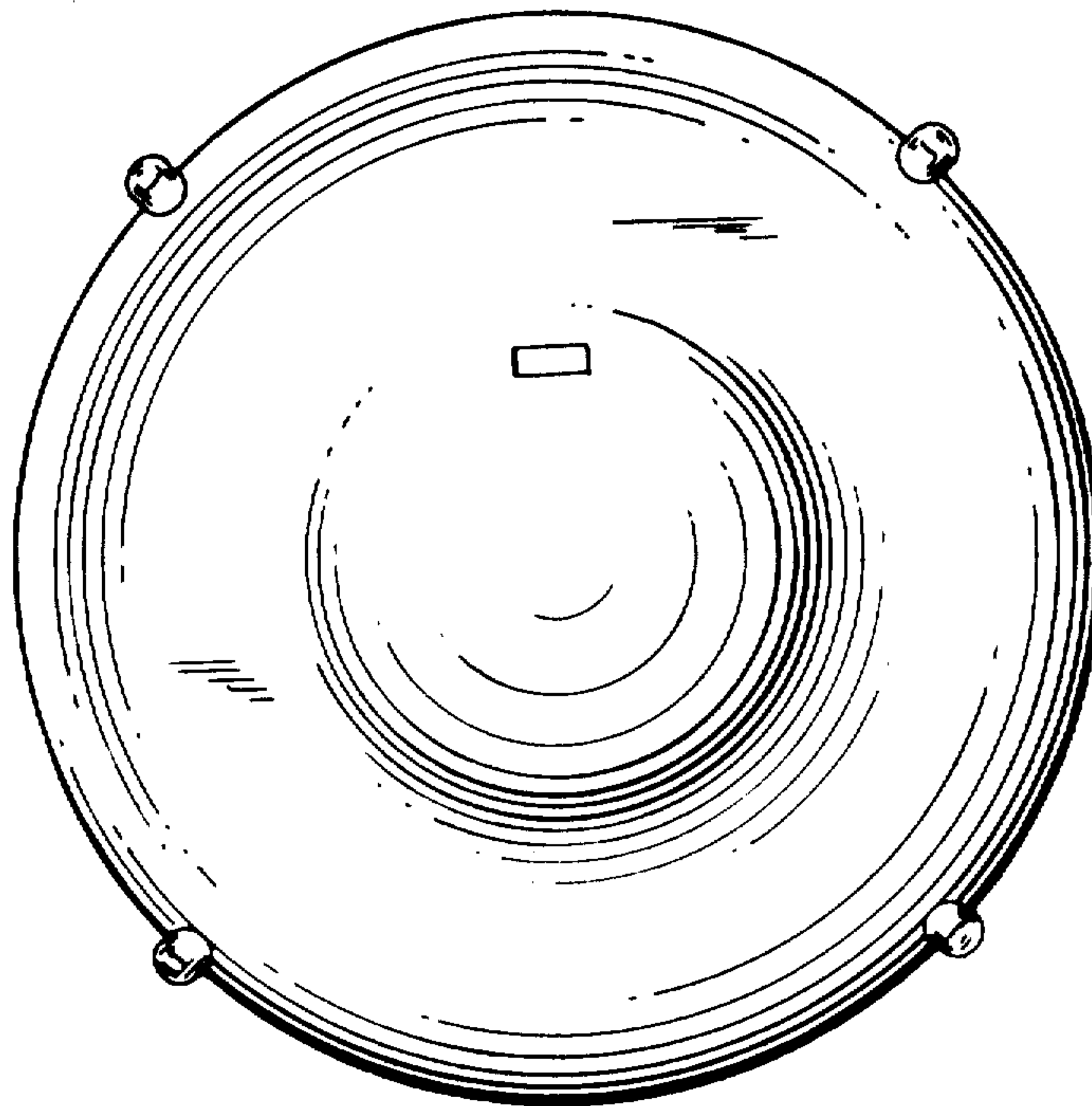

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an illumination device for attachment to a toy flying saucer, substantially as shown and described.

