FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a rider seat for playground apparatus showing my new design.

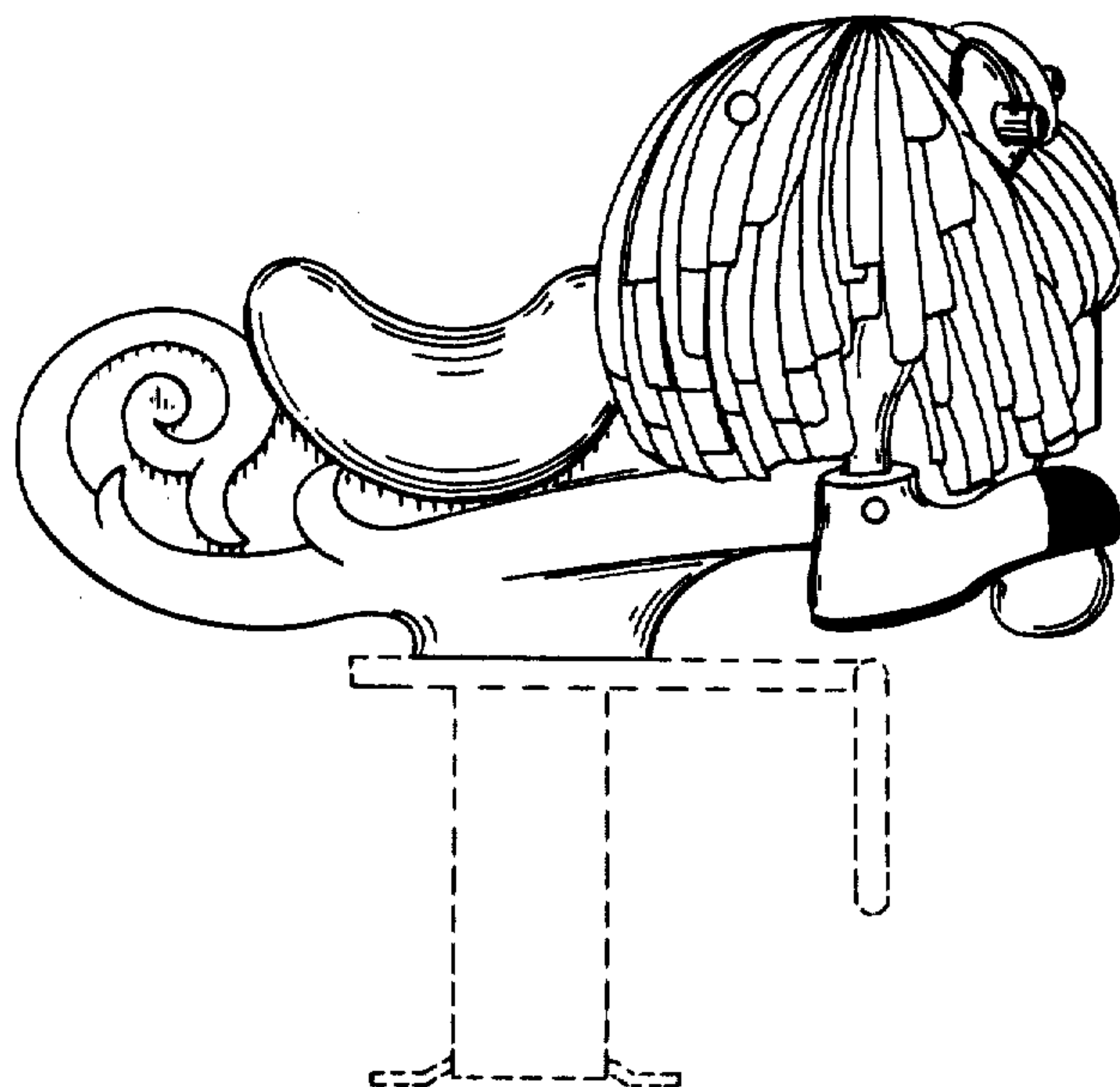
