DESCRIPTION

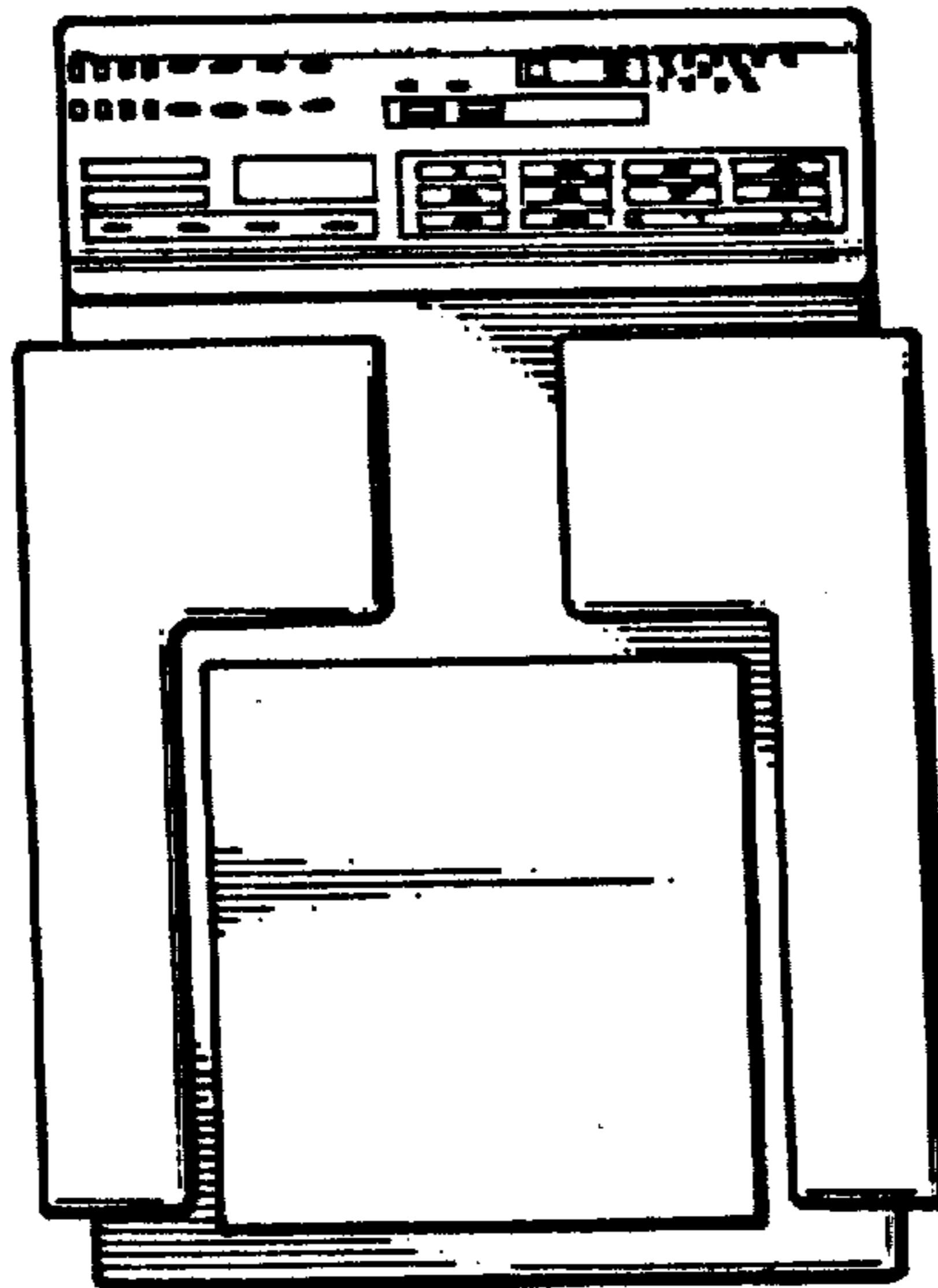
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy console illustrating my new design;

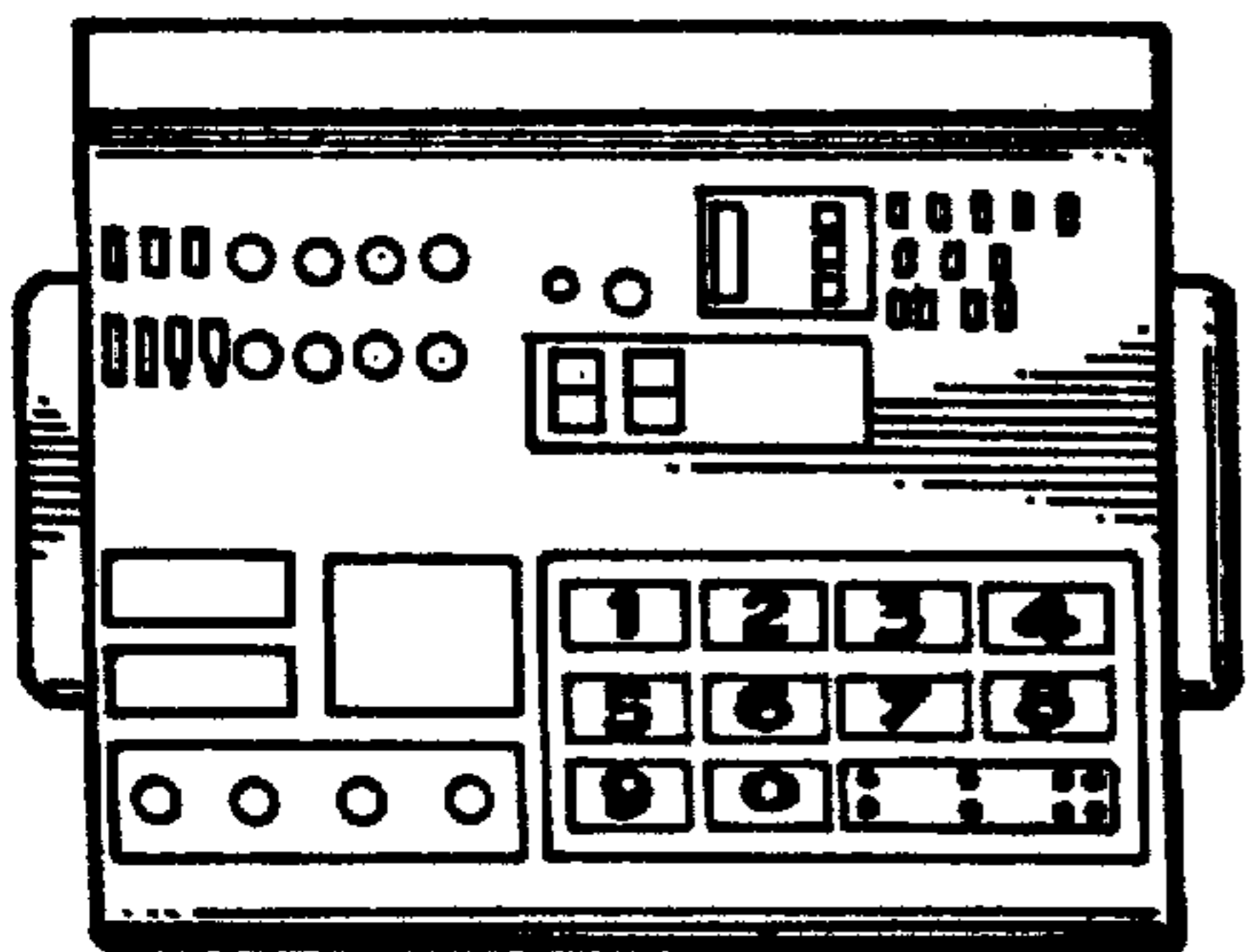
