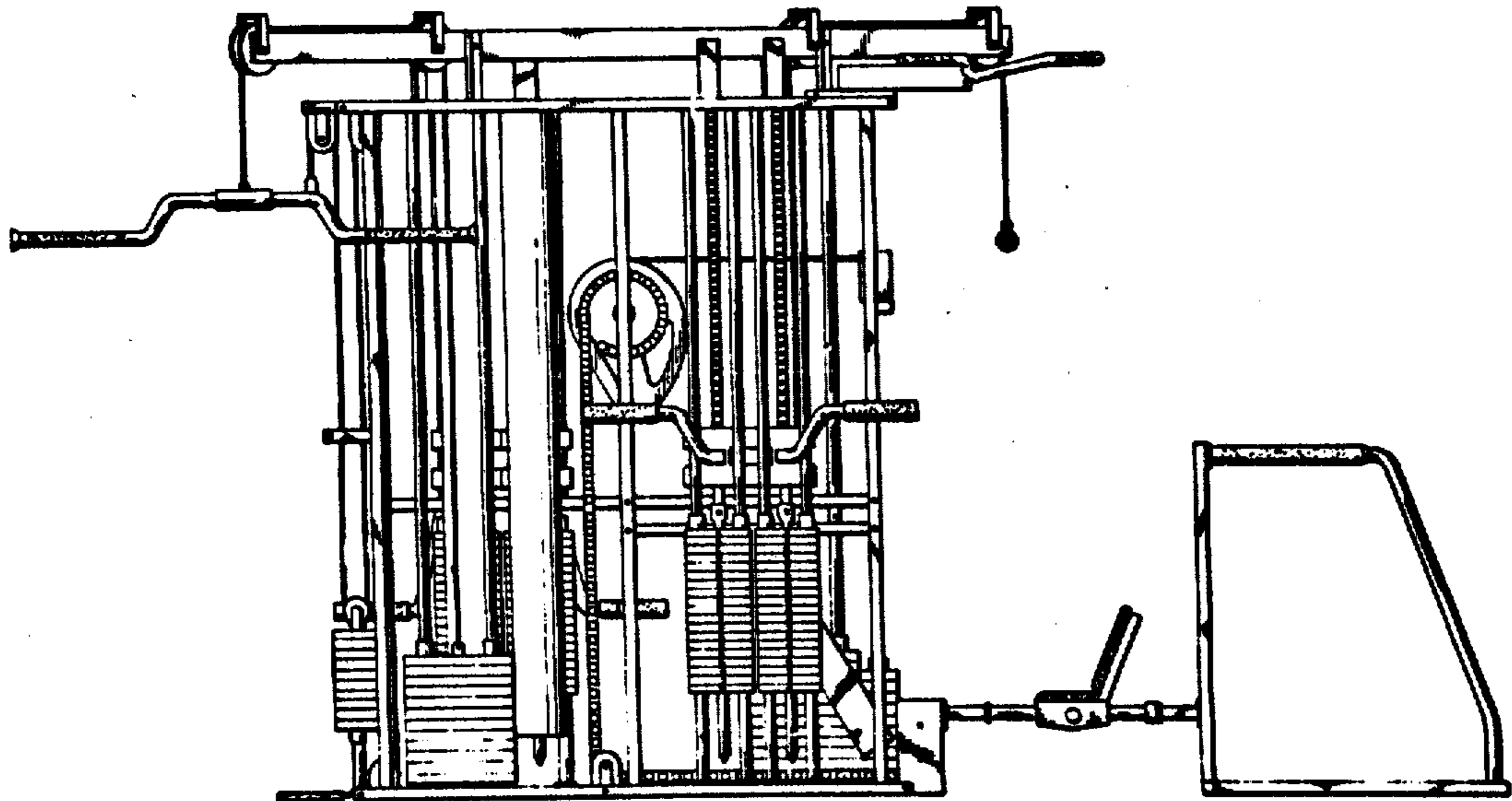

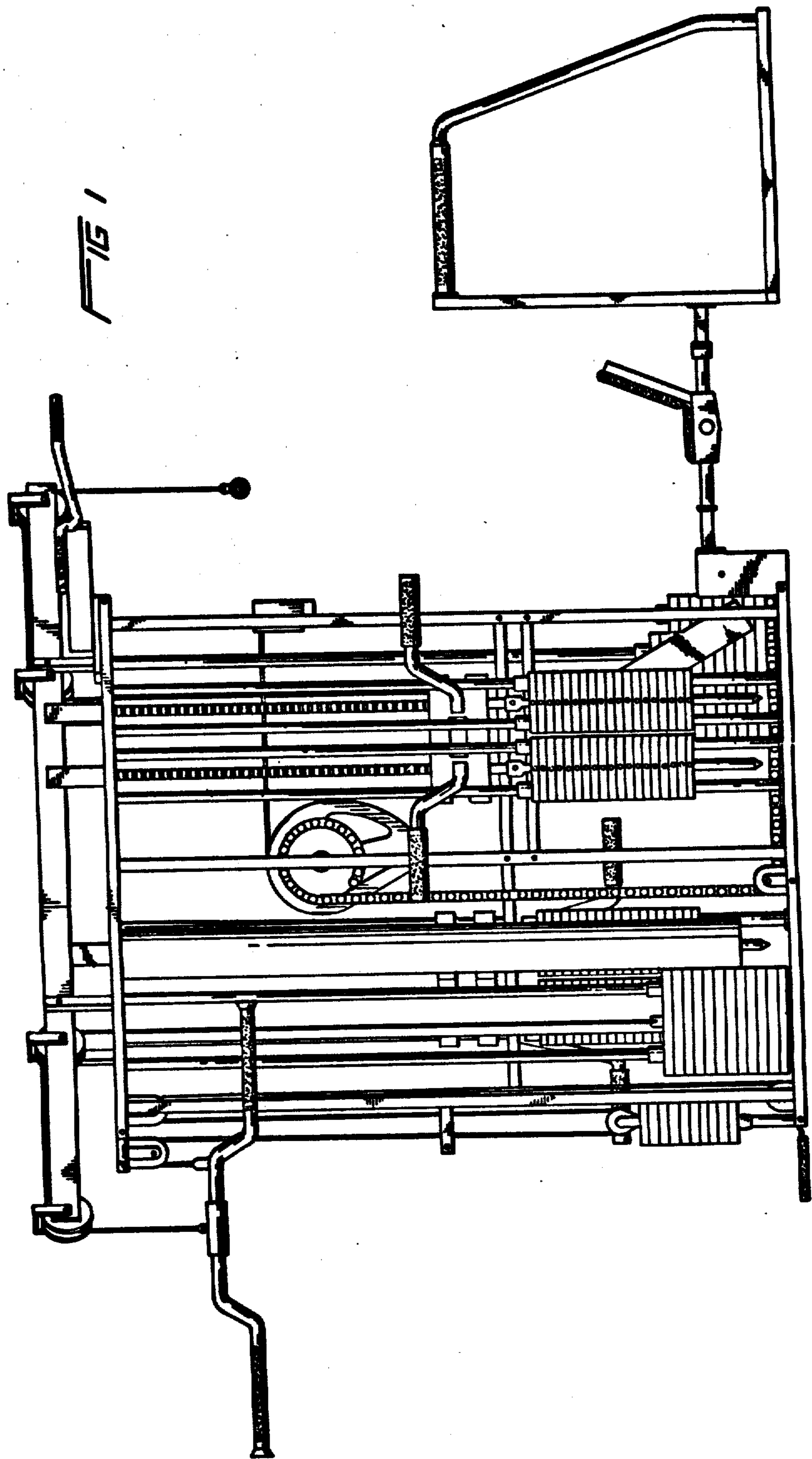

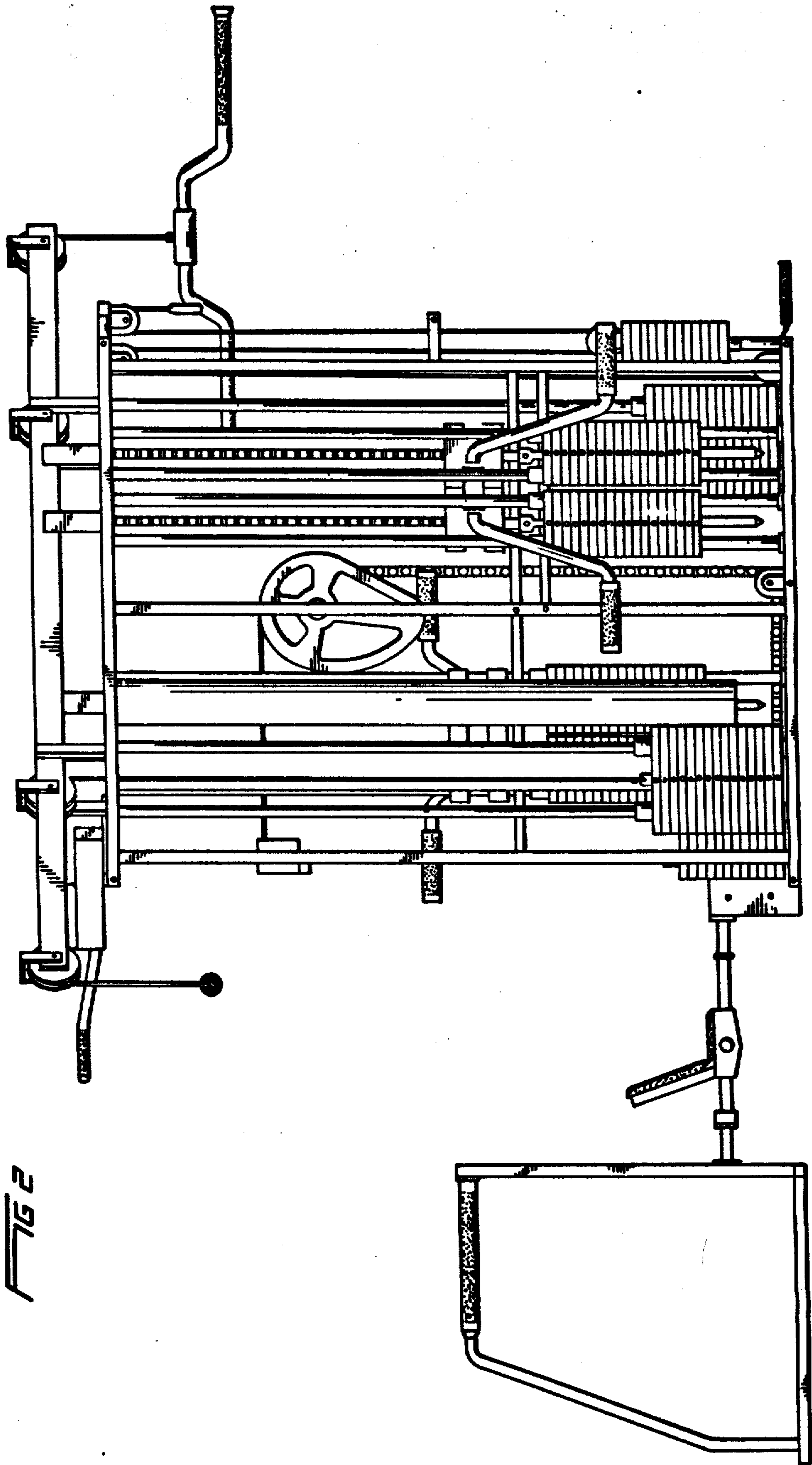
The ornamental design for a multi station physical exerciser, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a multi station physical exerciser showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.







