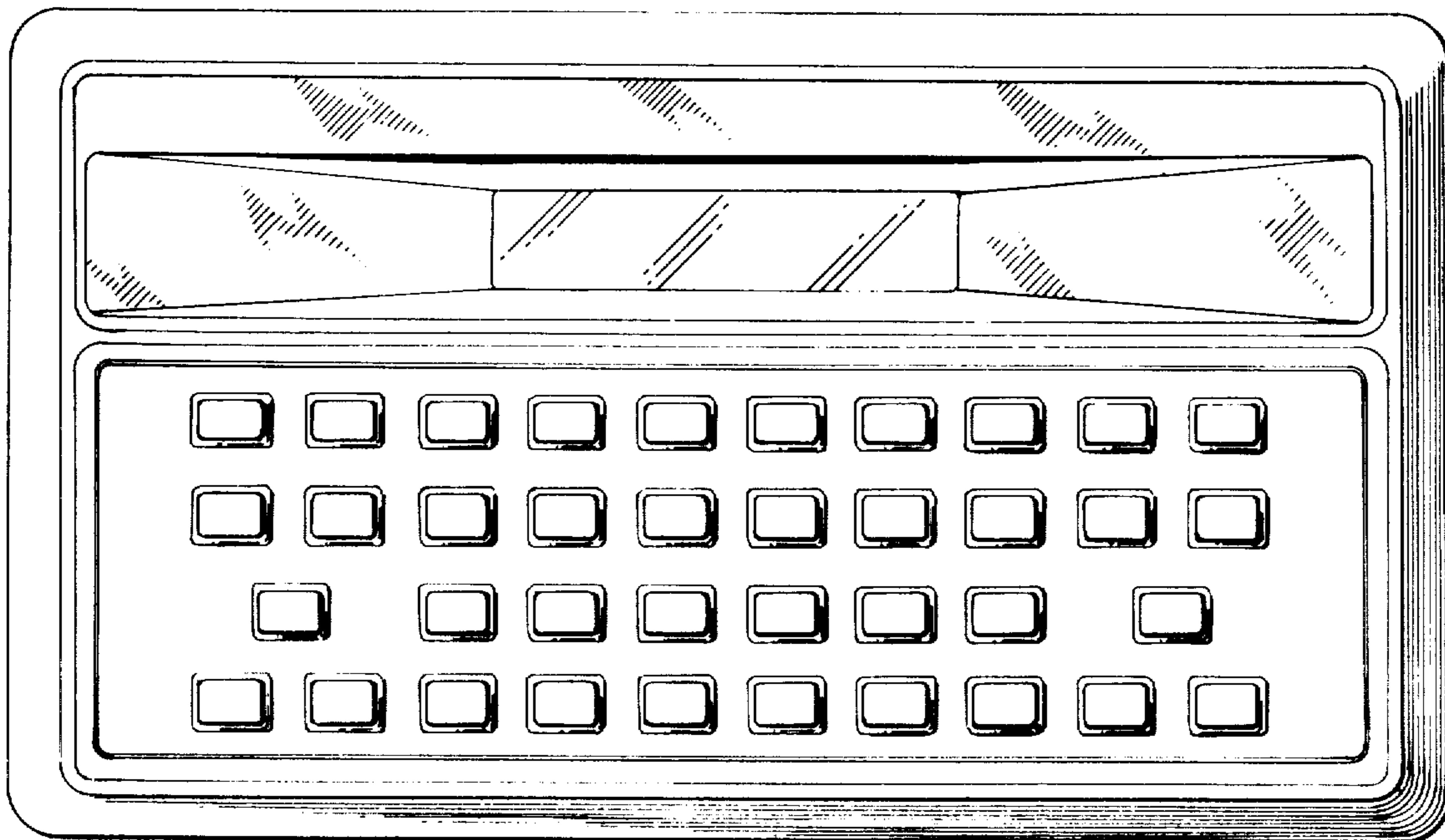

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an electronic word game casing or similar article, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the article of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view as viewed from the right in FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 6 is an end elevational view as viewed from the left in FIG. 1.