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

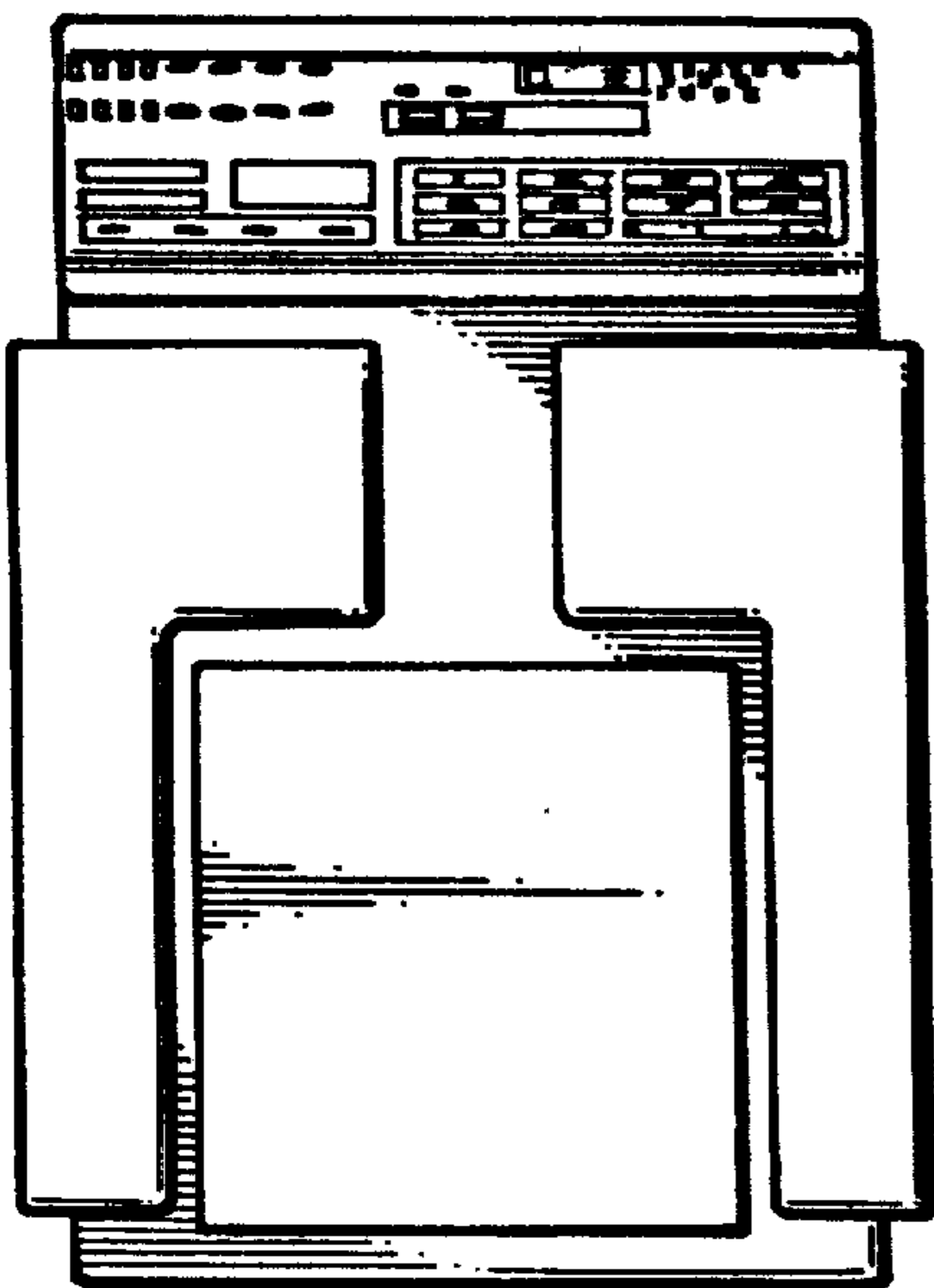
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