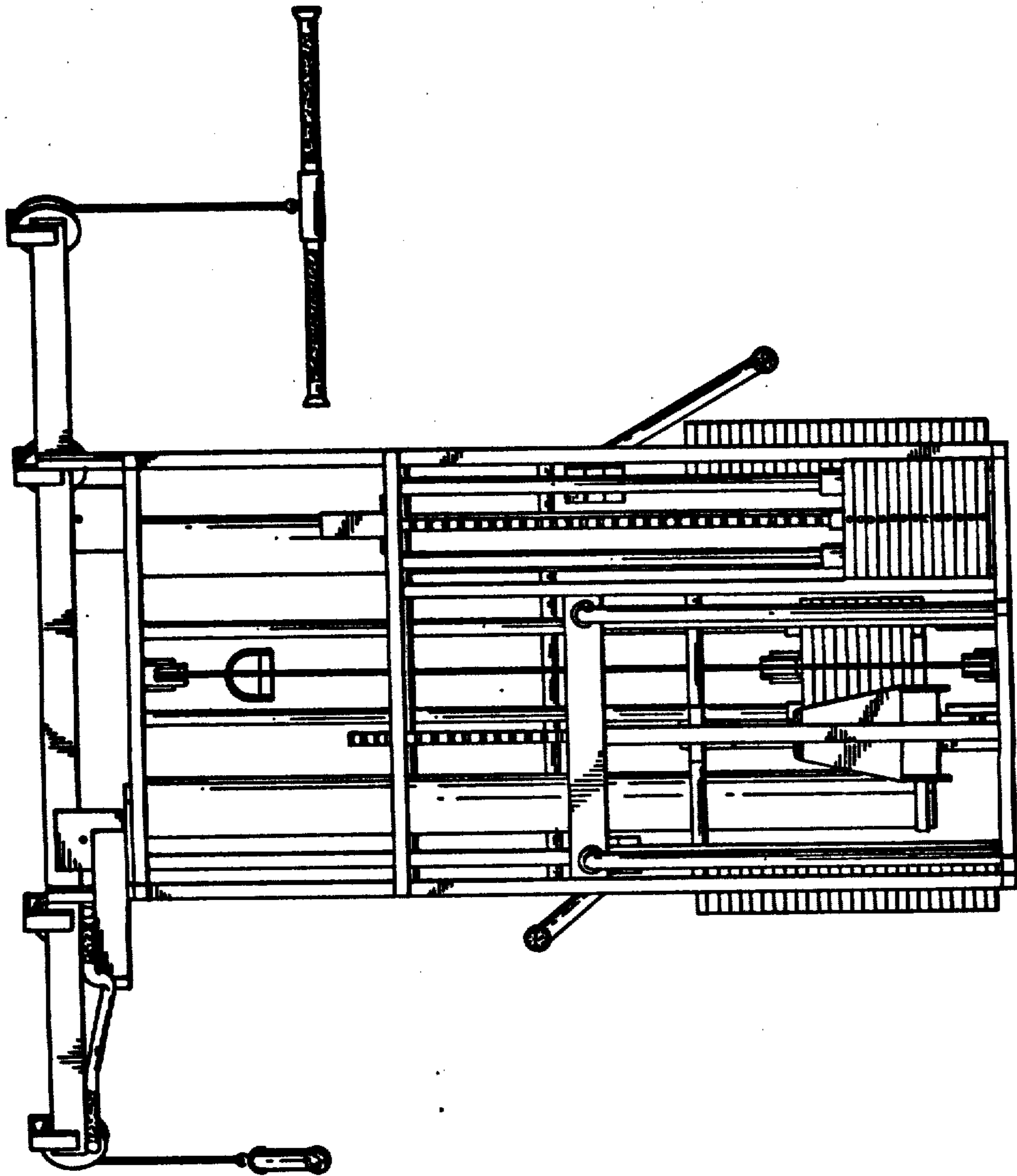