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

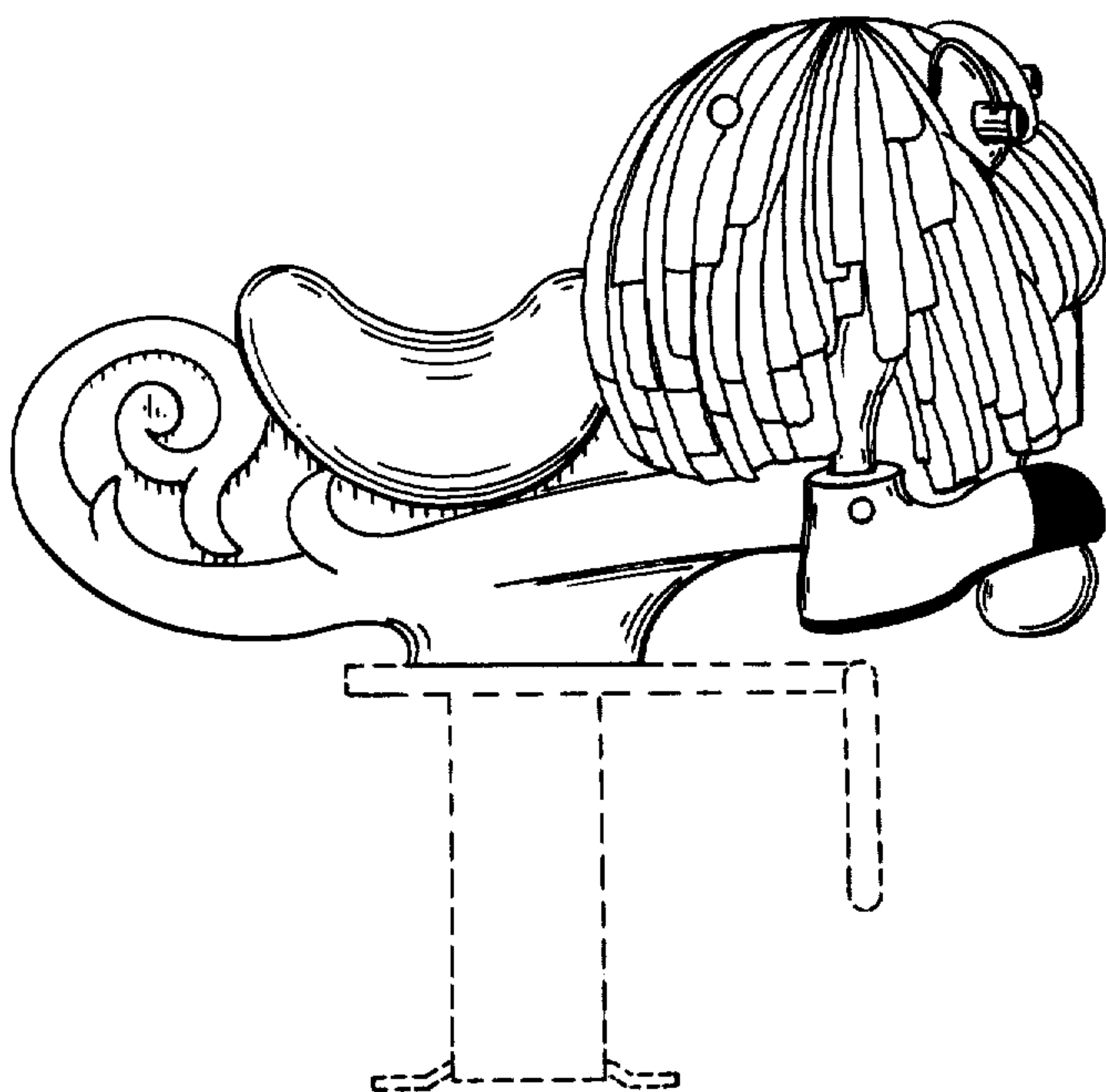
