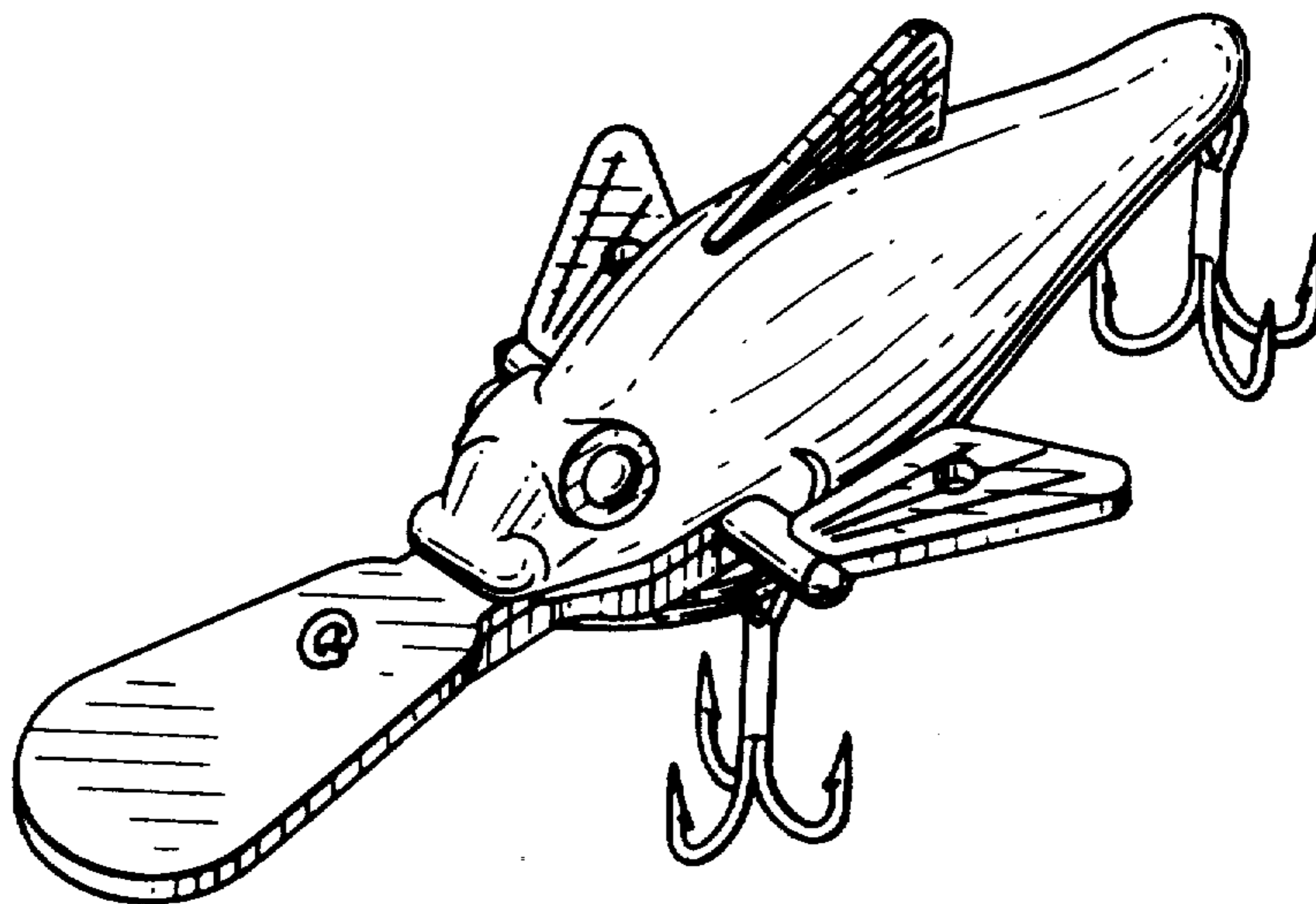

