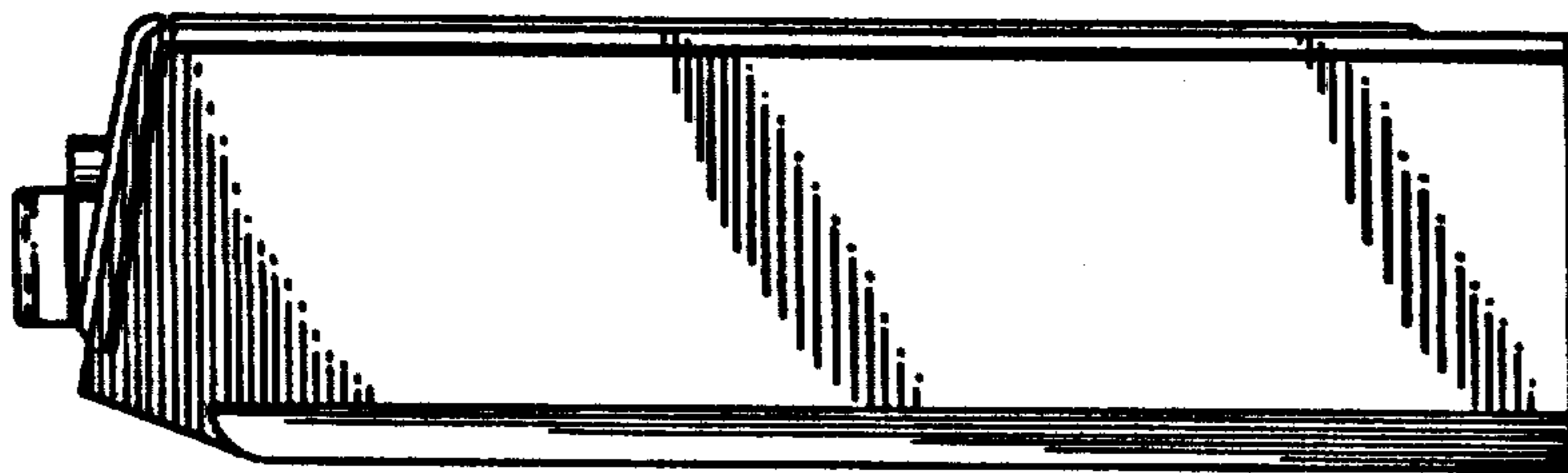
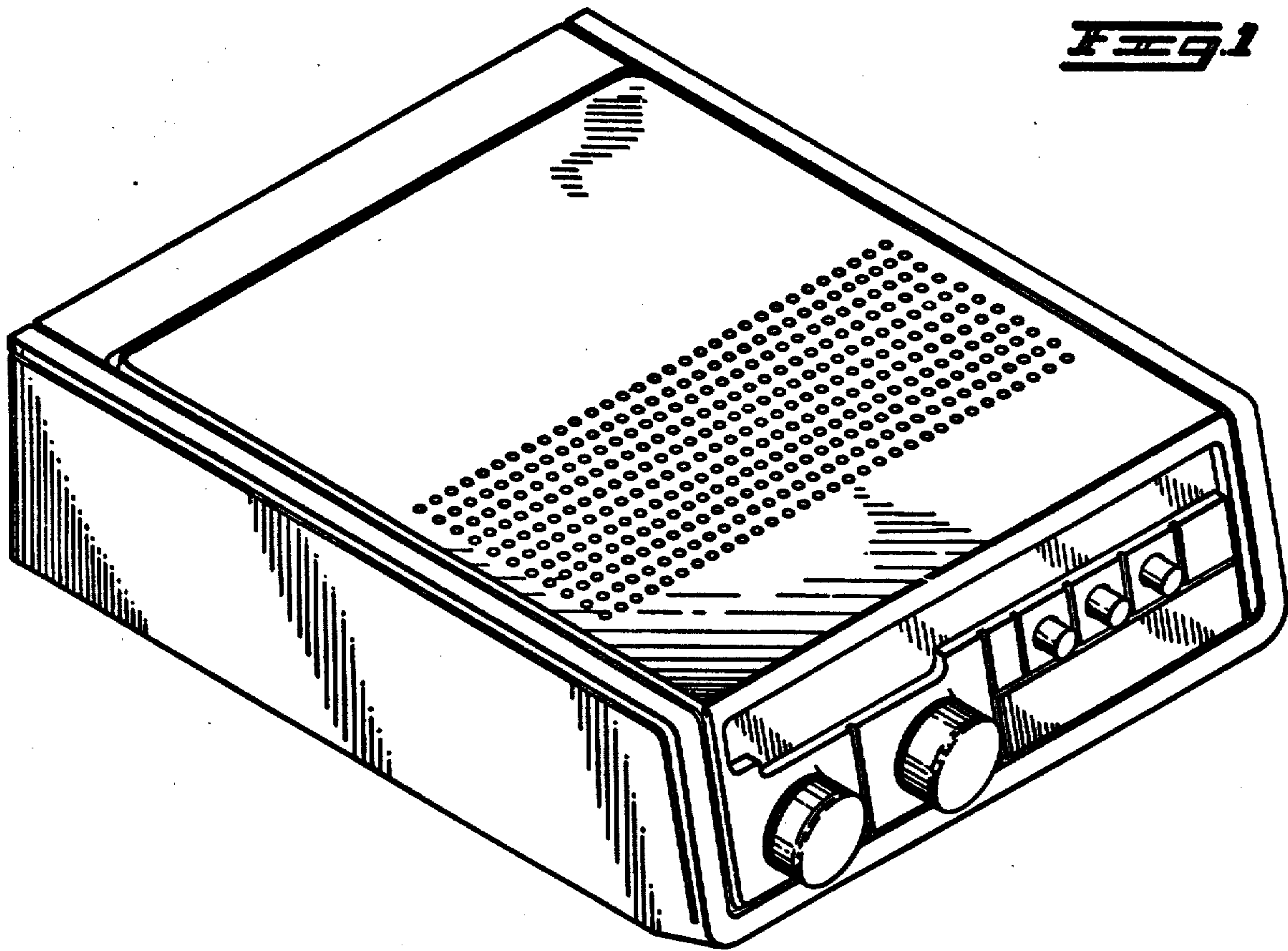
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vehicular