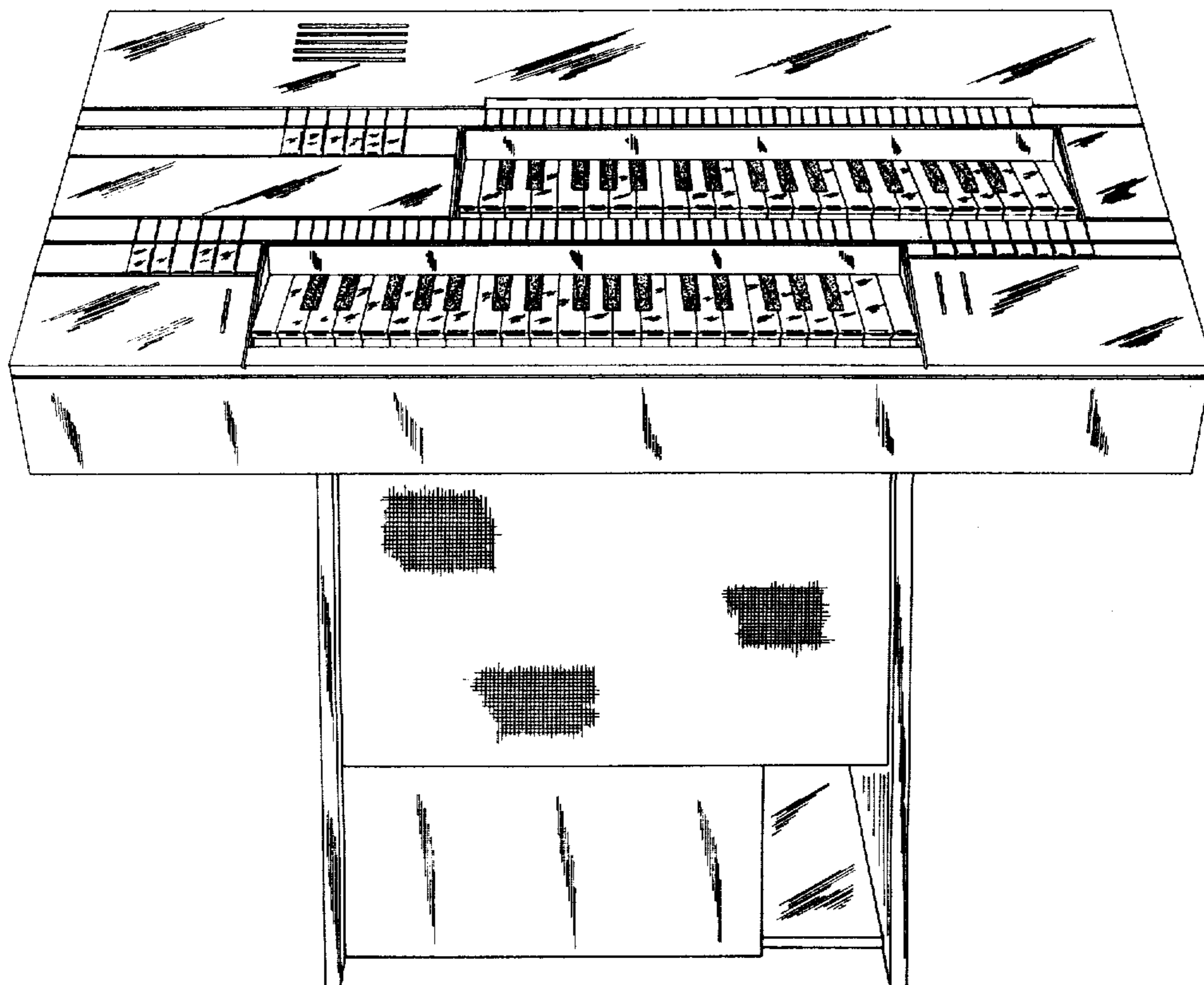