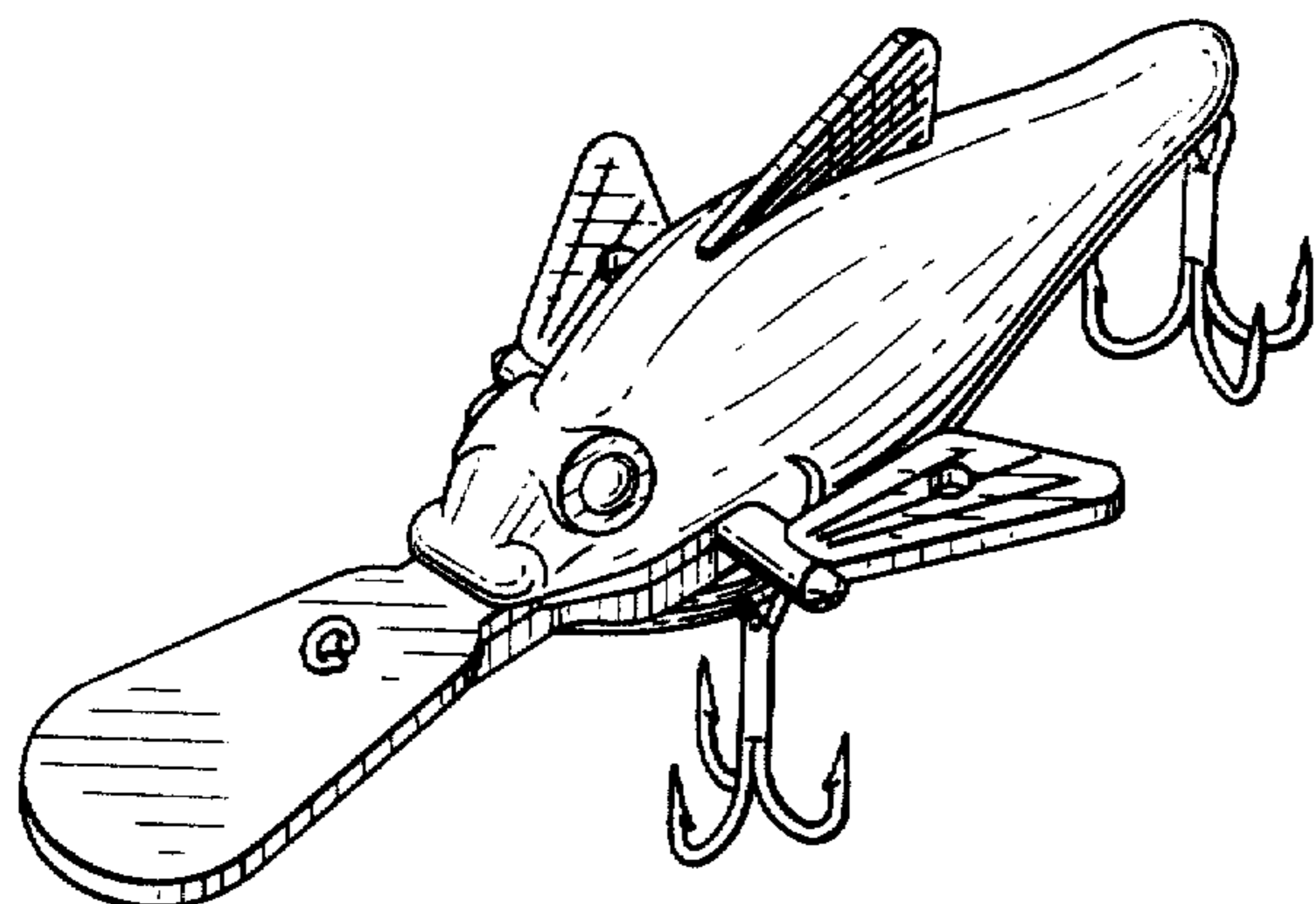

DESCRIPTION

