**CLAIM** 

The ornamental design for a plant container, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a plant container embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 4-4 of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 5—5 of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 6—6 of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 7-7 of FIG. 3; and

FIG. 8 is an enlarged fragmentary view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 8-8 of FIG. 3. The underside of the plant container follows the con-

tours shown in FIG. 3.
