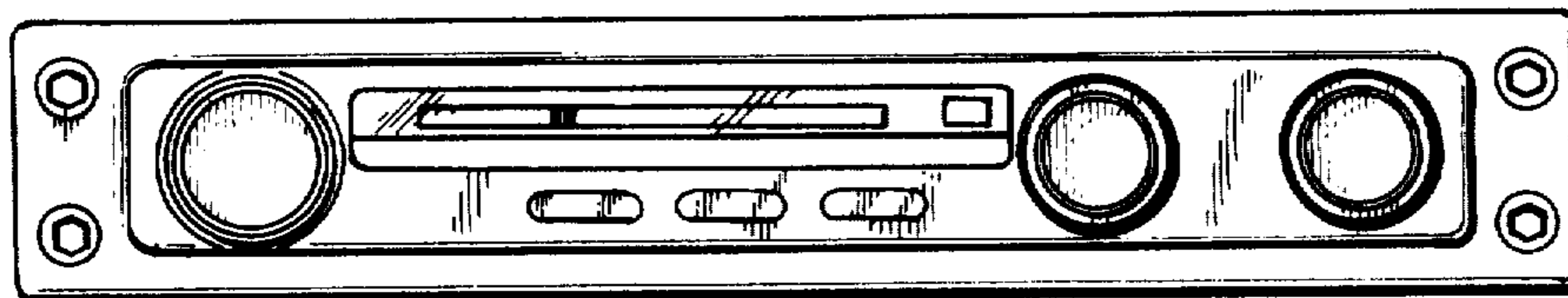

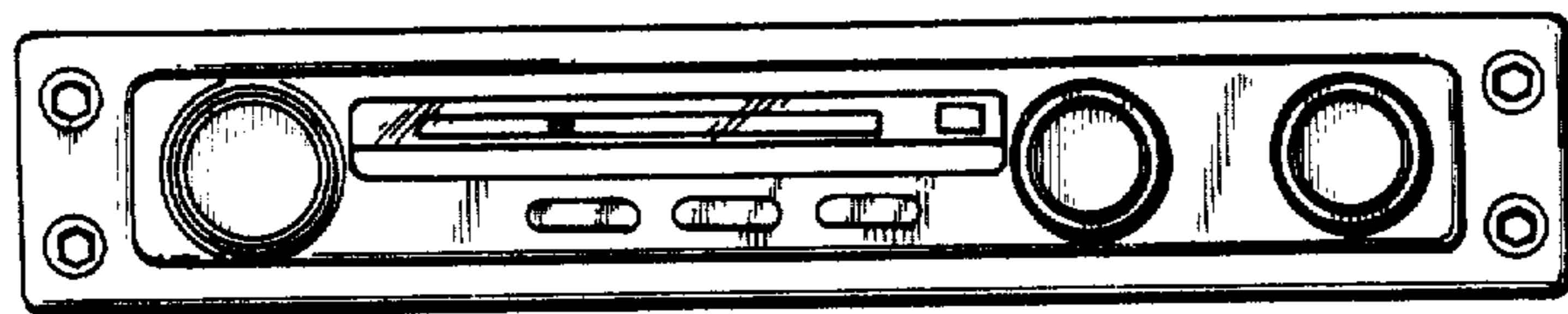
The ornamental design for a automobile radio receiver, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

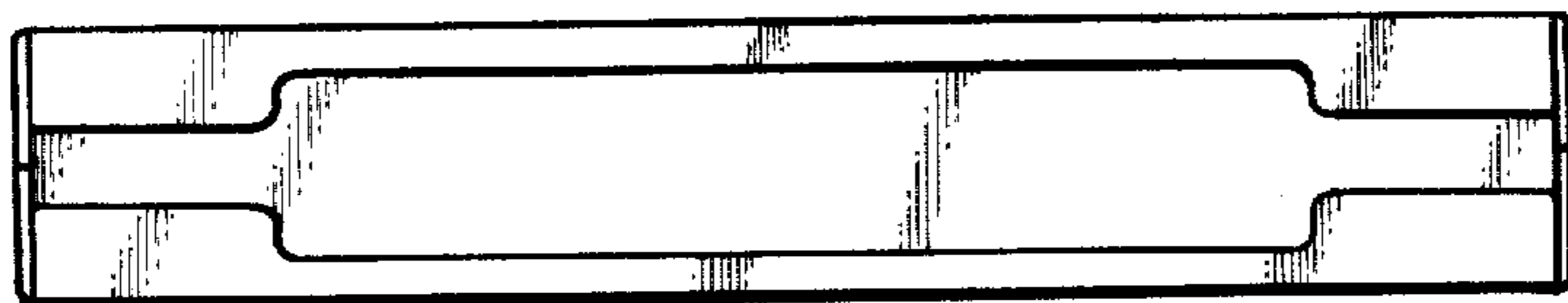

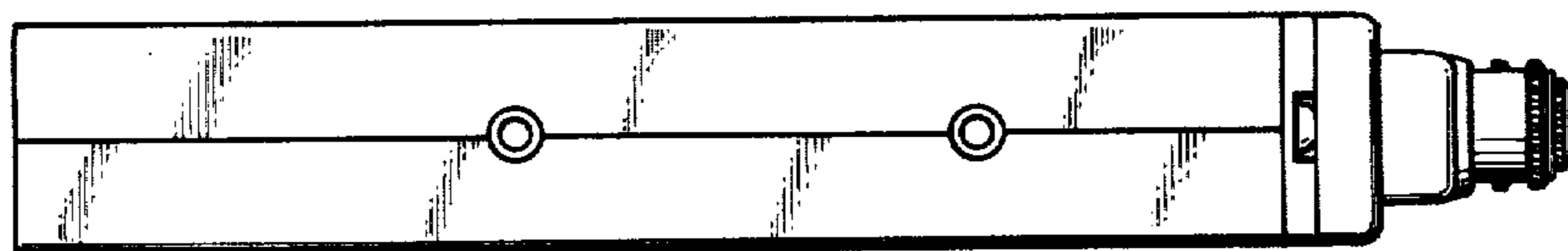

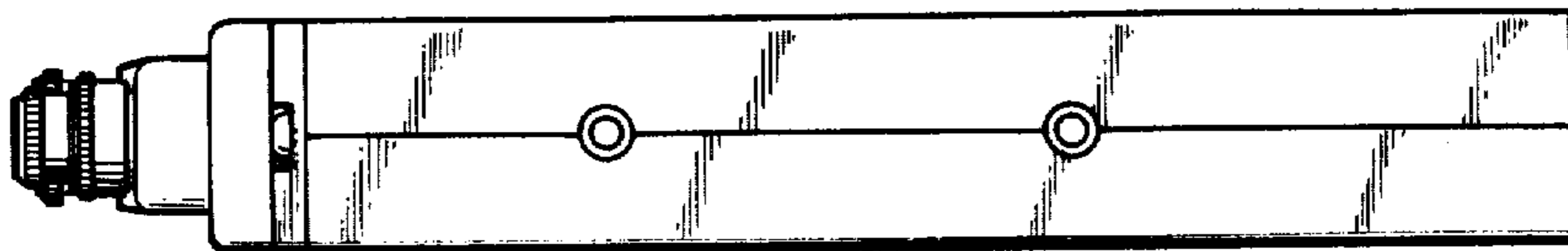
