The ornamental design for a four-legged table, substantially as shown and described.

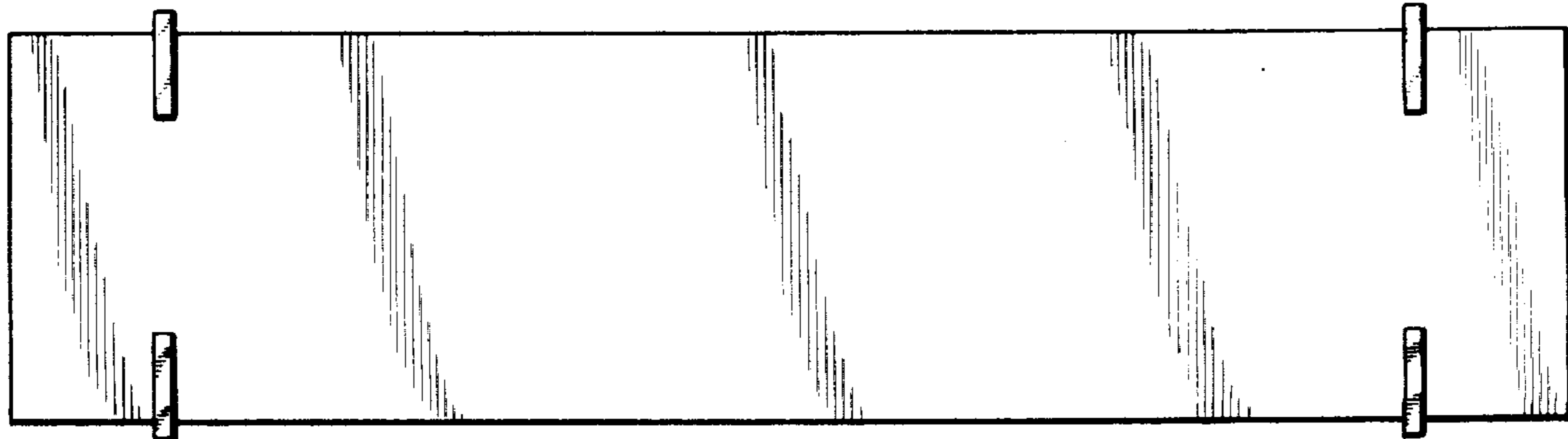
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