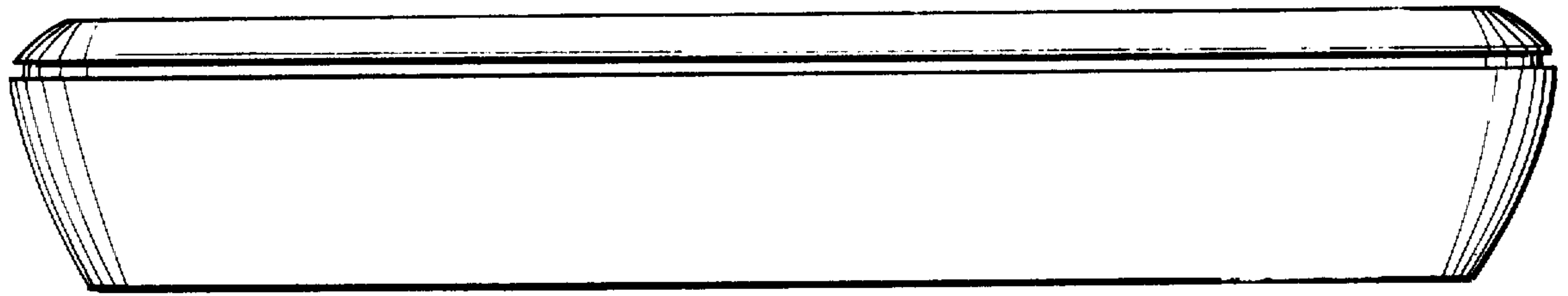

