The back and other side of the end table are substantially mirror images of the respective front and shown side thereof.

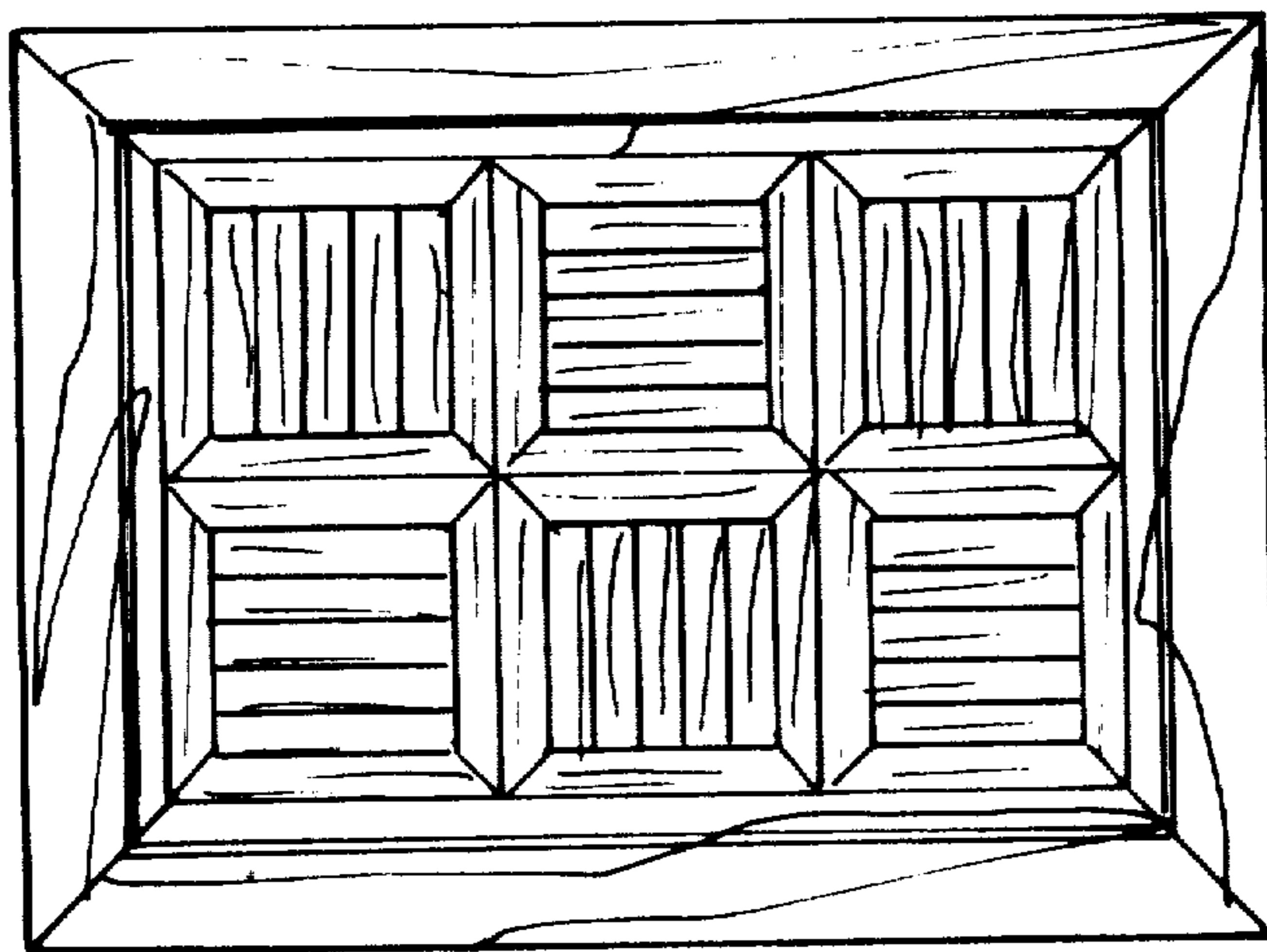

