DESCRIPTION

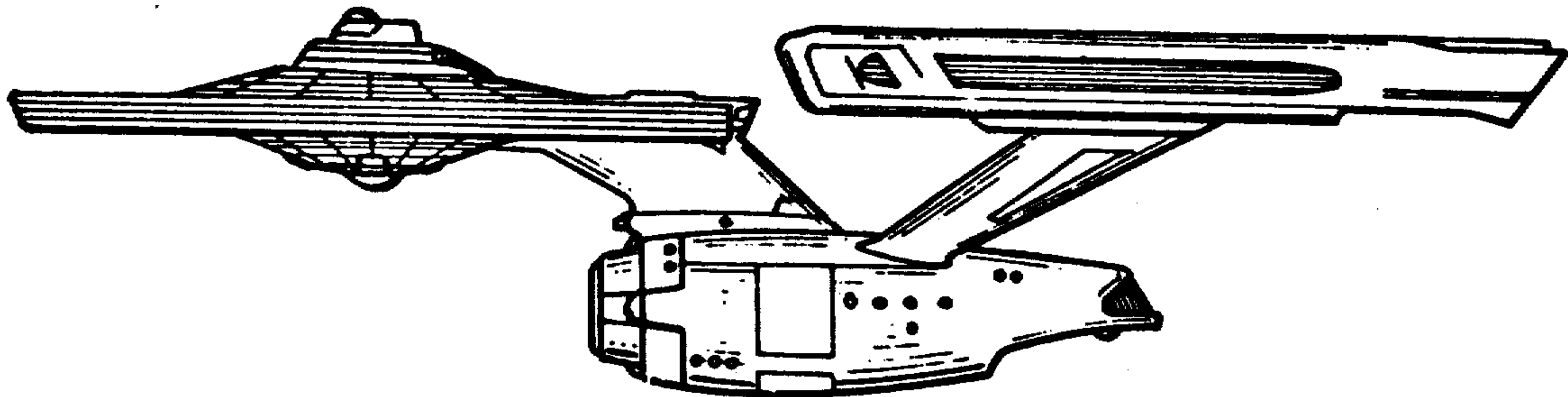
