The ornamental design for a vehicle track shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right top perspective view of a vehicle track shoe showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 4-4 in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken along lines 5-5 in FIG. 1.

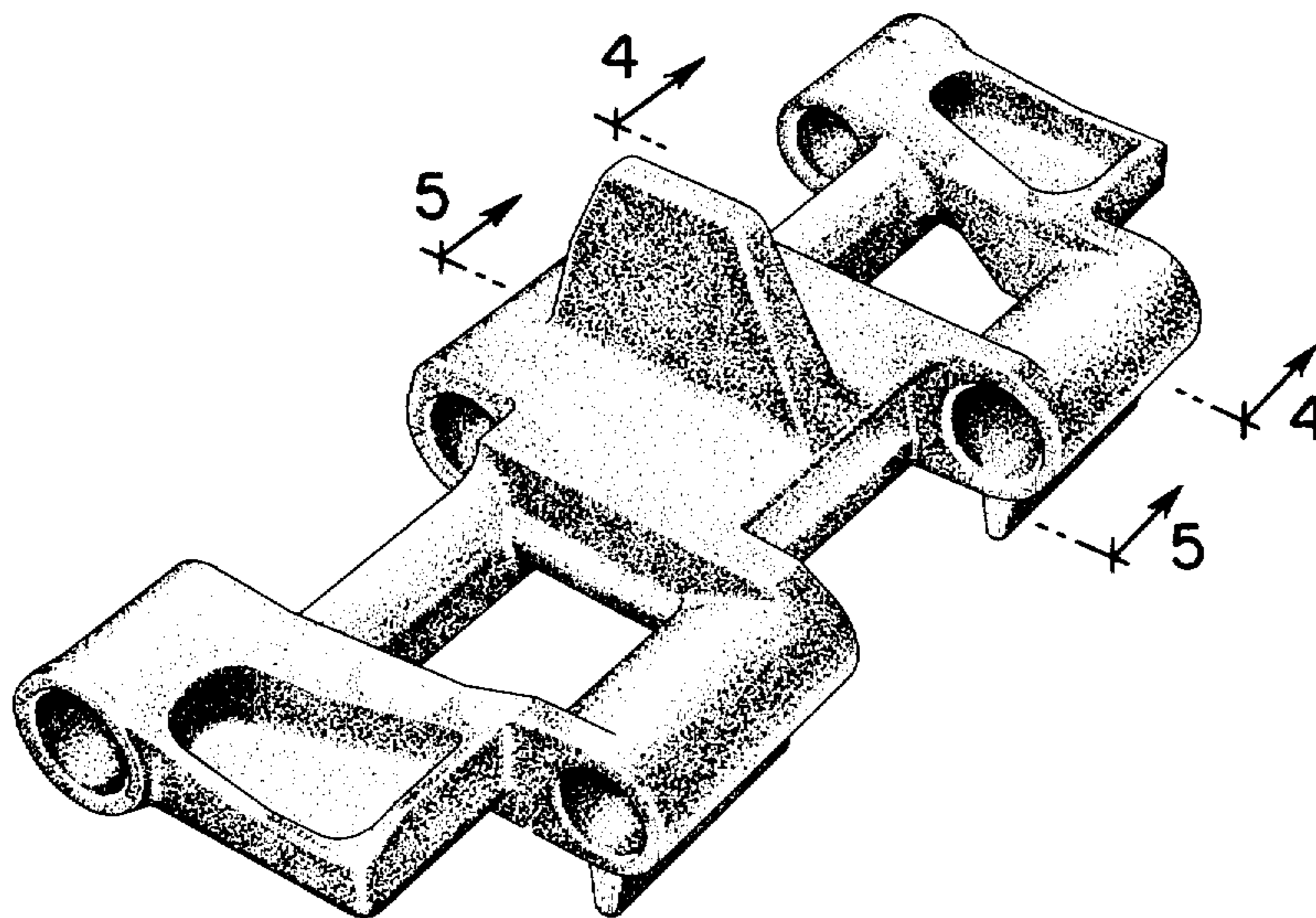

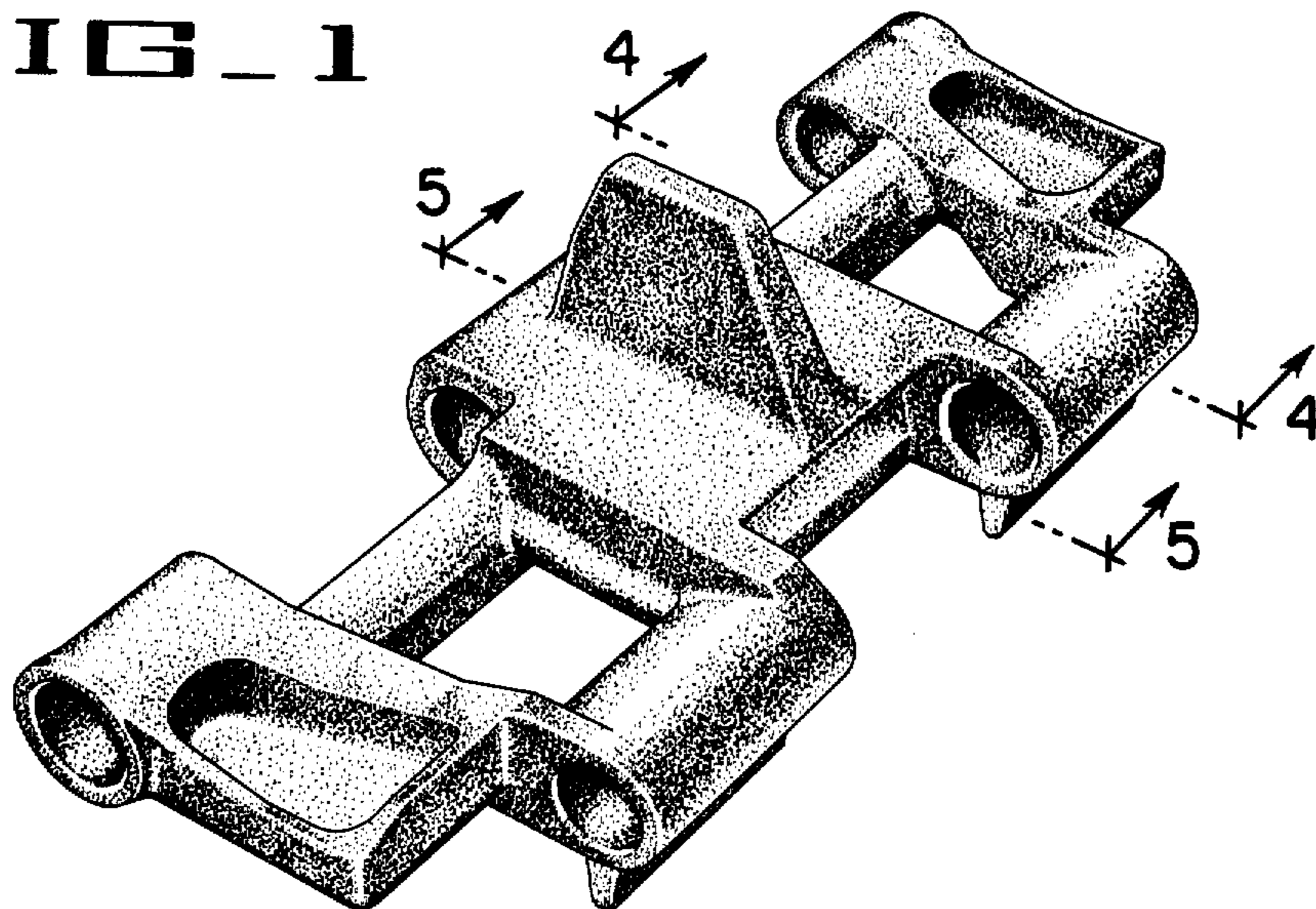