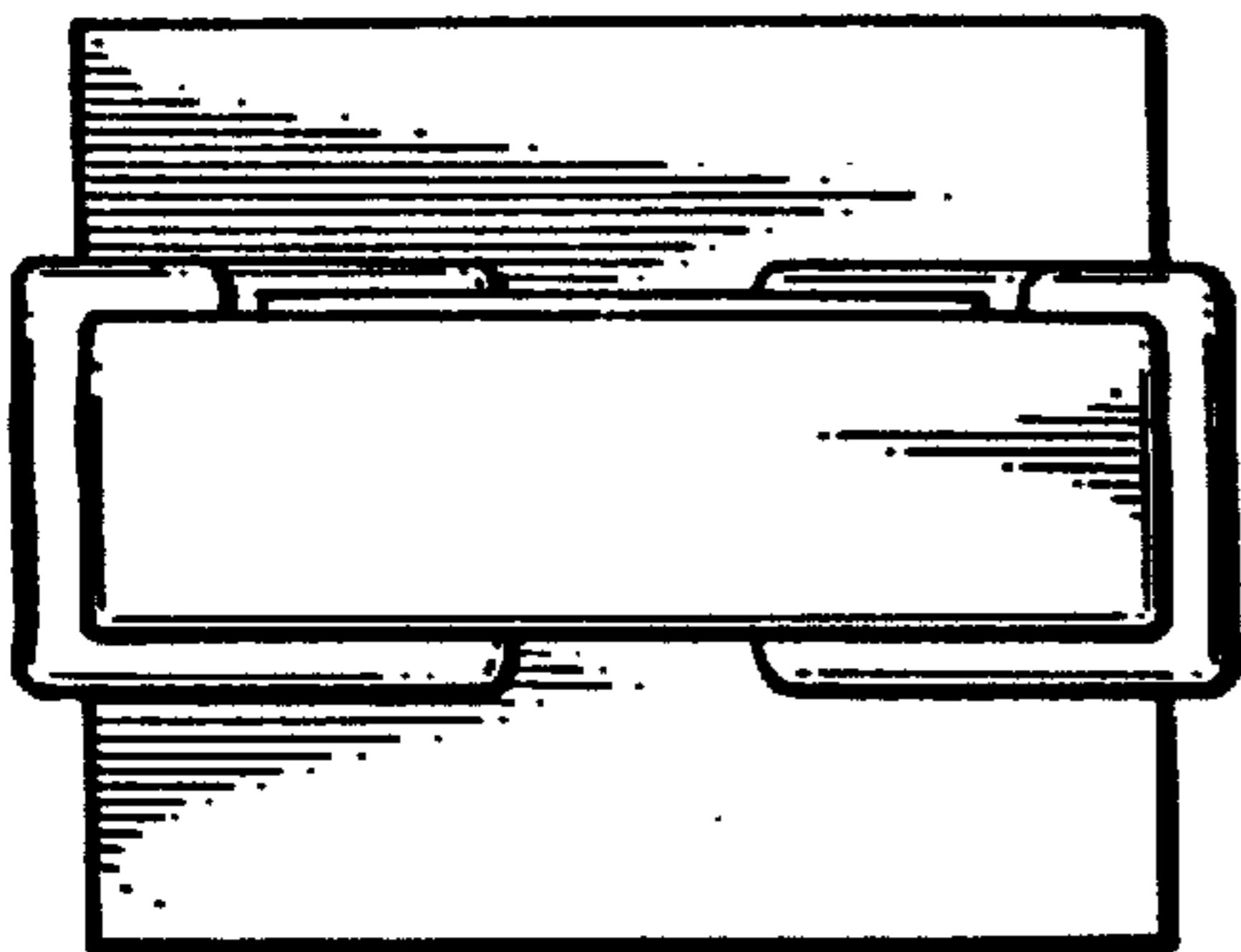

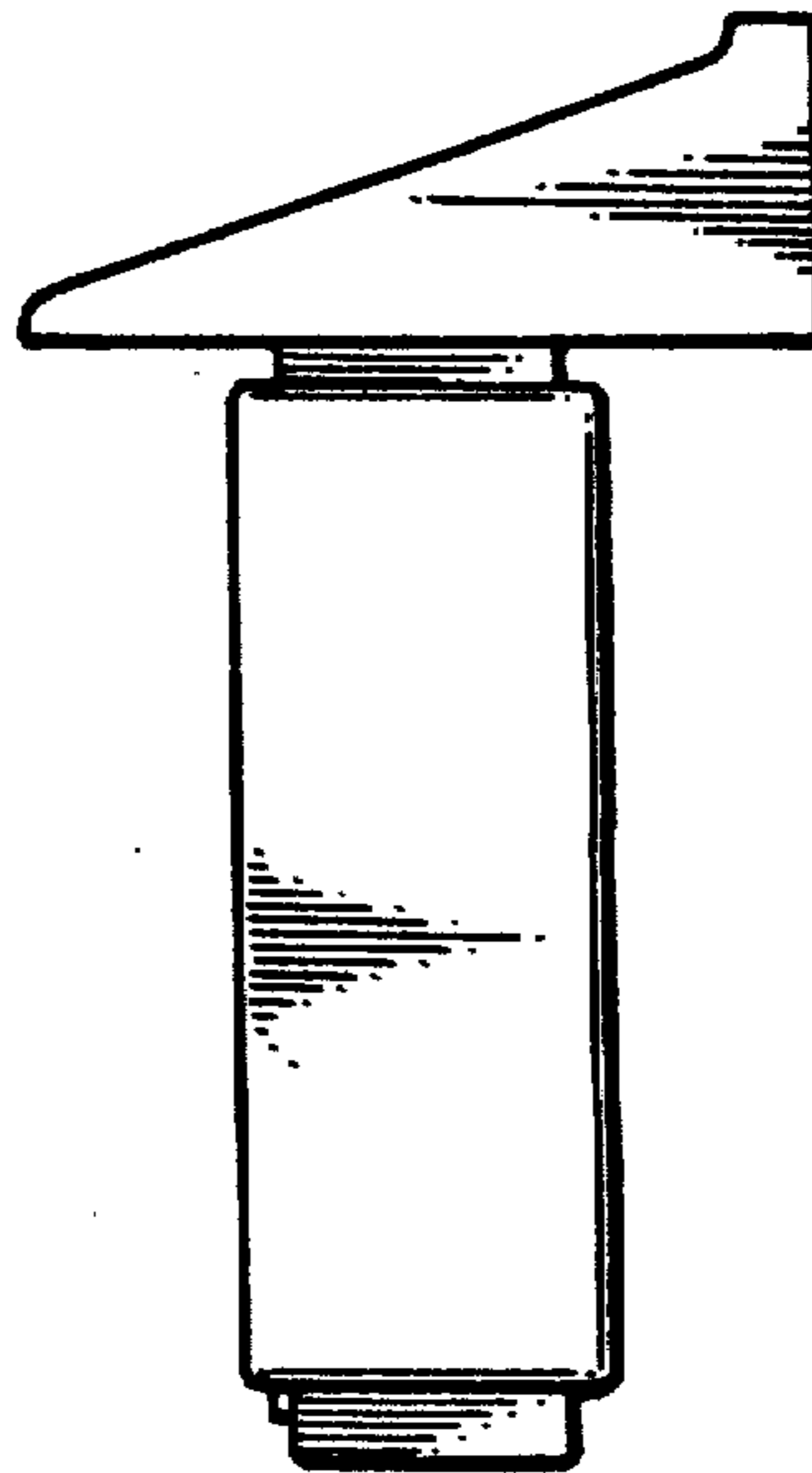