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy spaceship illustrating my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



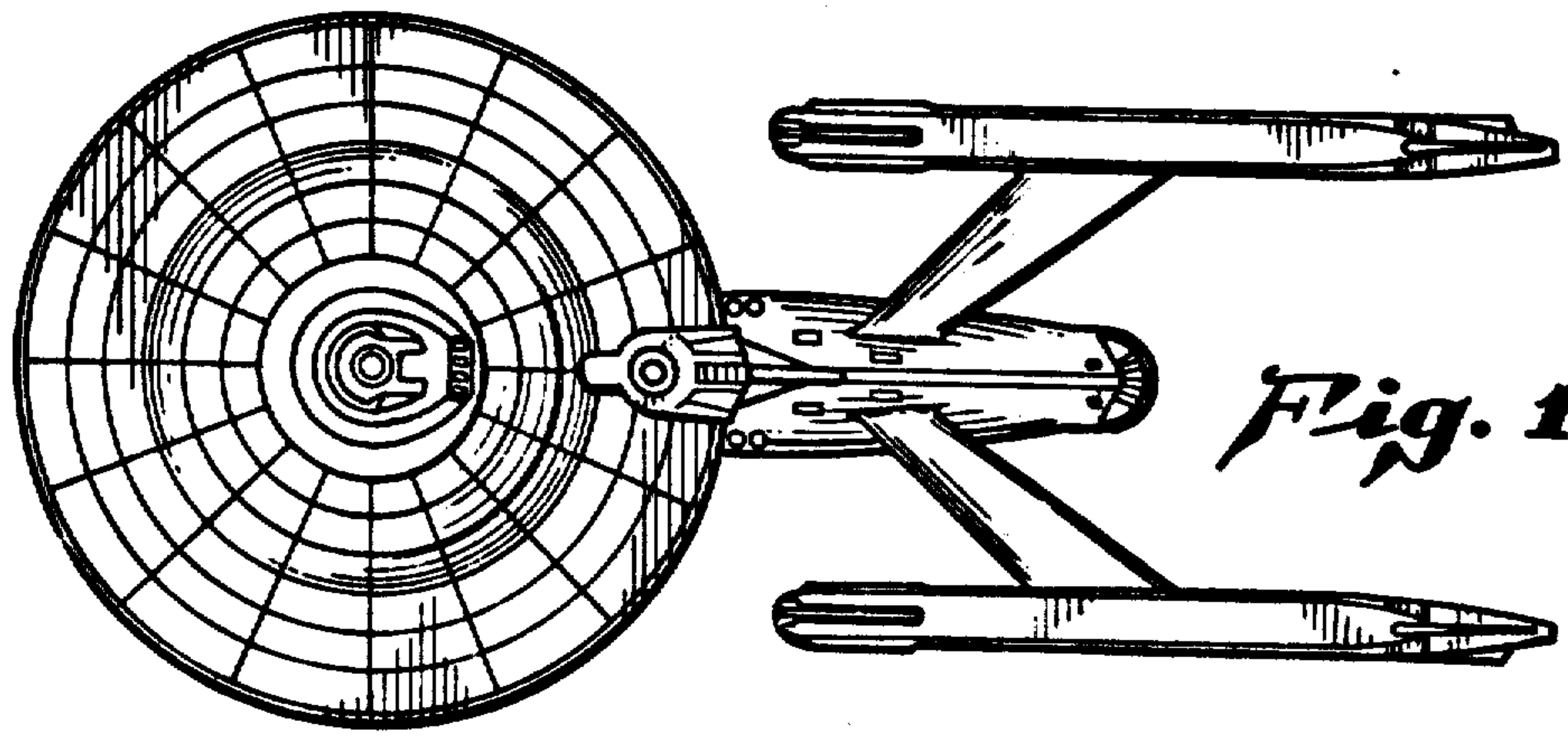

