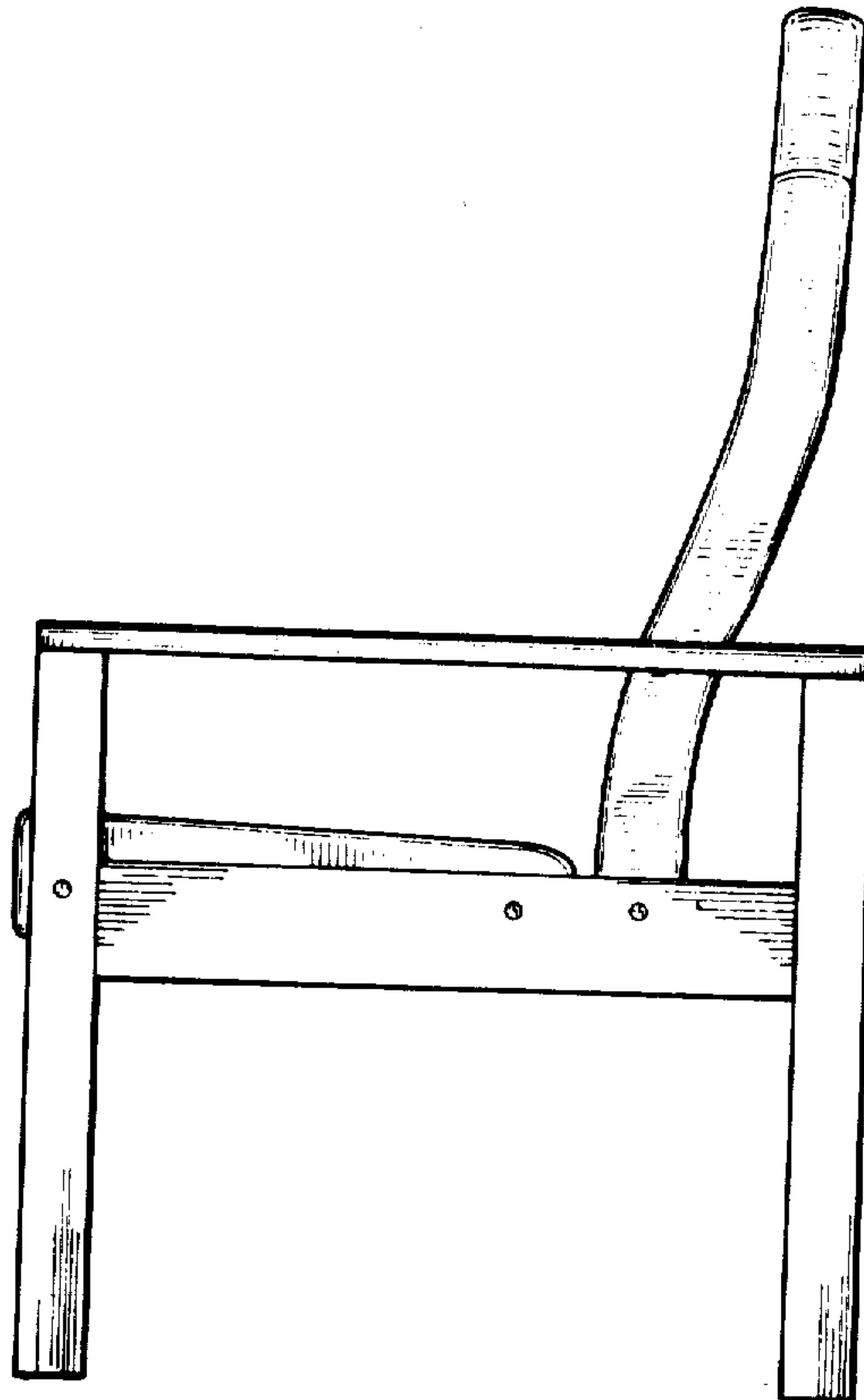

FIG. 4 is a front elevation thereof.



