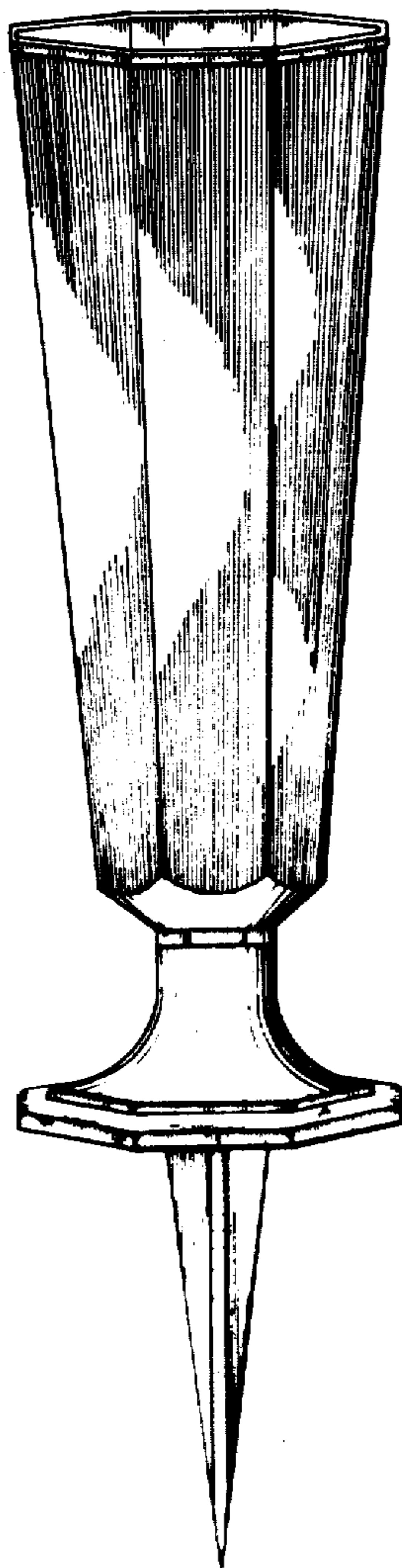

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a ground inserted flower vase, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a