CLAIM

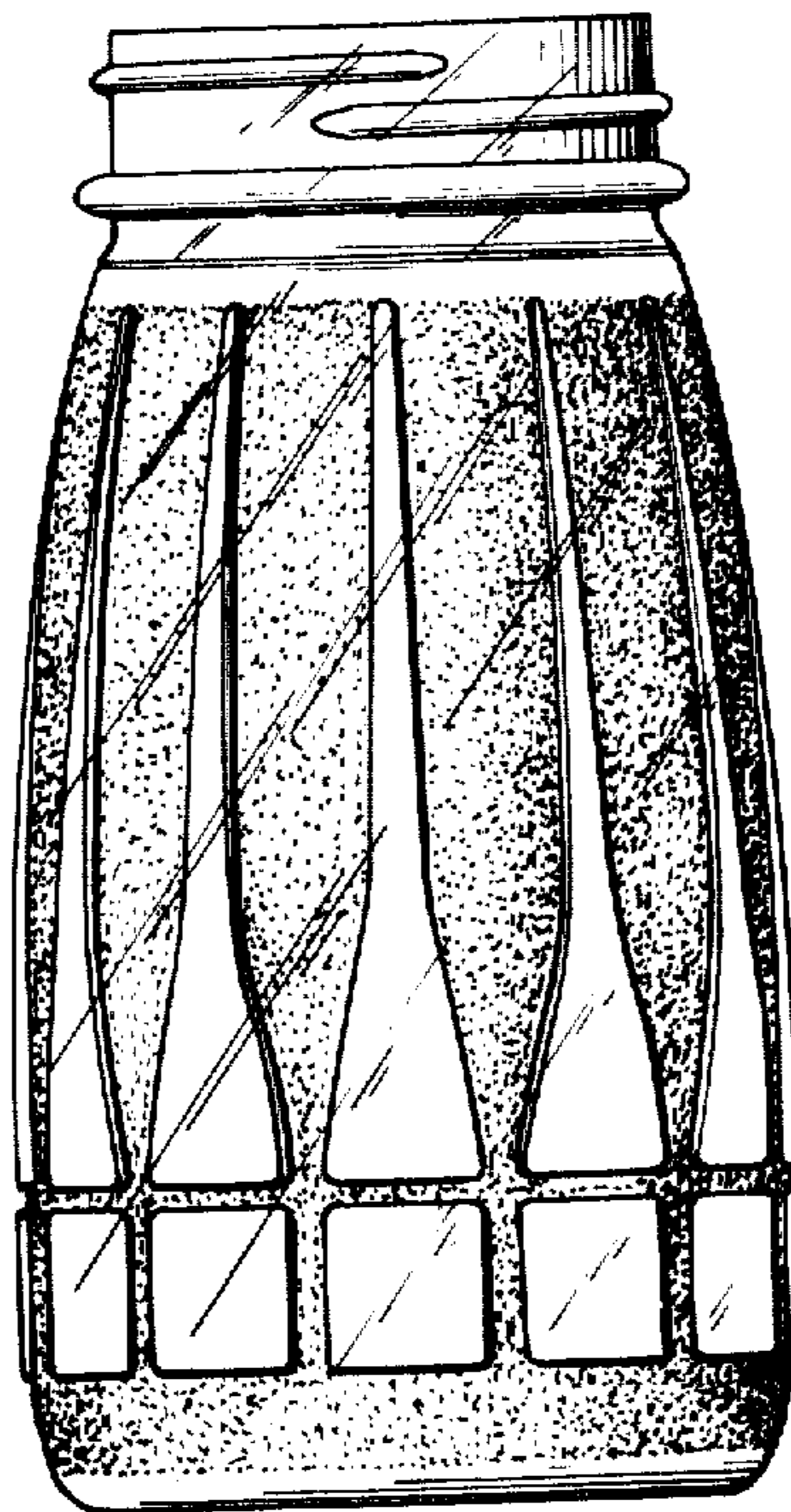
The ornamental design for a jar, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view.



