[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a spectacle holder, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spectacle holder embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken along the lines 4-4 of FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

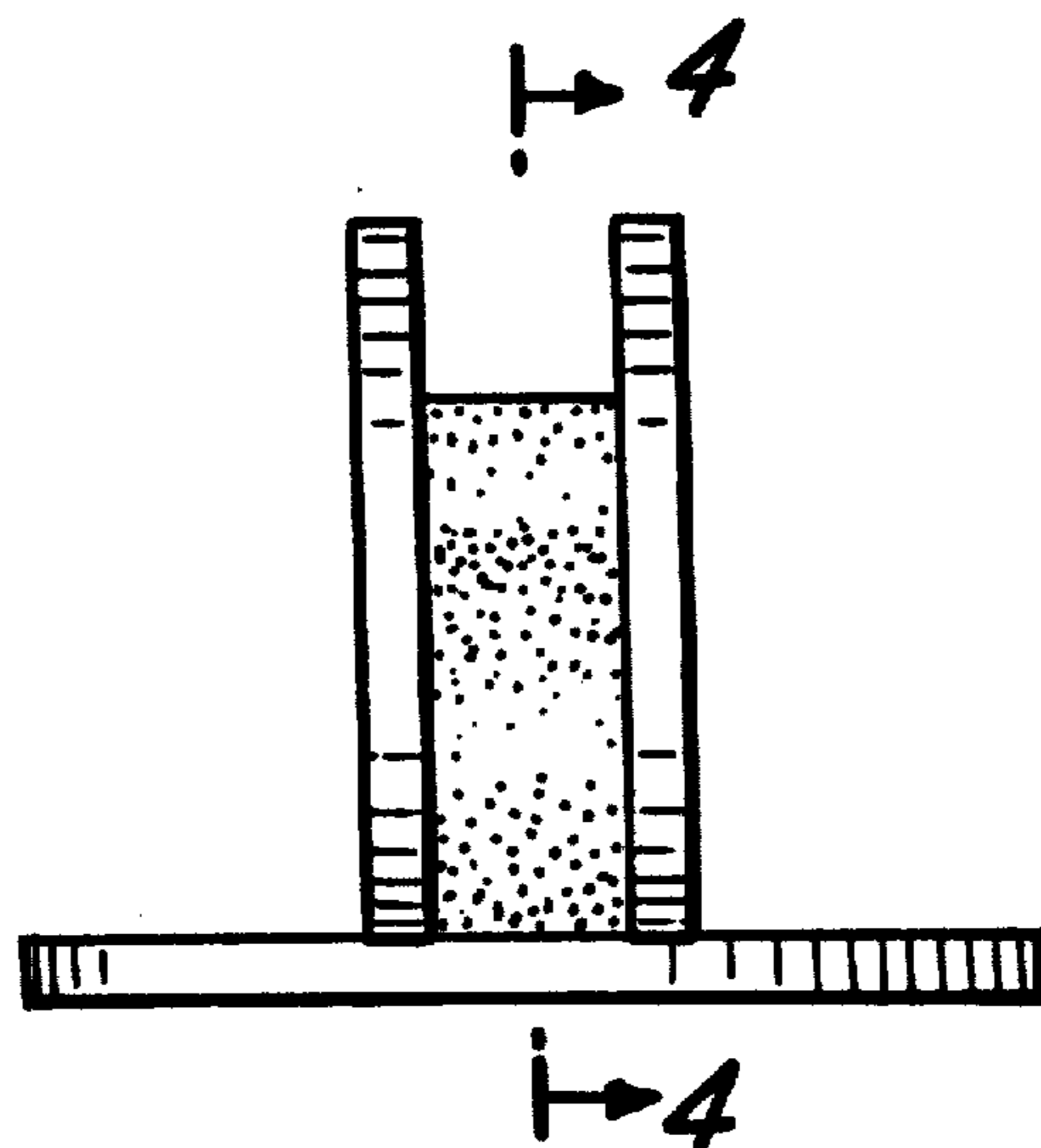
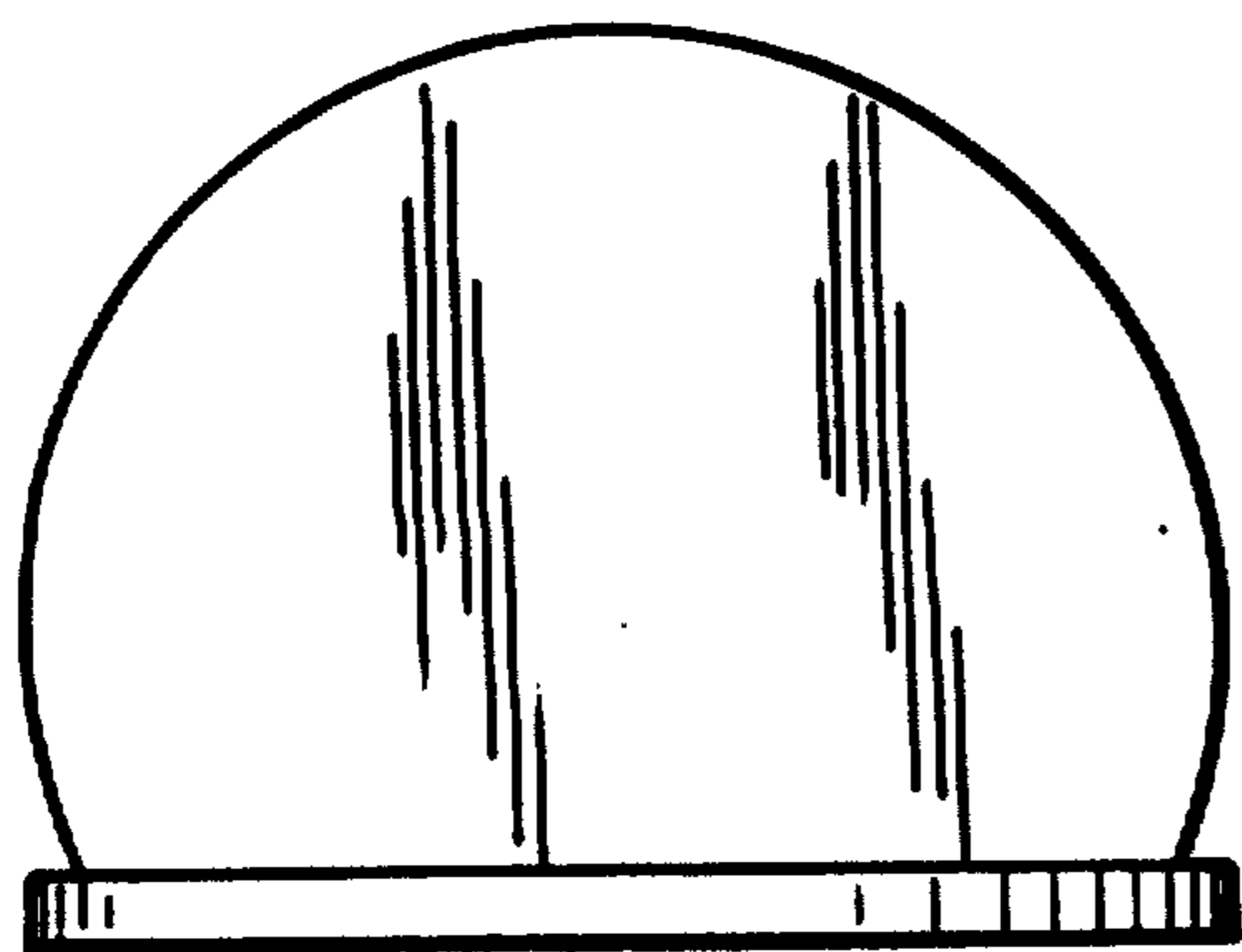