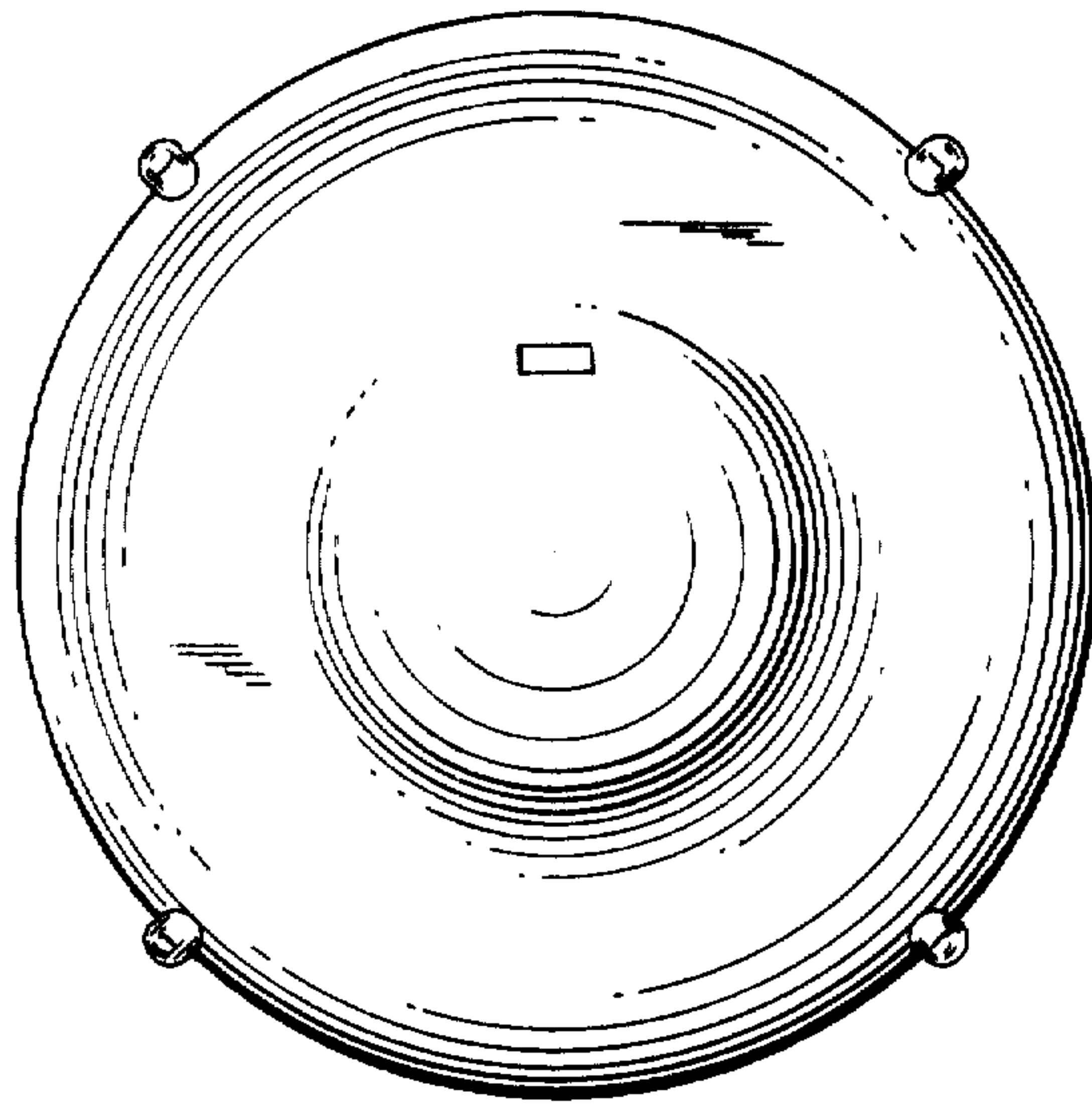