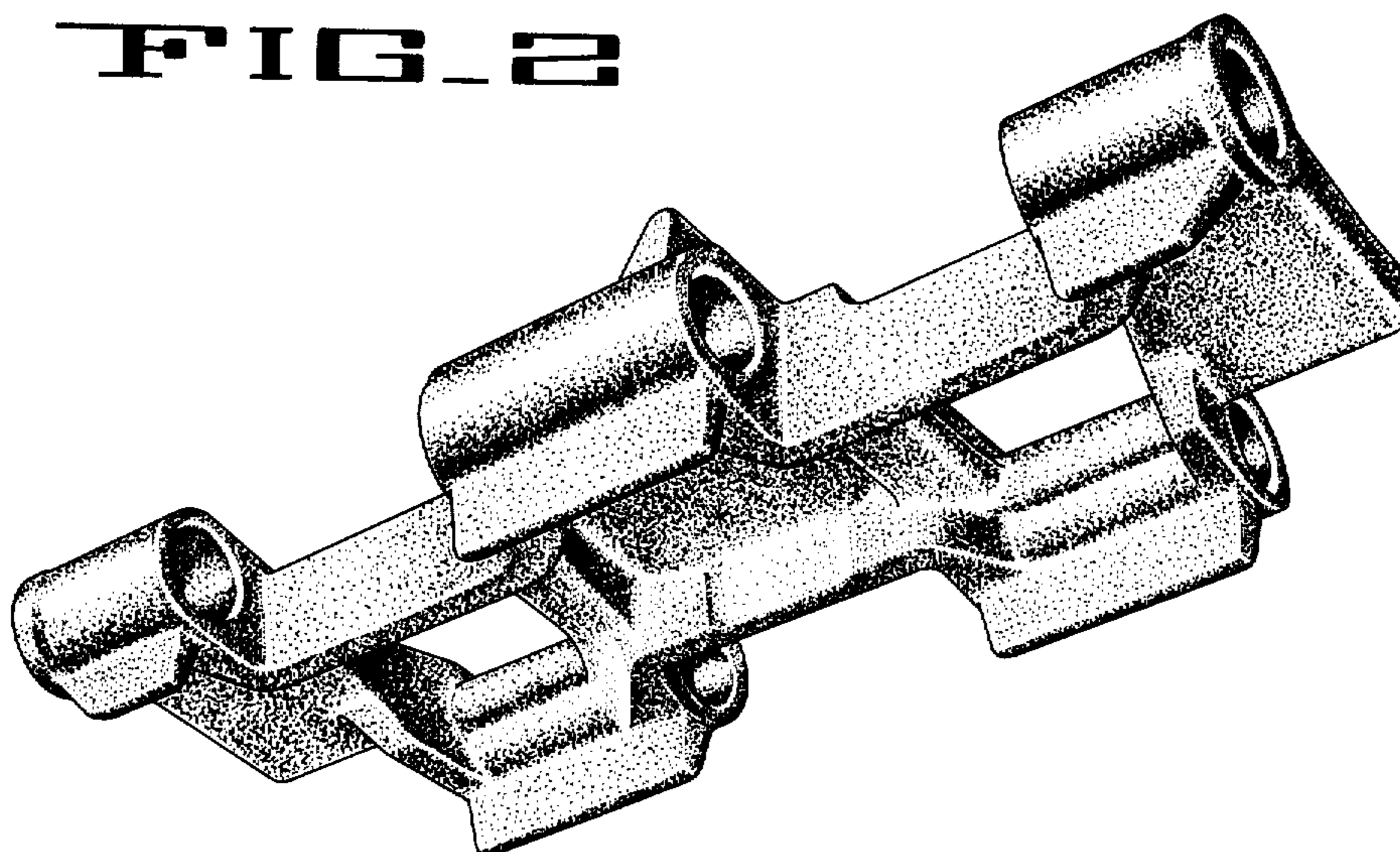

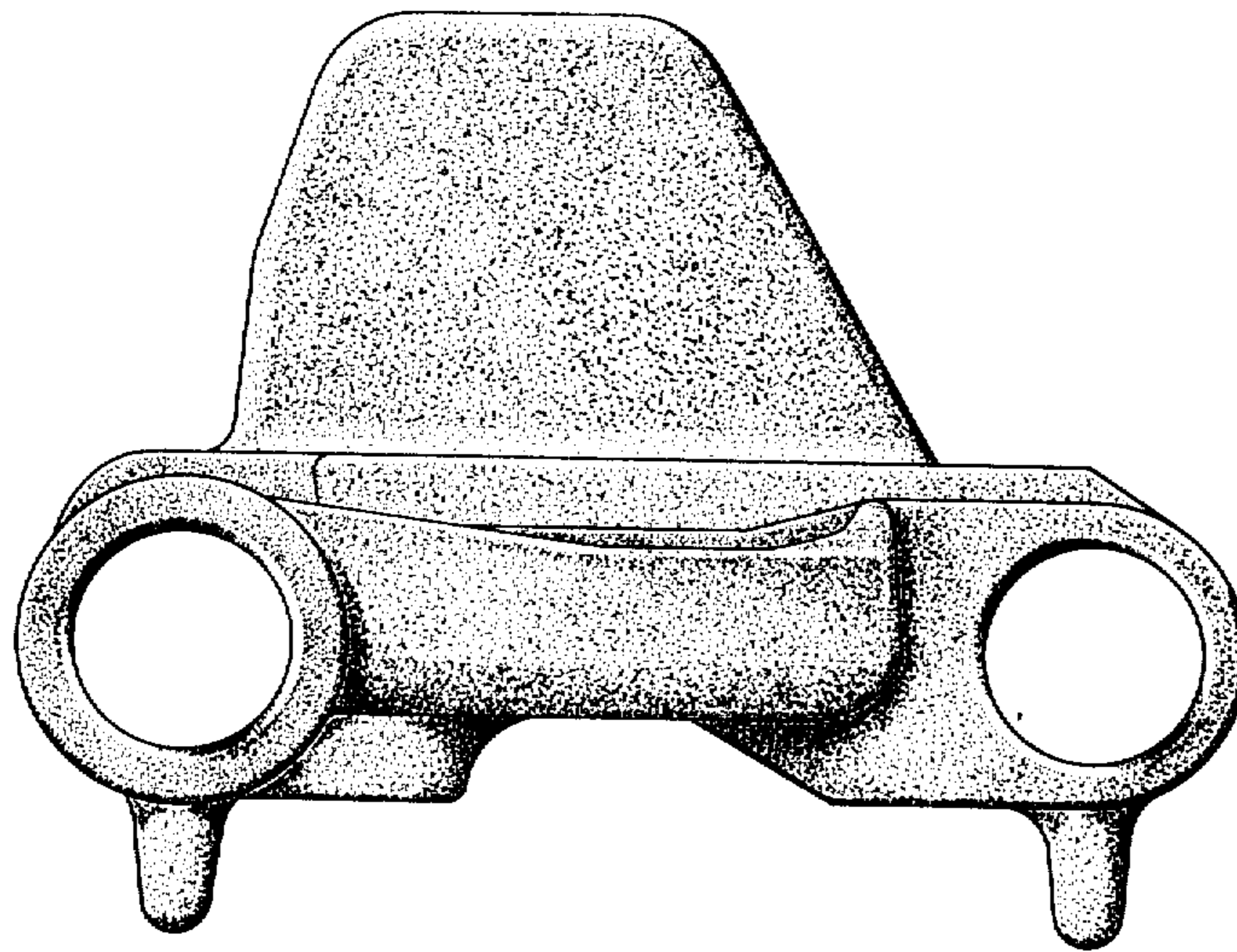

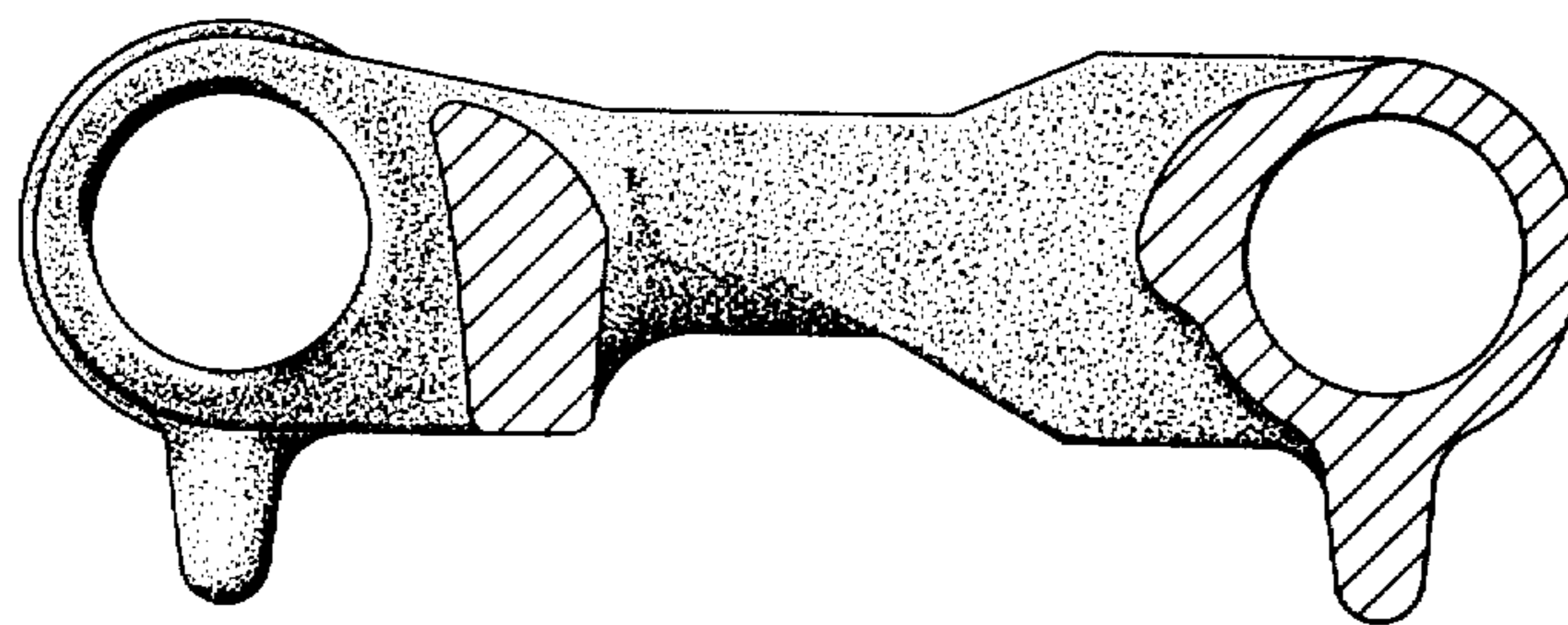