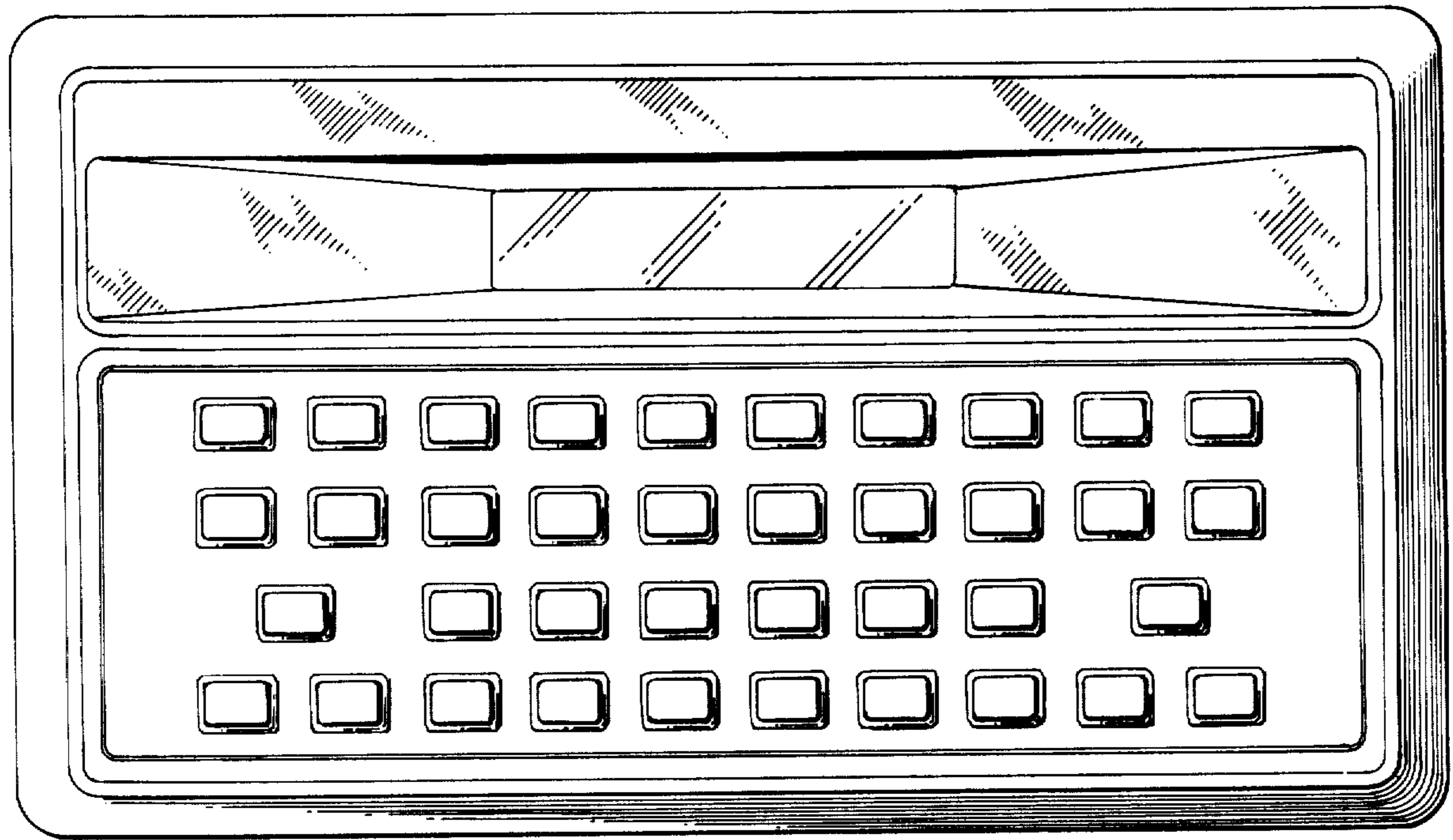

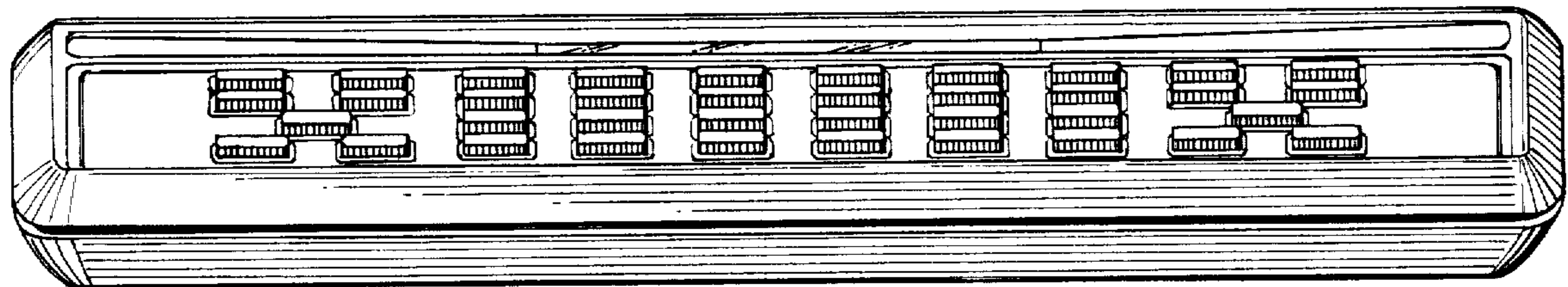

