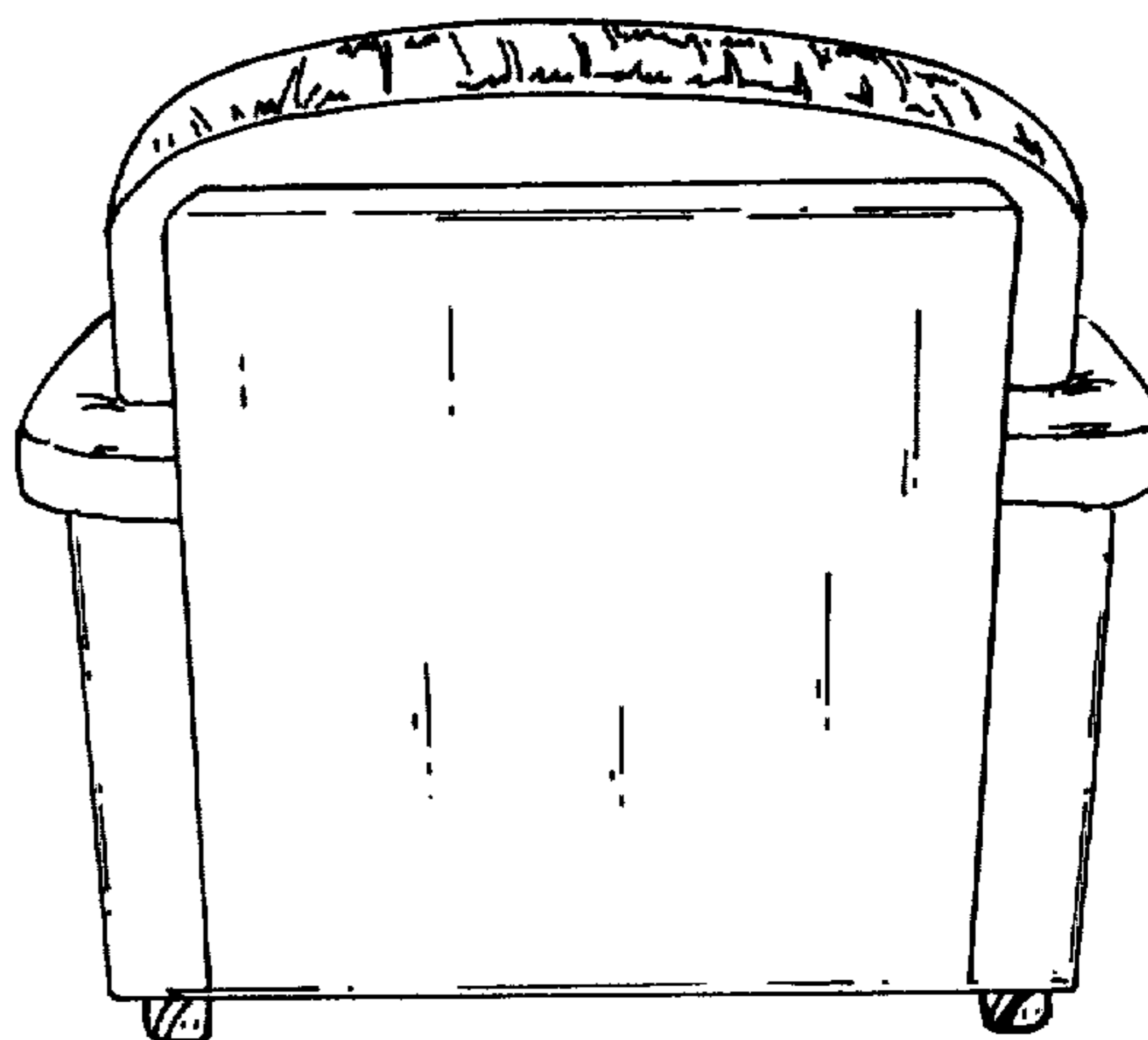
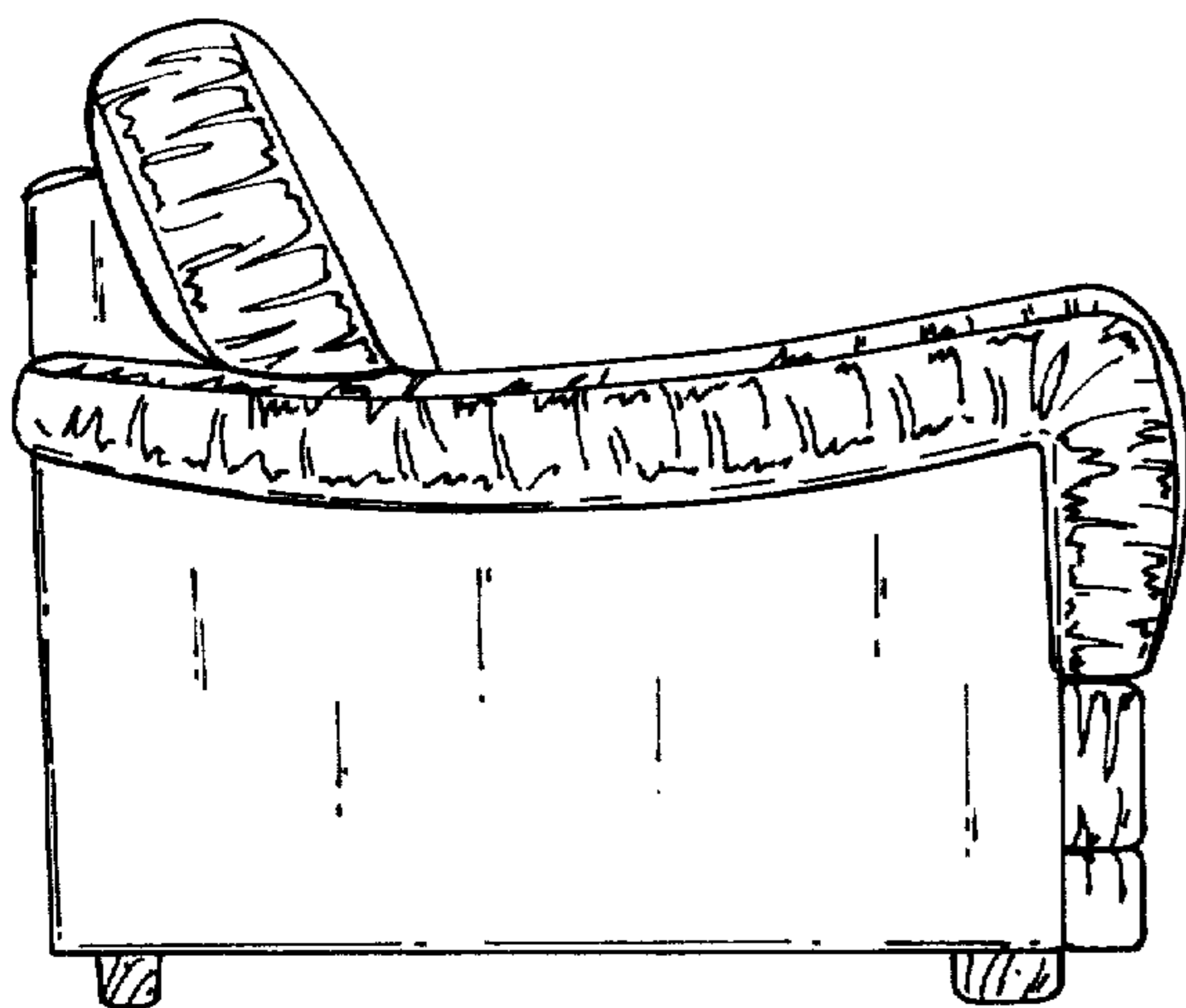

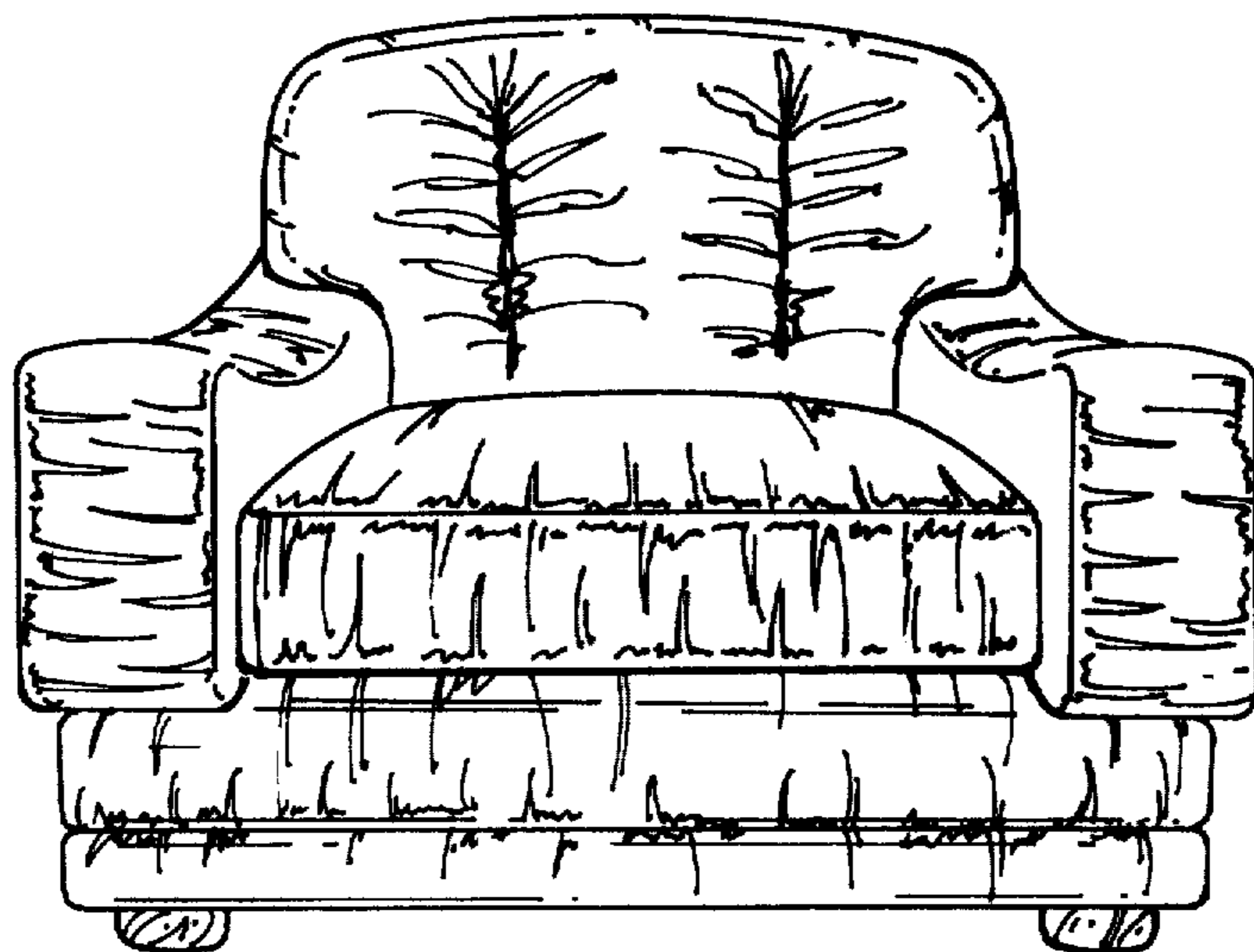
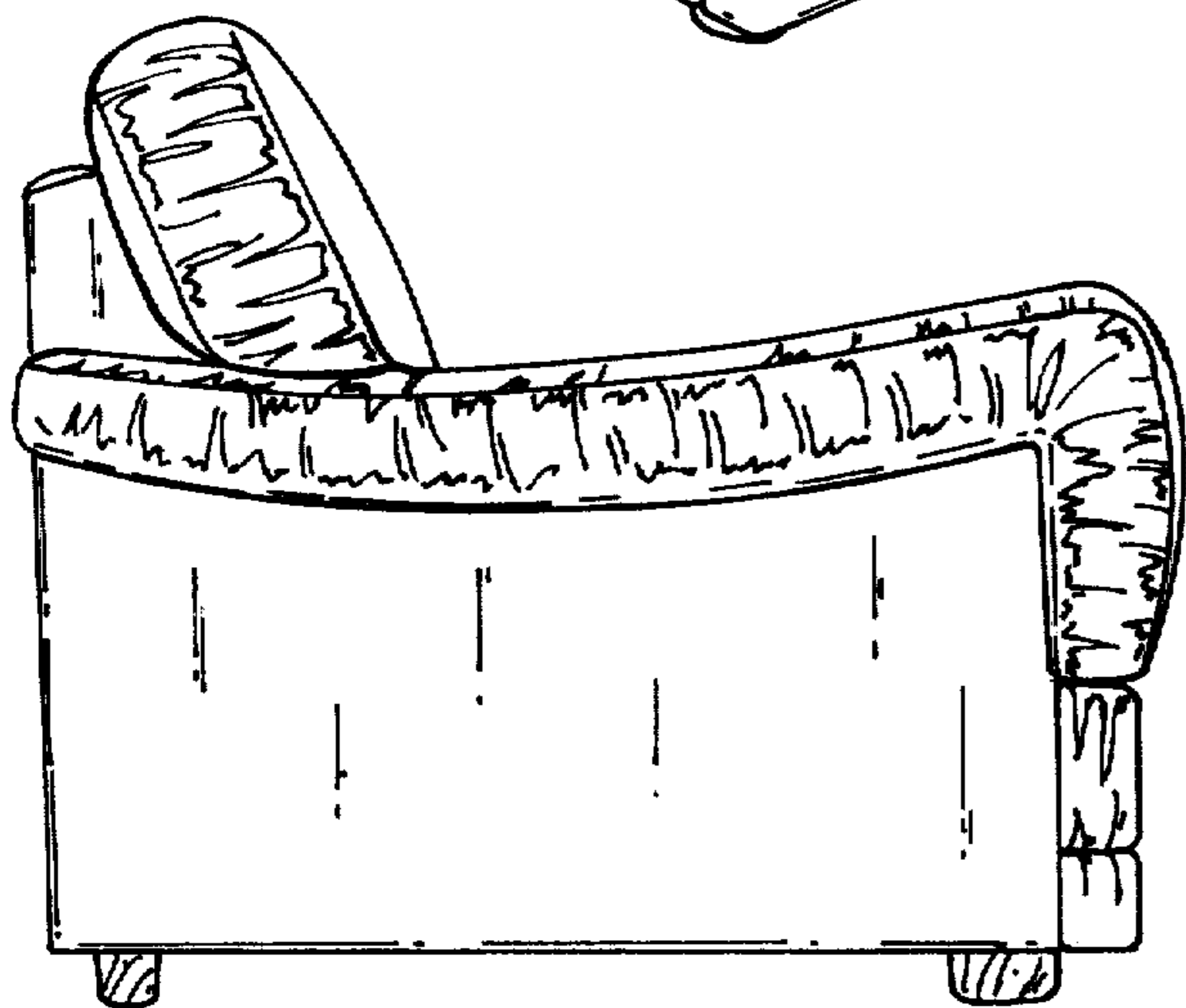
