[57] The ornamental design for a hair dryer, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a hair dryer showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

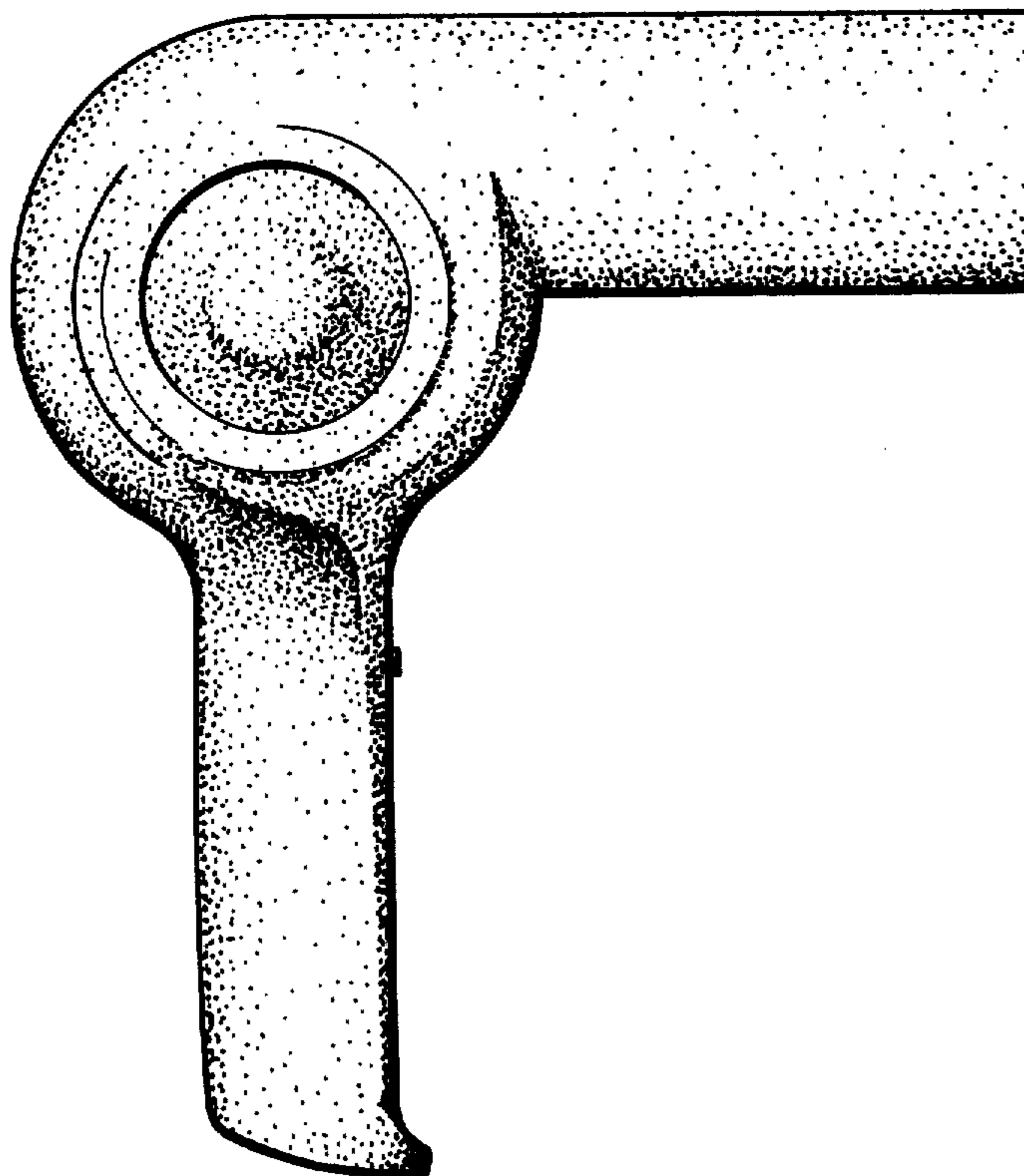