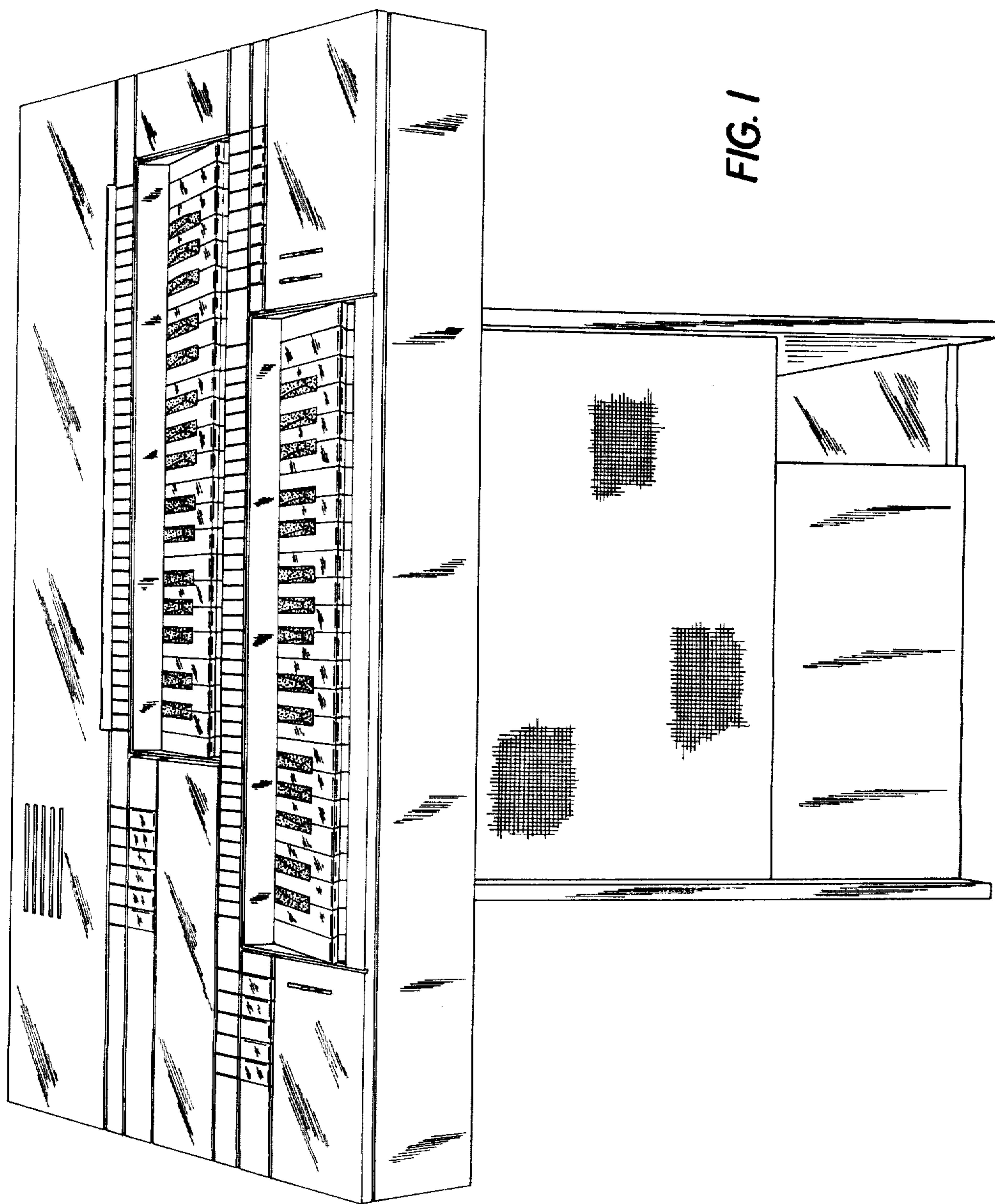
[57] CLAIM

