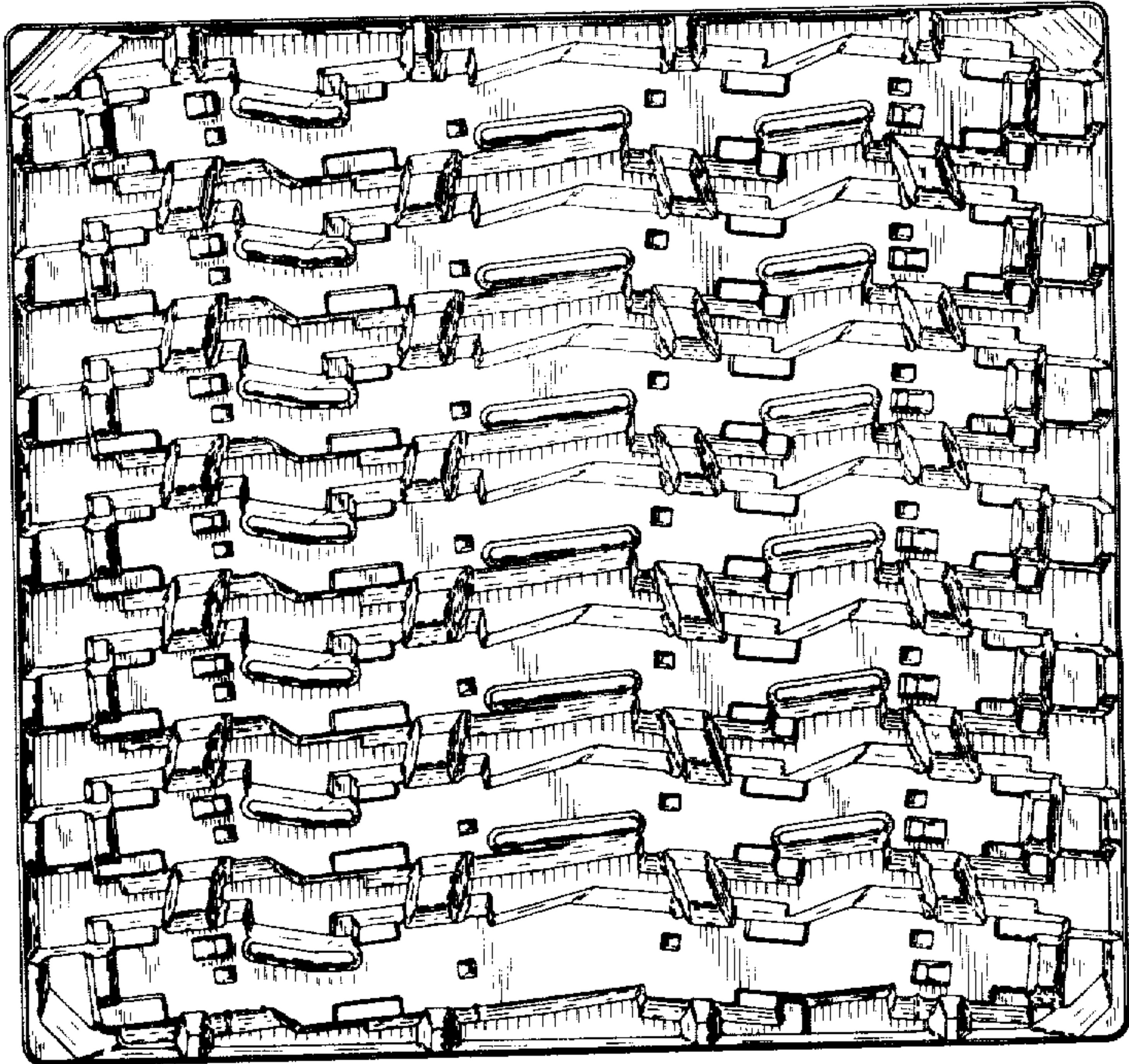

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shipping tray for dynamo-electric machines, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a shipping tray for dynamo-electric machines showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; and
FIG. 6 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1.