a four-legged table showing my new design;

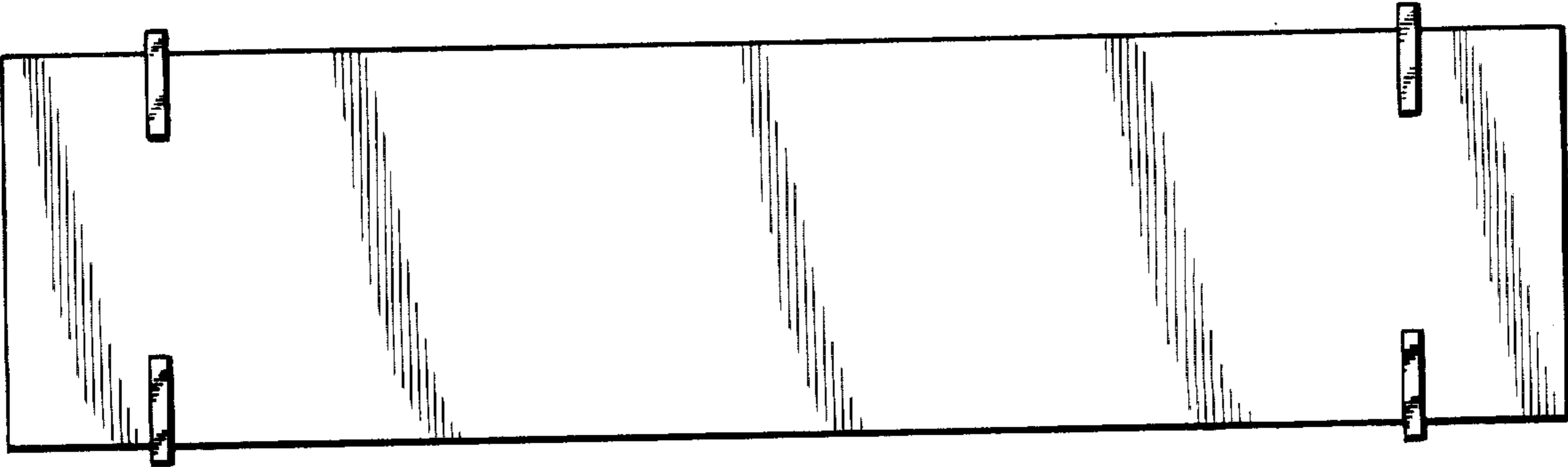
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and