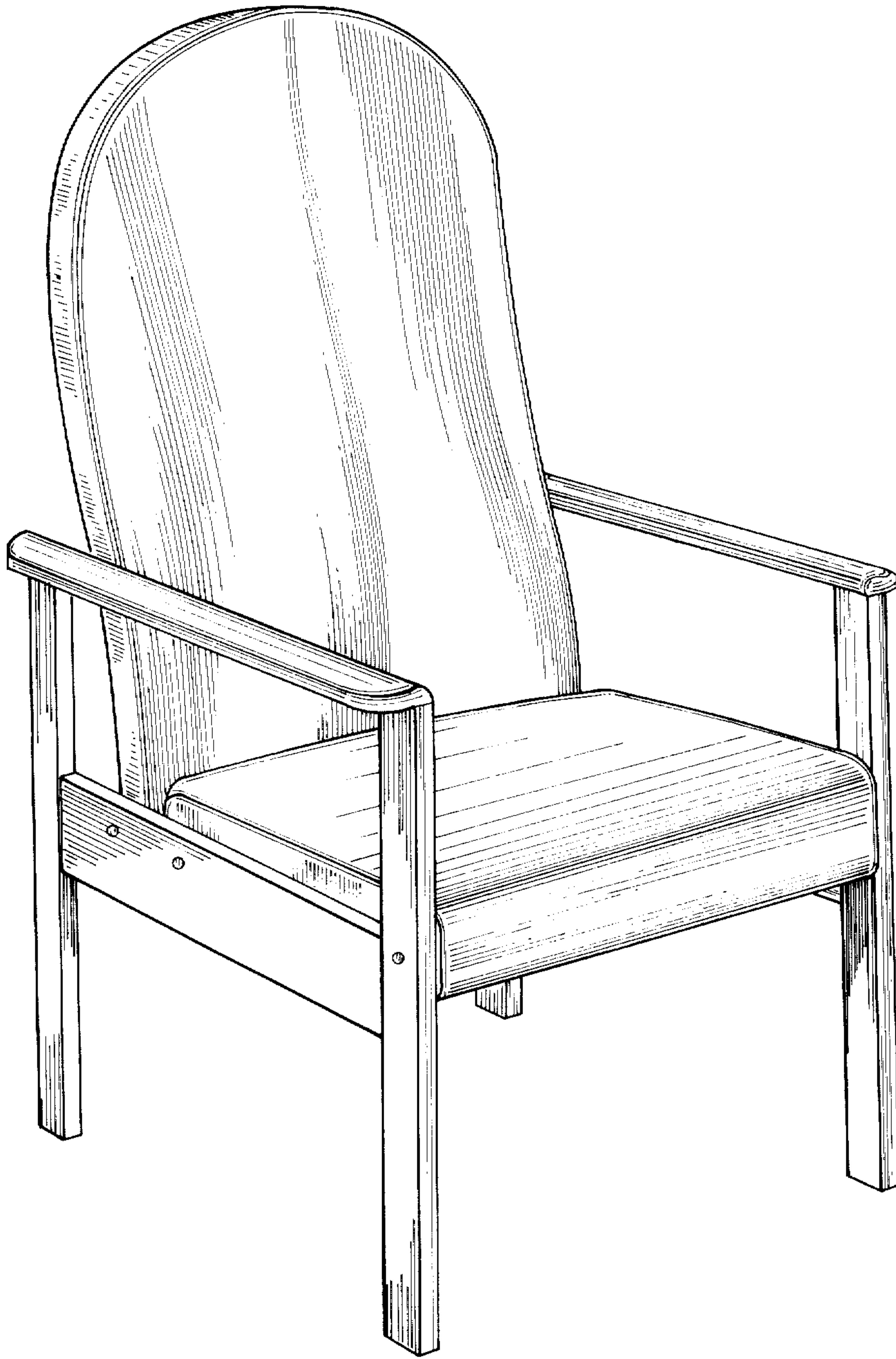