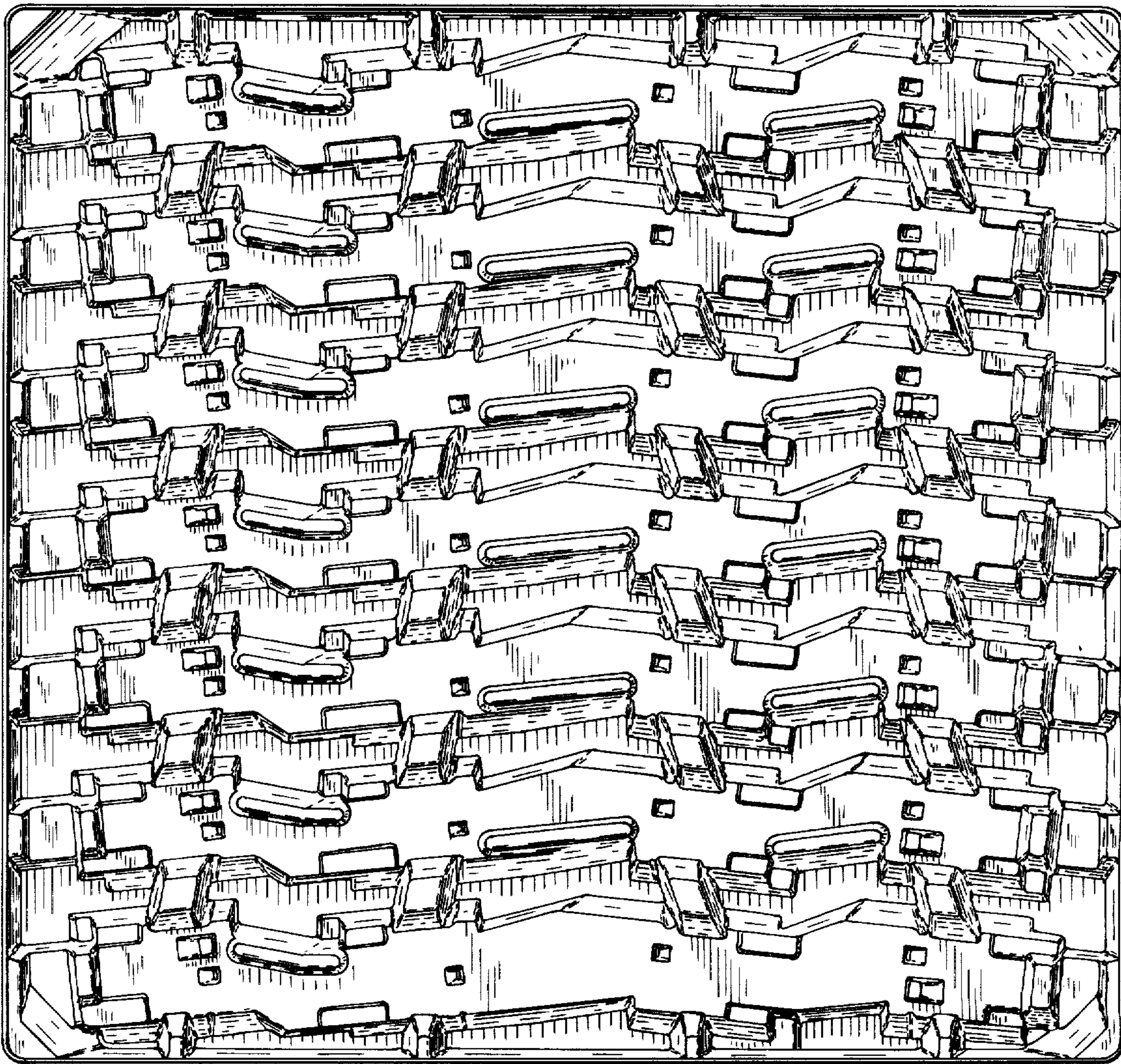

