[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined blade and carrying case for herbs, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the case from the upper left front;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the case from the upper right front with the blade withdrawn and flap raised for clarity;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view from the lower right rear of the case;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view from the upper right rear of the case showing the flap in its flacid position;

FIG. 5 is a side elevation view of the case taken from the right side.

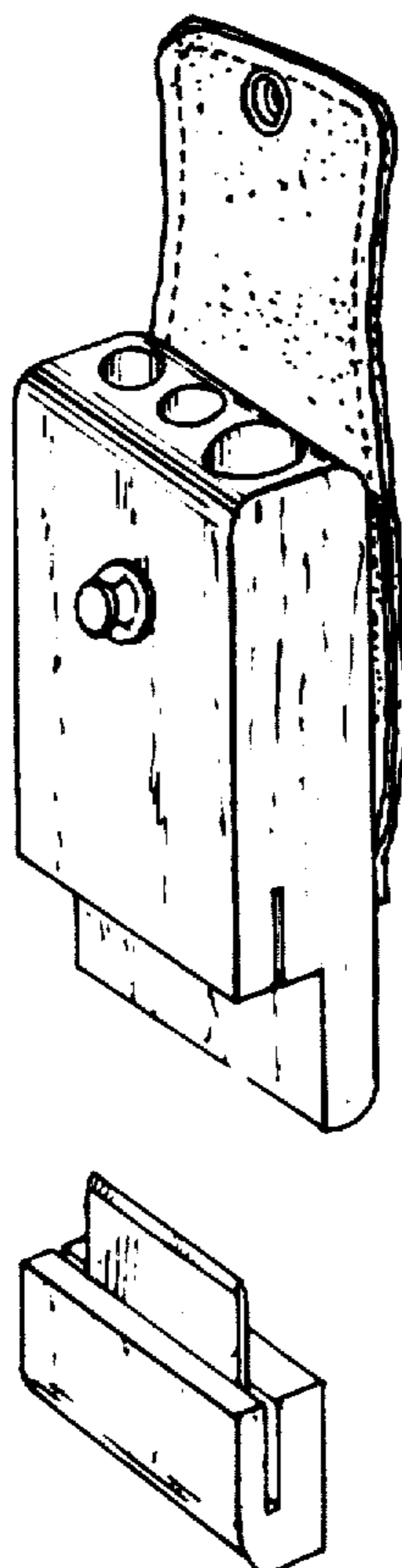

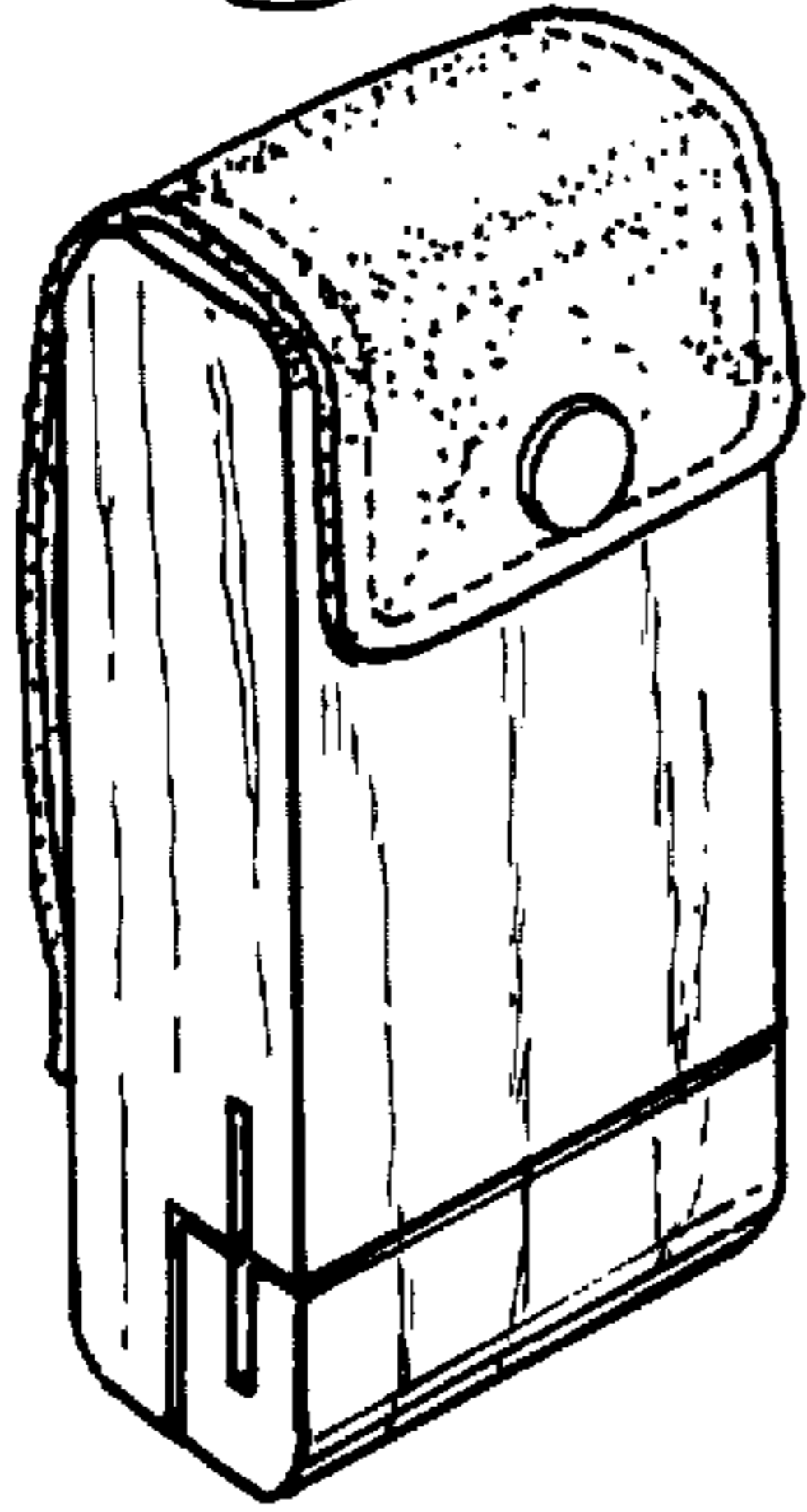

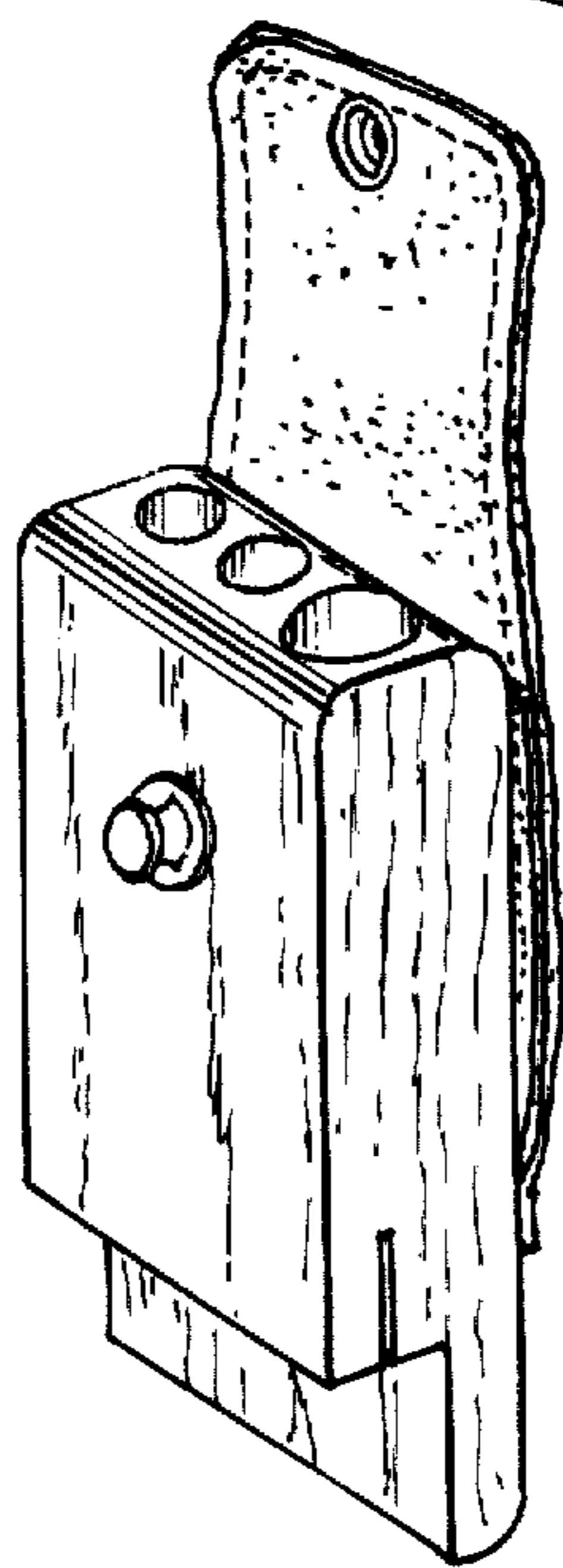
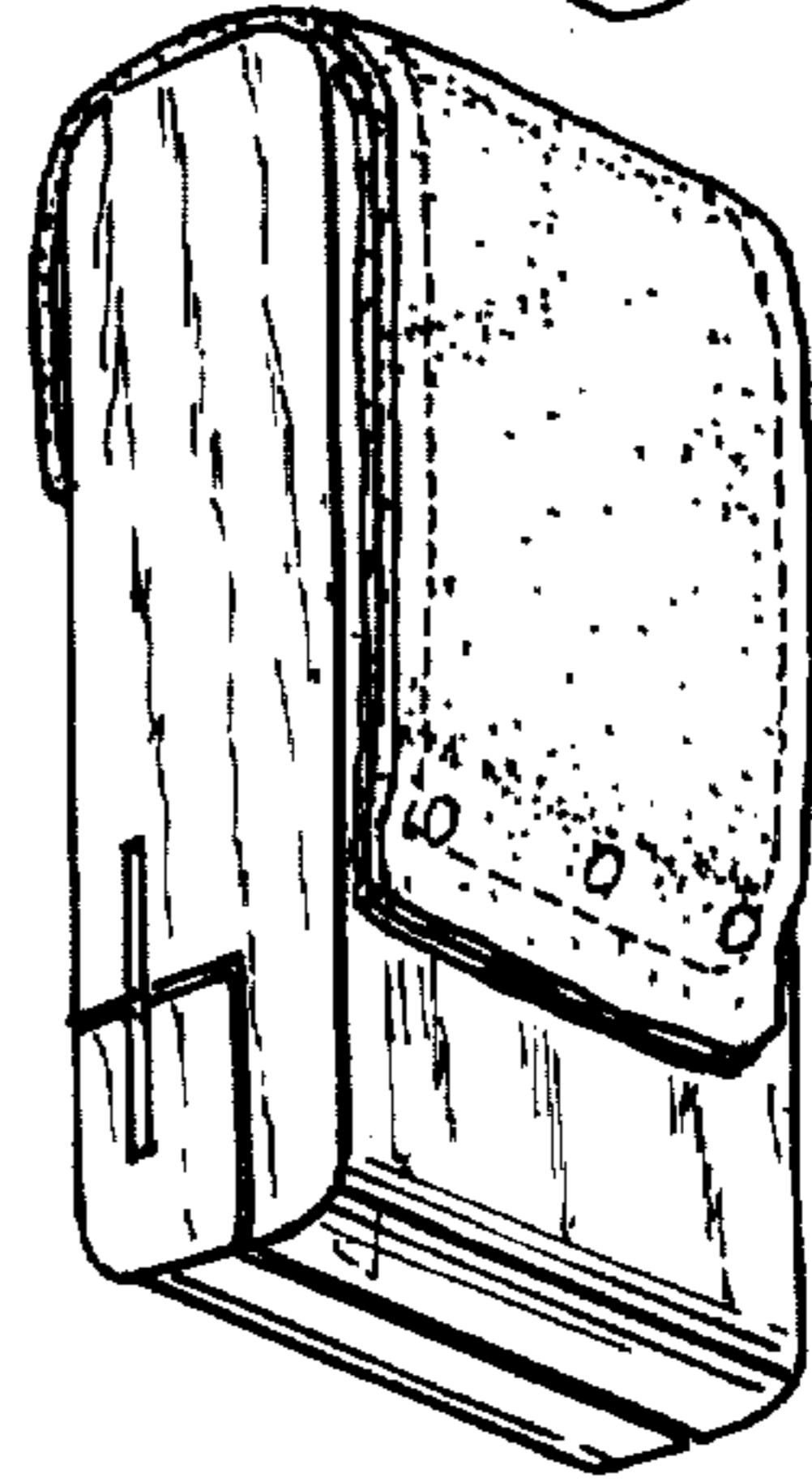

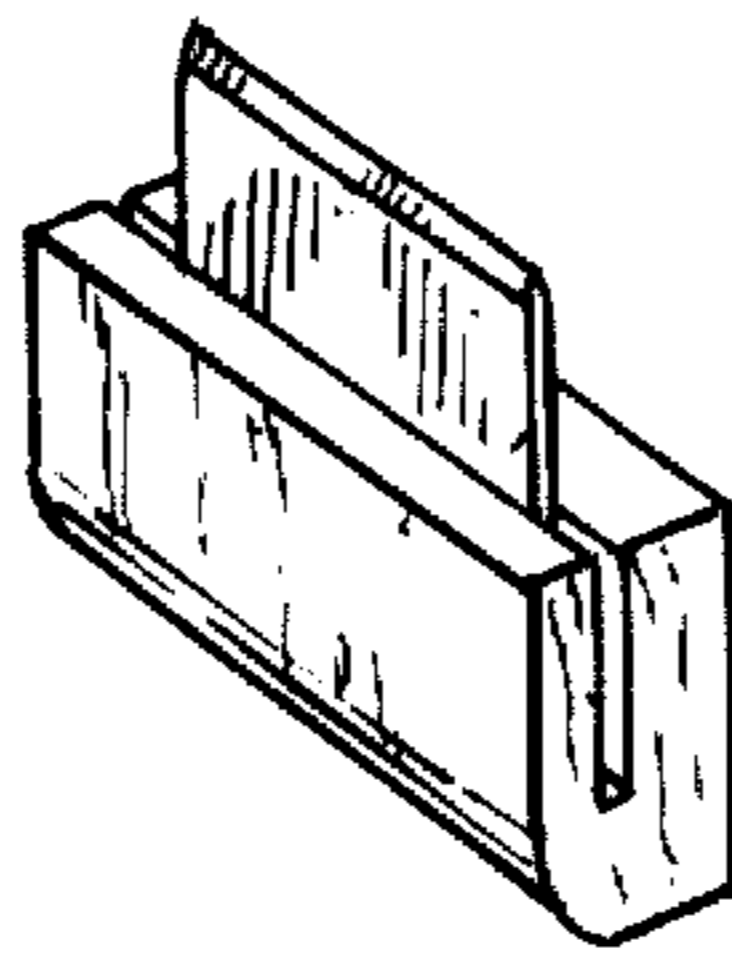