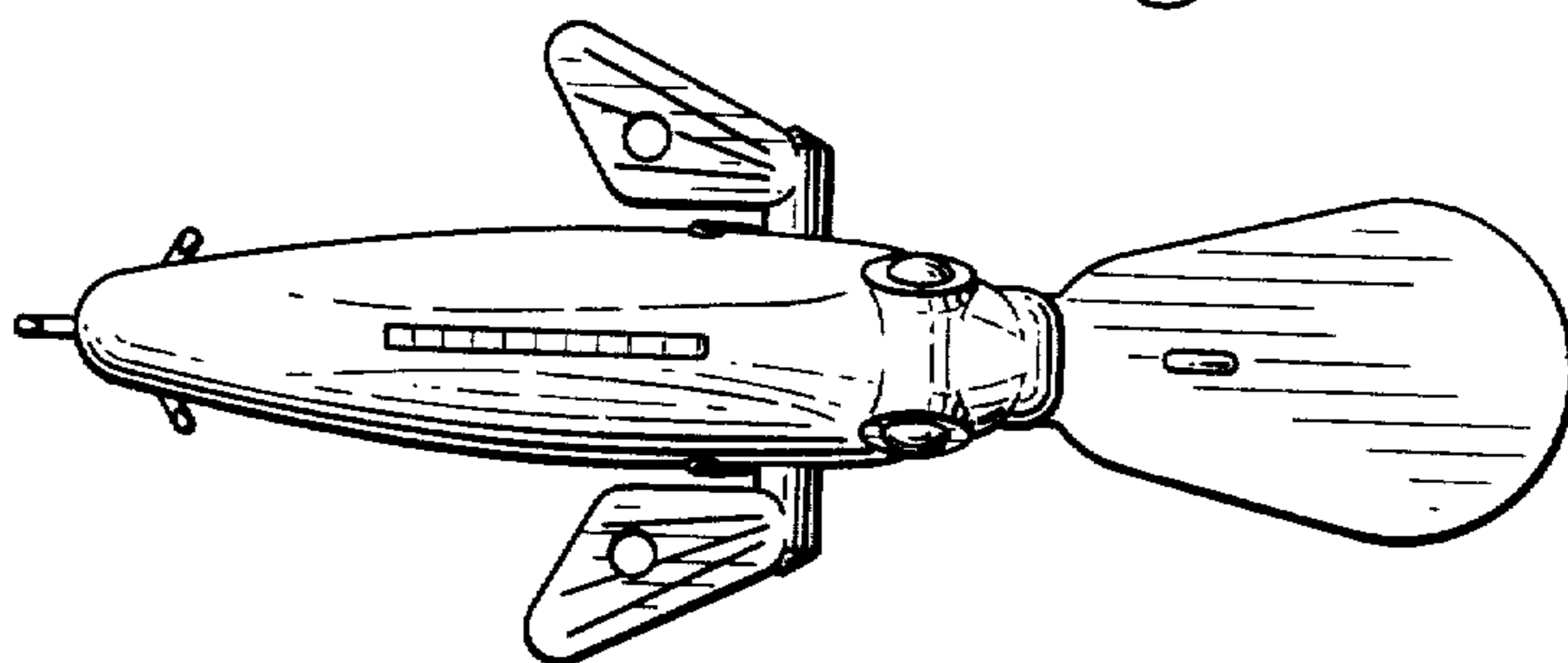