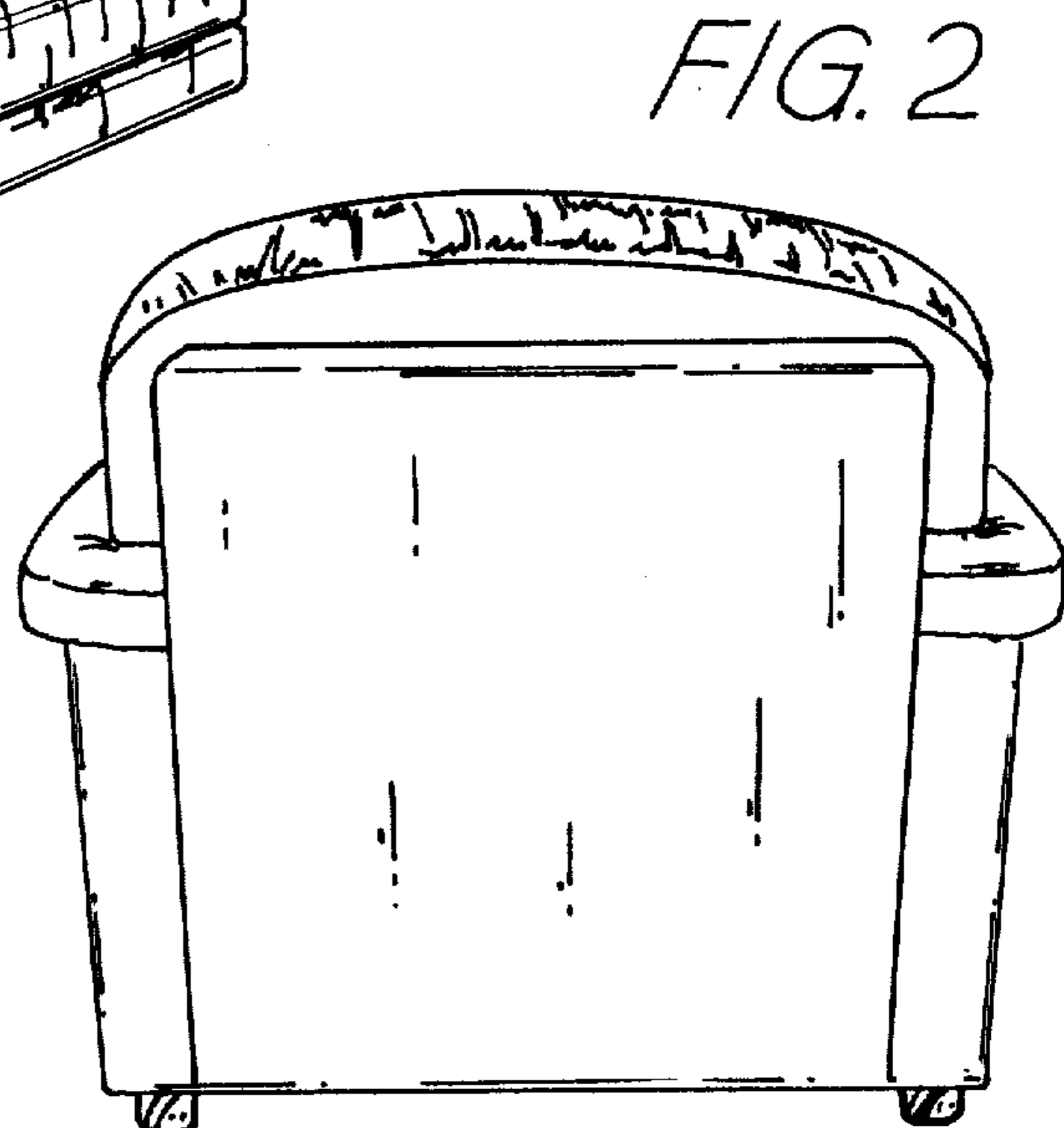
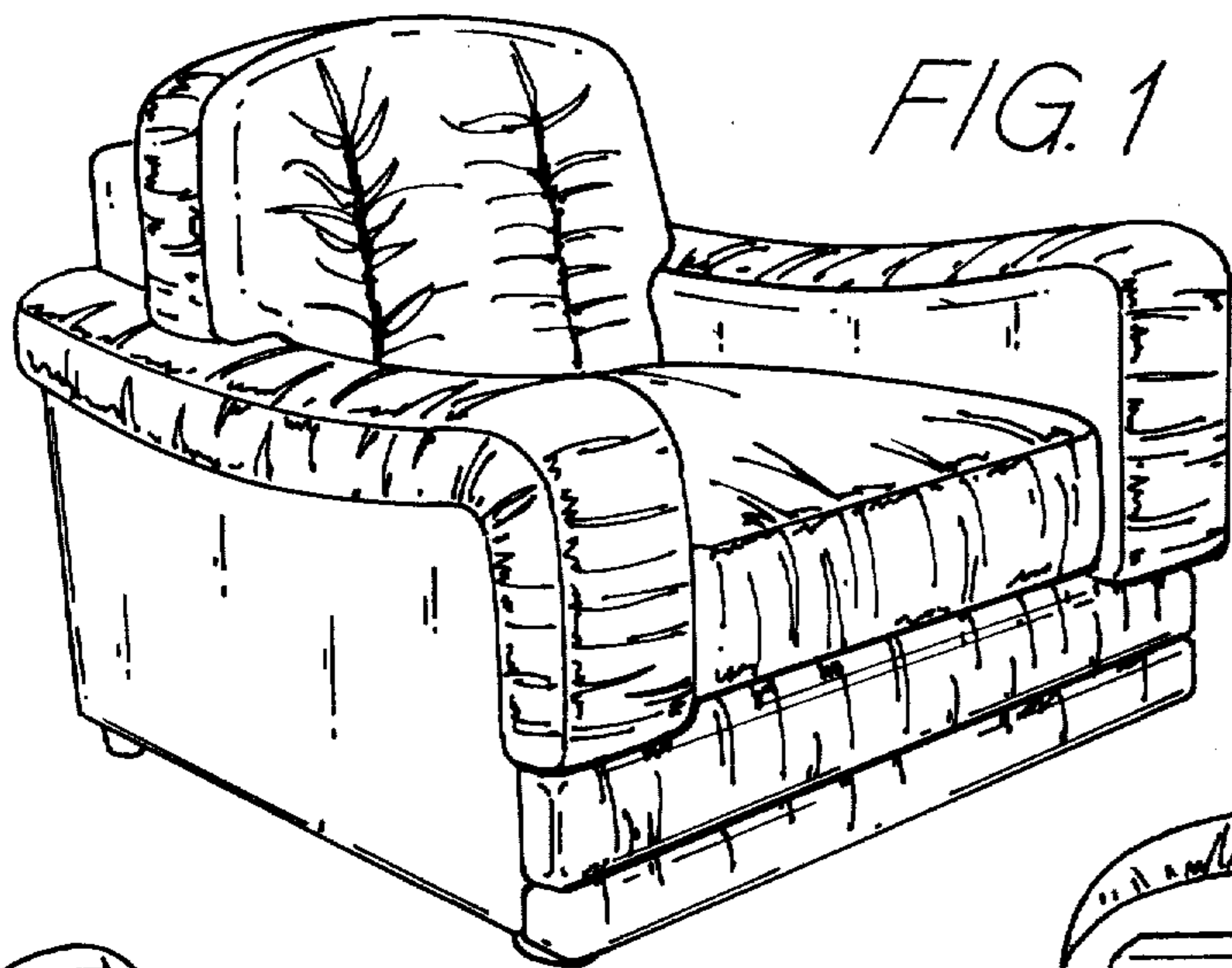
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a seat, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a three-quarter, front perspective view of a seat showing my new design in the form of a lounge chair;
 FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the lounge chair;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the lounge chair;
 FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the lounge chair;
 FIG. 5 is a three-quarter, front perspective view of a seat showing my new design in the form of a sofa;
 FIG. 6 is a three-quarter, front perspective view of a seat showing my new design in the form of a love seat.