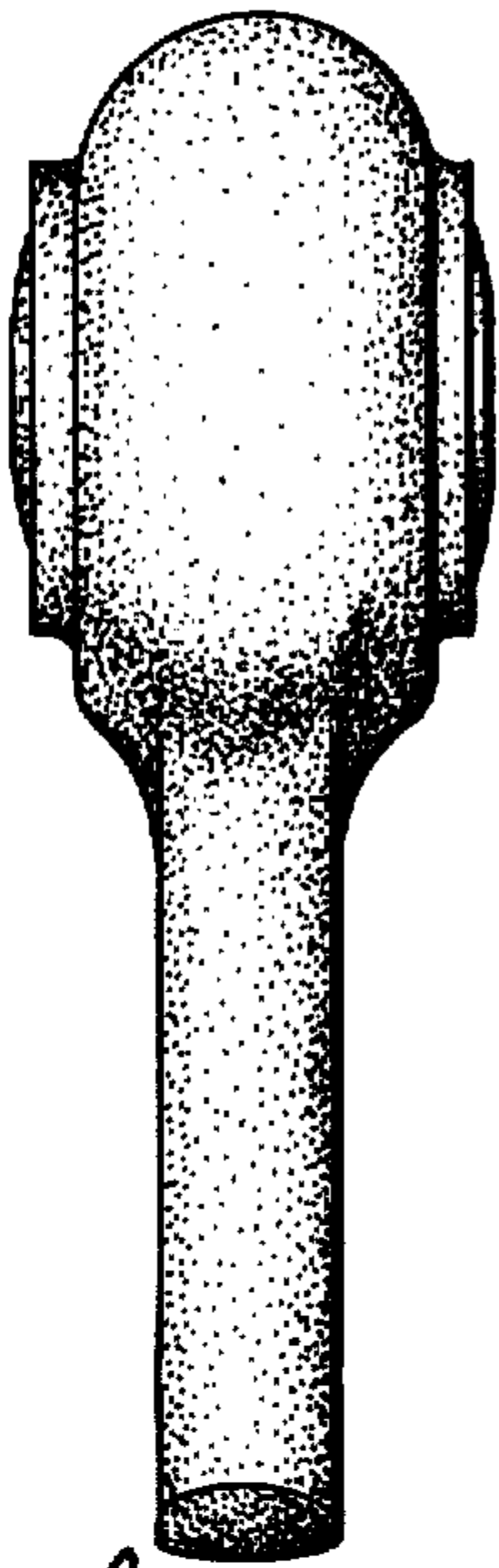
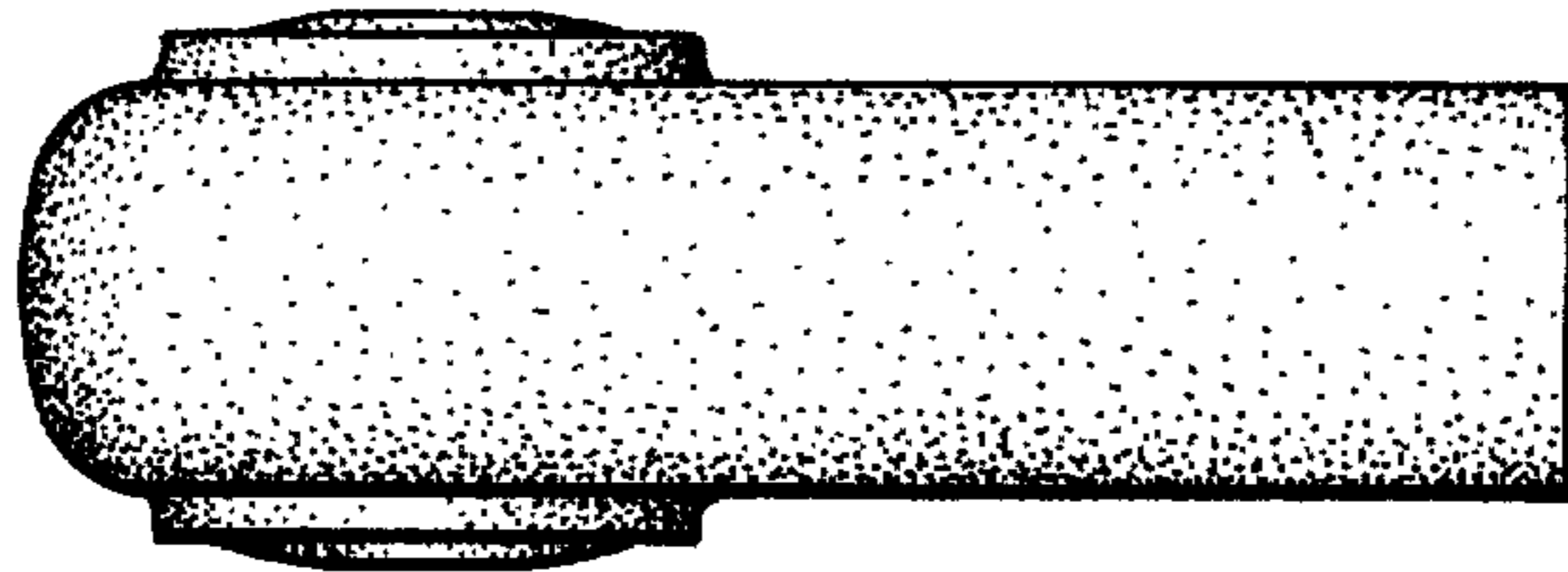