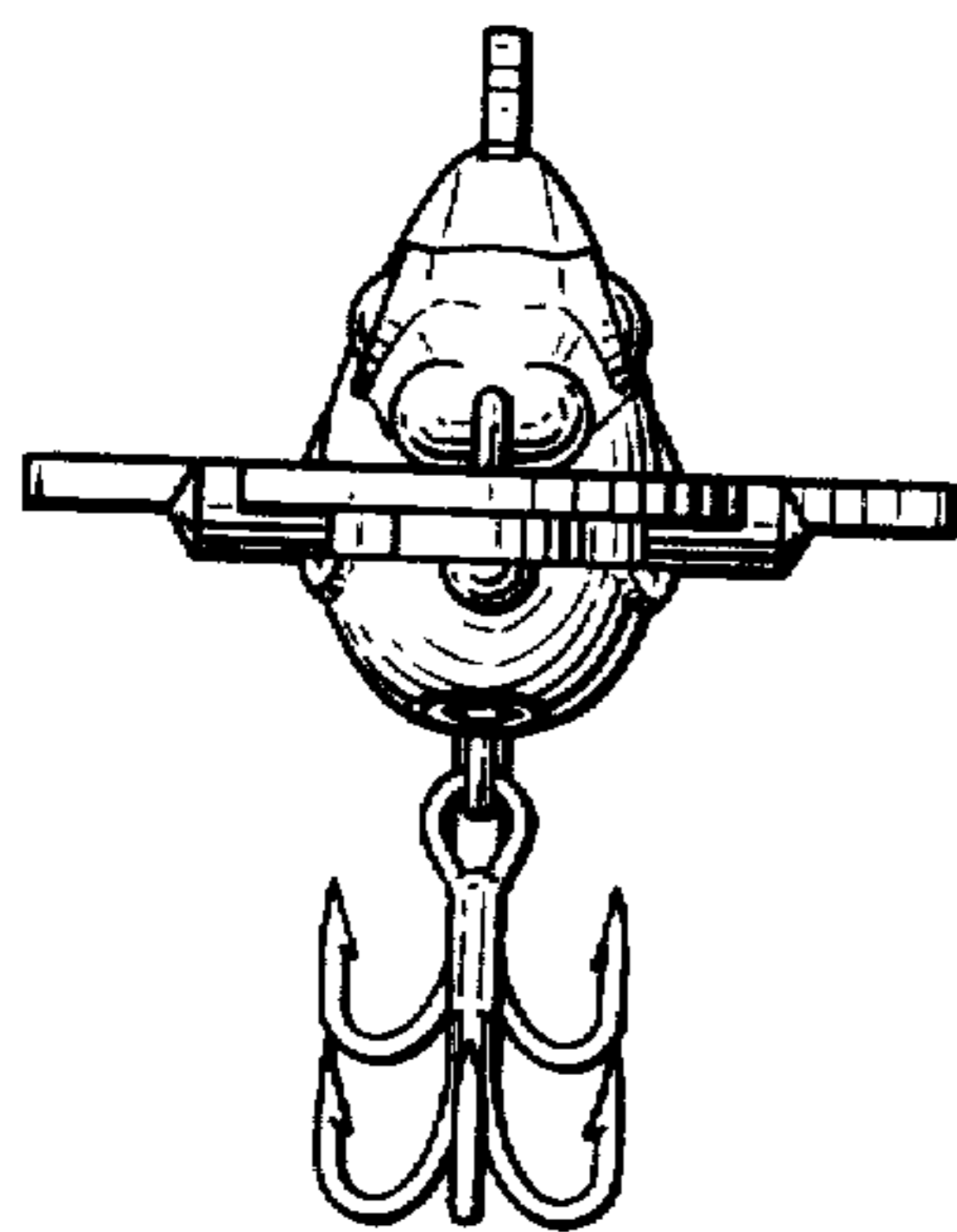

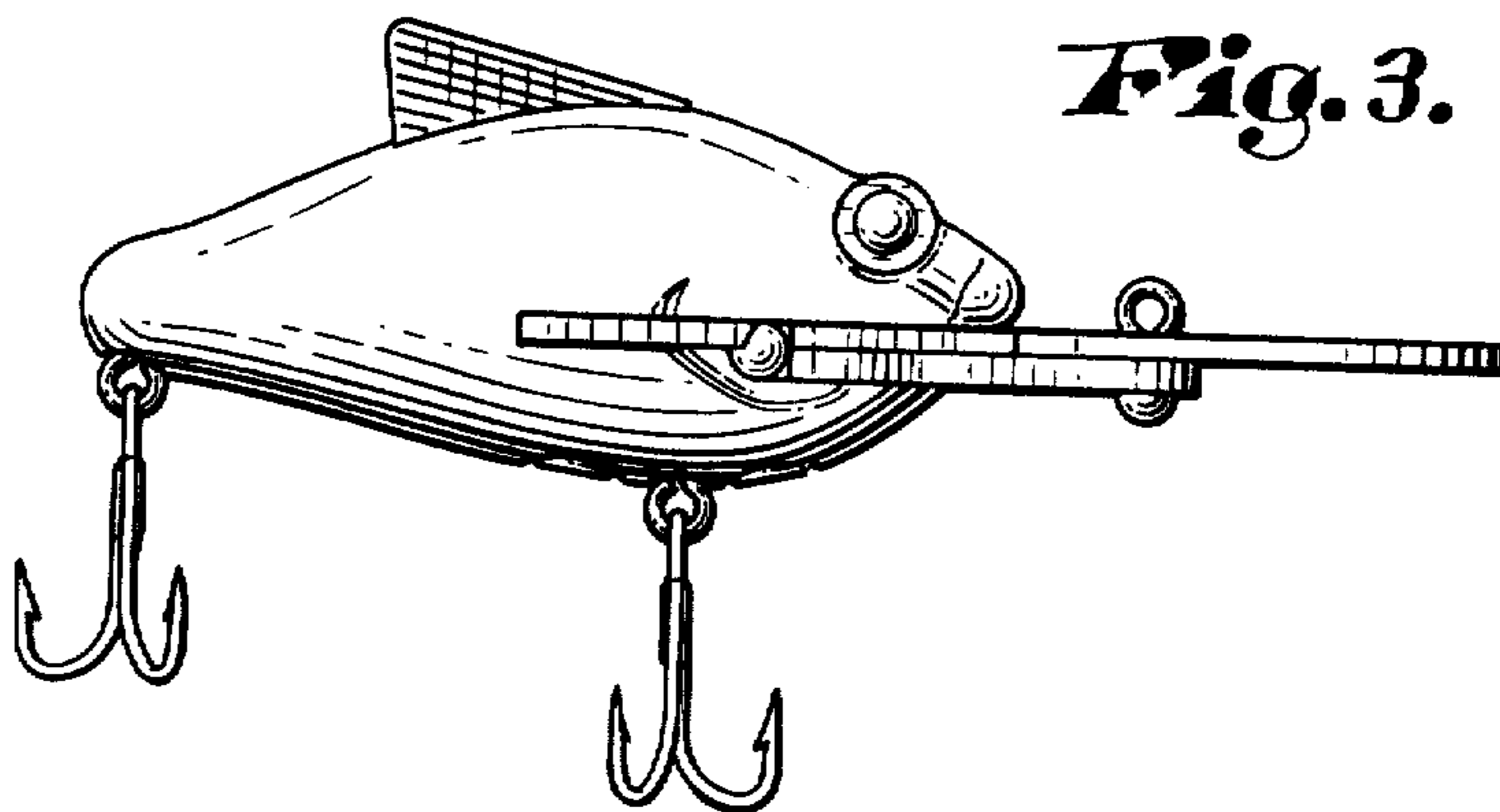