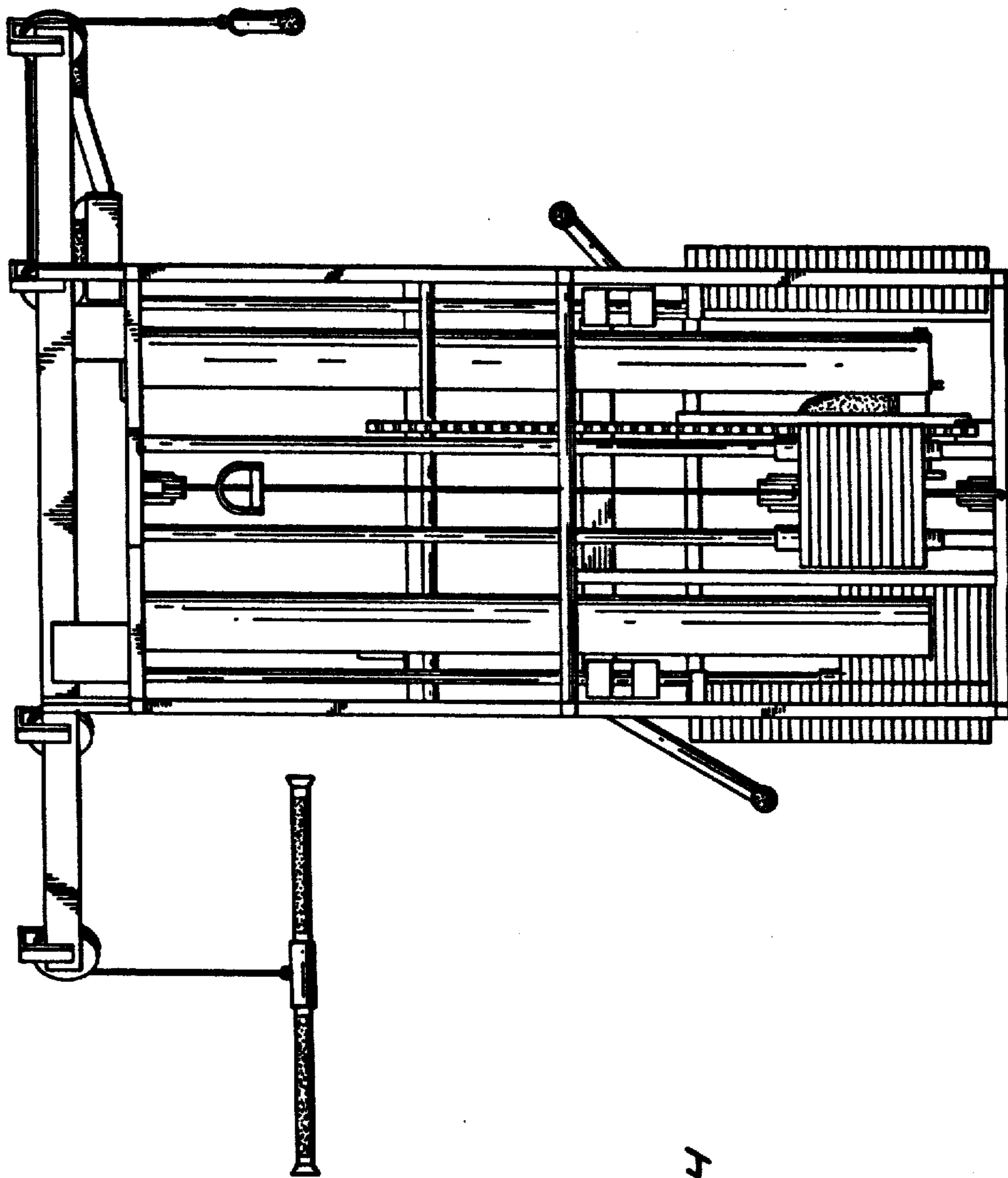