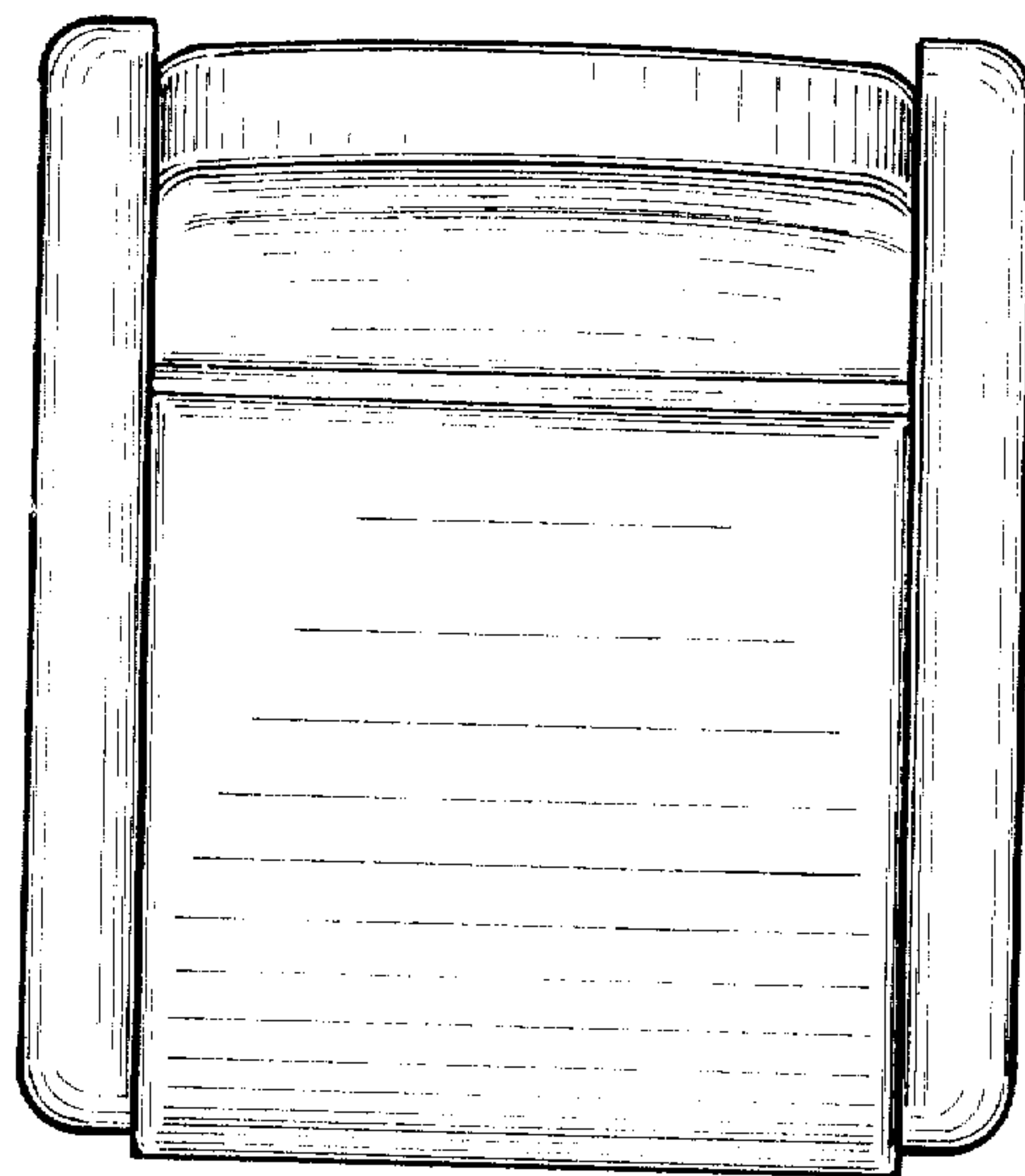