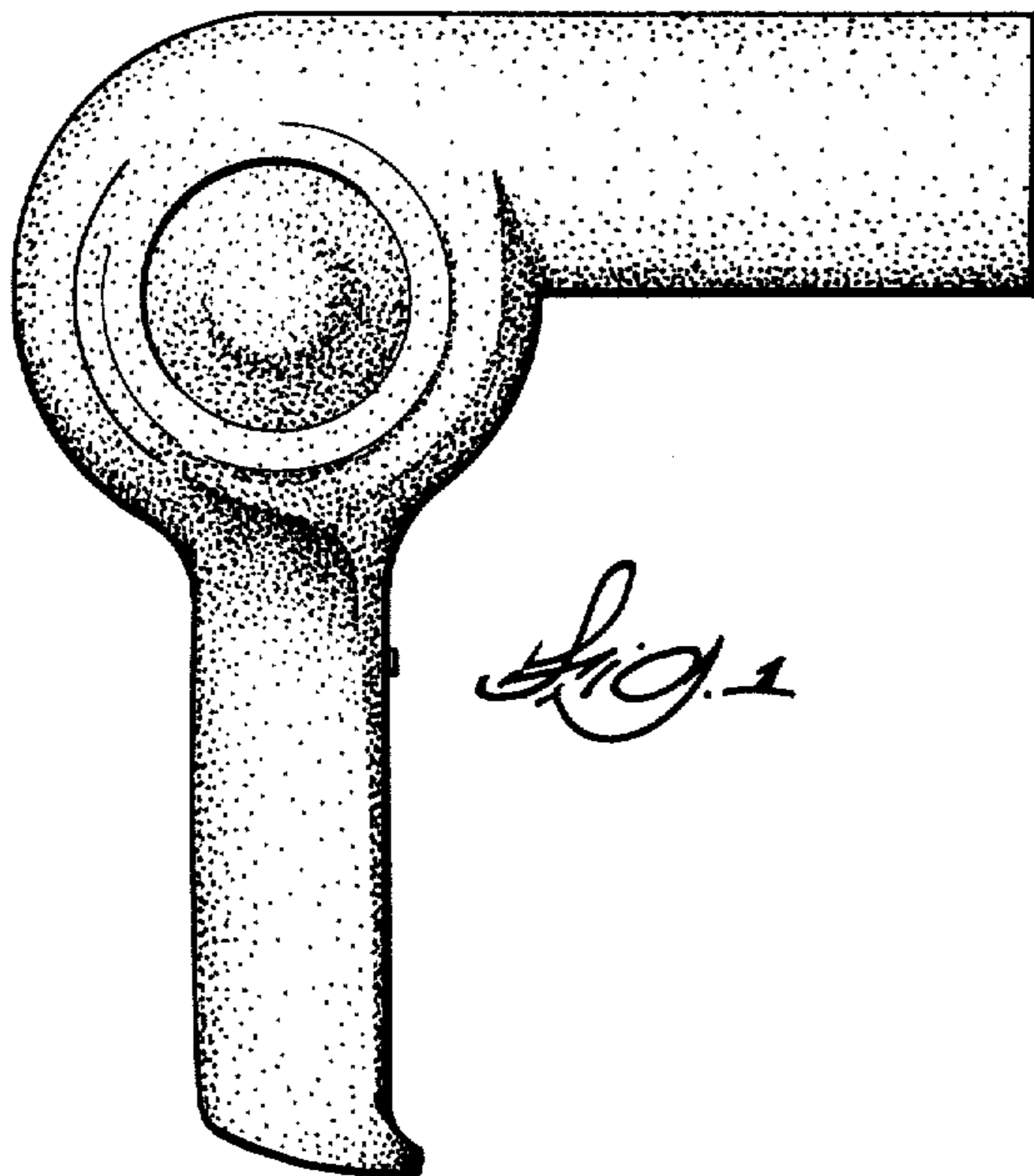

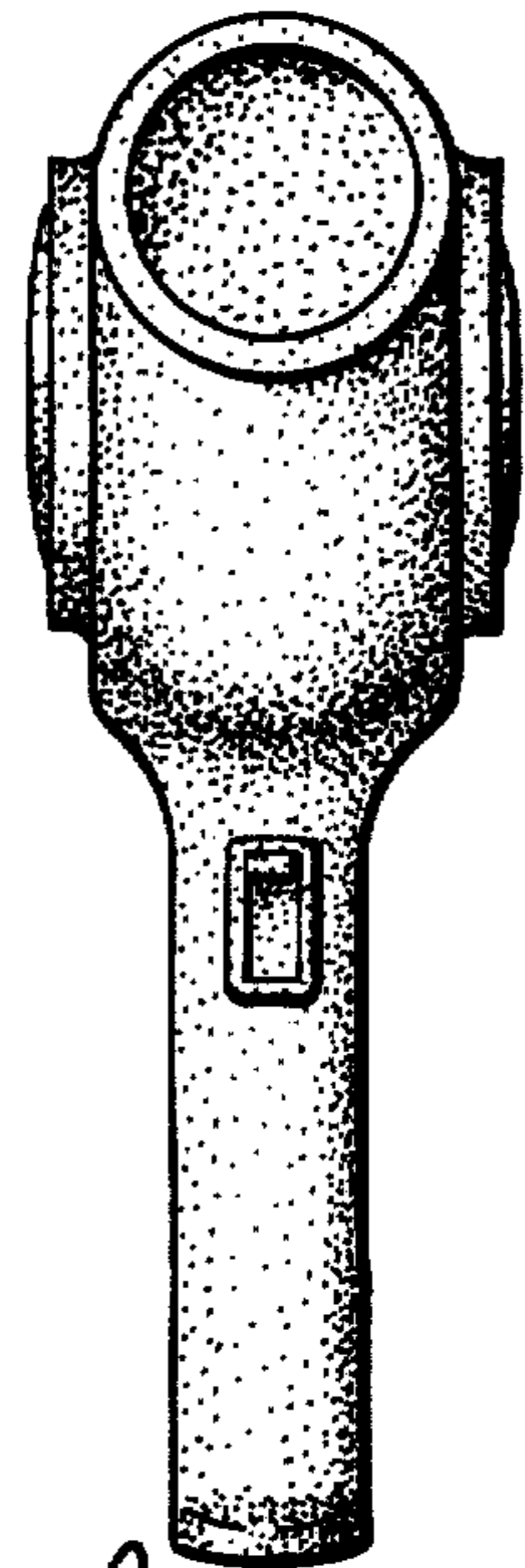

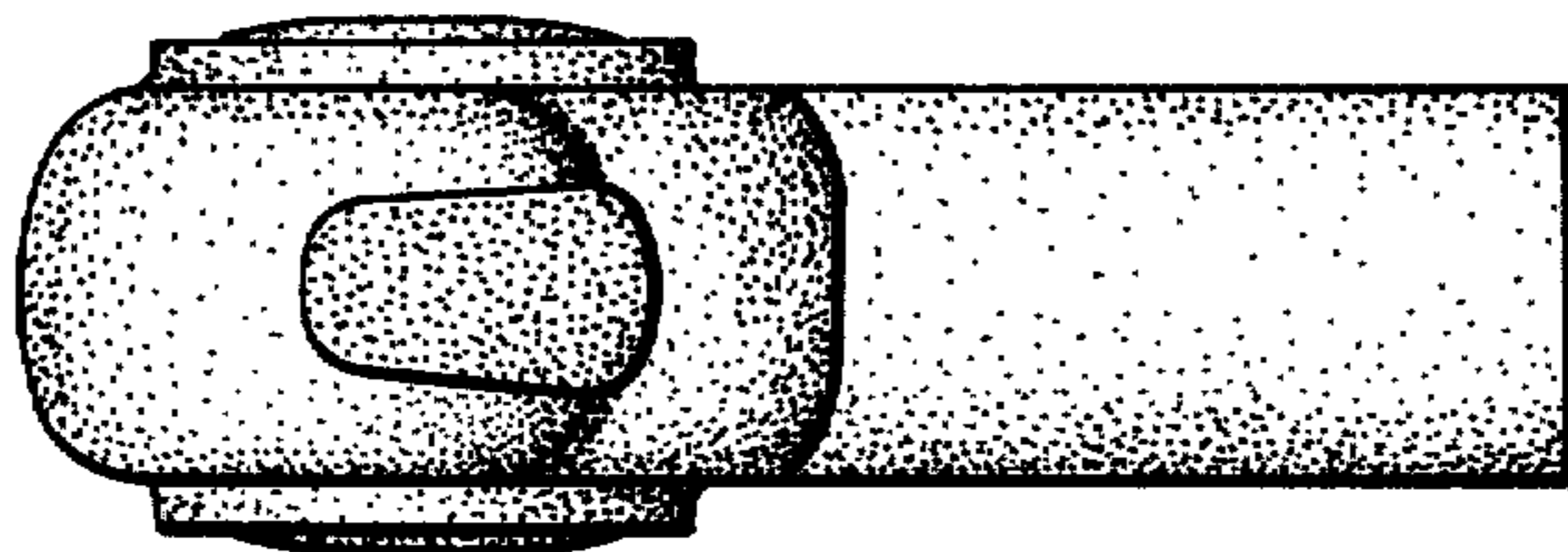