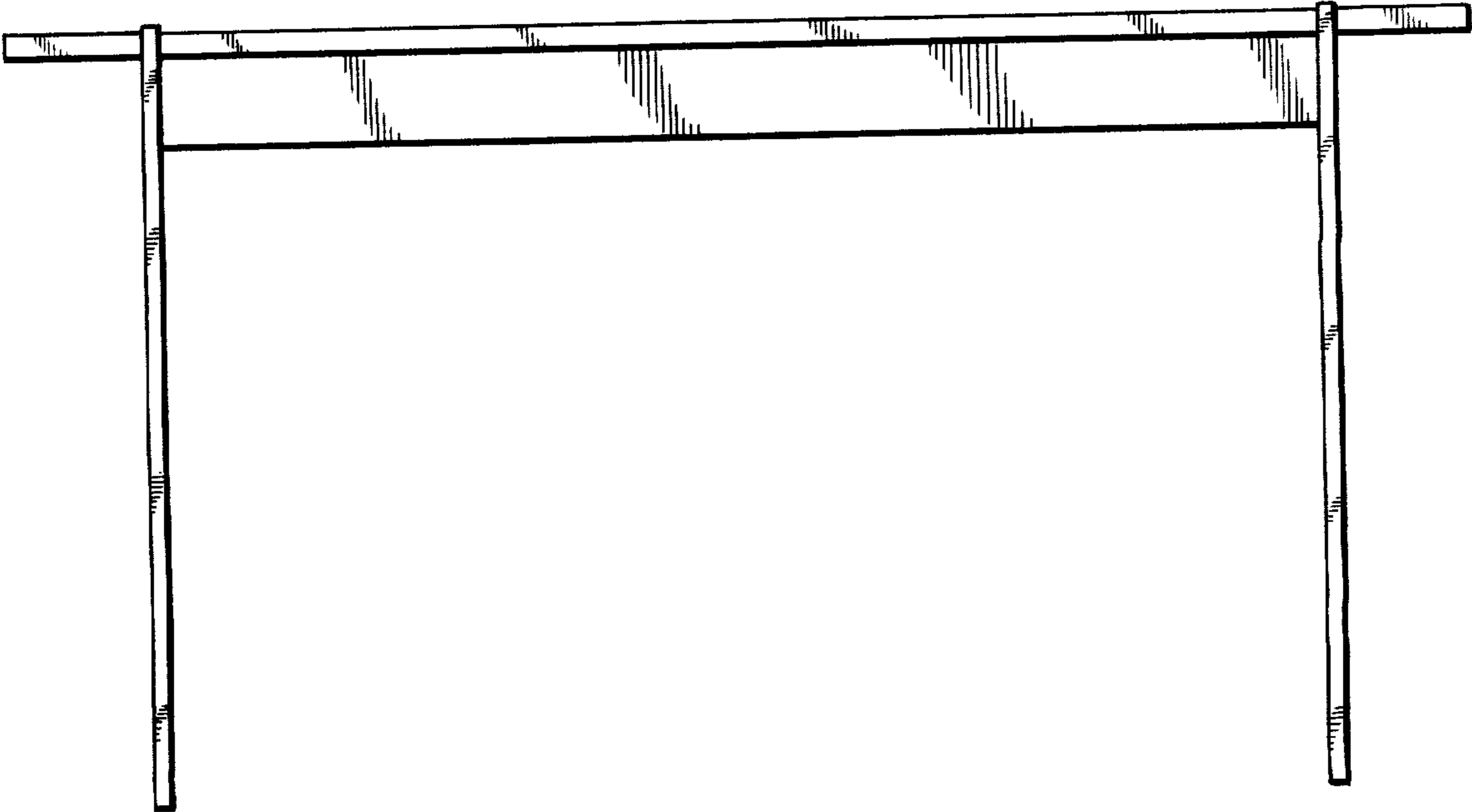
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



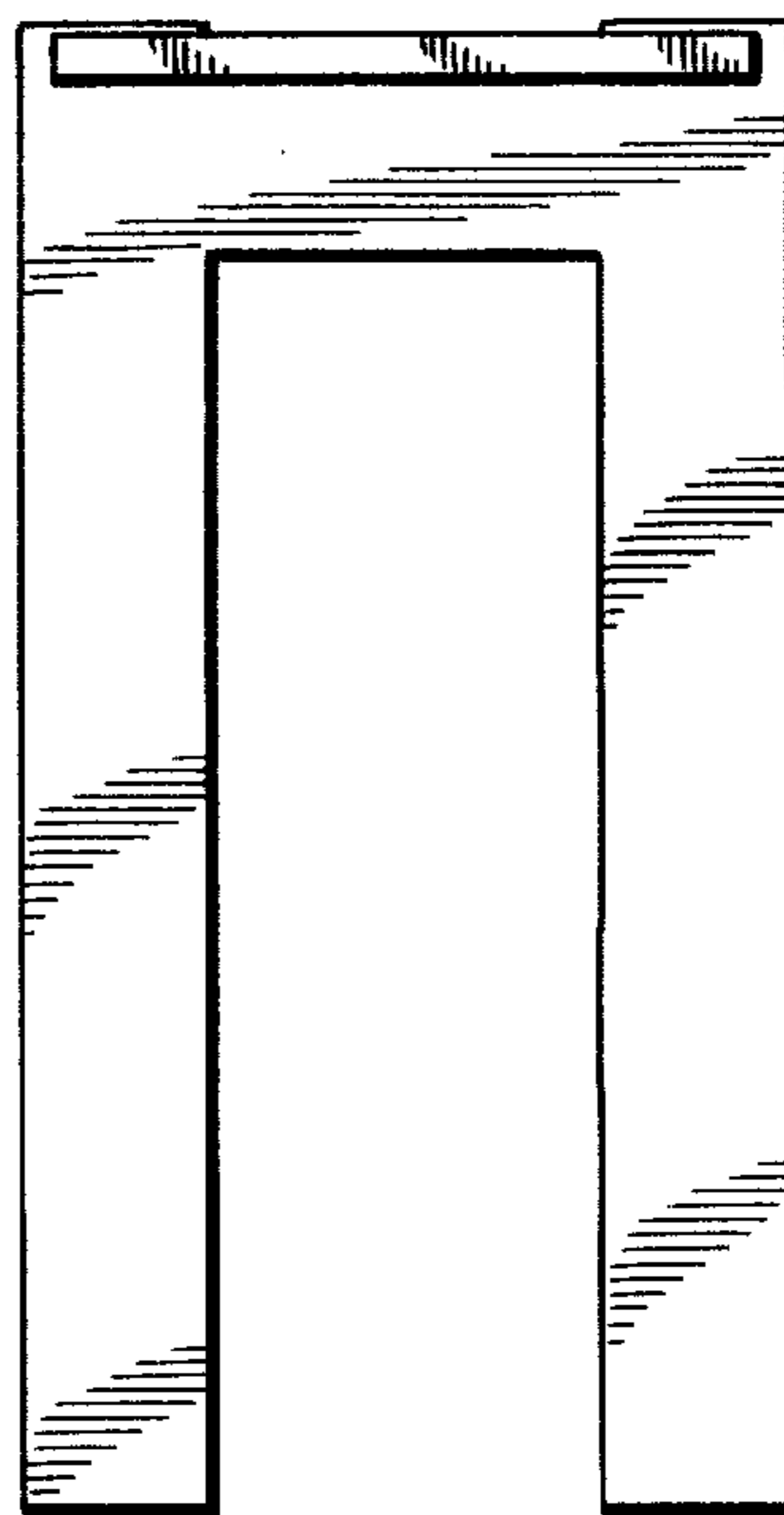