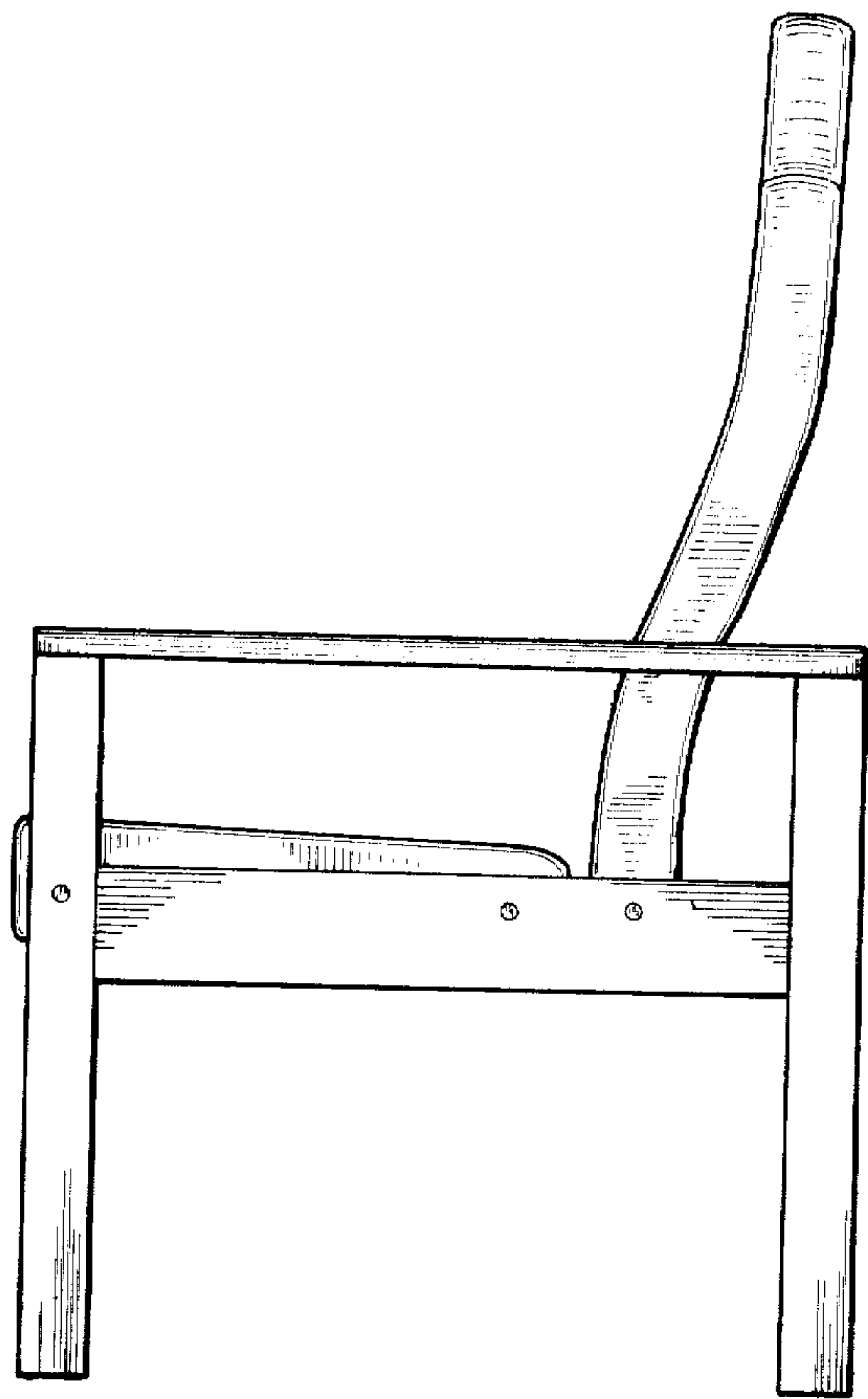