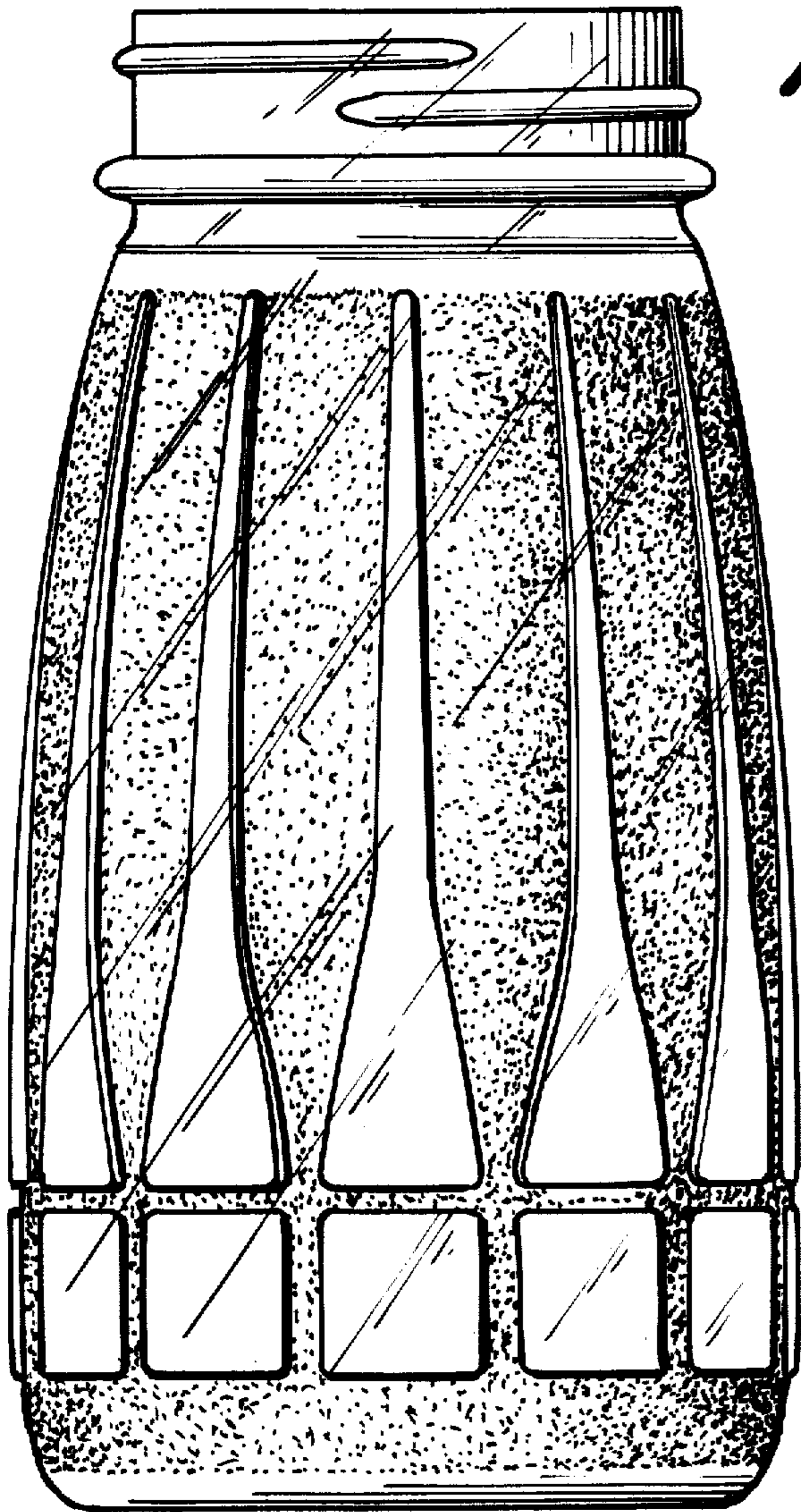