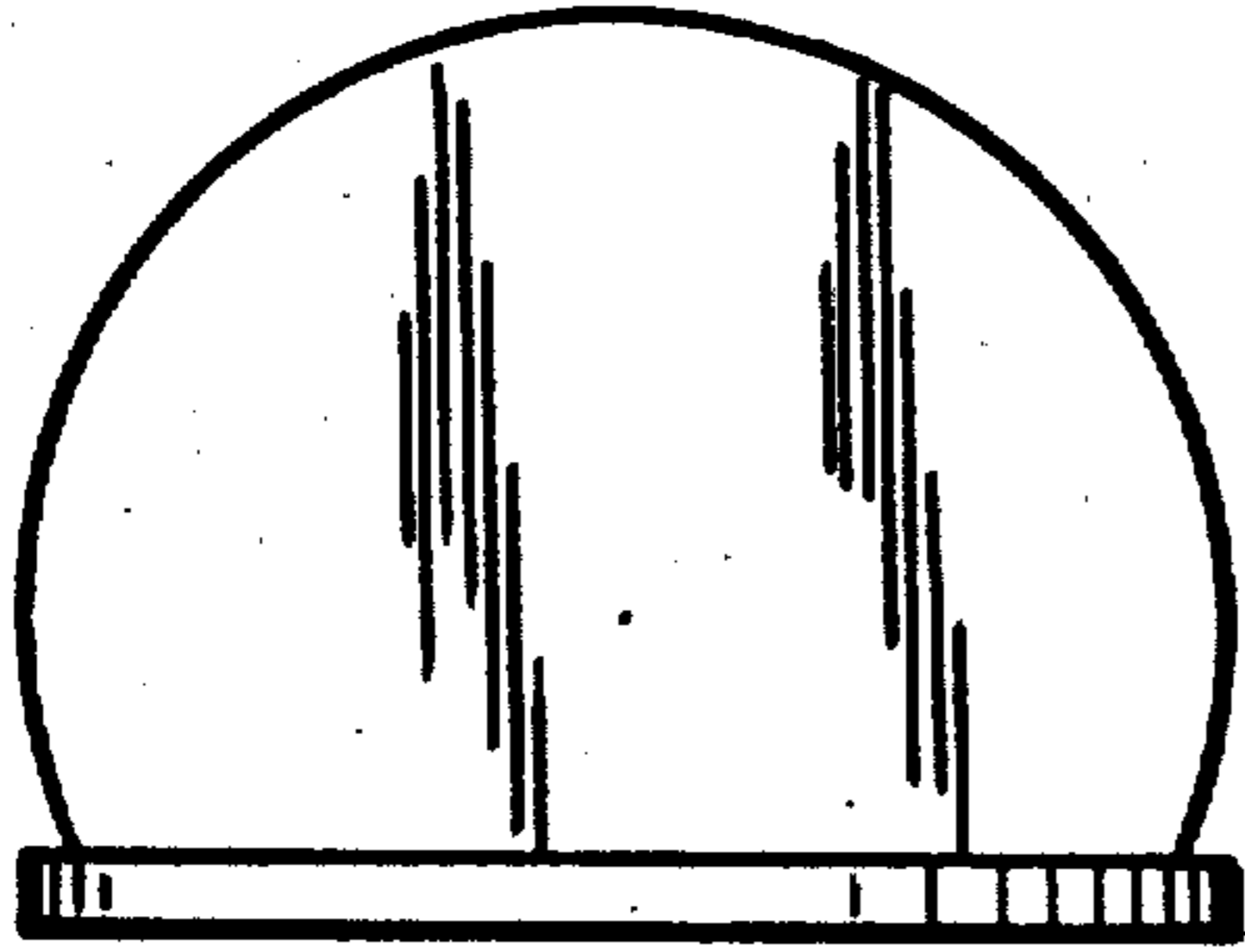

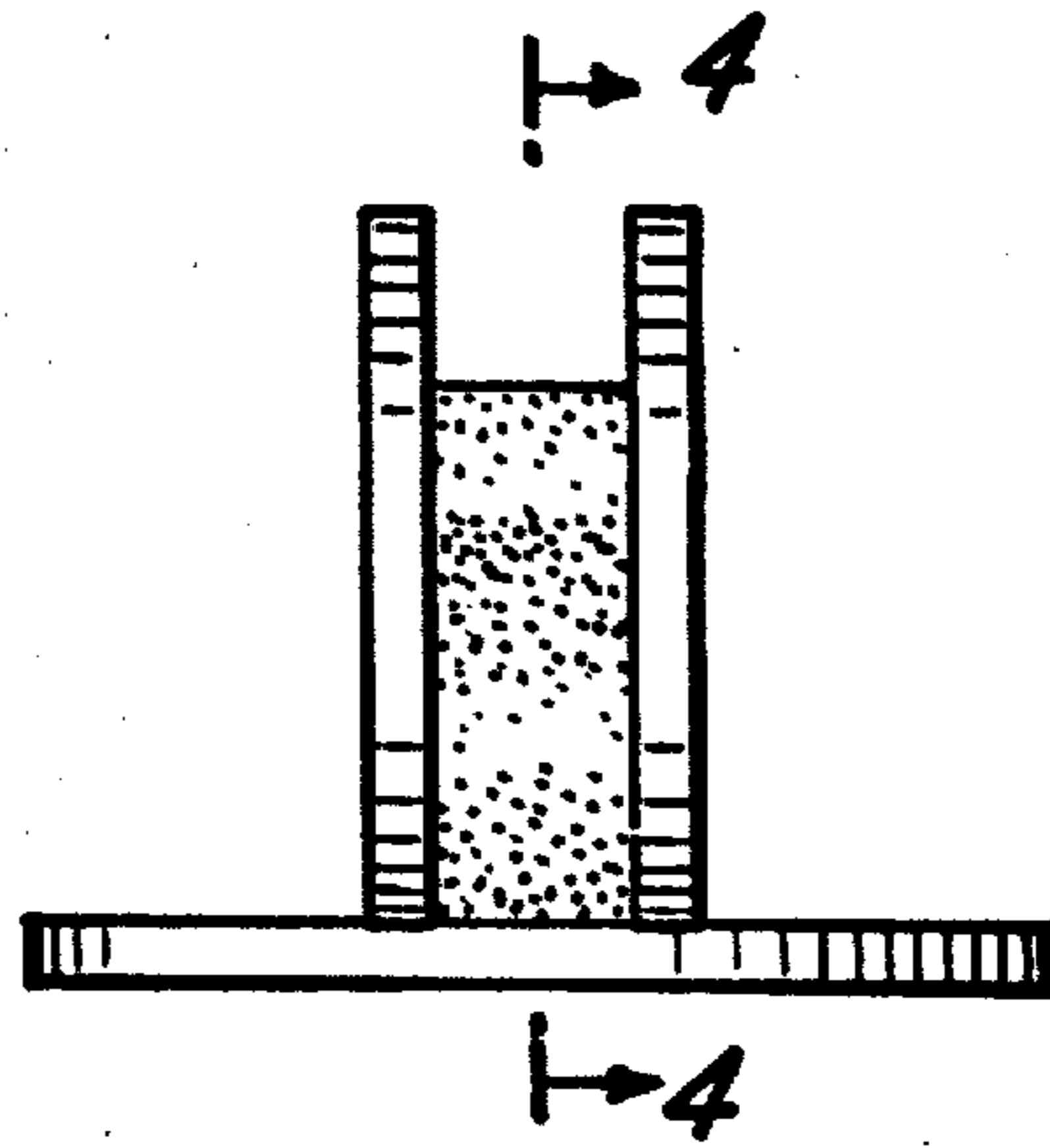