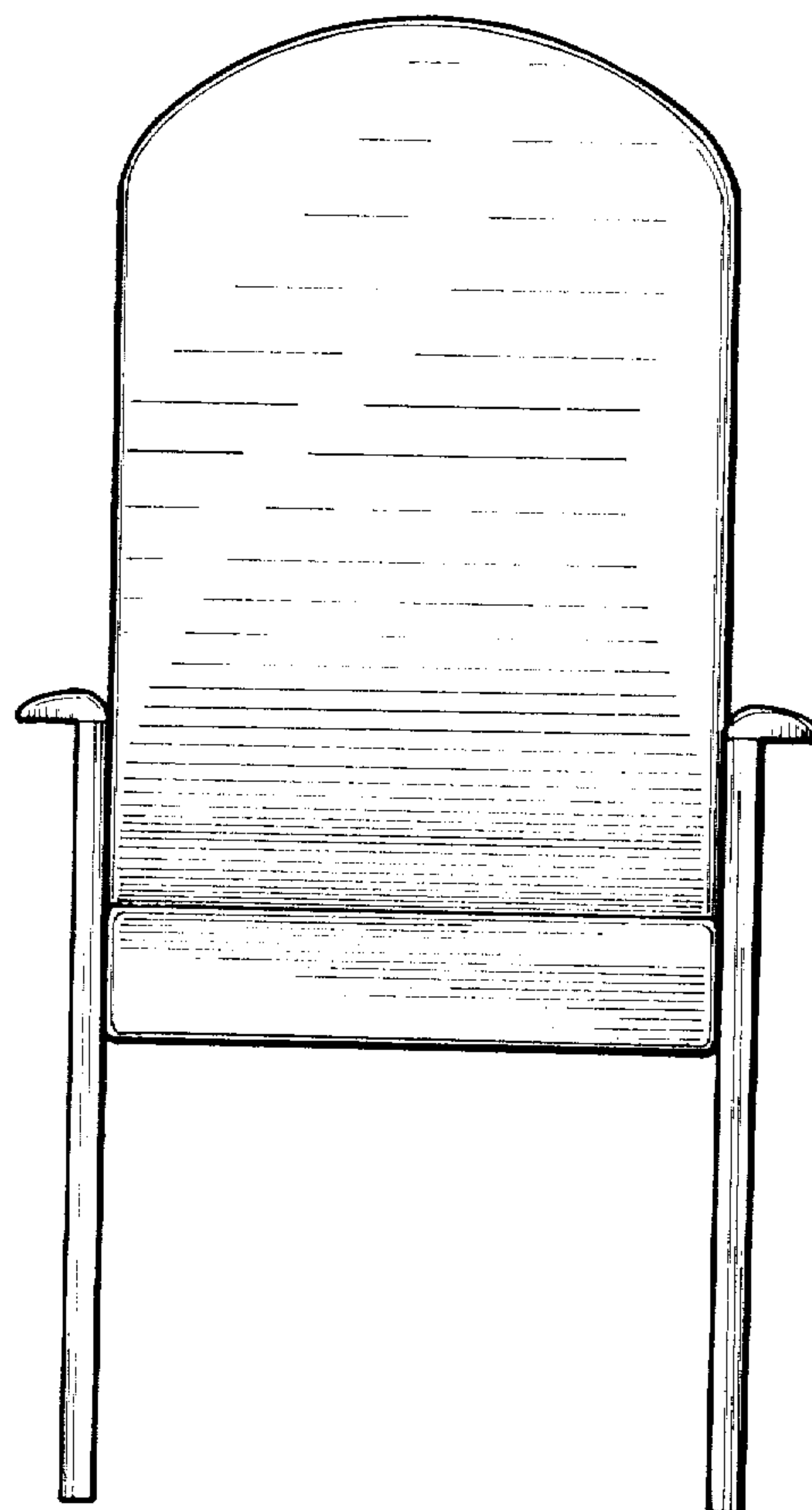