 The sides of the seat not shown are mirror images of the sides shown.





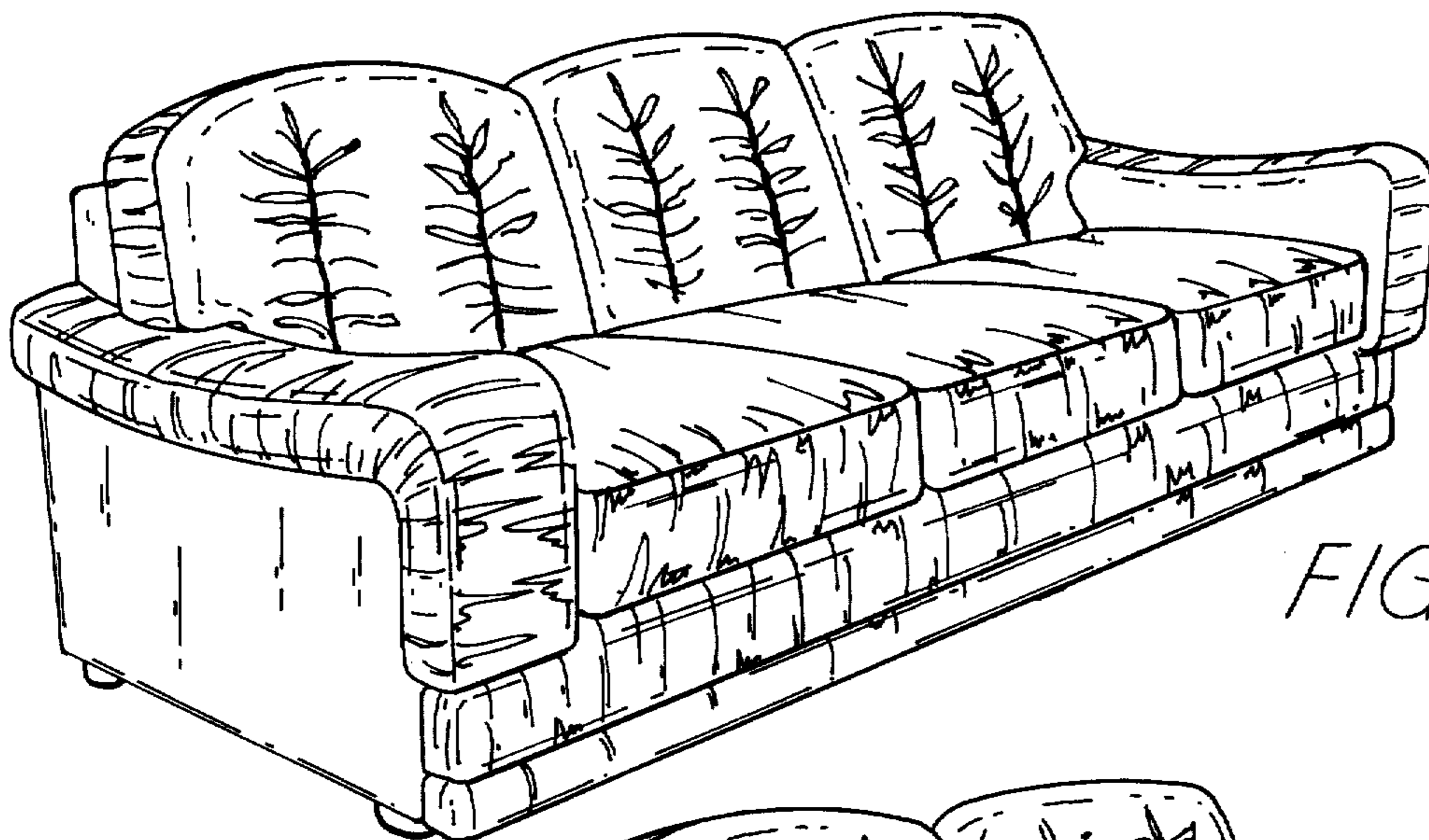

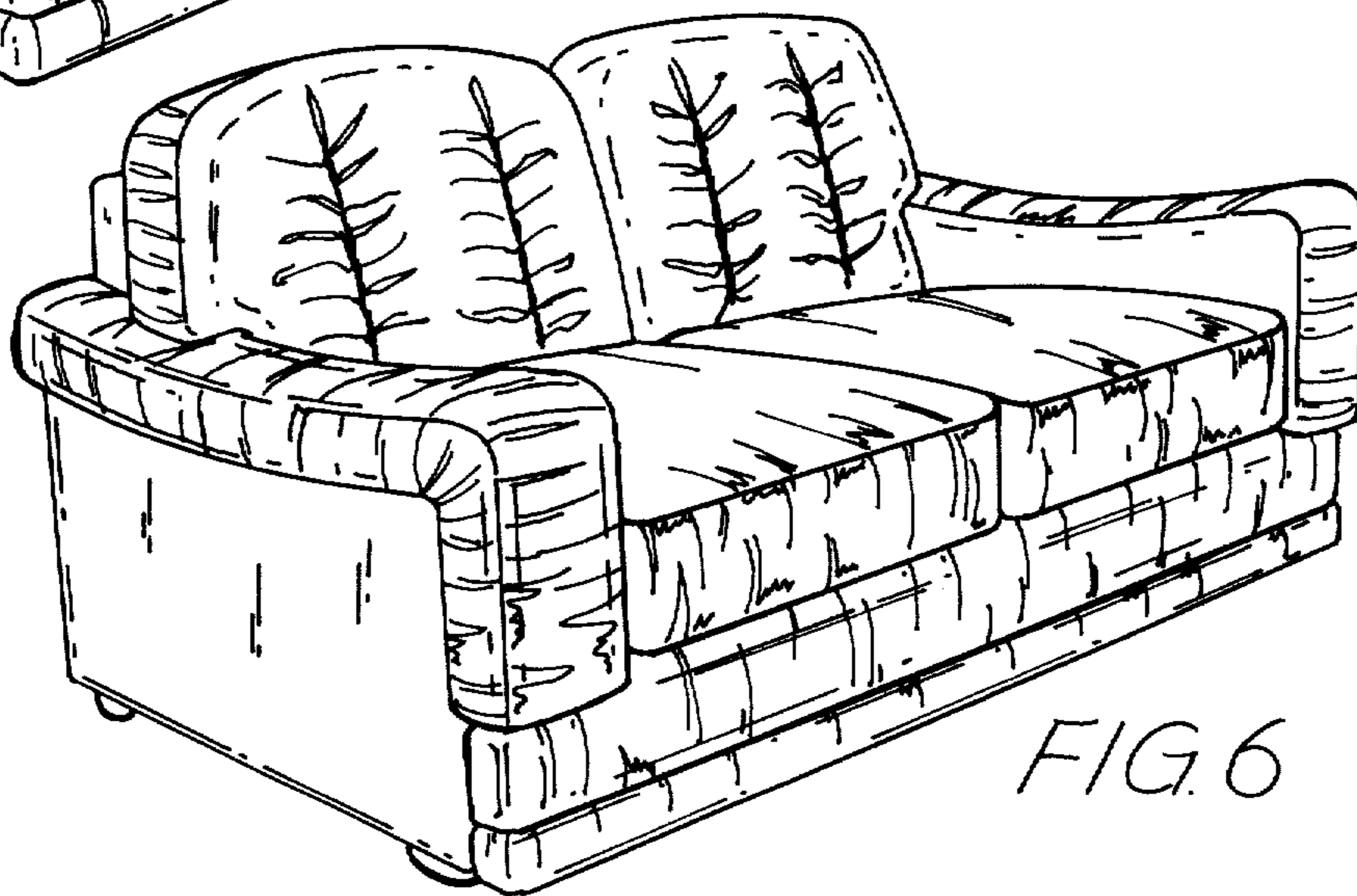