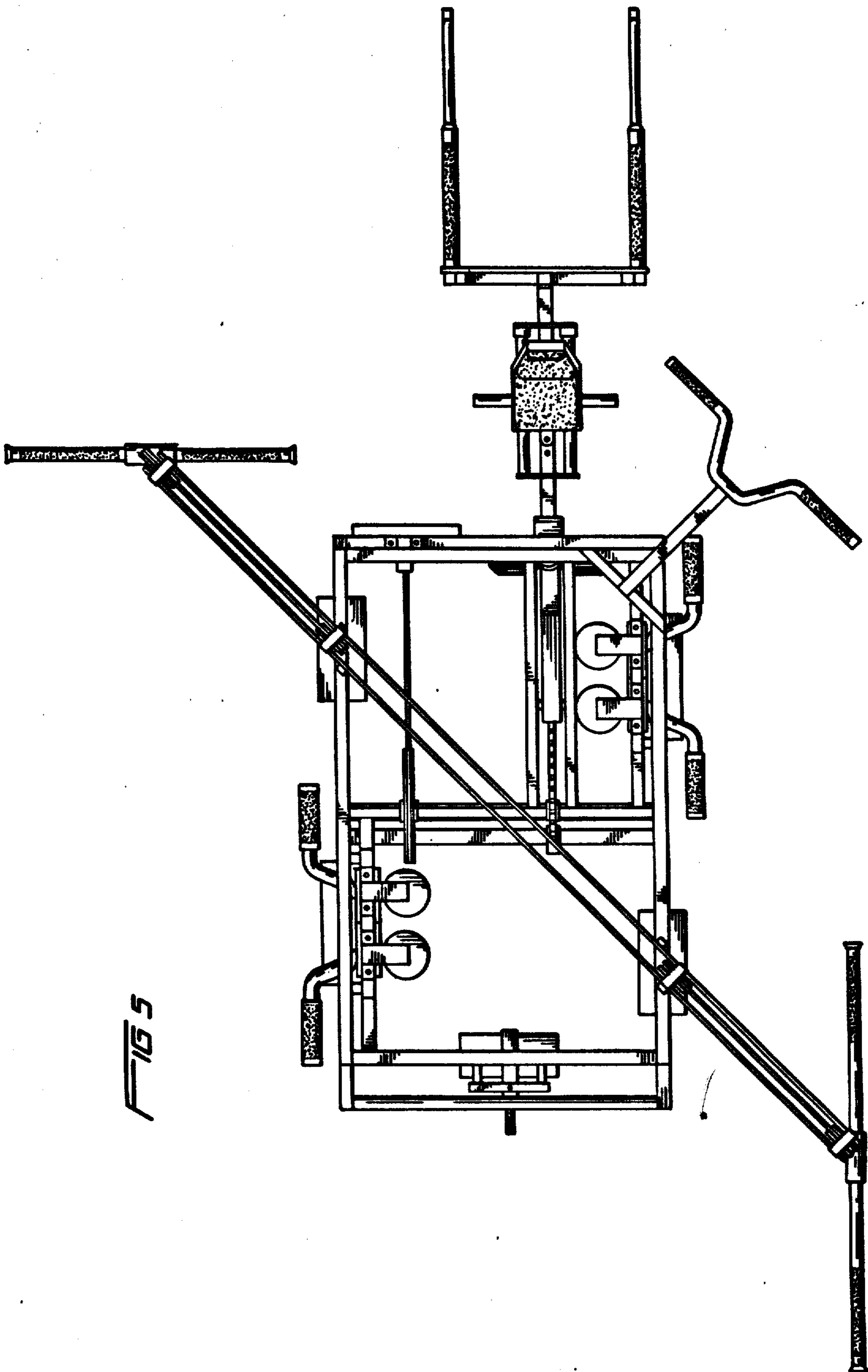