two-way radio or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a vehicular two-way radio or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.





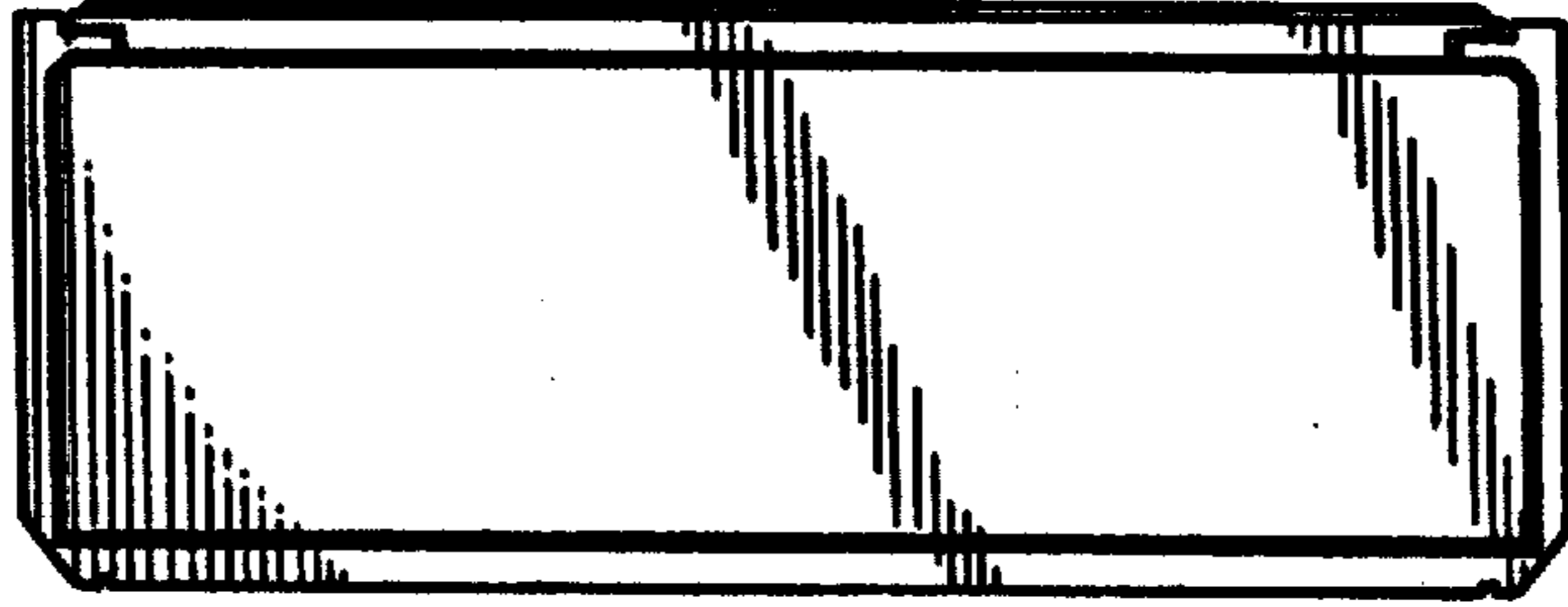

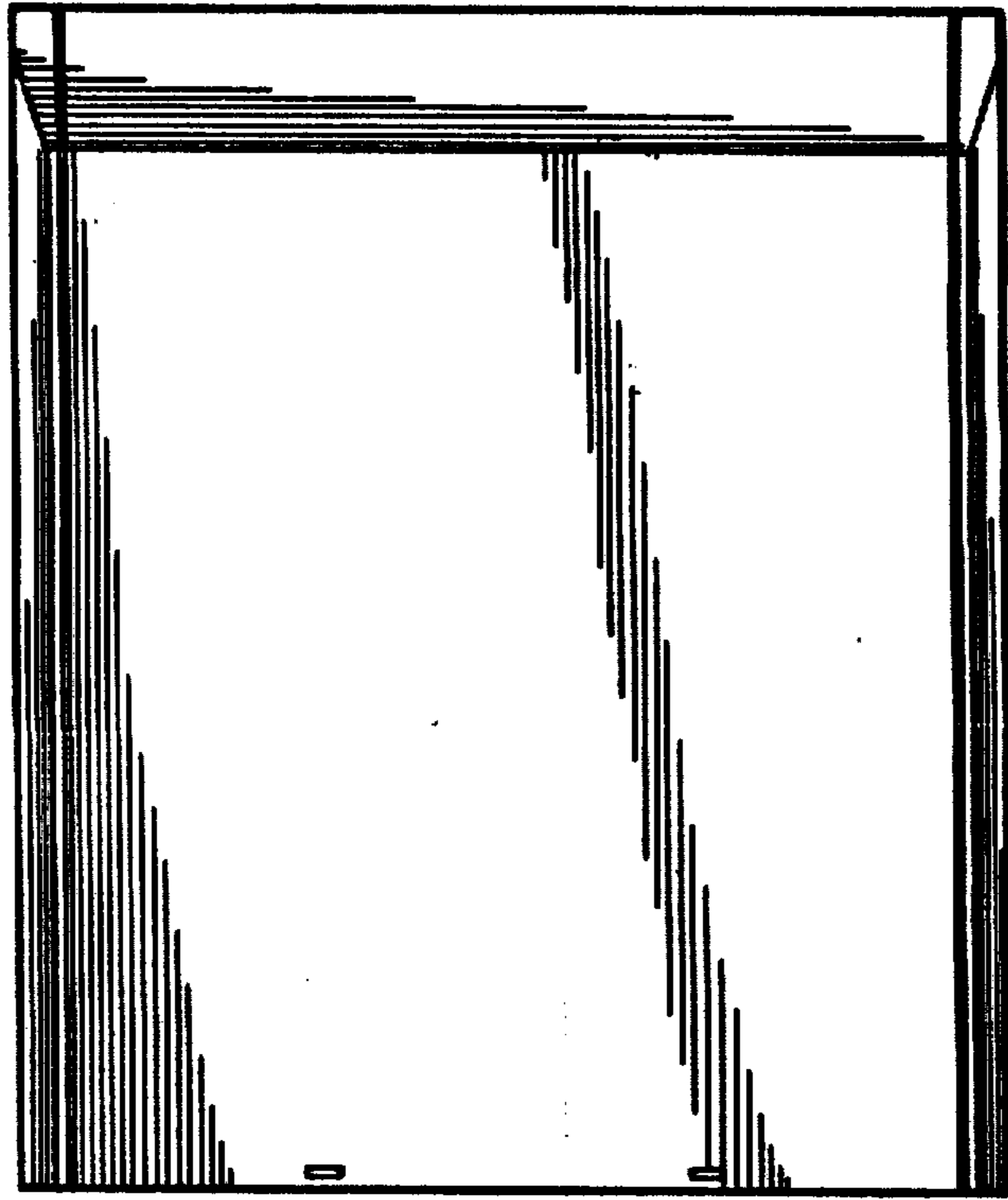
