DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a playground swing, showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof taken from the right side as viewed in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.


FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof taken from the left side as viewed in FIG. 1.