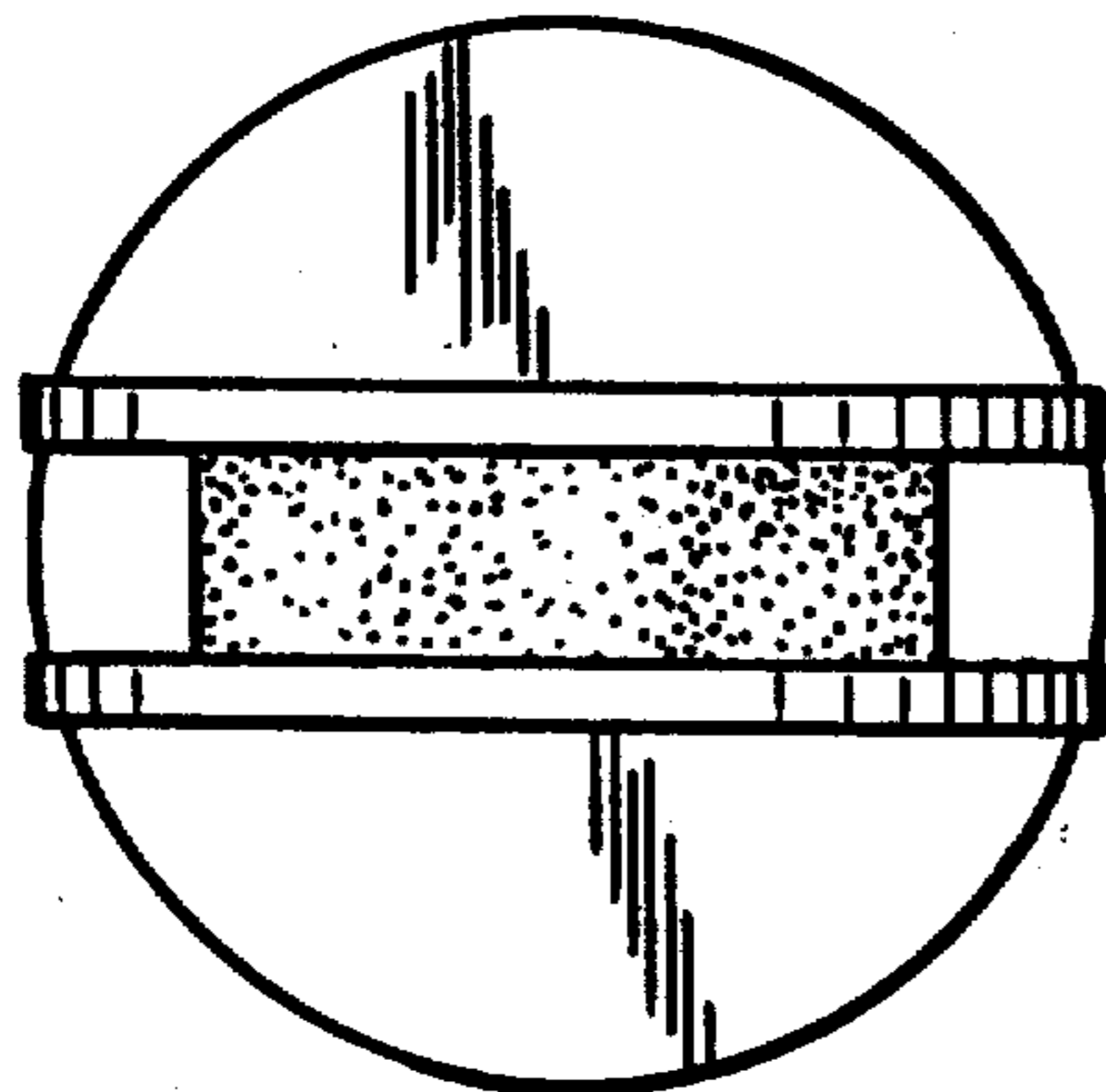

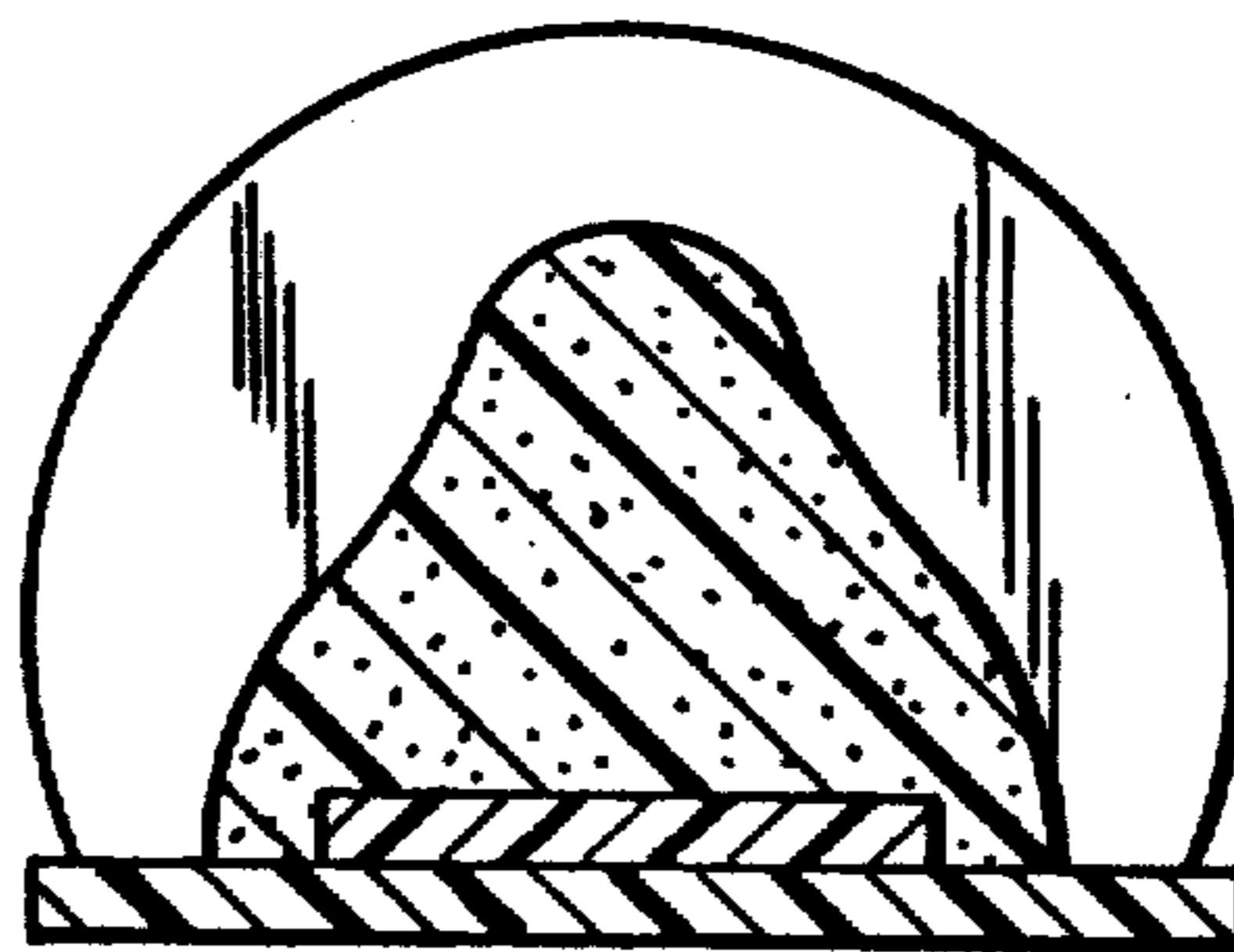