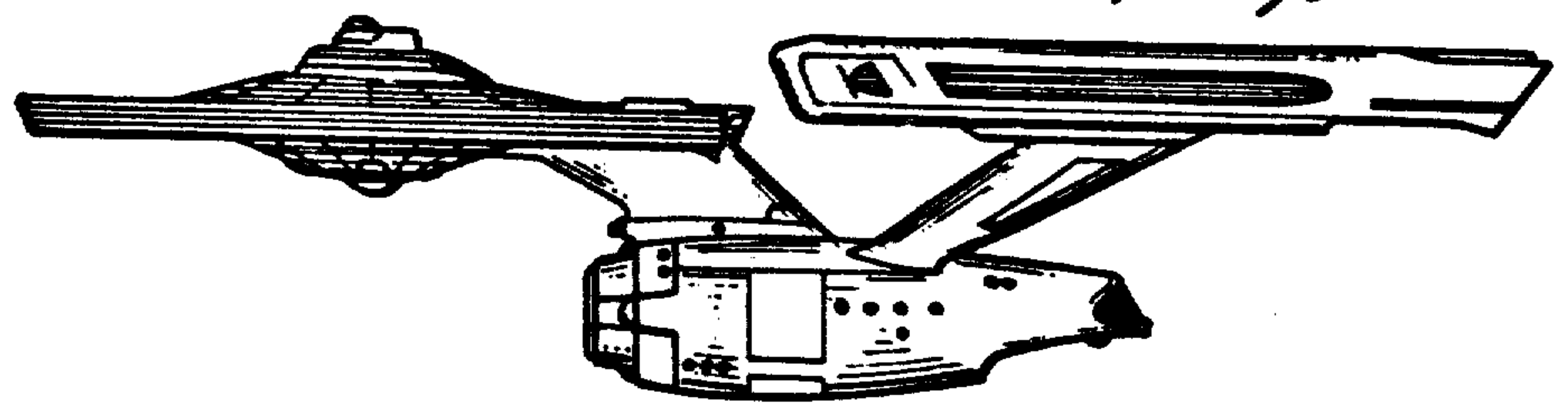

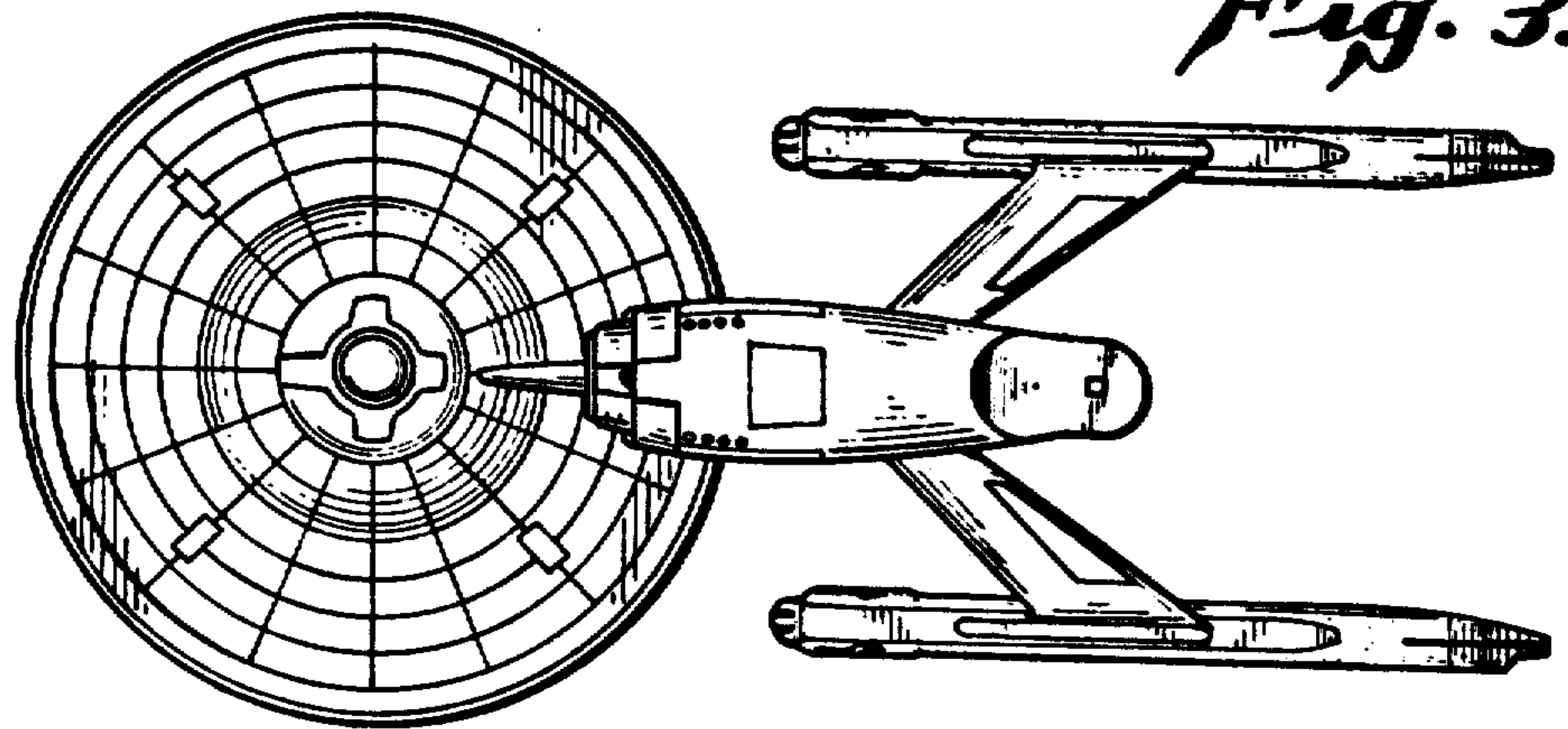