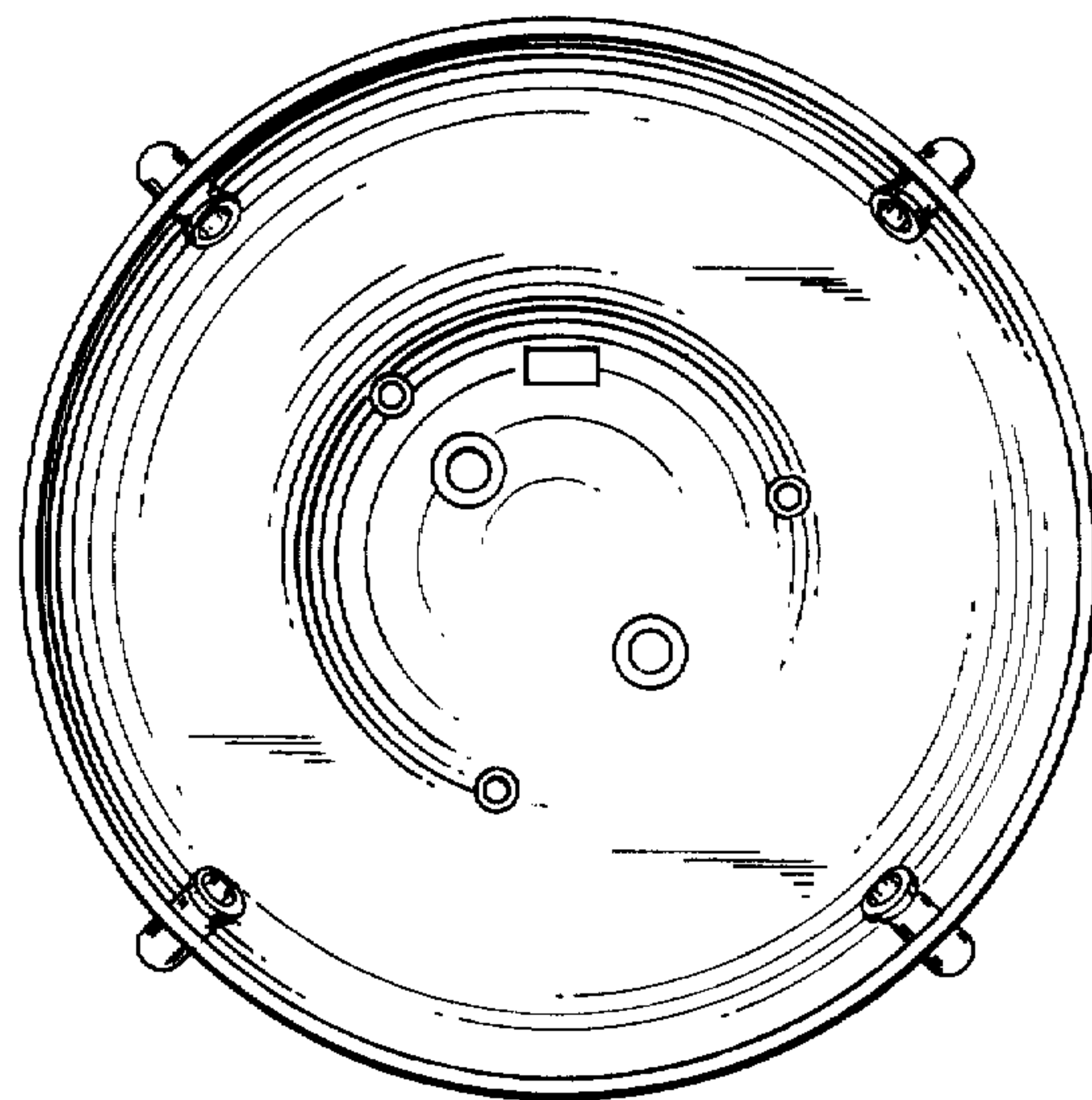

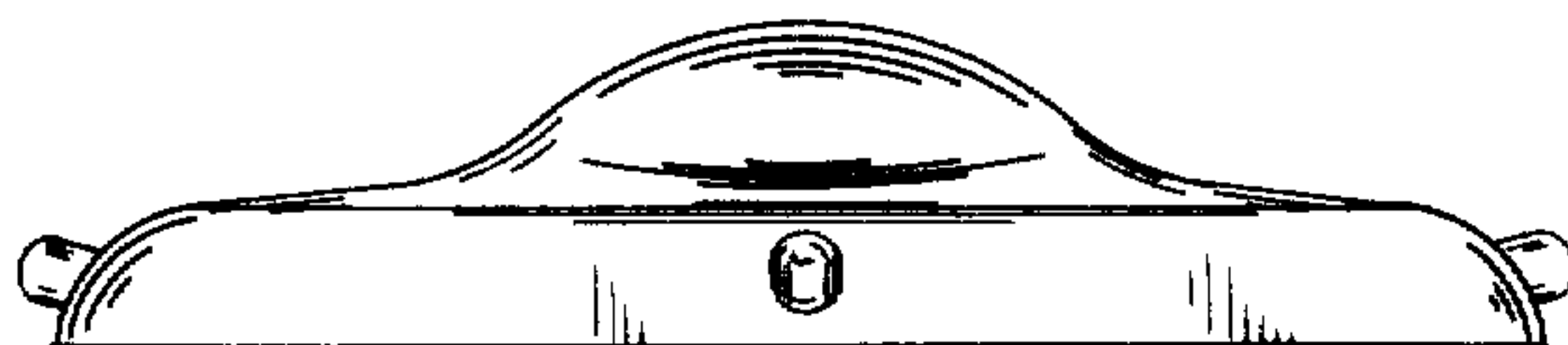