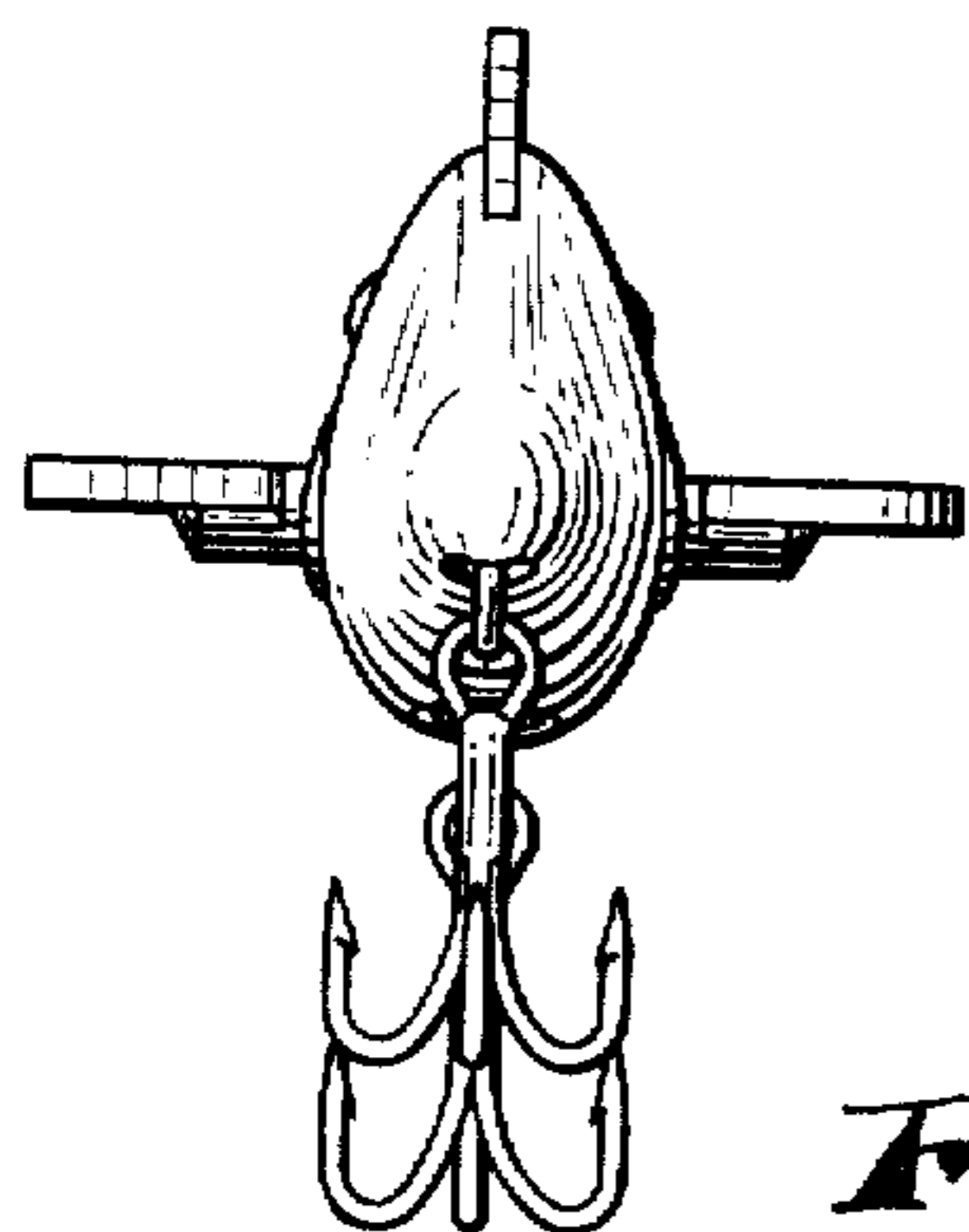