ground inserted flower vase showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an exploded side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the upper element of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the central element of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the lower element of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 4;
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5.



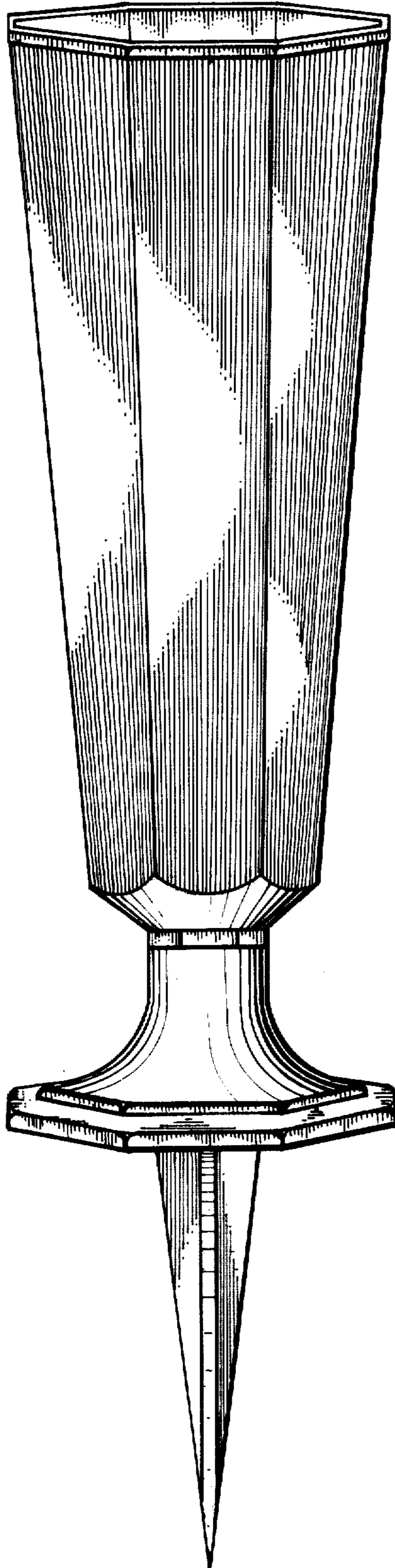

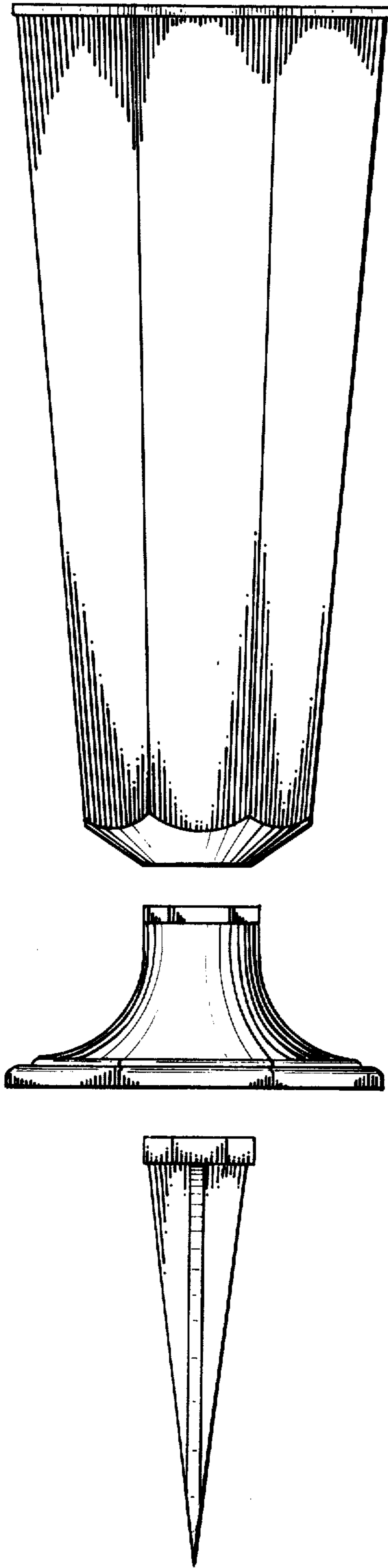

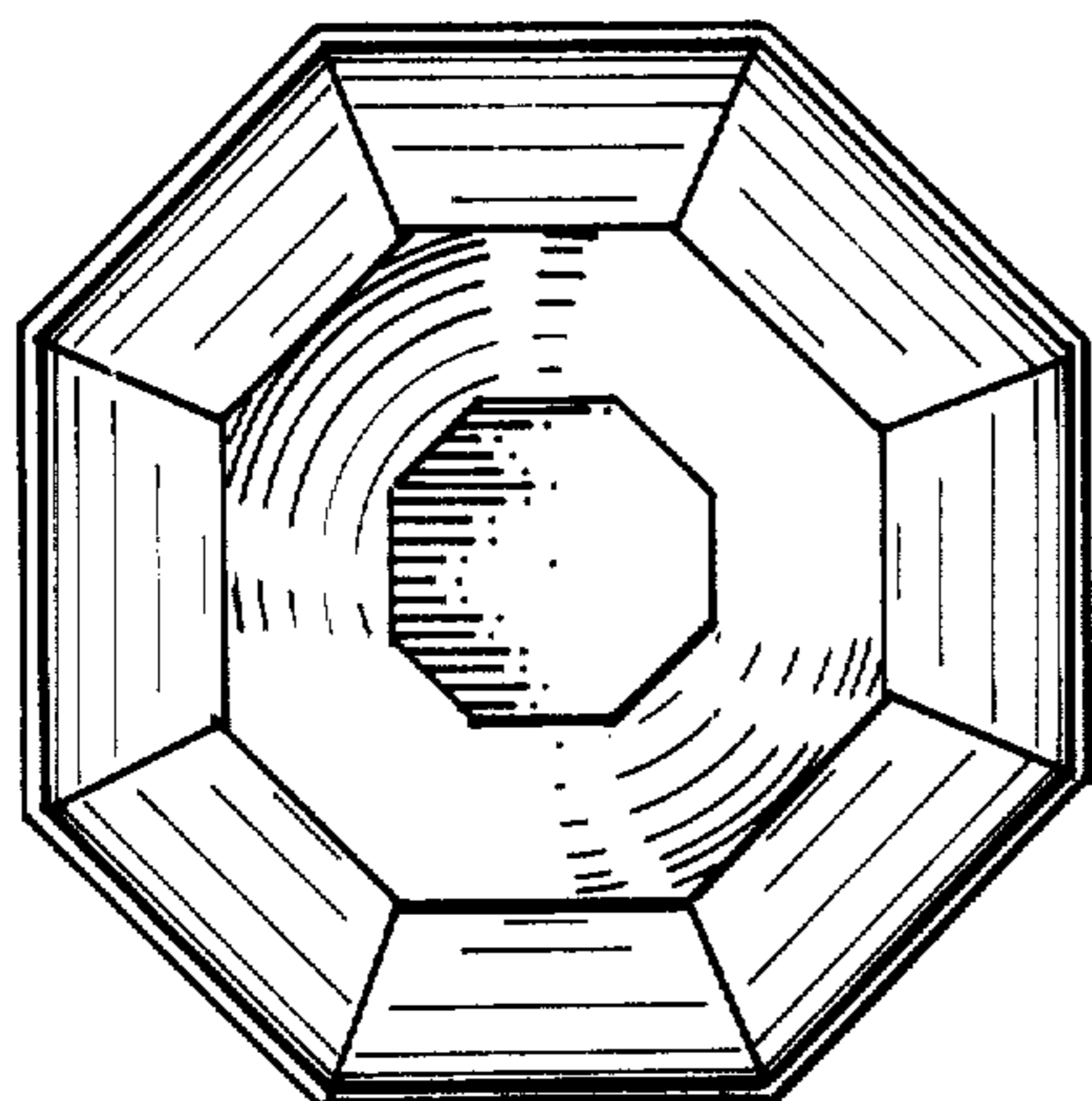

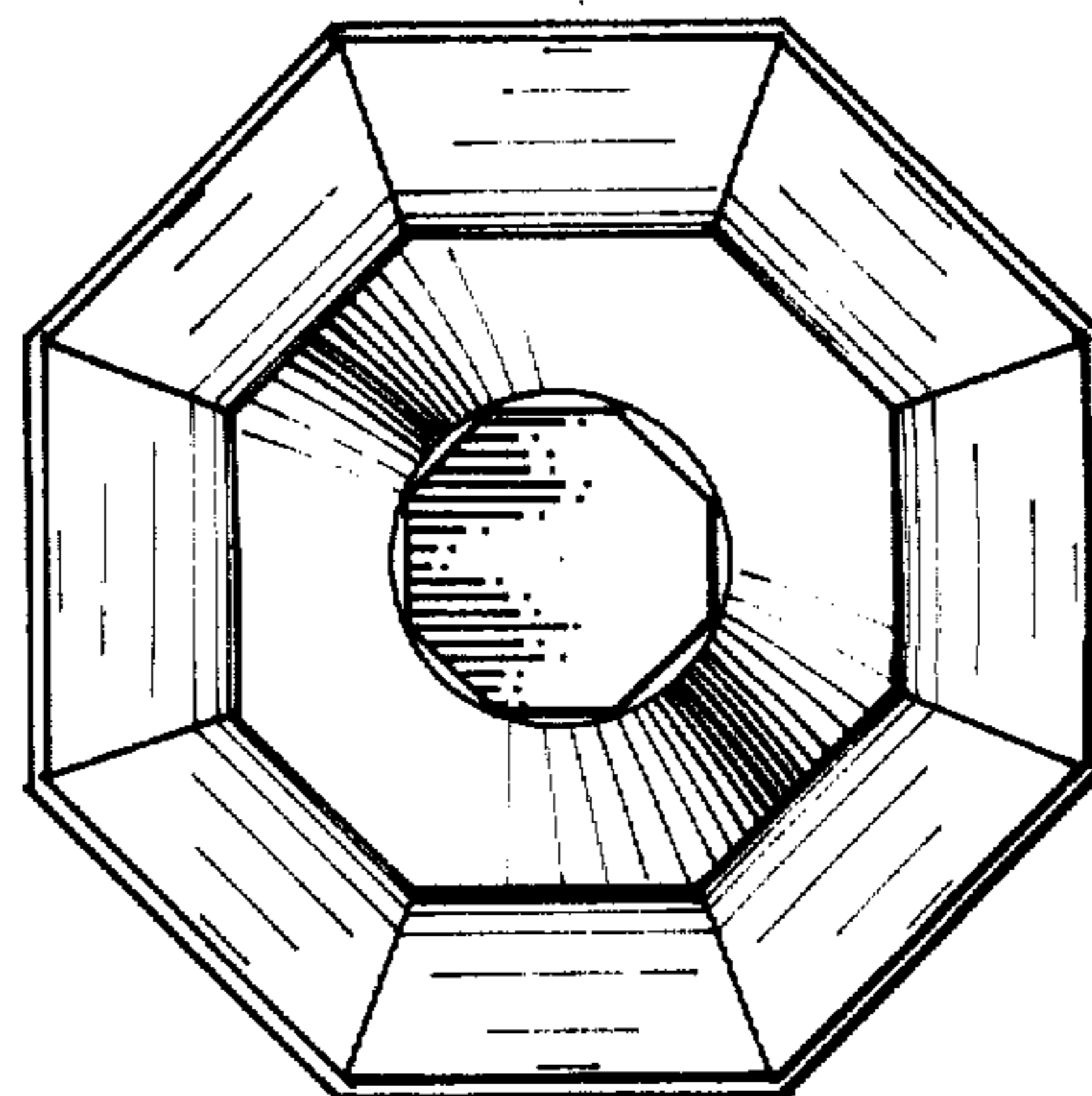