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

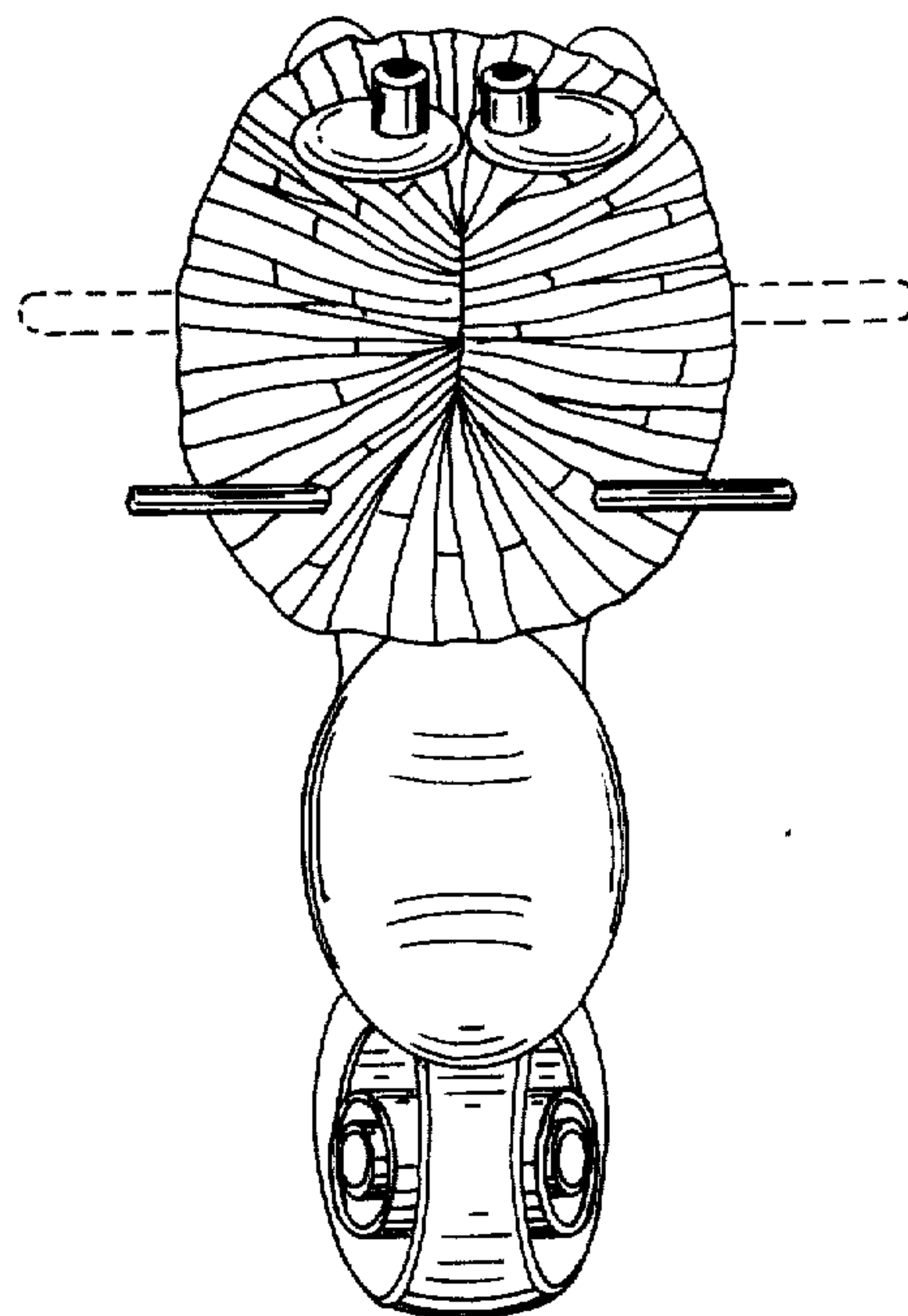
The side opposite that shown in FIG. 1 is a mirror image thereof.