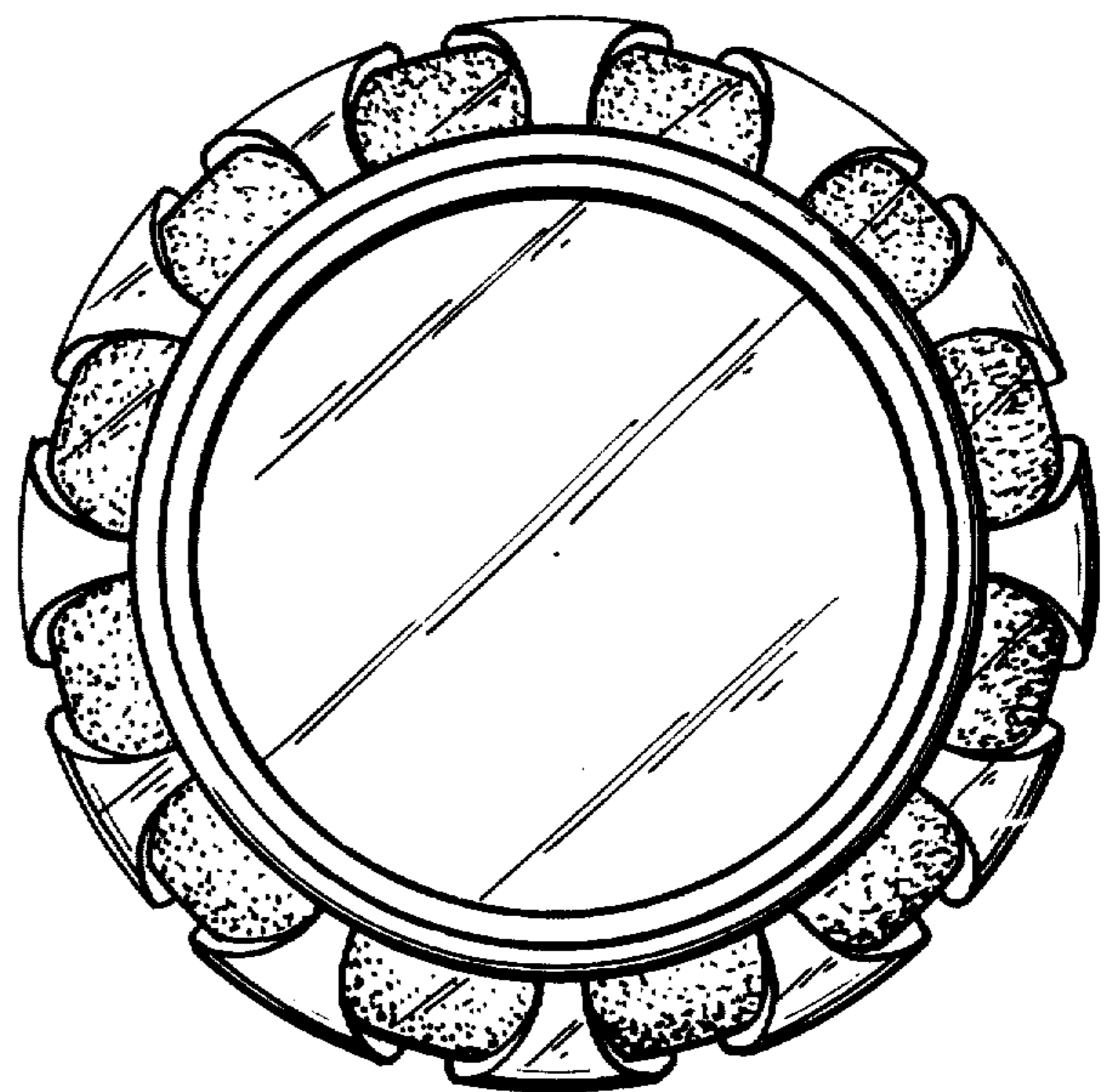