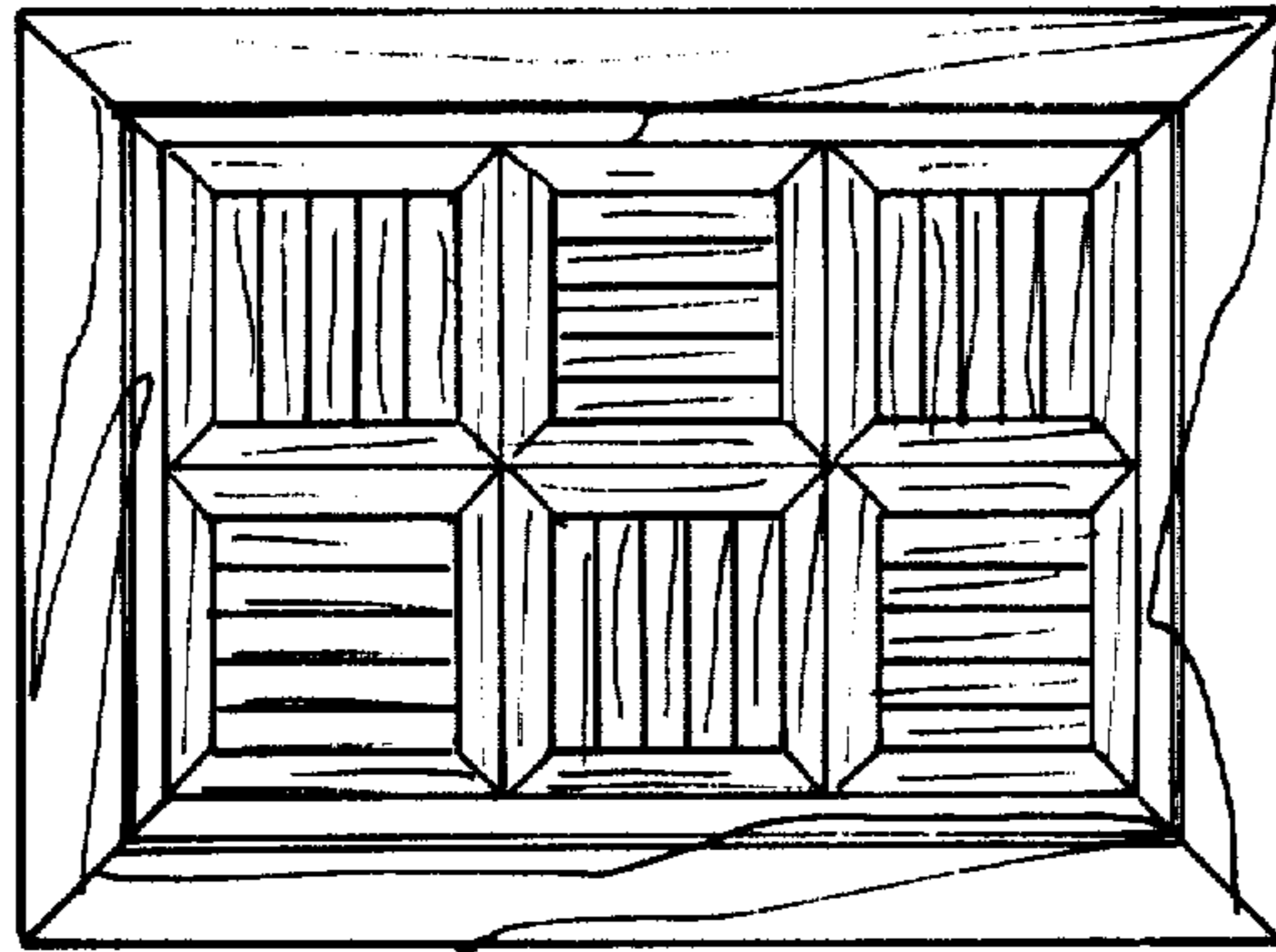

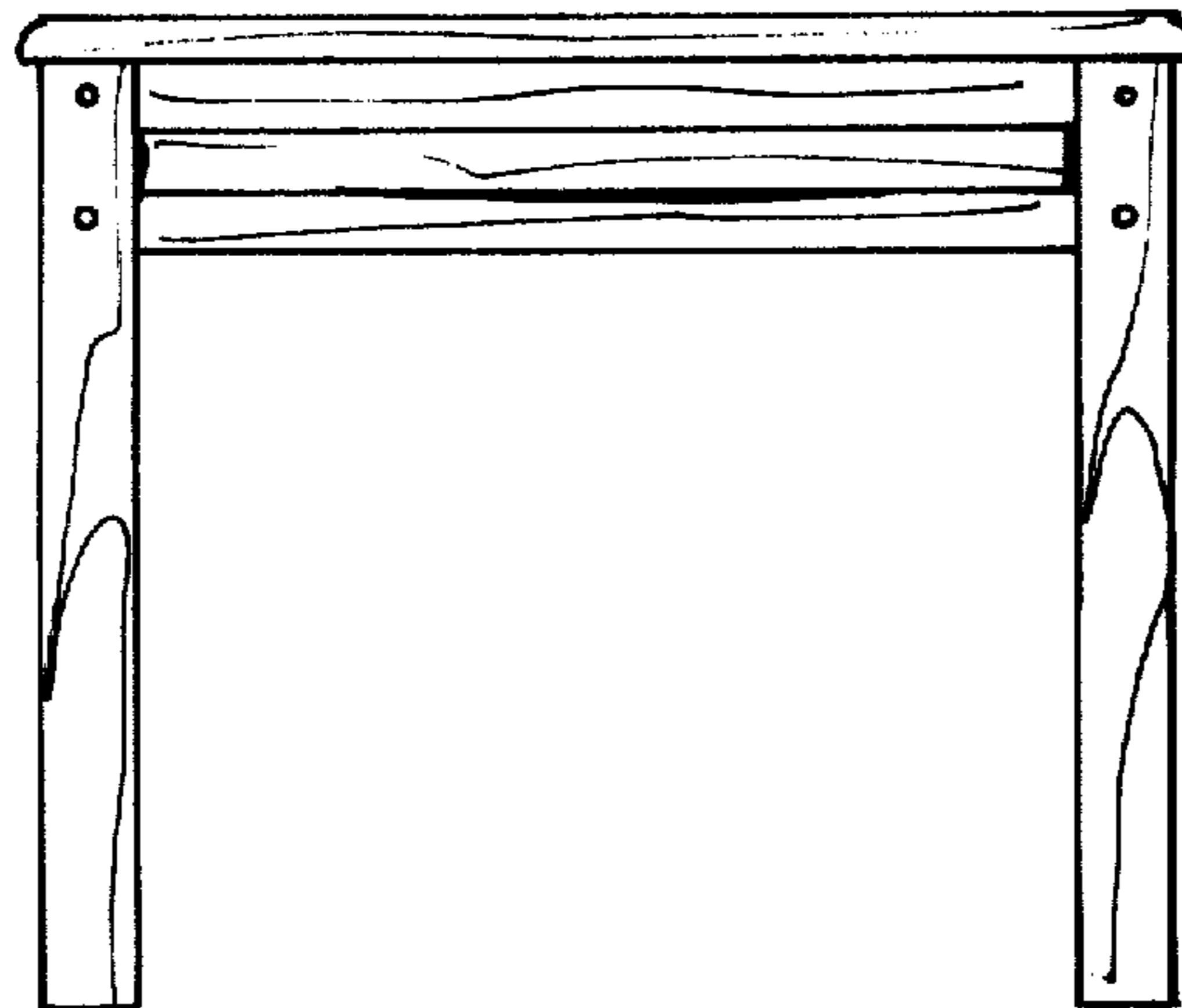