The broken lines indicating a spring base and foot rest are for illustrative purposes only.

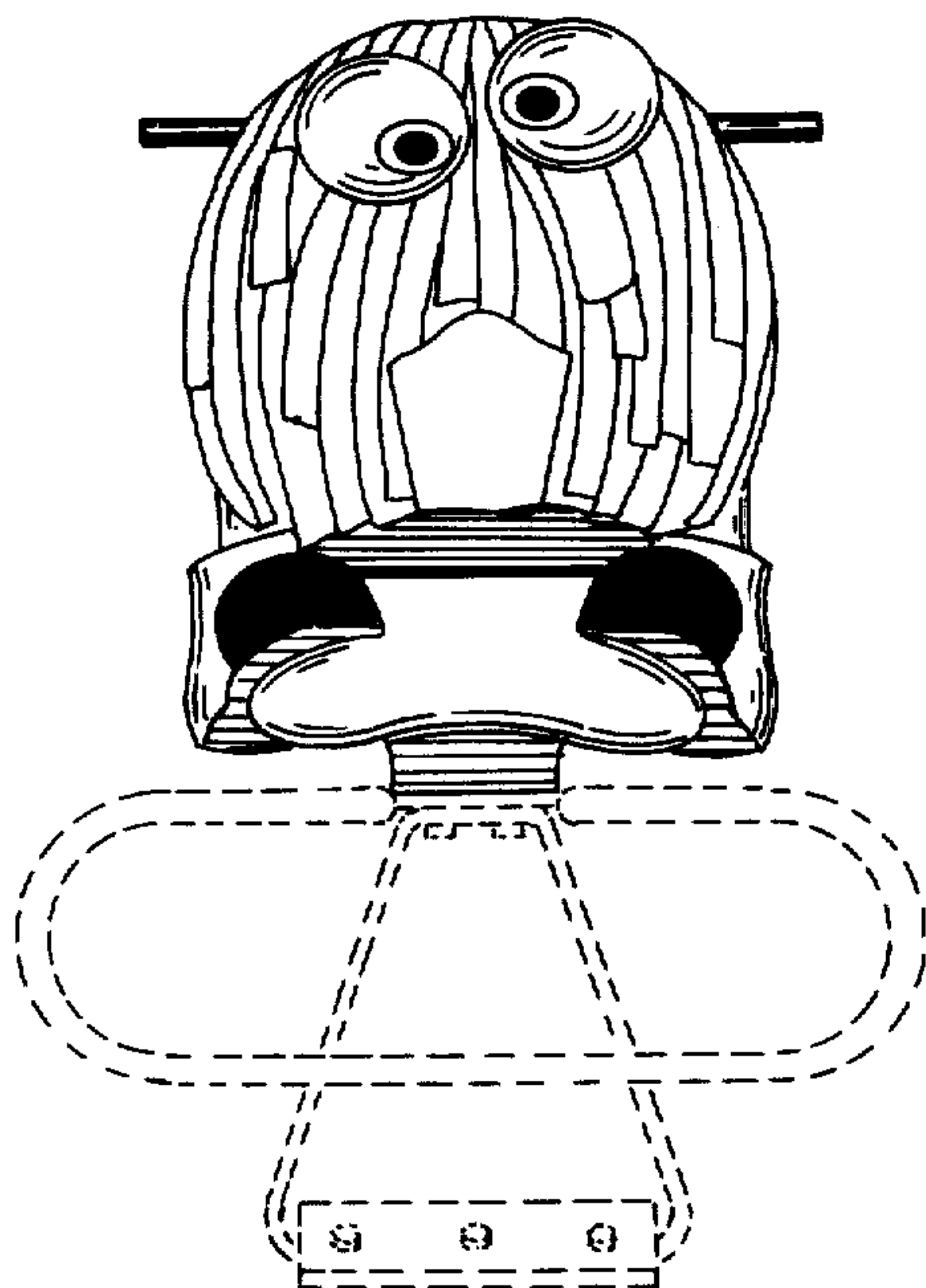




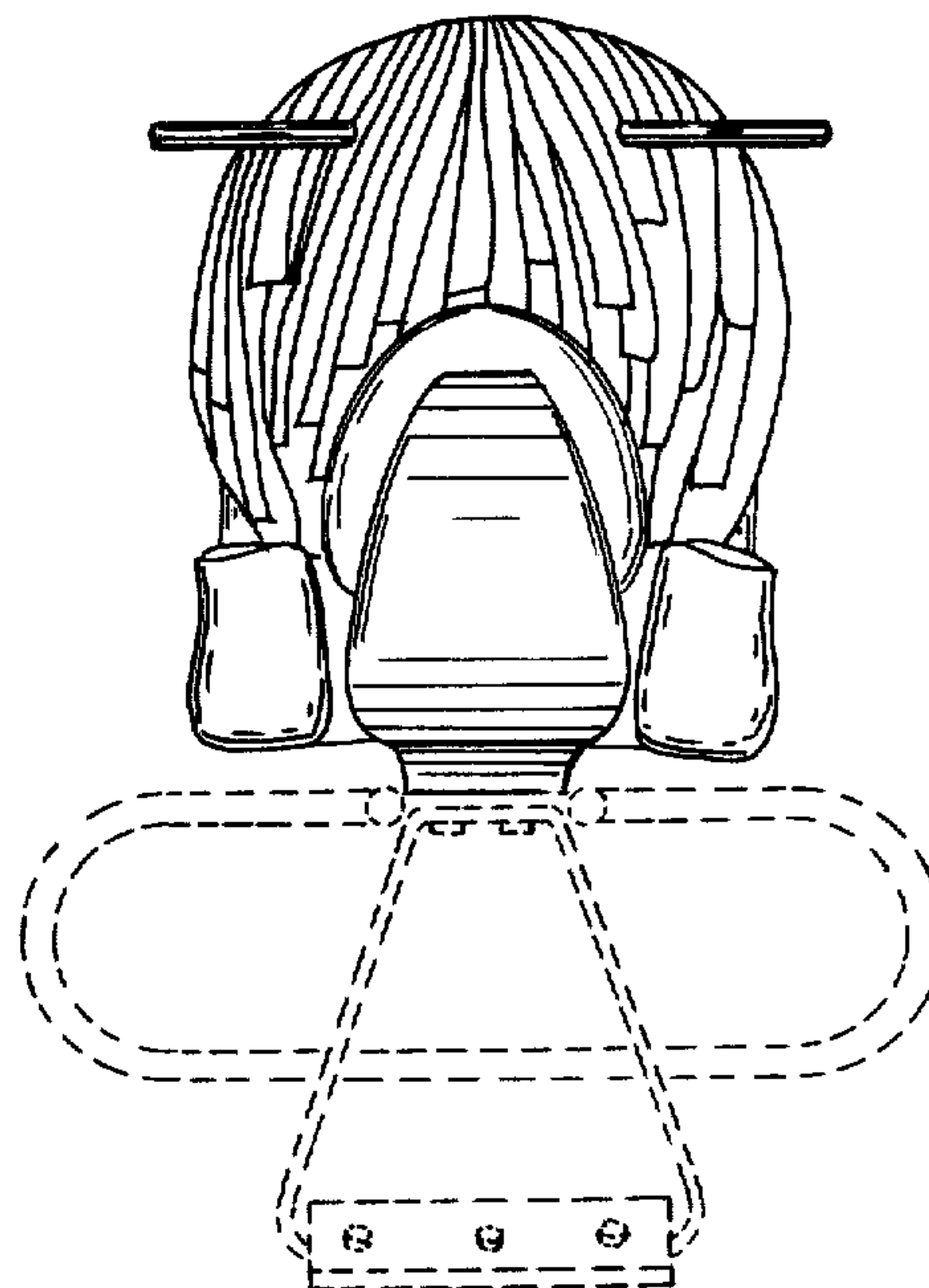