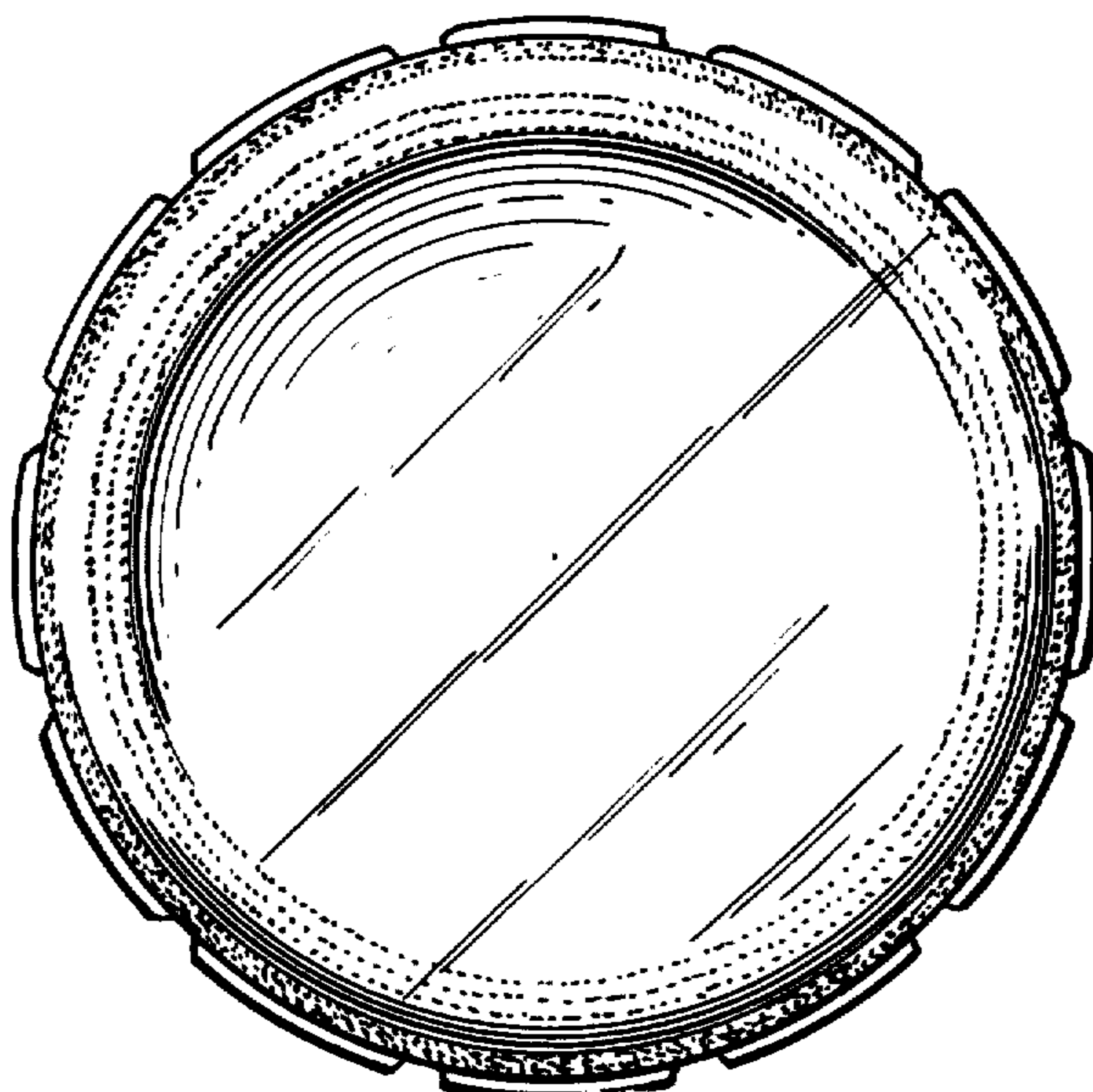