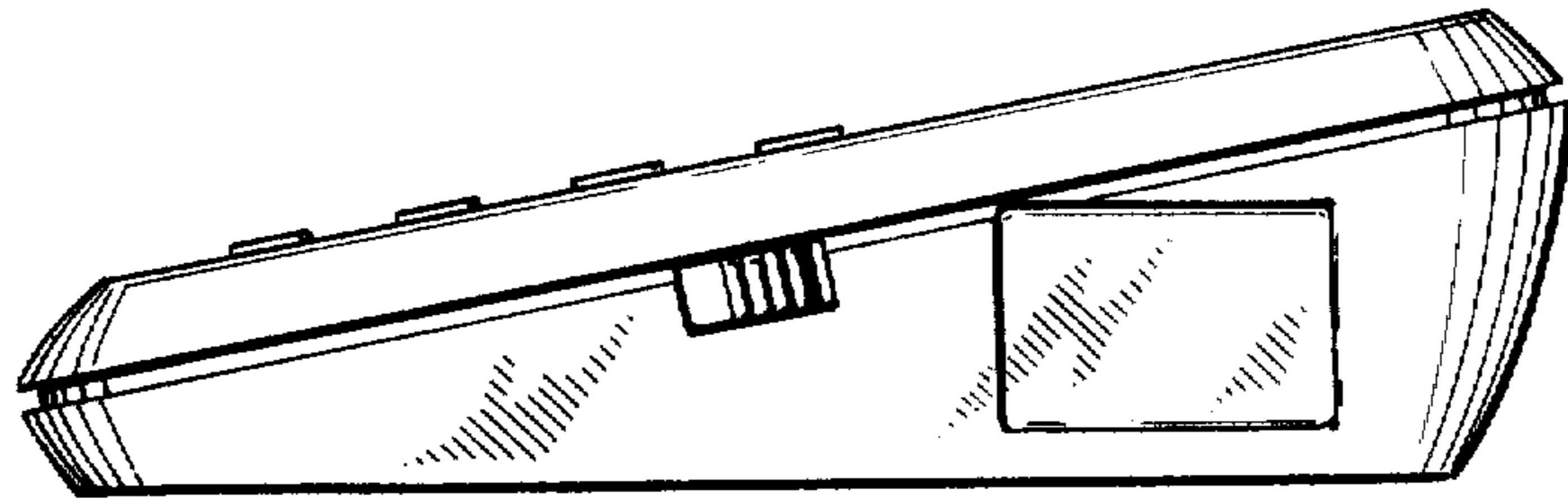