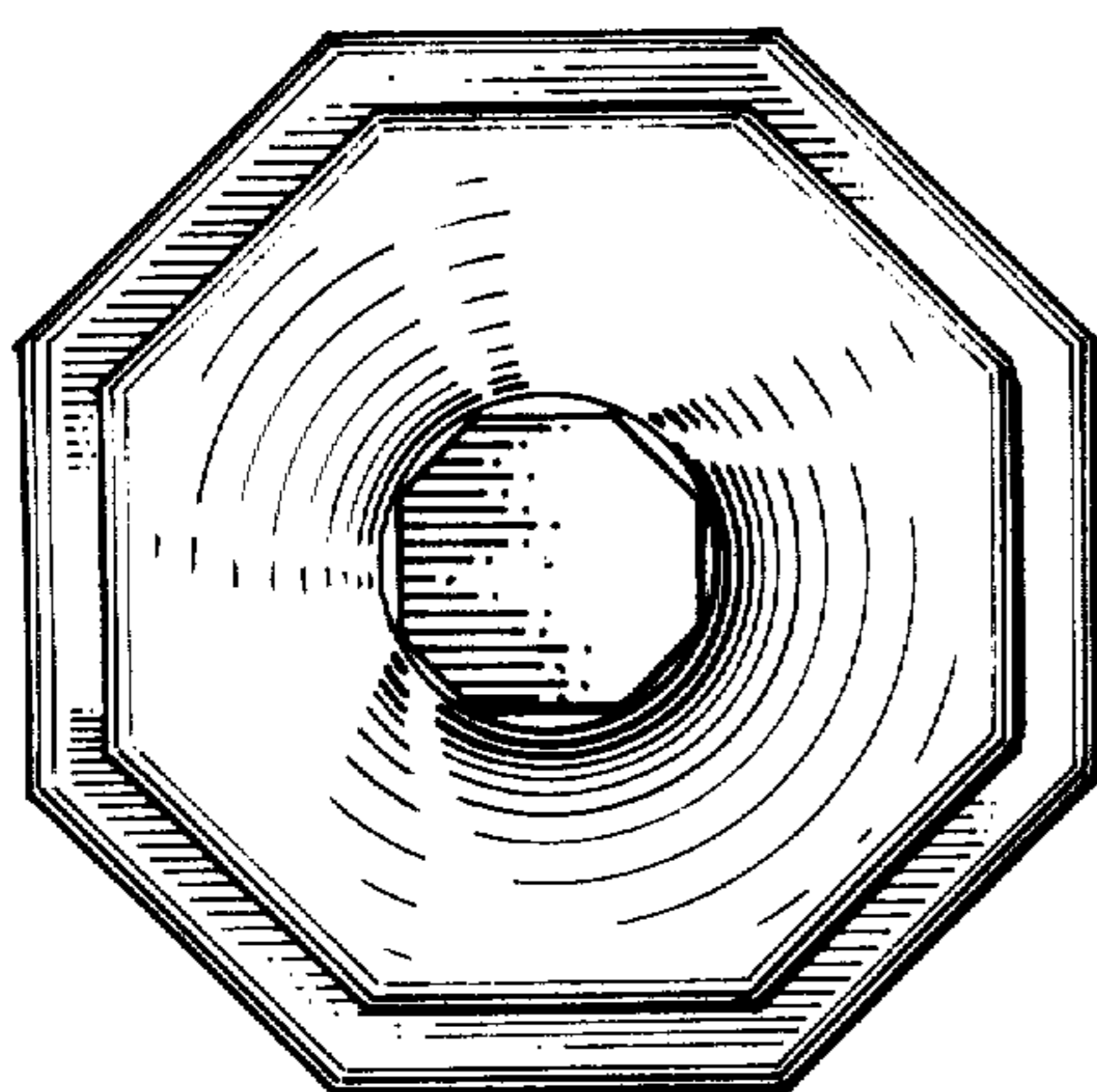

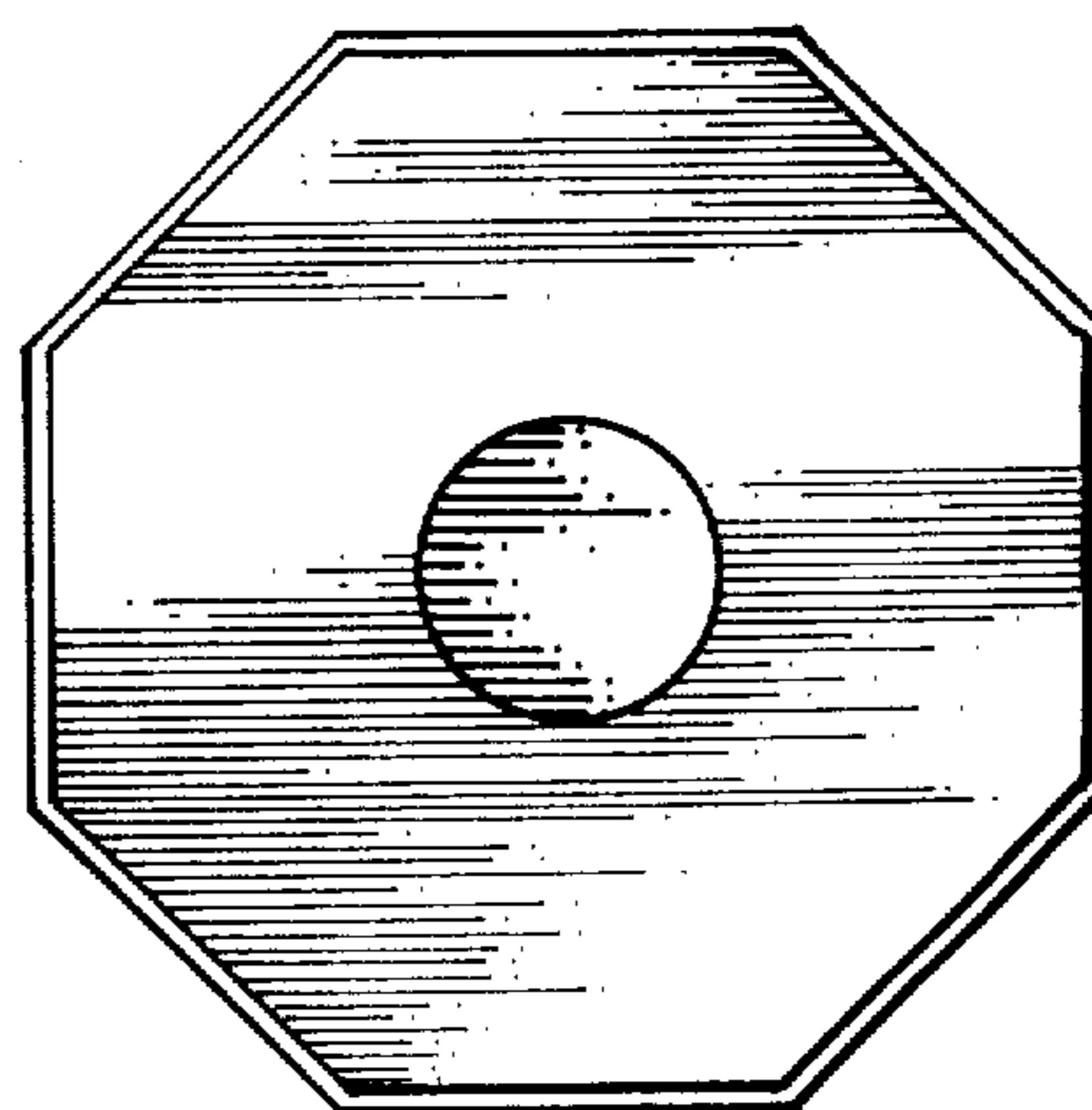

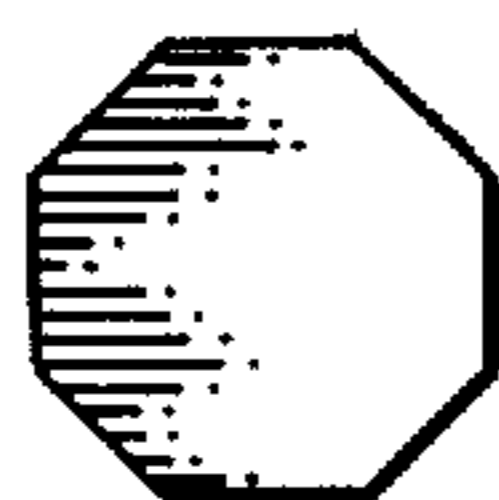

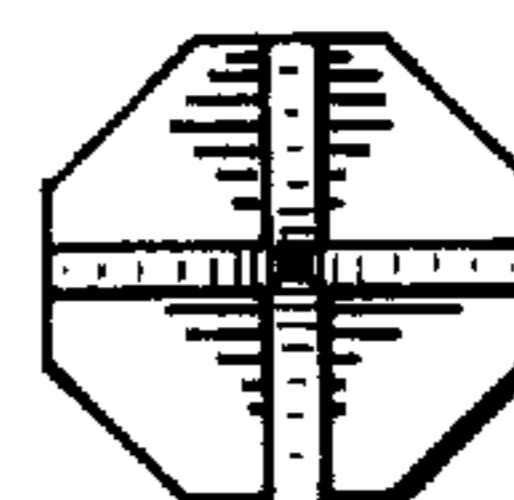