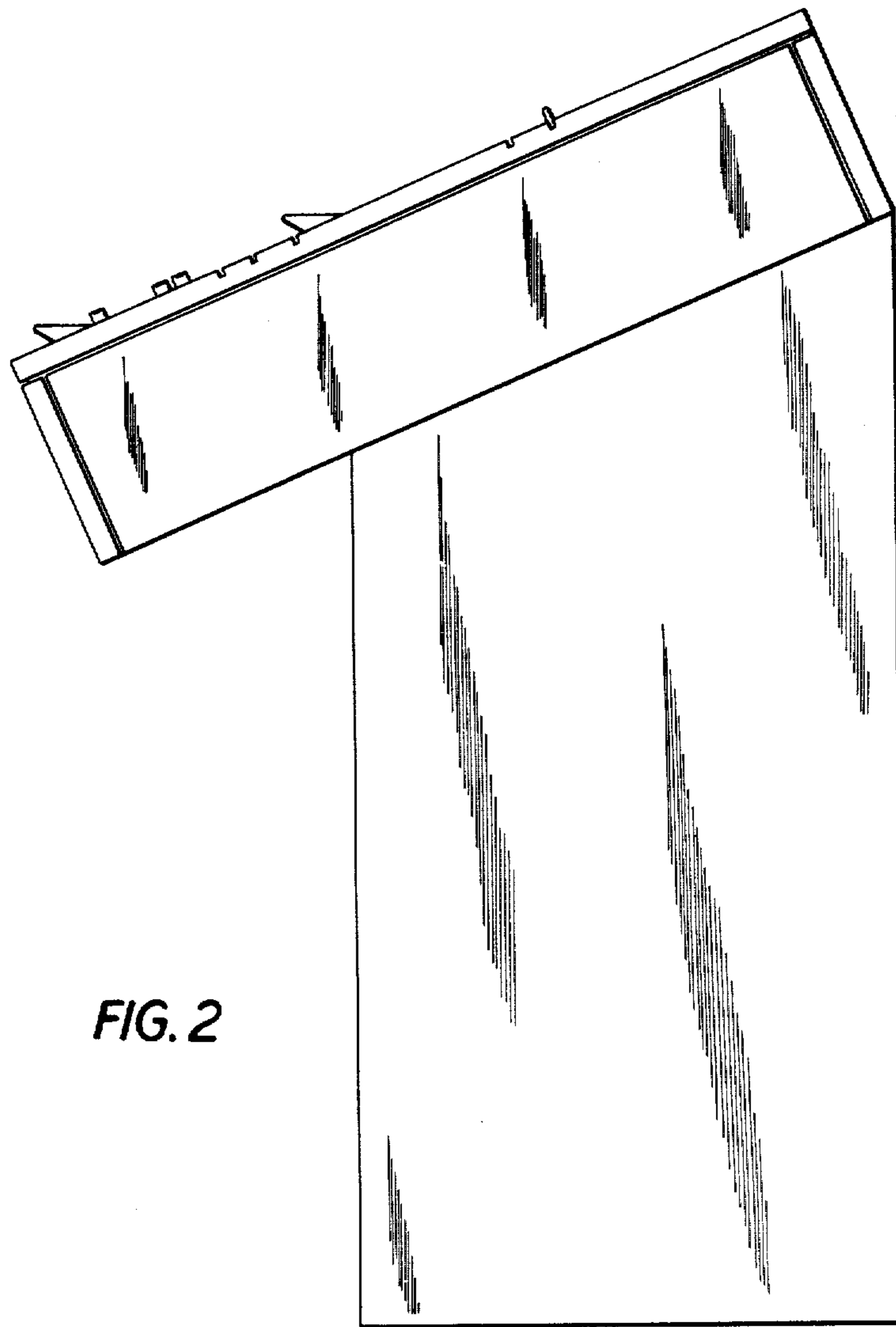