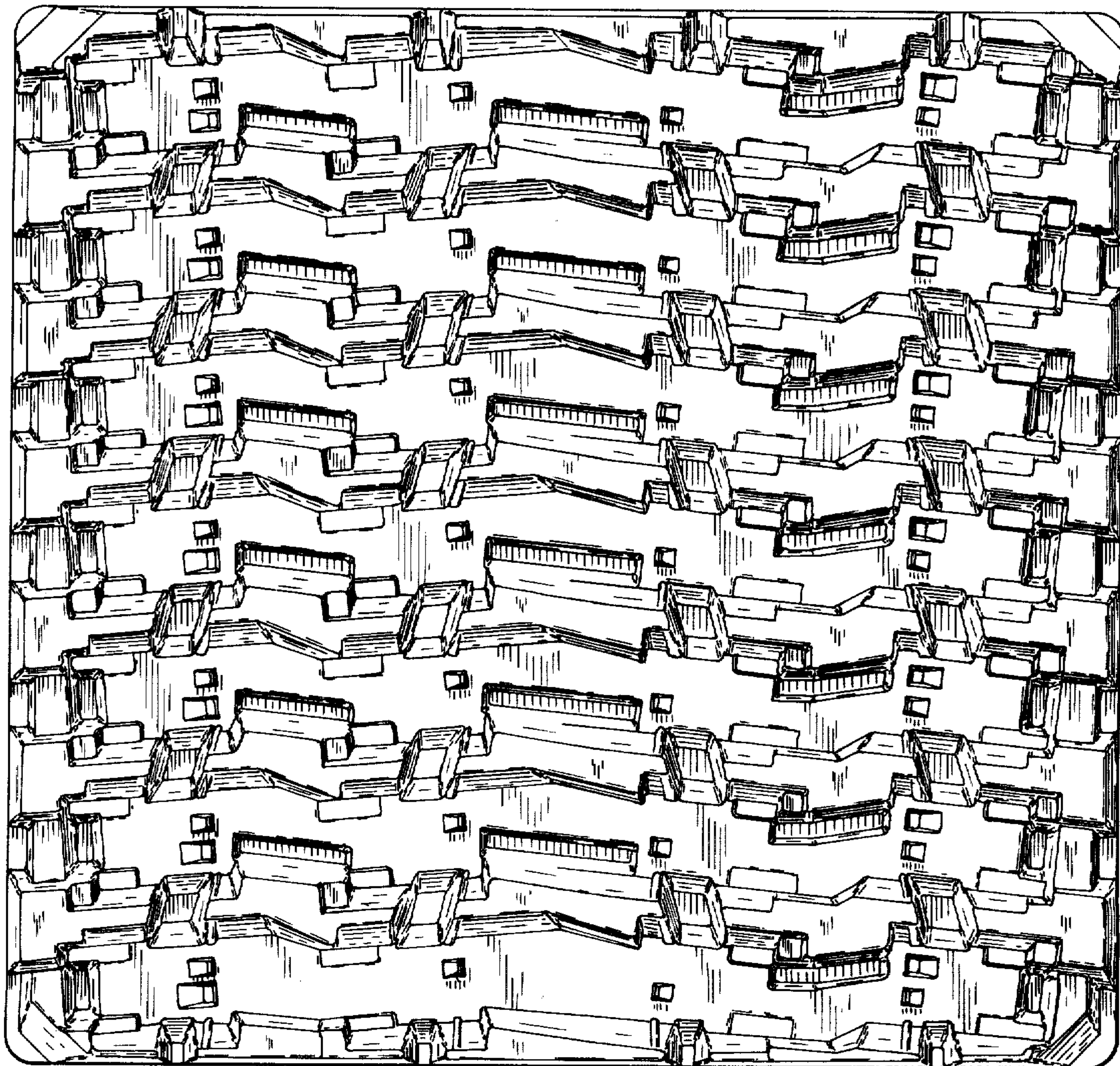

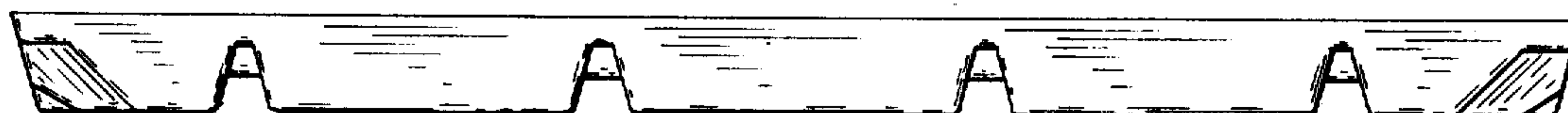