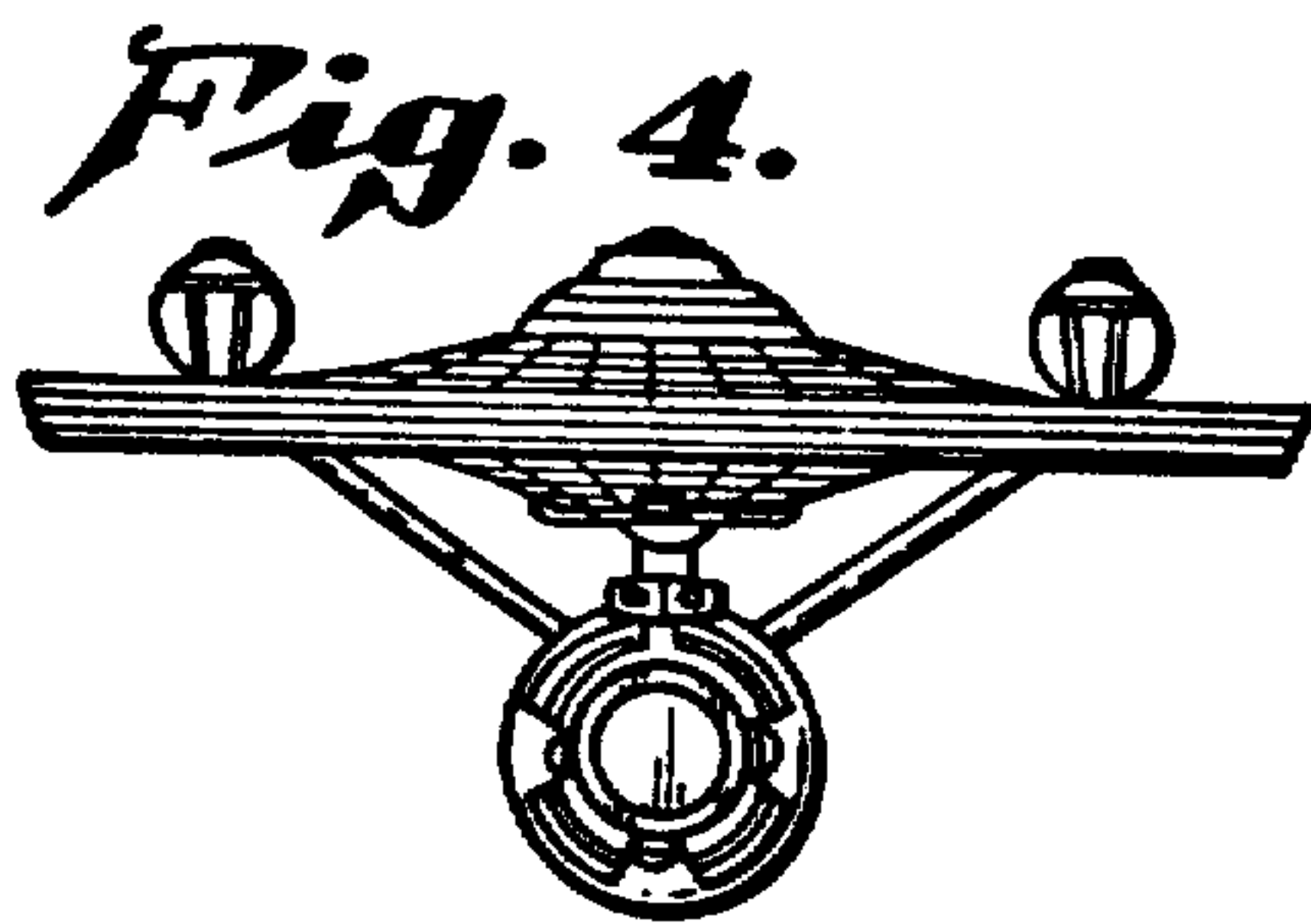

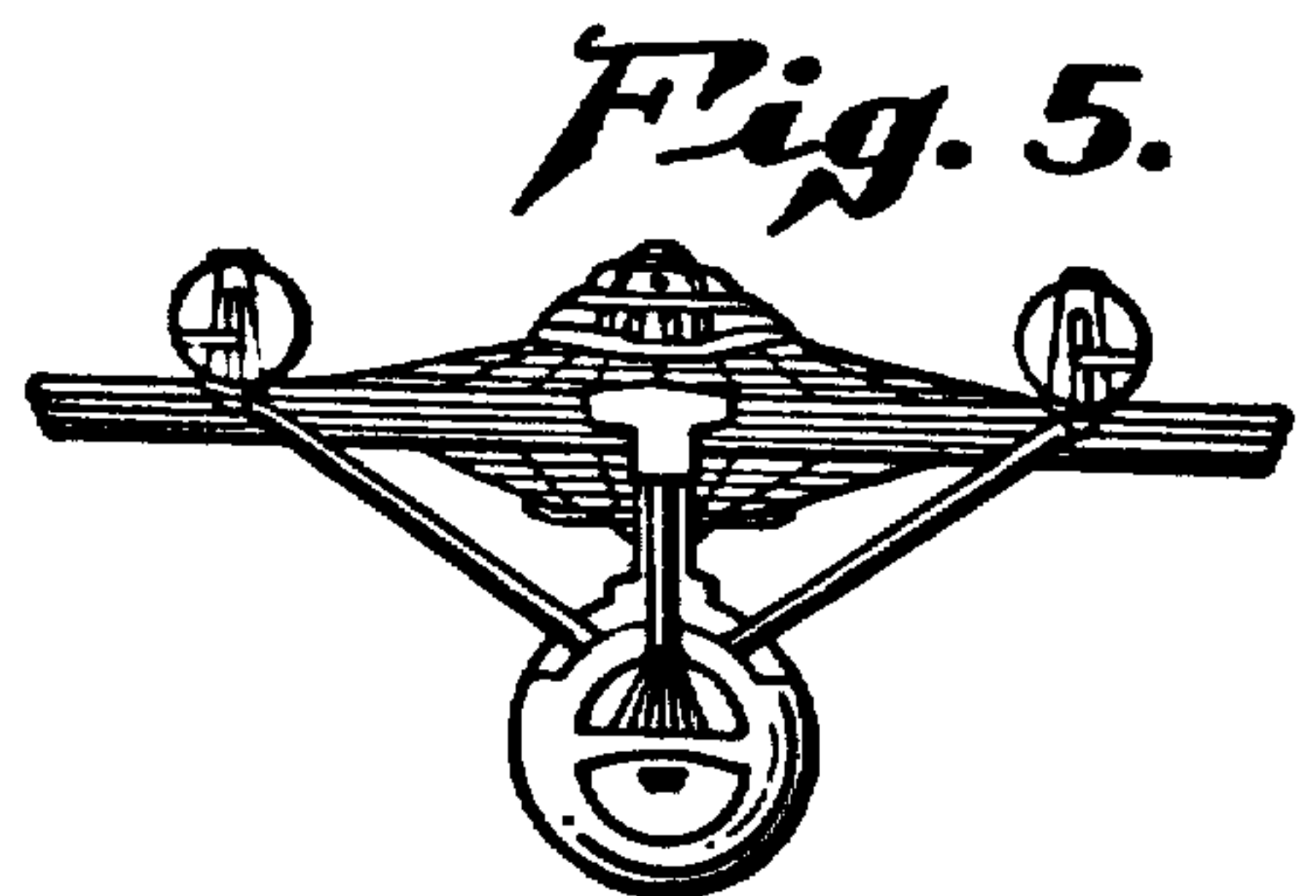