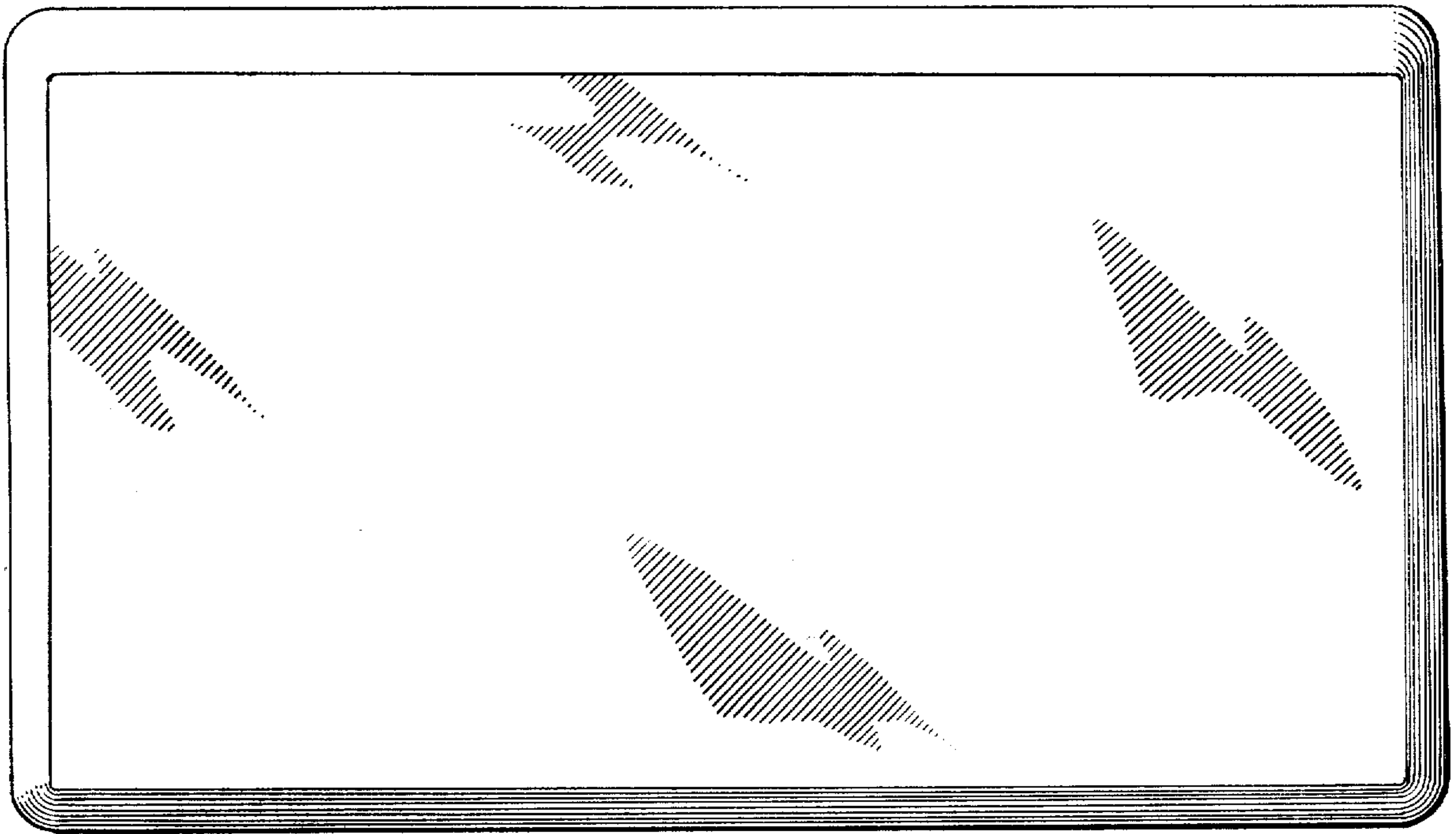

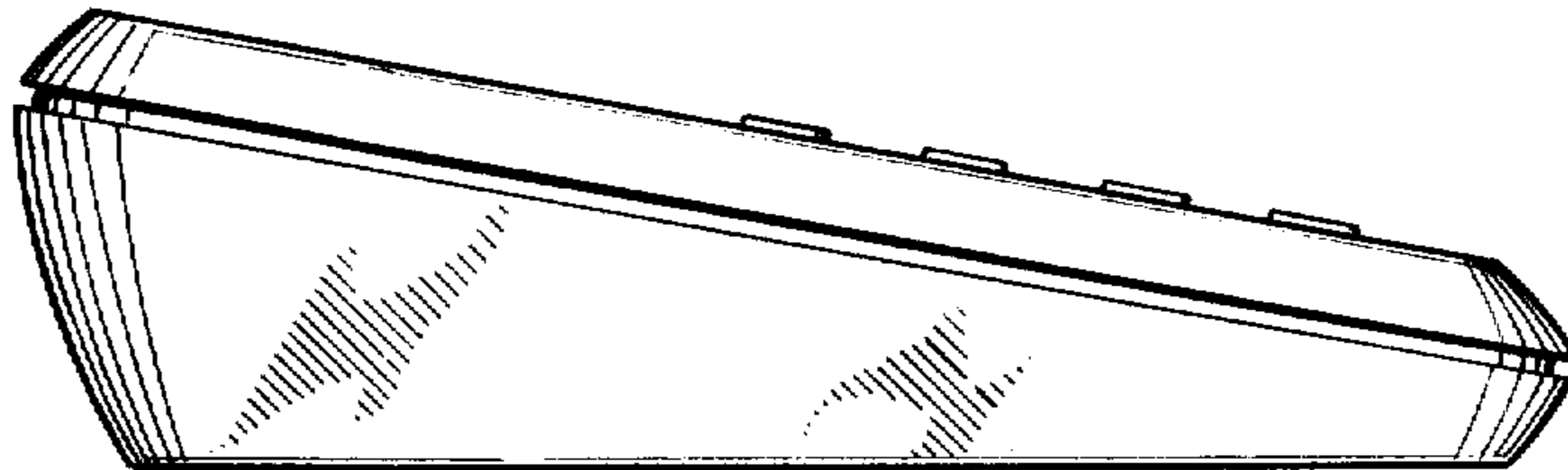
